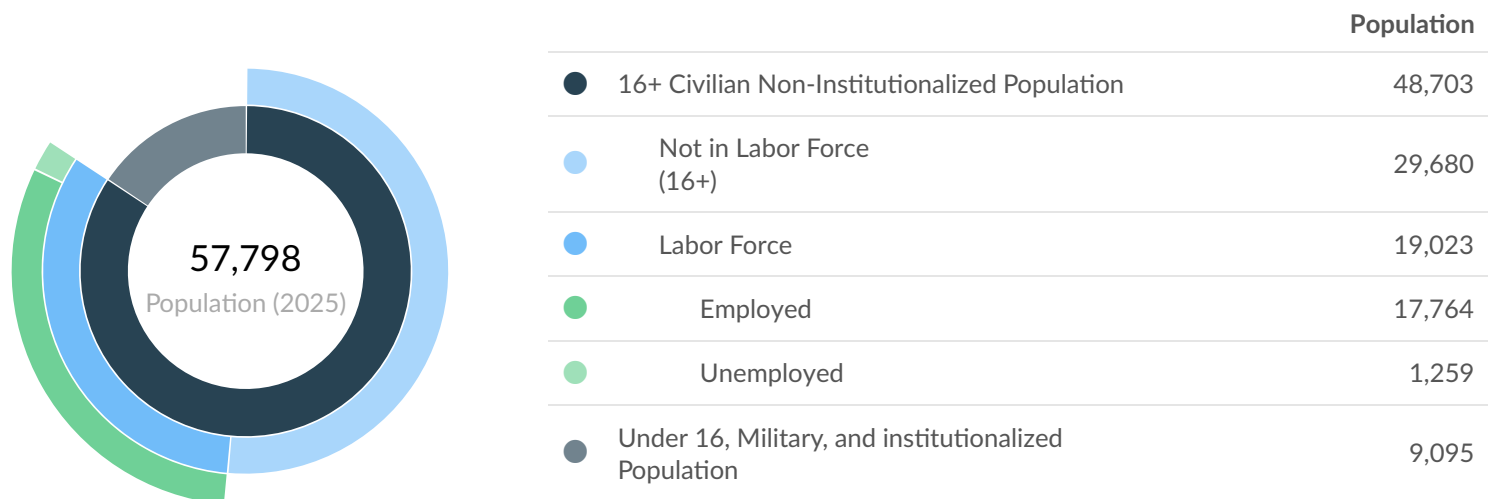
Median household income is **\$22.6K below** the national median household income of \$78.5K.

- From 2019 to 2024, jobs **increased by 10.4%** in Nye County, NV from 13,996 to **15,445**. This change **outpaced the national growth rate of 4.4% by 6.0%**. As the number of jobs increased, the **labor force participation rate decreased from 44.7% to 40.3% between 2019 and 2024**.
- Concerning educational attainment, **8.8% of Nye County, NV residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (12.7% below the national average), and **8.3% hold an Associate's Degree** (0.6% below the national average).
- The top three industries in 2024 are Scientific Research and Development Services, Education and Hospitals (Local Government), and Restaurants and Other Eating Places.

