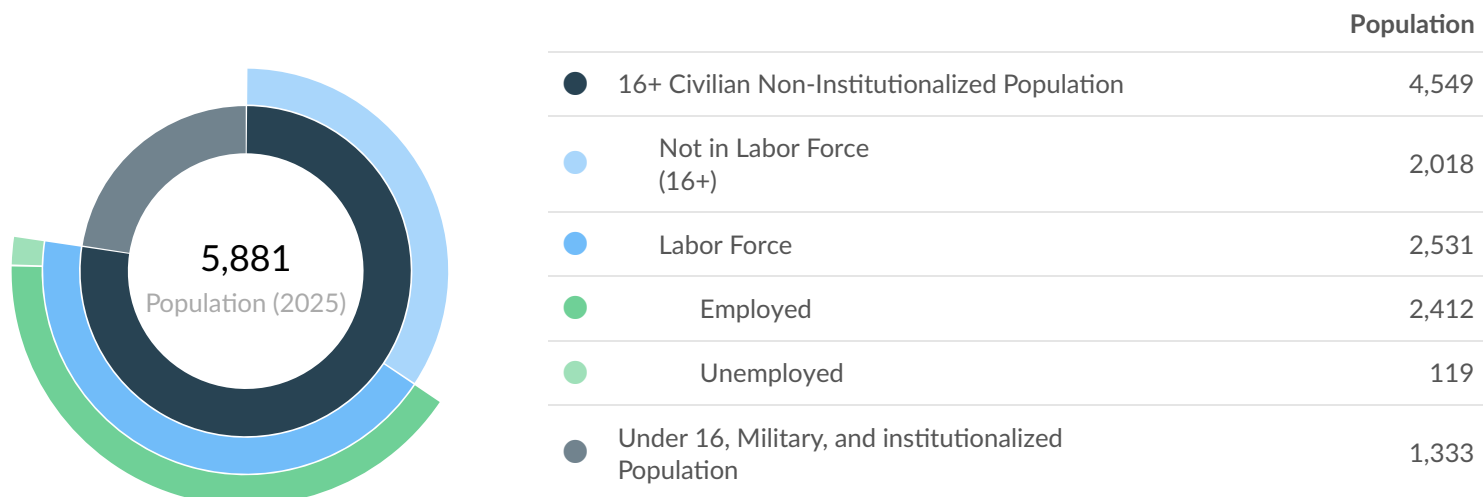
Median household income is **\$5.9K above** the national median household income of \$78.5K.

Takeaways

- As of 2024 the region's population **increased by 4.9%** since 2019, growing by 269. Population is expected to **increase by 7.7%** between 2024 and 2029, adding 445.
- From 2019 to 2024, jobs **increased by 6.0%** in Lander County, NV from 3,732 to **3,955**. This change **outpaced the national growth rate of 4.4% by 1.6%**. As the number of jobs increased, the **labor force participation rate decreased from 60.1% to 54.2% between 2019 and 2024**.
- Concerning educational attainment, **6.2% of Lander County, NV residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (15.3% below the national average), and **15.6% hold an Associate's Degree** (6.8% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2024 are Metal Ore Mining, Education and Hospitals (Local Government), and Local Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals.

