
Takeaways

- As of 2024 the region's population **declined by 0.9%** since 2019, falling by 41. Population is expected to **increase by 4.2%** between 2024 and 2029, adding 188.
- From 2019 to 2024, jobs declined by 27.2% in Mineral County, NV from 1,782 to 1,297. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 4.4% by 31.6%. As the number of jobs declined, the labor force participation rate decreased from 43.3% to 31.1% between 2019 and 2024.
- Concerning educational attainment, **9.1% of Mineral County, NV residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (12.5% below the national average), and **5.7% hold an Associate's Degree** (3.2% below the national average).
- The top three industries in 2024 are Local Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals, Education and Hospitals (Local Government), and Traveler Accommodation.








Unemployment by Gender




Unemployment by Race

Unemployment by Ethnicity







Job Trends





Mineral County, NV had an August 2025 unemployment rate of 9.66%, increasing from 7.59% 5 years before.






Mineral County, NV has 1.56 violent crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 3.38 per 1,000 people.


Property Crime








Top Growing Industries





Top Industry Employment Concentration






Top Industry GRP






Top Occupation Employment Concentration