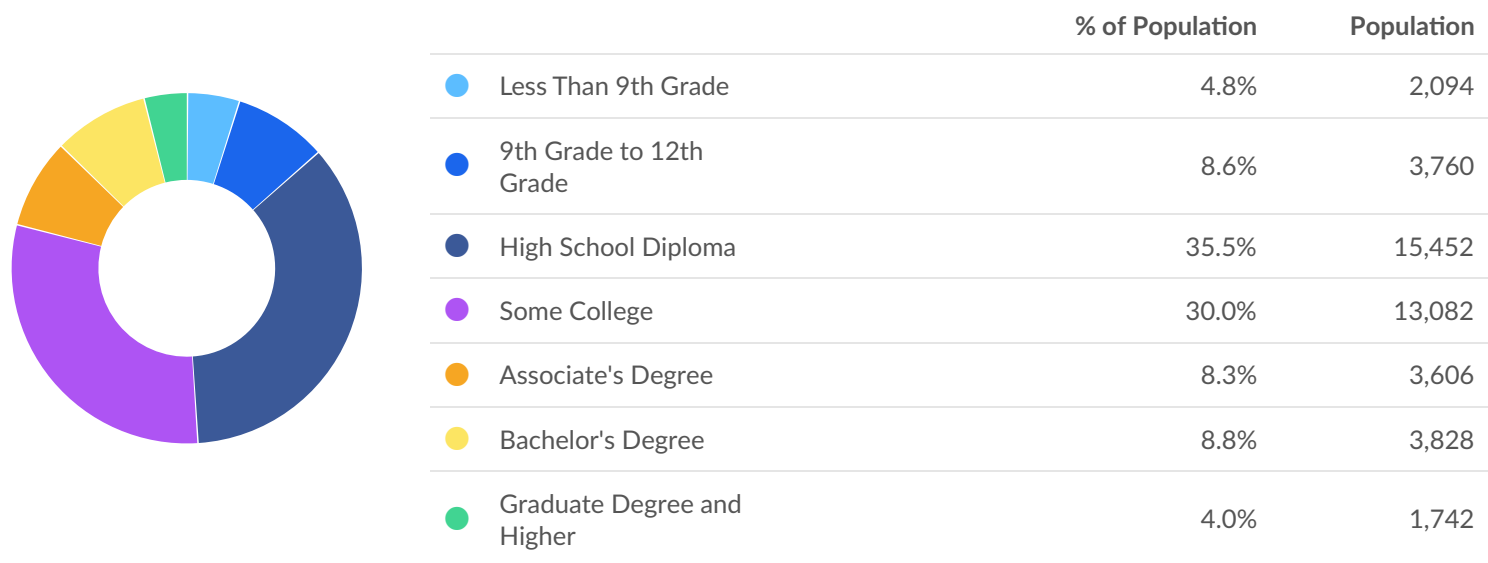

Aug 2025 Labor Force Breakdown



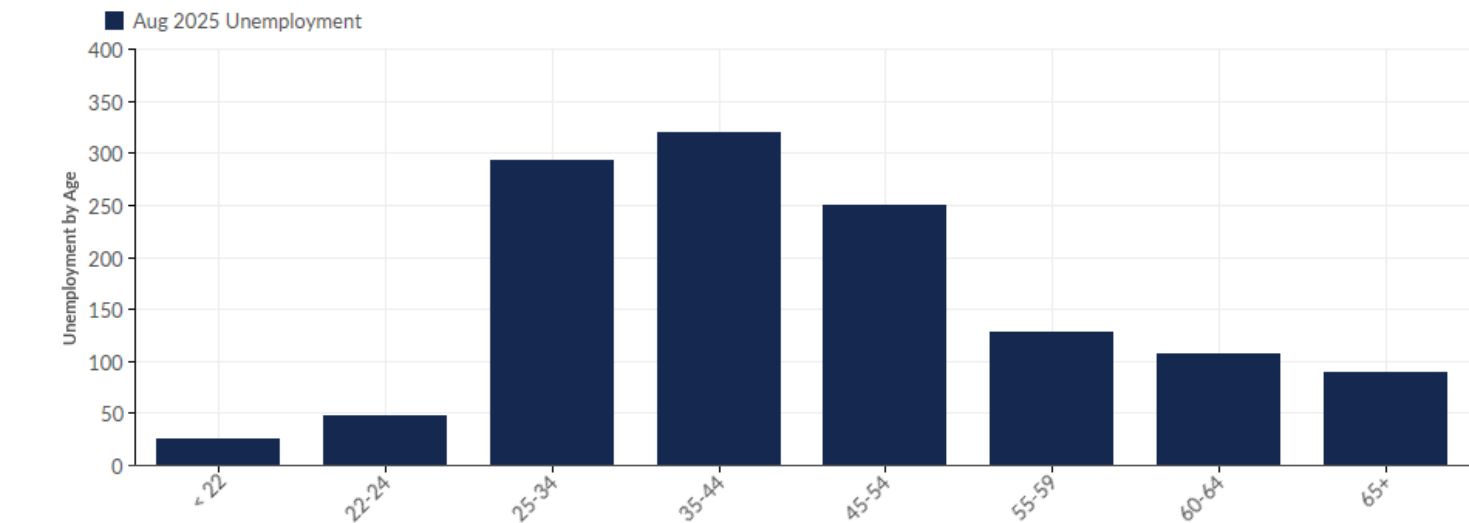