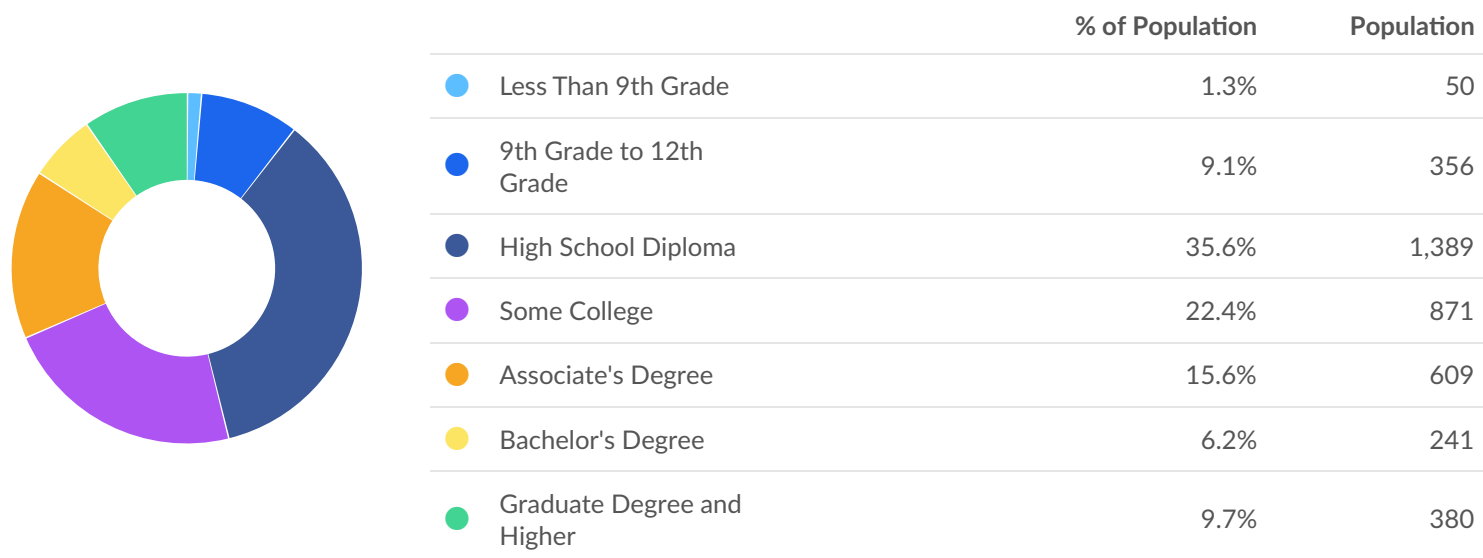

Aug 2025 Labor Force Breakdown



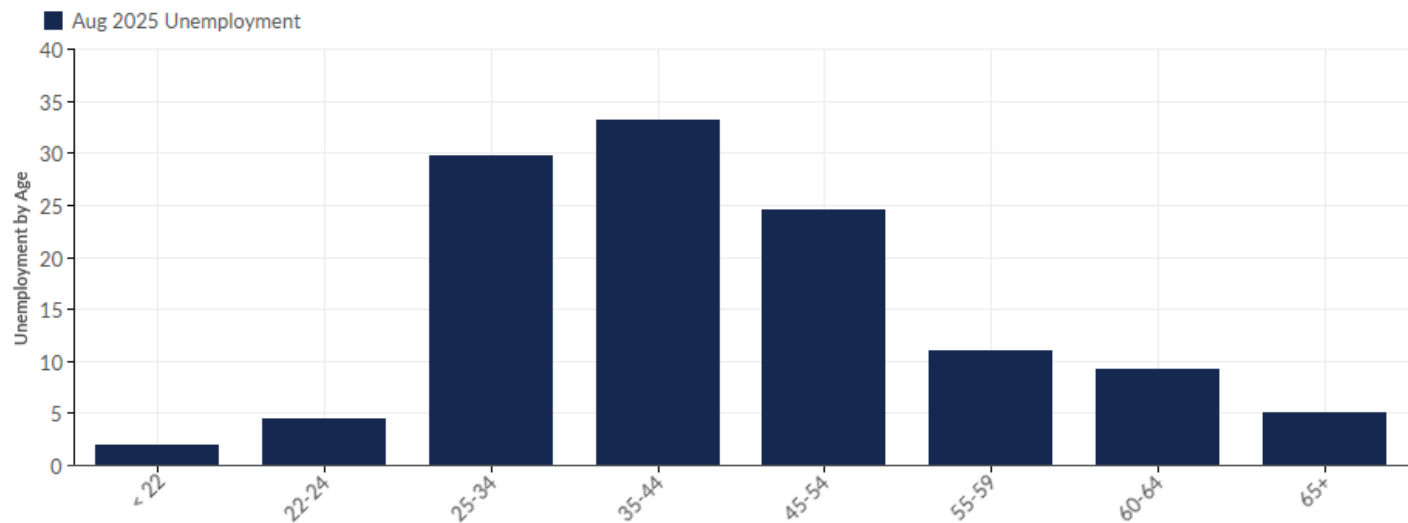
Educational Attainment

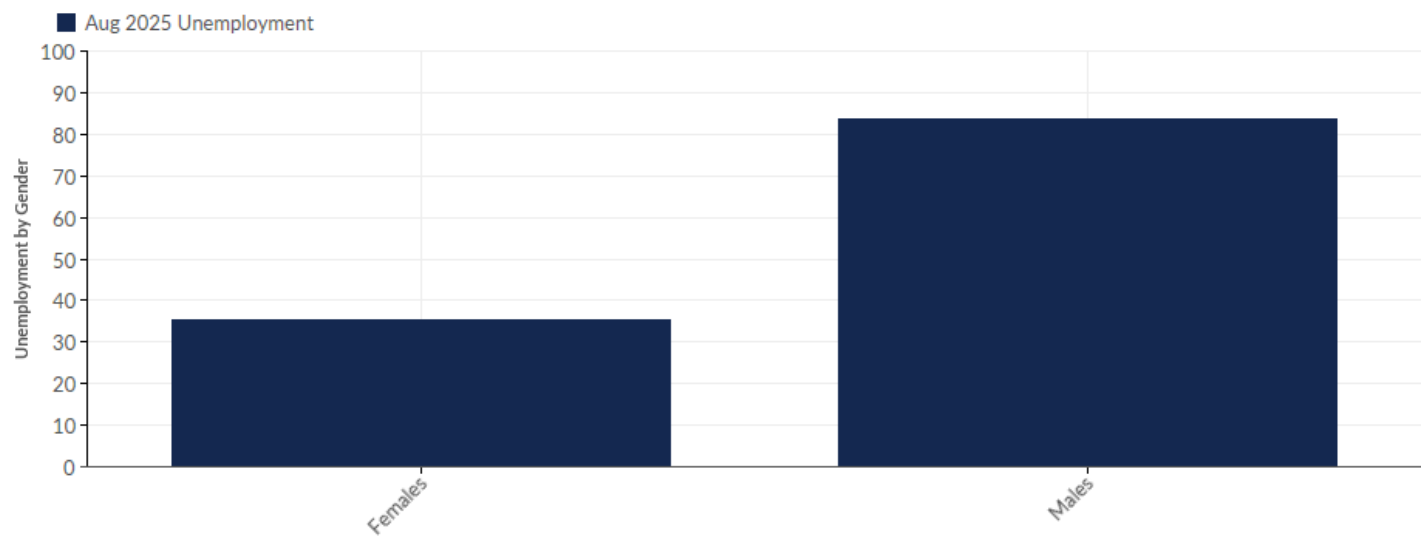

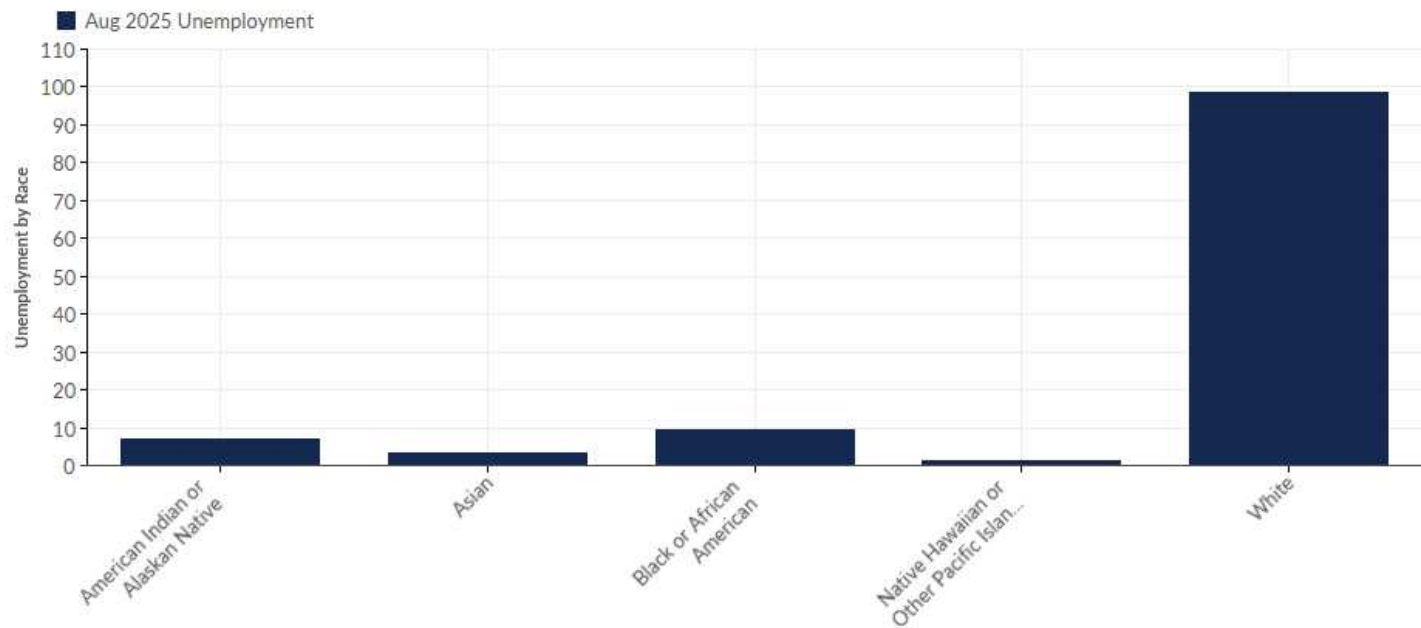

Unemployment by Gender



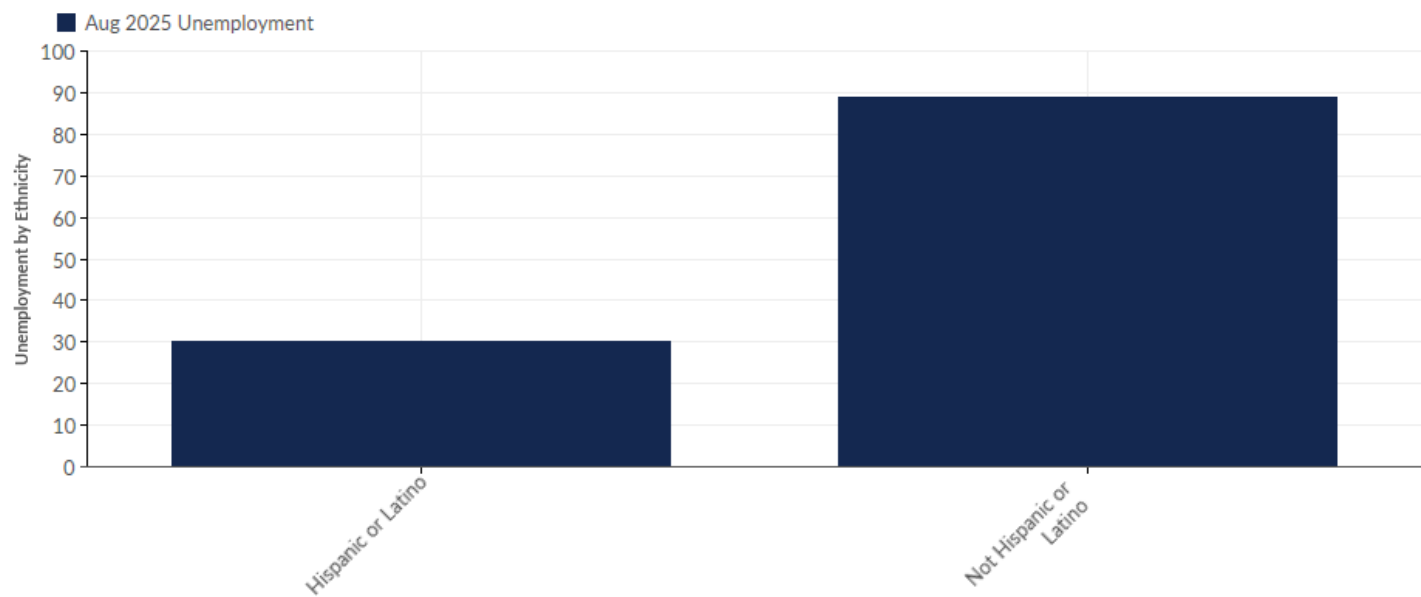

Unemployment by Ethnicity

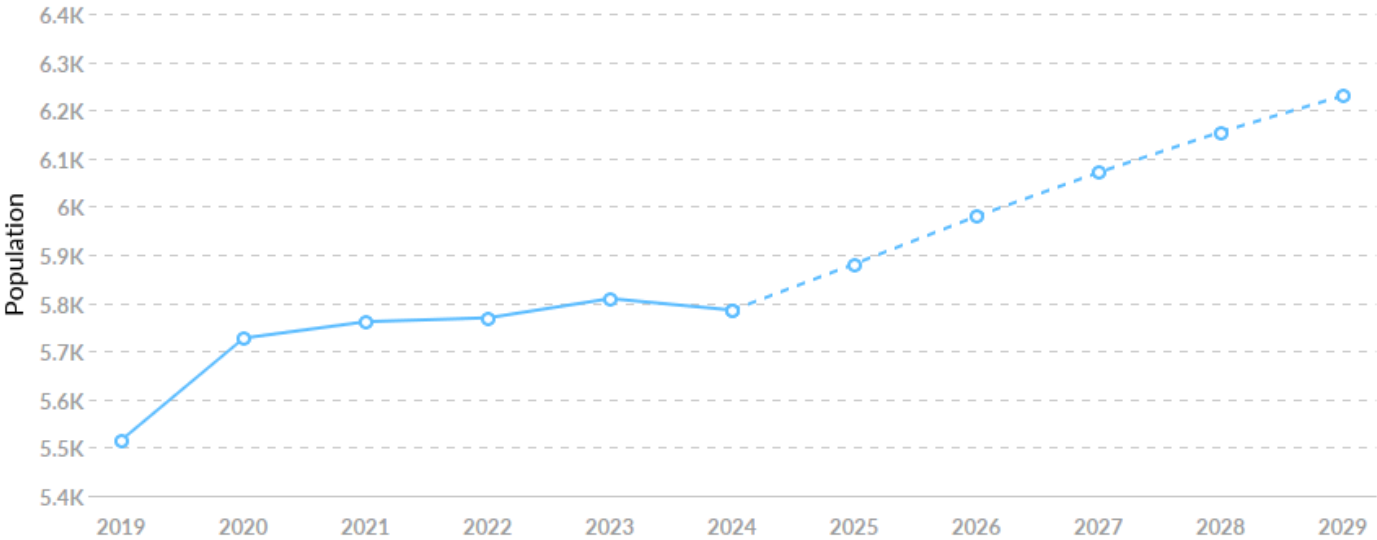

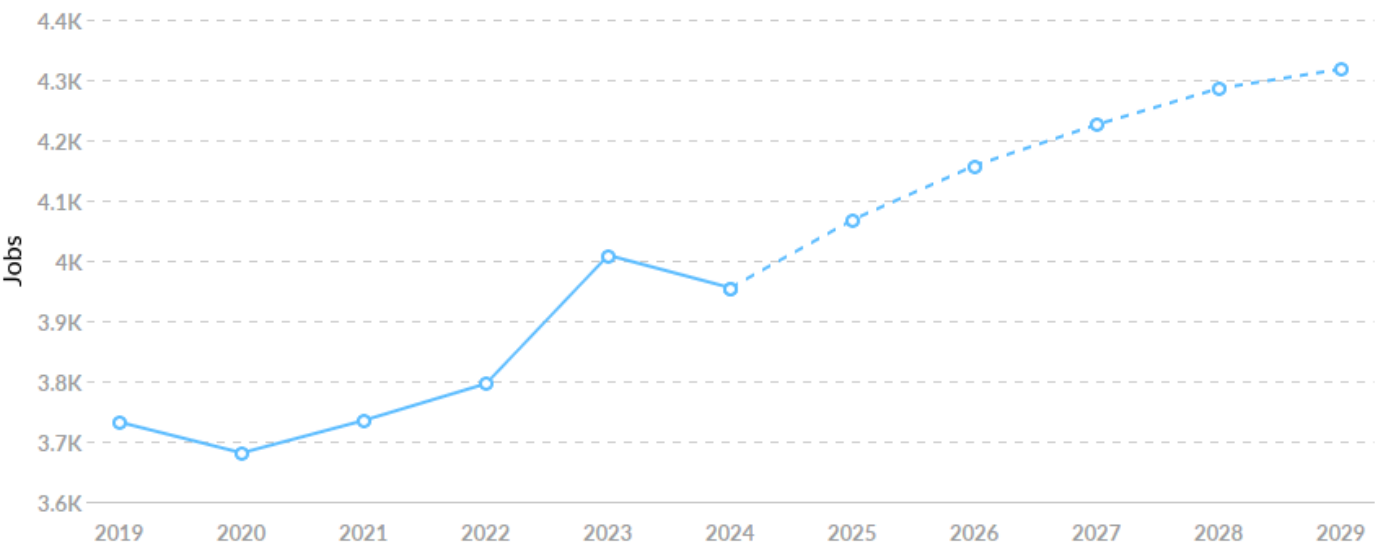

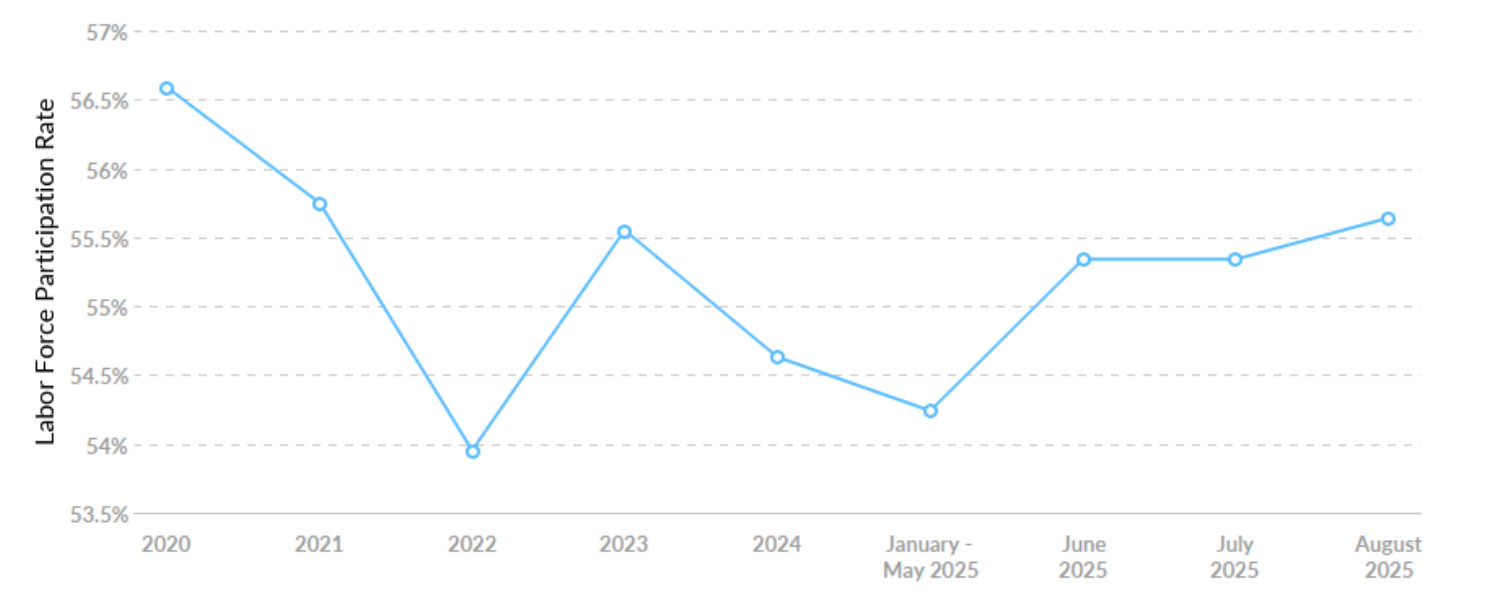
