
#### **Takeaways**

- As of 2024 the region's population declined by 16.1% since 2019, falling by 834. Population is expected to decrease by 6.0% between 2024 and 2029, losing 263.
- From 2019 to 2024, jobs increased by 4.9% in Lincoln County, NV from 1,510 to 1,584. This change outpaced the national growth rate of 4.4% by 0.5%. As the number of jobs increased, the labor force participation rate increased from 45.7% to 54.9% between 2019 and 2024.
- Concerning educational attainment, **11.9% of Lincoln County, NV residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (9.6% below the national average), and **6.5% hold an Associate's Degree** (2.3% below the national average).
- The top three industries in 2024 are Education and Hospitals (Local Government), Local Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals, and State Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals.








# **Unemployment by Gender**



# **Unemployment by Ethnicity**







# **Job Trends**






Lincoln County, NV had an August 2025 unemployment rate of 4.43%, decreasing from 5.93% 5 years before.





#### **Millennials**


Lincoln County, NV has 678 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 889.

Retirement risk is high in Lincoln County, NV. The national average for an area this size is 1,314 people 55 or older, while there are 1,716 here.


#### **Racial Diversity**

Lincoln County, NV has 0.46 violent crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 3.38 per 1,000 people.