Educational Attainment

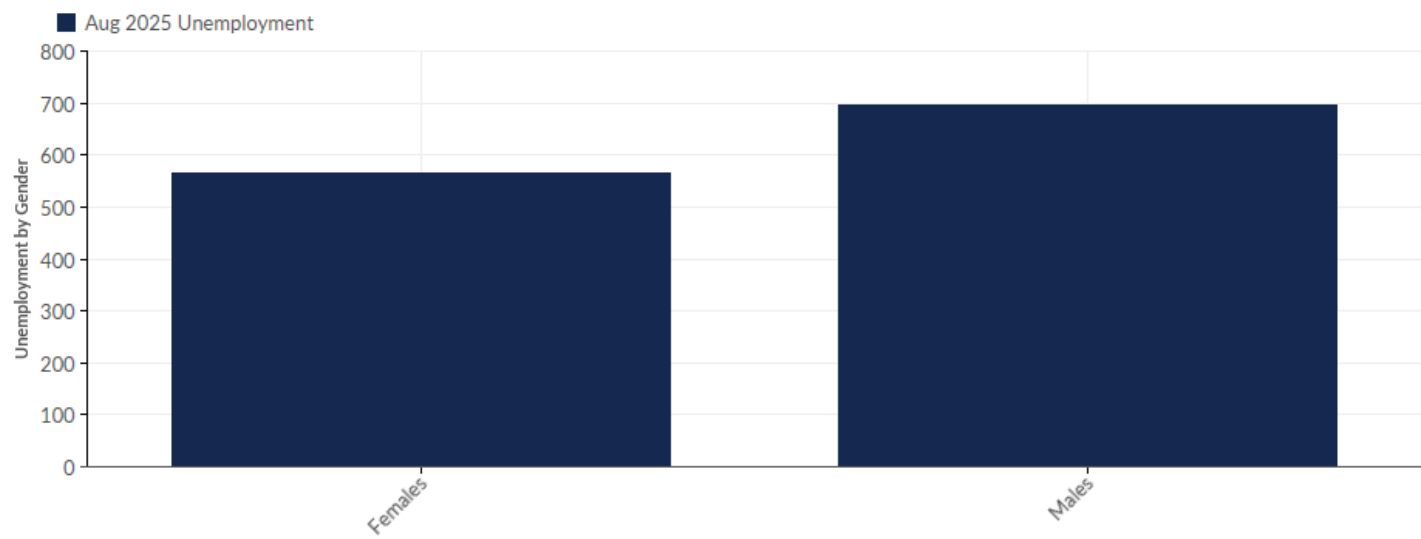

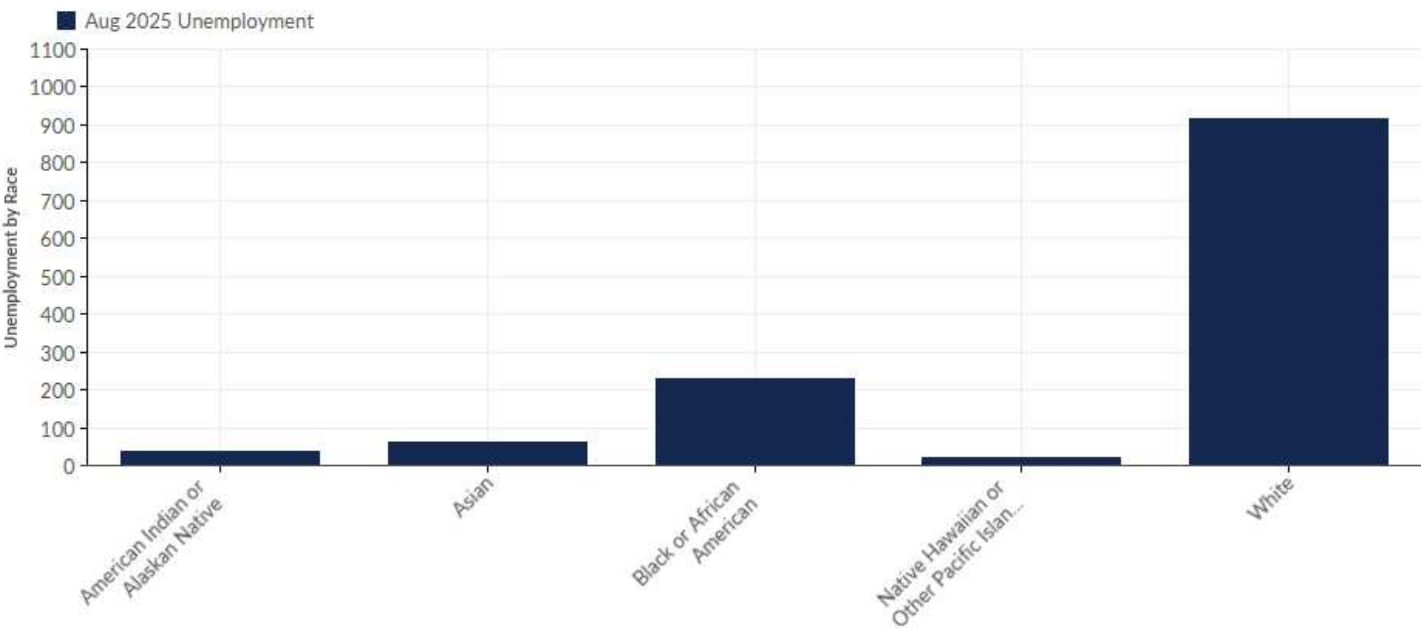