Job Trends

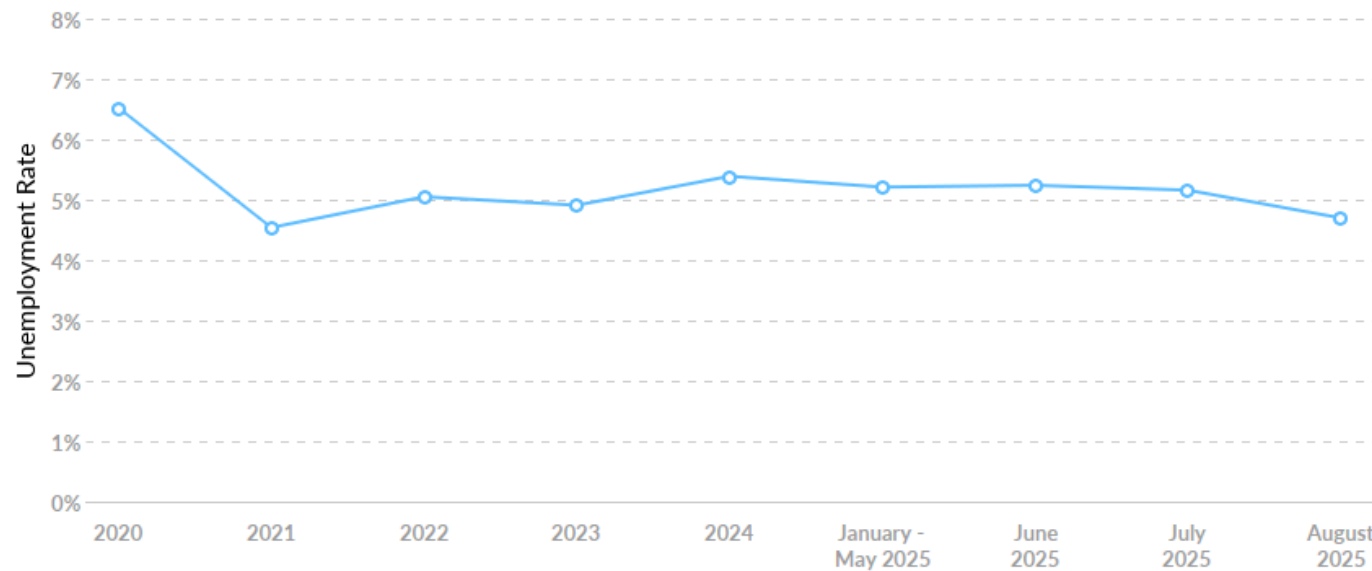

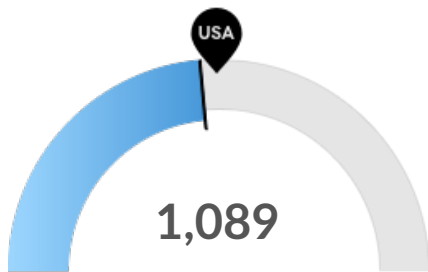
Unemployment Rate Trends

Lander County, NV had an August 2025 unemployment rate of 4.70%, **decreasing from 6.52%** 5 years before.



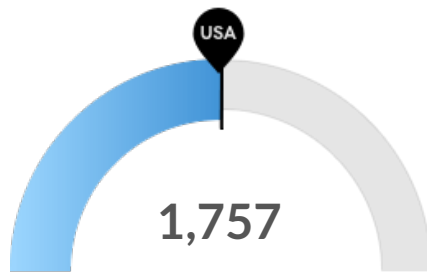

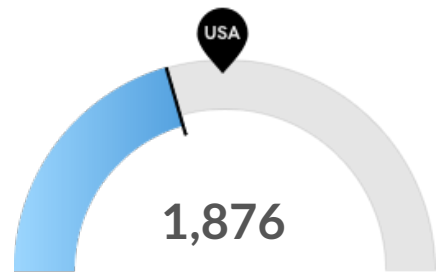
Millennials

Lander County, NV has 1,089 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 1,184.



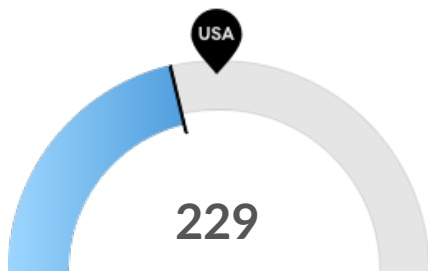
Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is about average in Lander County, NV. The national average for an area this size is 1,749 people 55 or older, while there are 1,757 here.



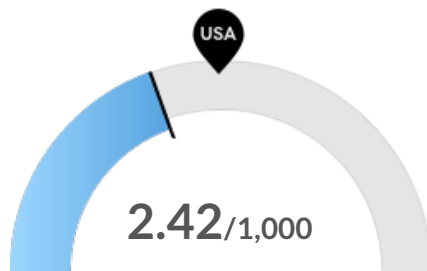
Racial Diversity

Racial diversity is low in Lander County, NV. The national average for an area this size is 2,461 racially diverse people, while there are 1,876 here.



