
Takeaways

- As of 2024 the region's population **declined by 17.2**% since 2019, falling by 150. Population is expected to **increase by 11.4**% between 2024 and 2029, adding 82.
- From 2019 to 2024, jobs increased by 14.7% in Esmeralda County, NV from 339 to 389. This change outpaced the national growth rate of 4.4% by 10.3%. As the number of jobs increased, the labor force participation rate increased from 37.7% to 45.0% between 2019 and 2024.
- Concerning educational attainment, **14.7% of Esmeralda County, NV residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (6.8% below the national average), and **5.9% hold an Associate's Degree** (3.0% below the national average).
- The top three industries in 2024 are Local Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals, Nonmetallic Mineral Mining and Quarrying, and Support Activities for Mining.








Unemployment by Gender



Unemployment by Ethnicity












Esmeralda County, NV had an August 2025 unemployment rate of 4.66%, decreasing from 7.52% 5 years before.


Millennials

Esmeralda County, NV has 102 veterans. The national average for an area this size is 36.




Retiring Soon
















Top Industry Employment Concentration






Top Growing Occupations




Top Occupation Employment Concentration


Top Occupation Earnings