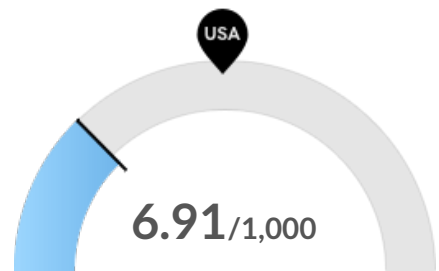
Veterans

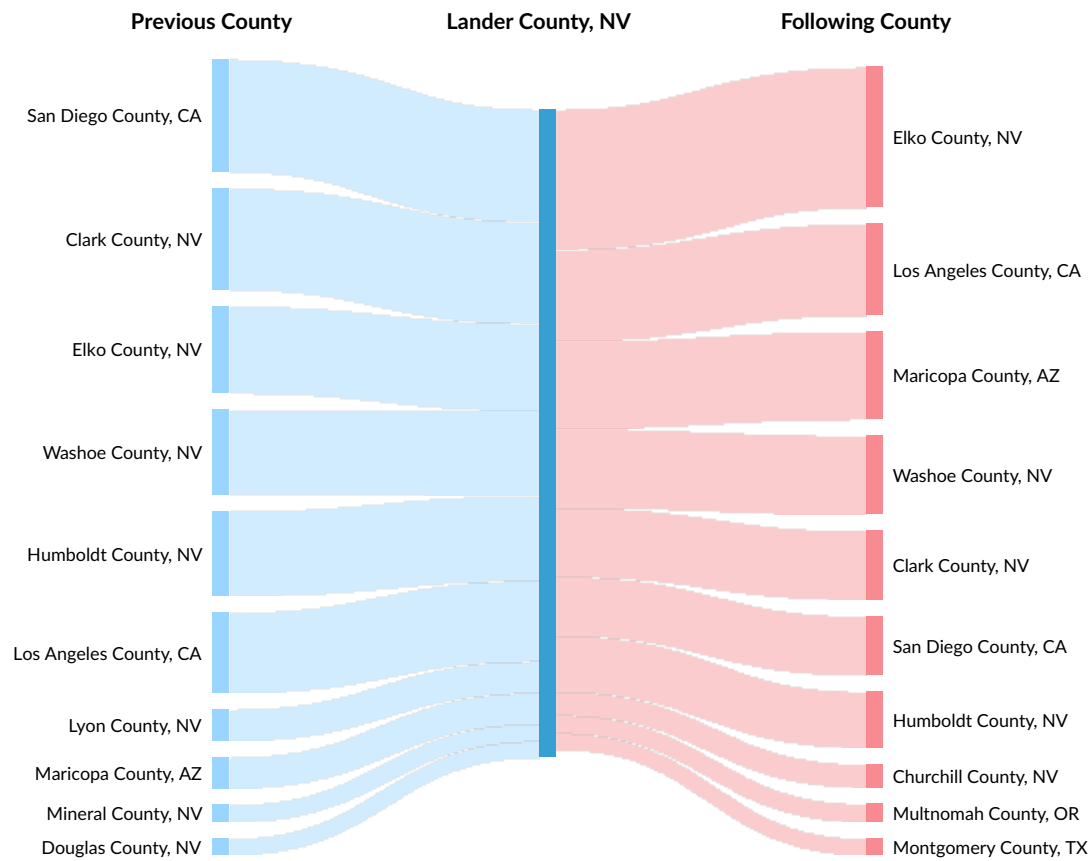

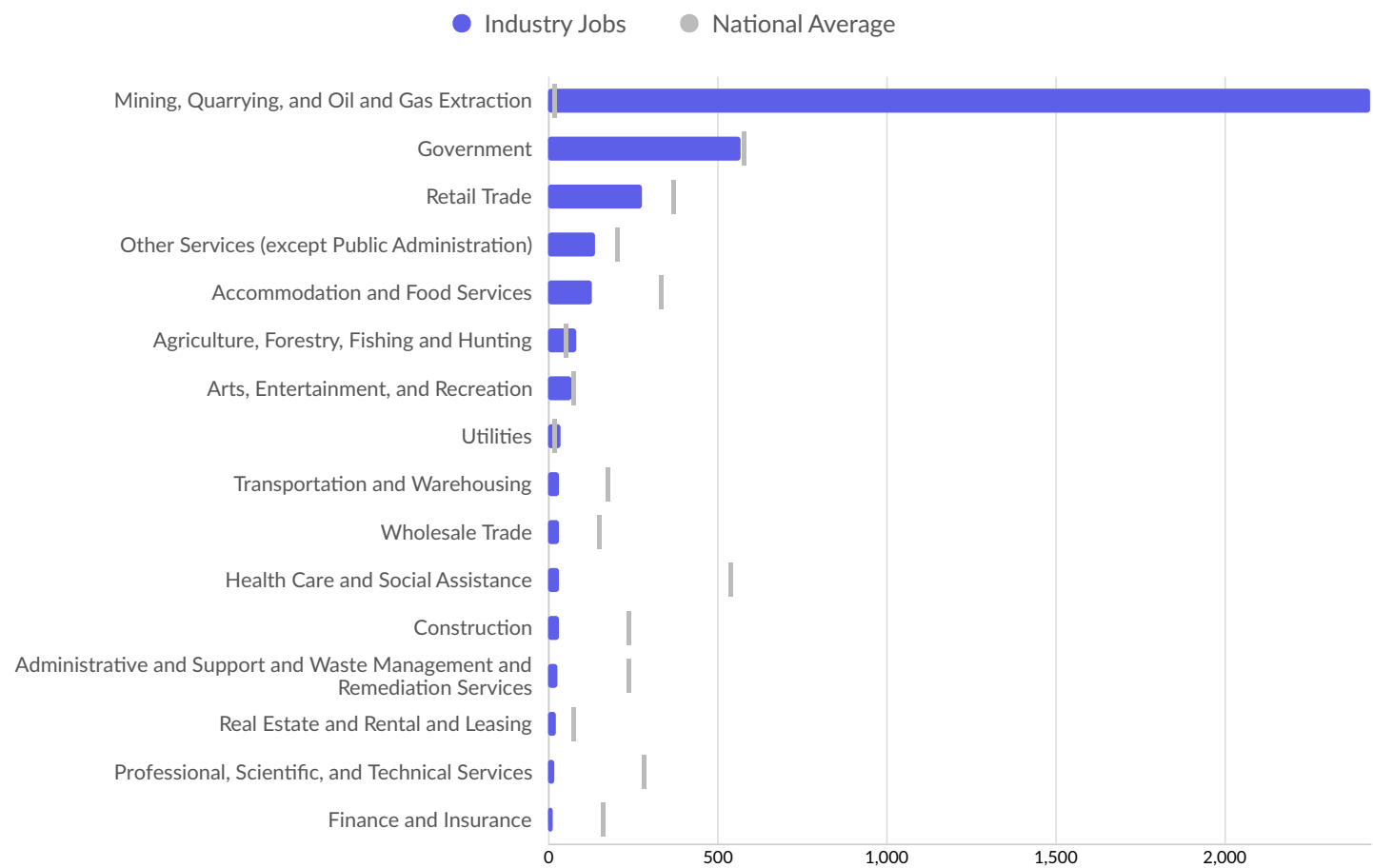

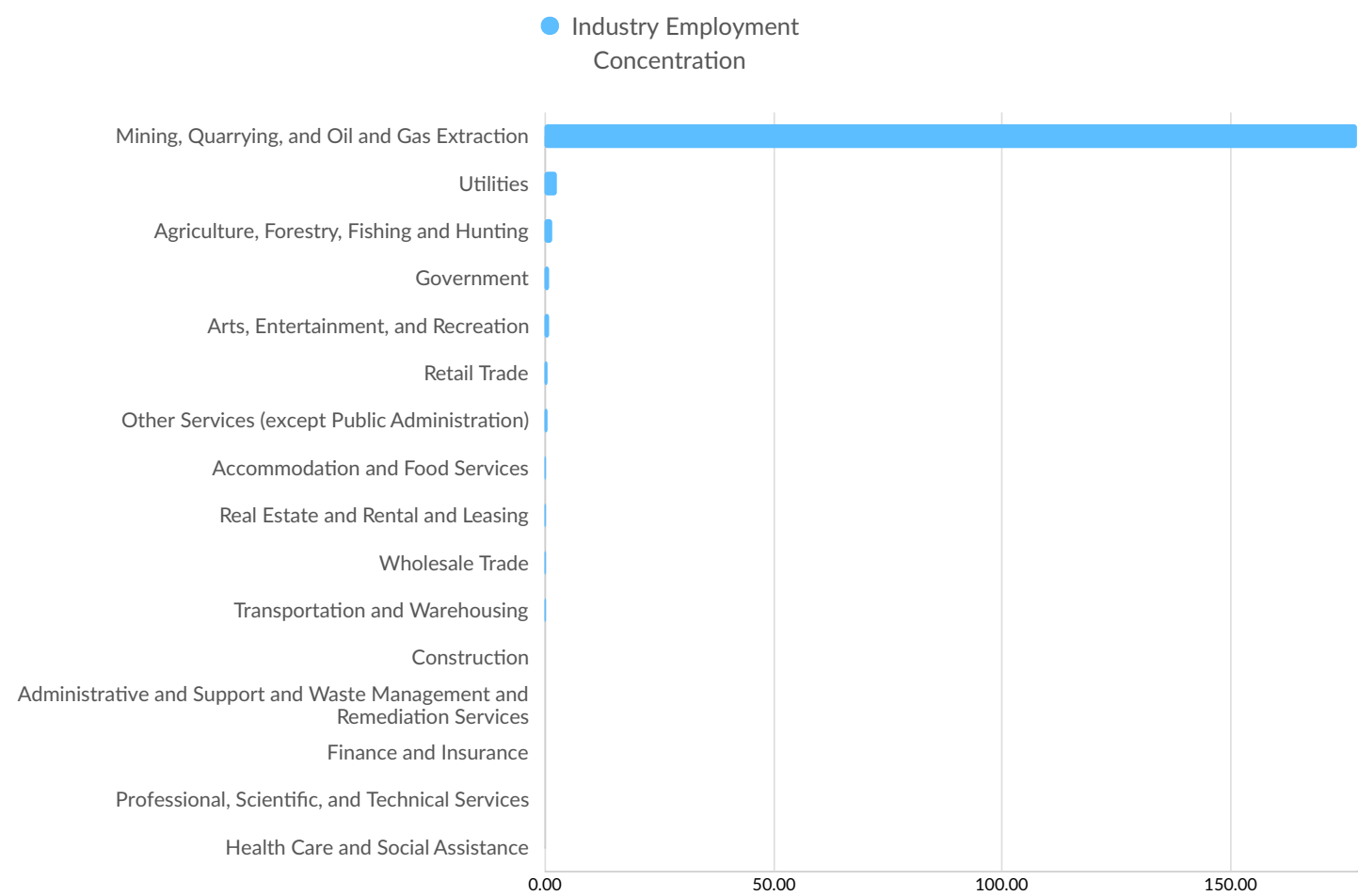

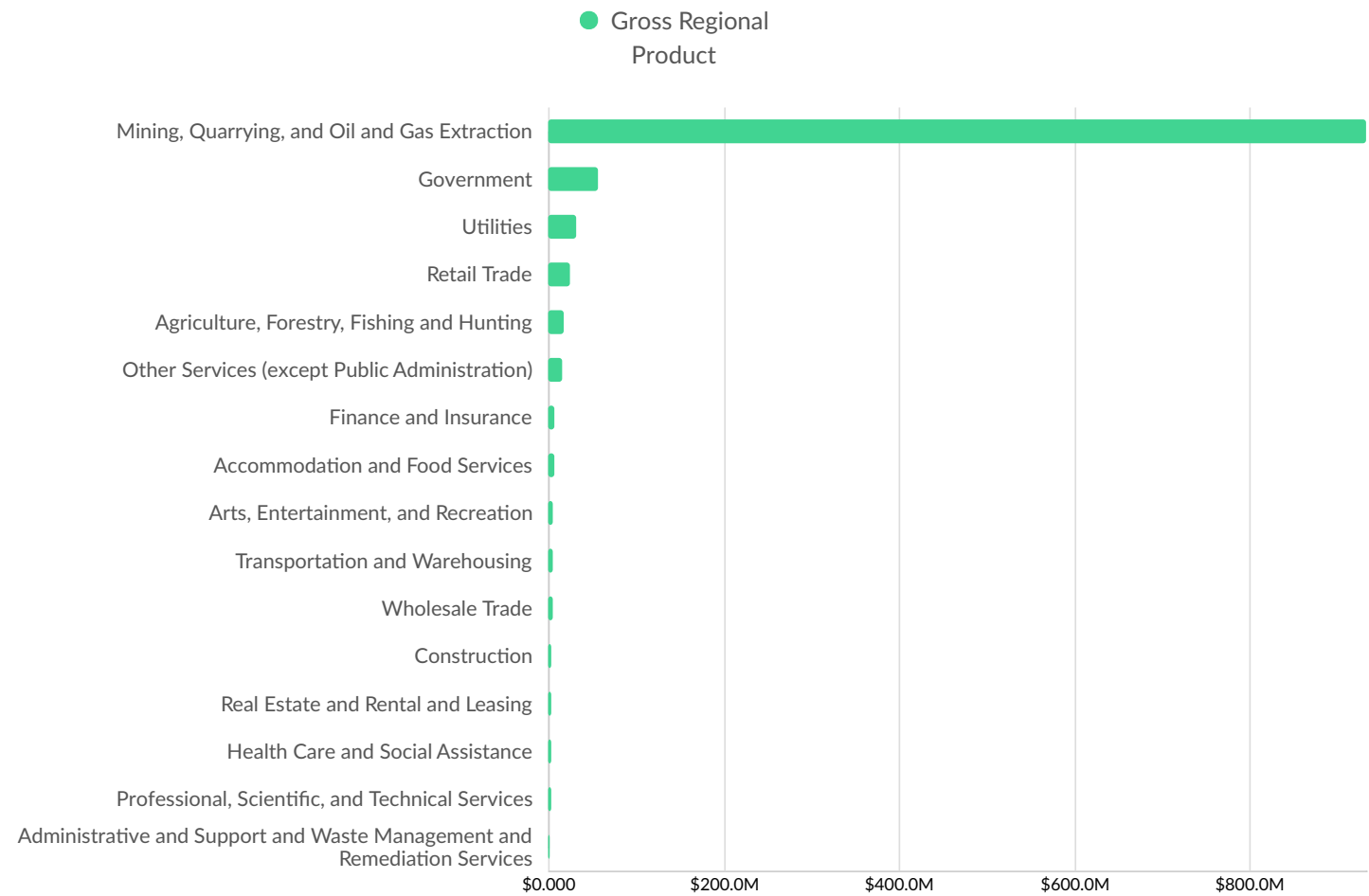
Top Growing Industries



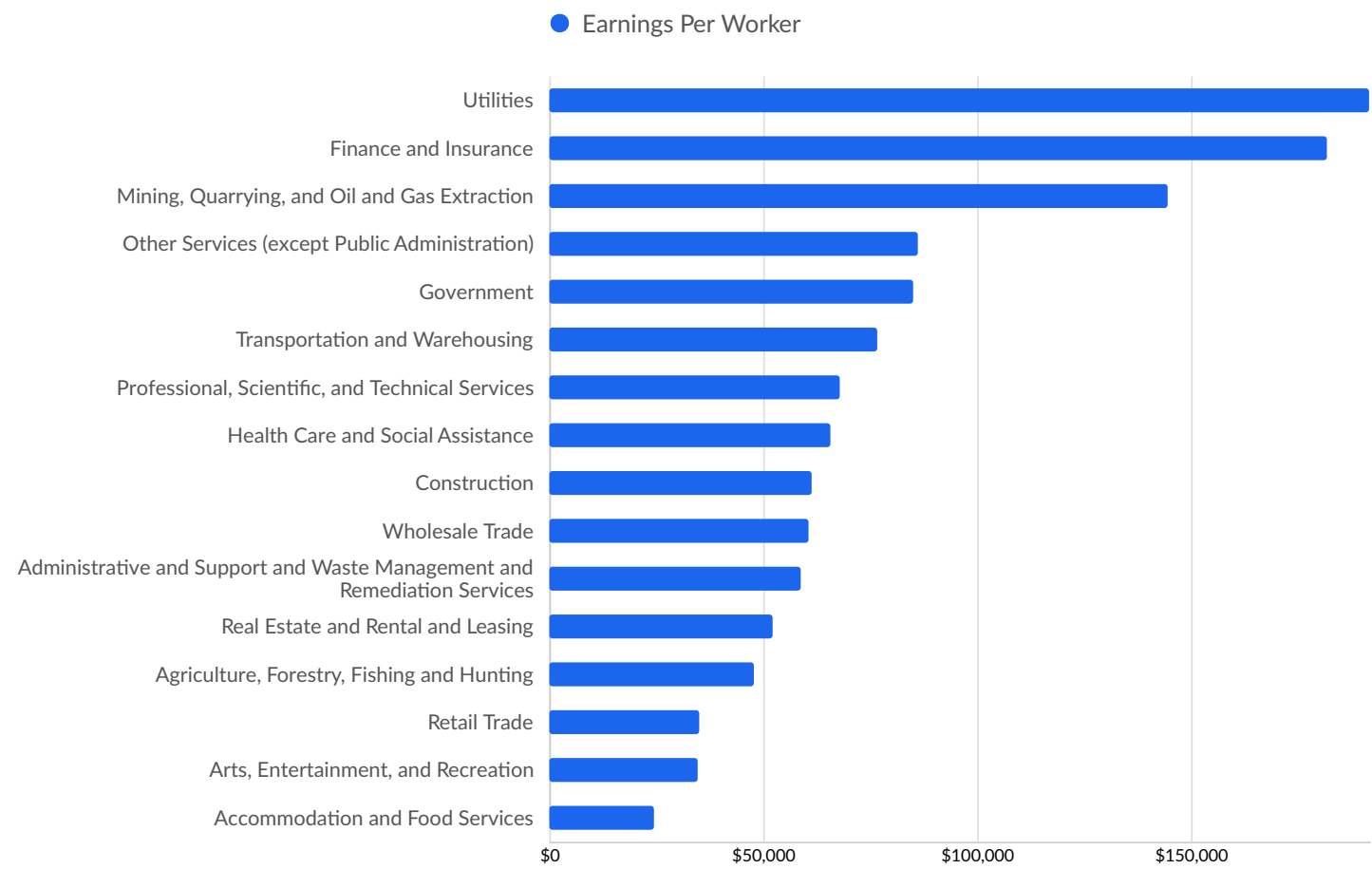
Top Industry Employment Concentration

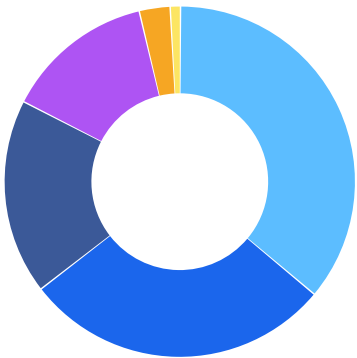

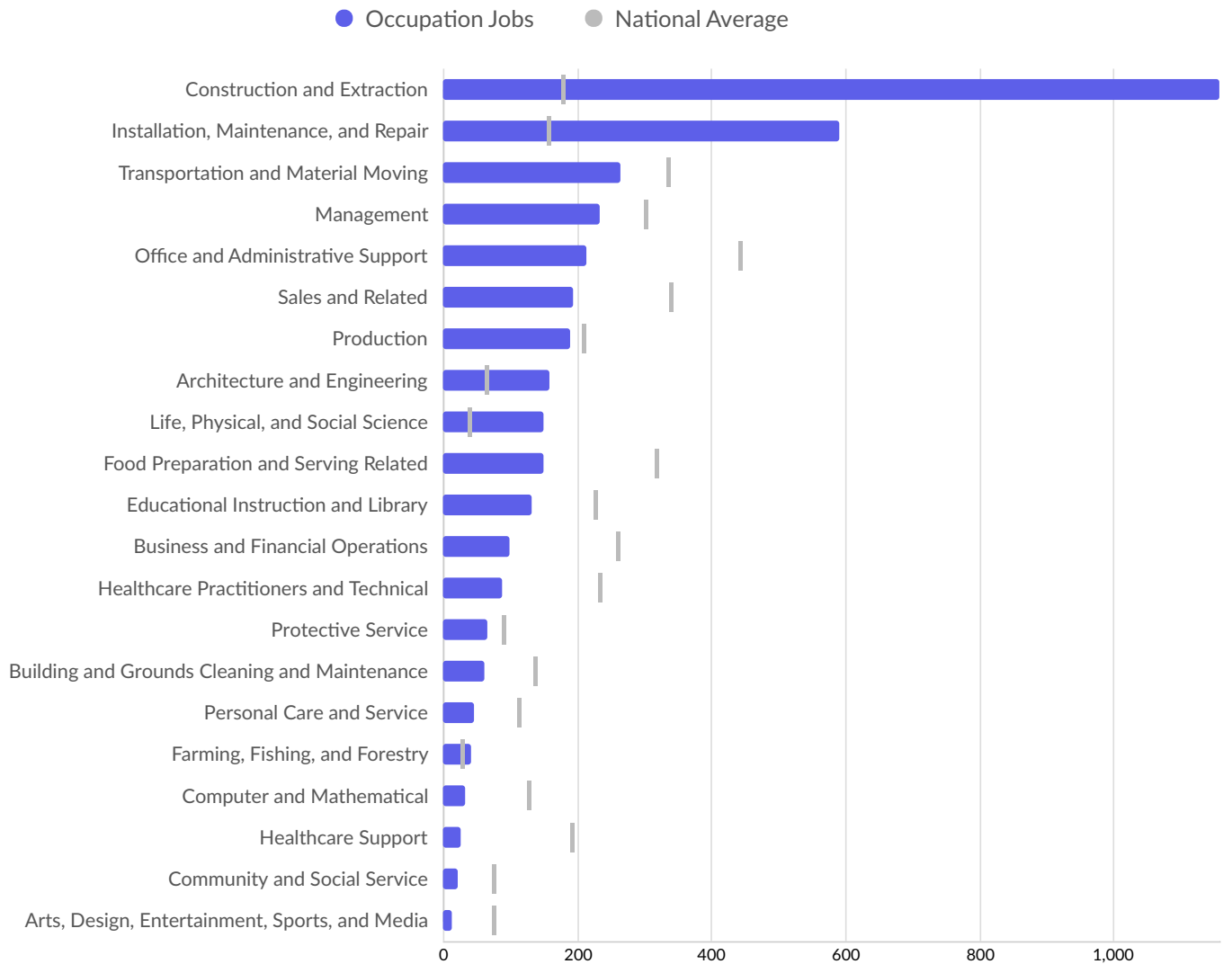

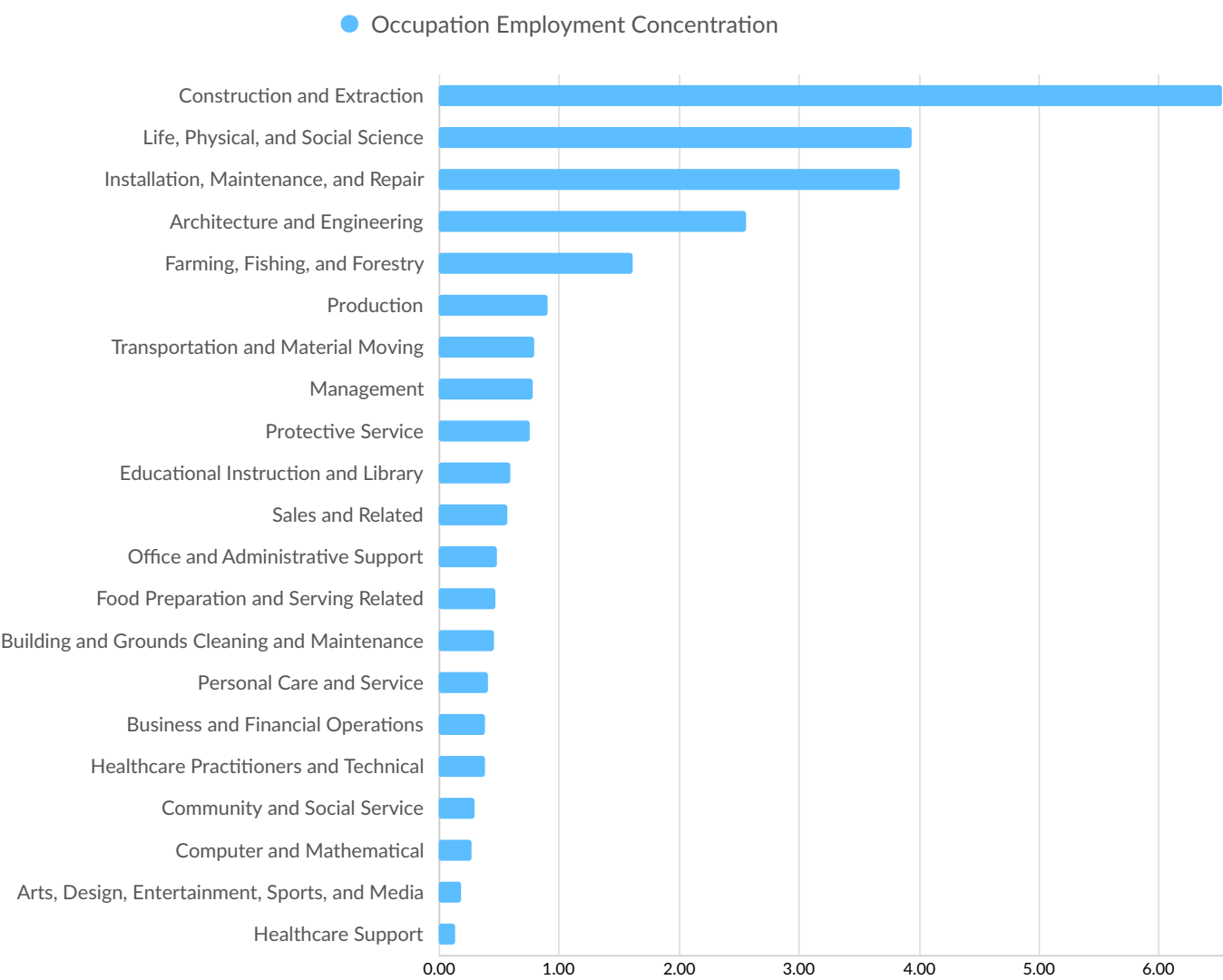

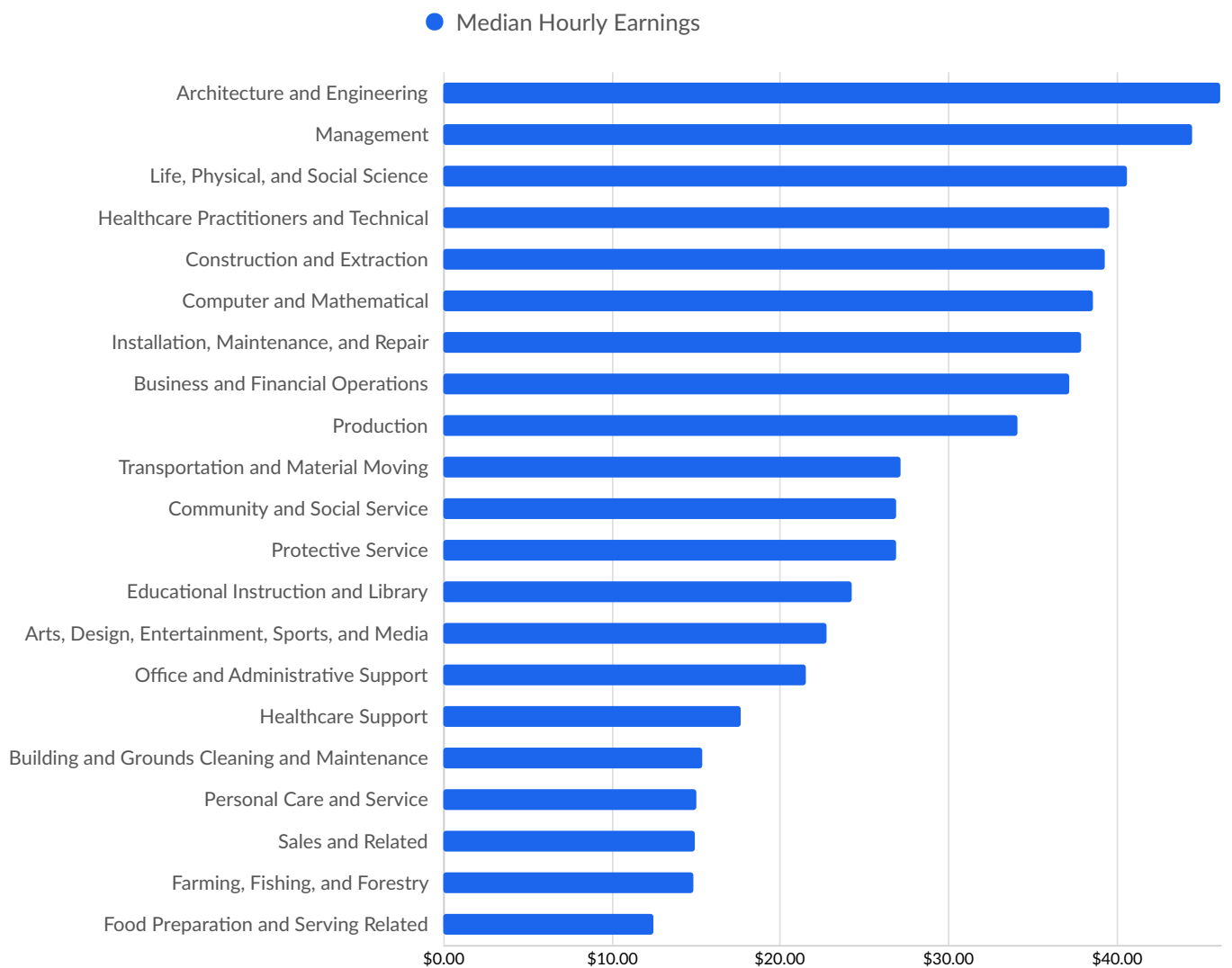
Top Growing Occupations



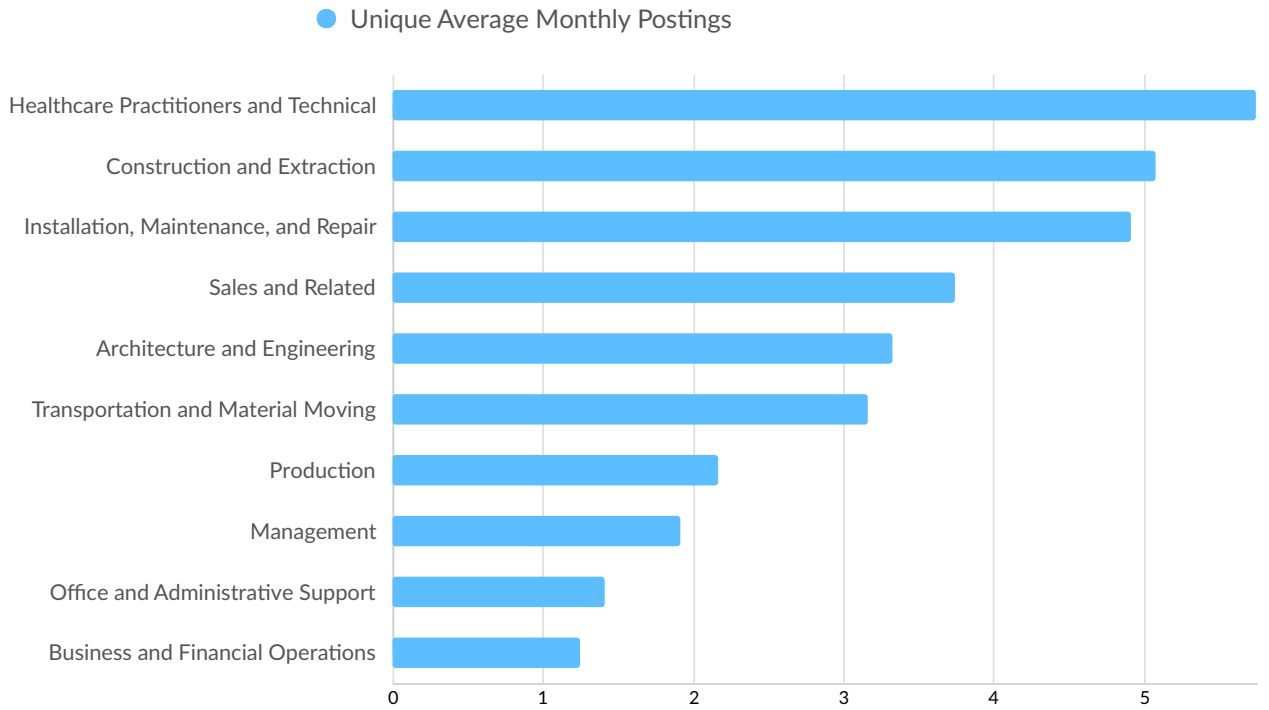
Top Occupation Employment Concentration



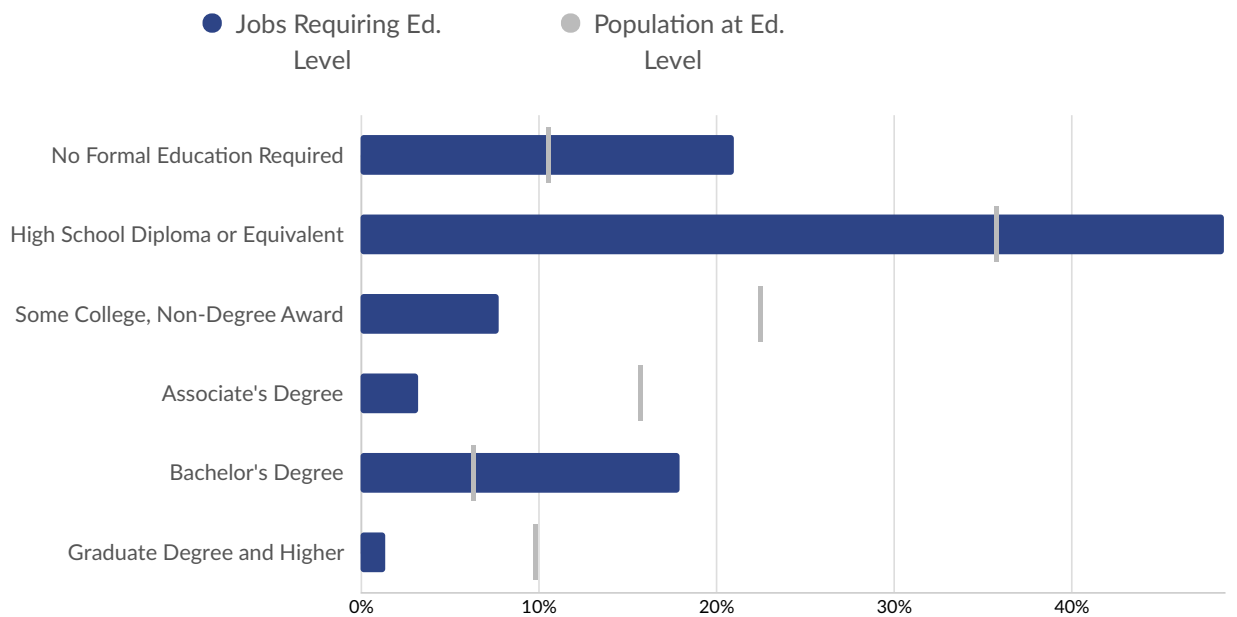