Unemployment by Gender



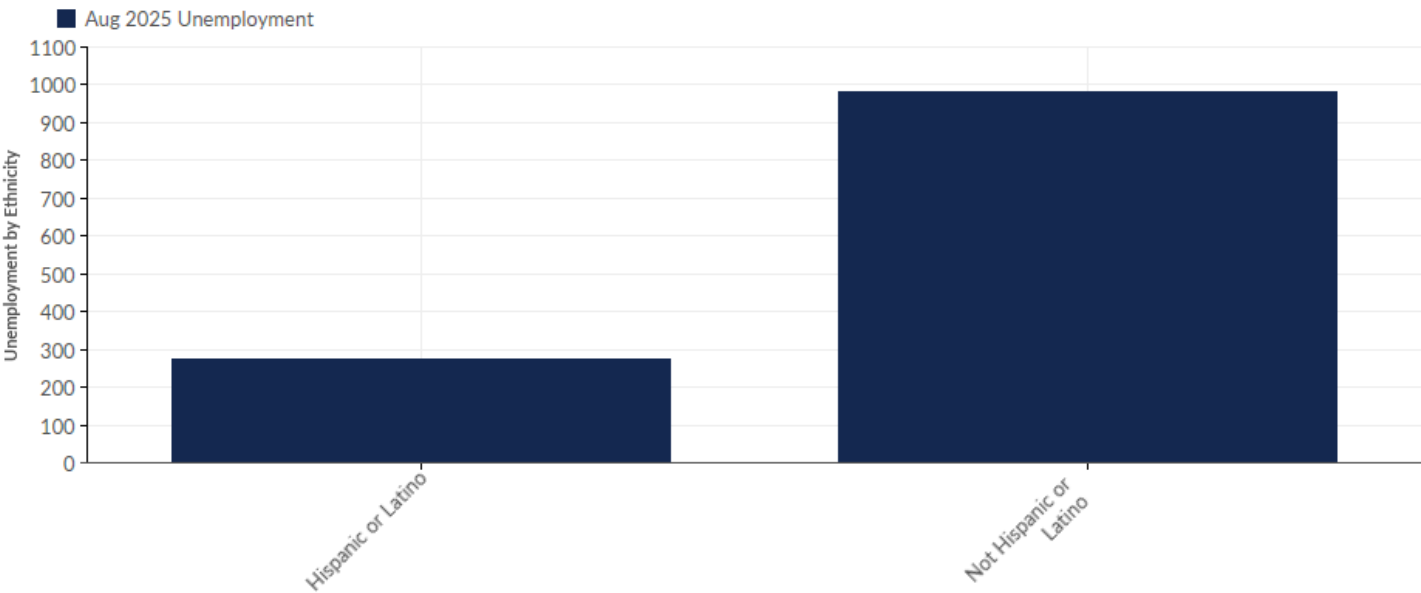

Unemployment by Ethnicity

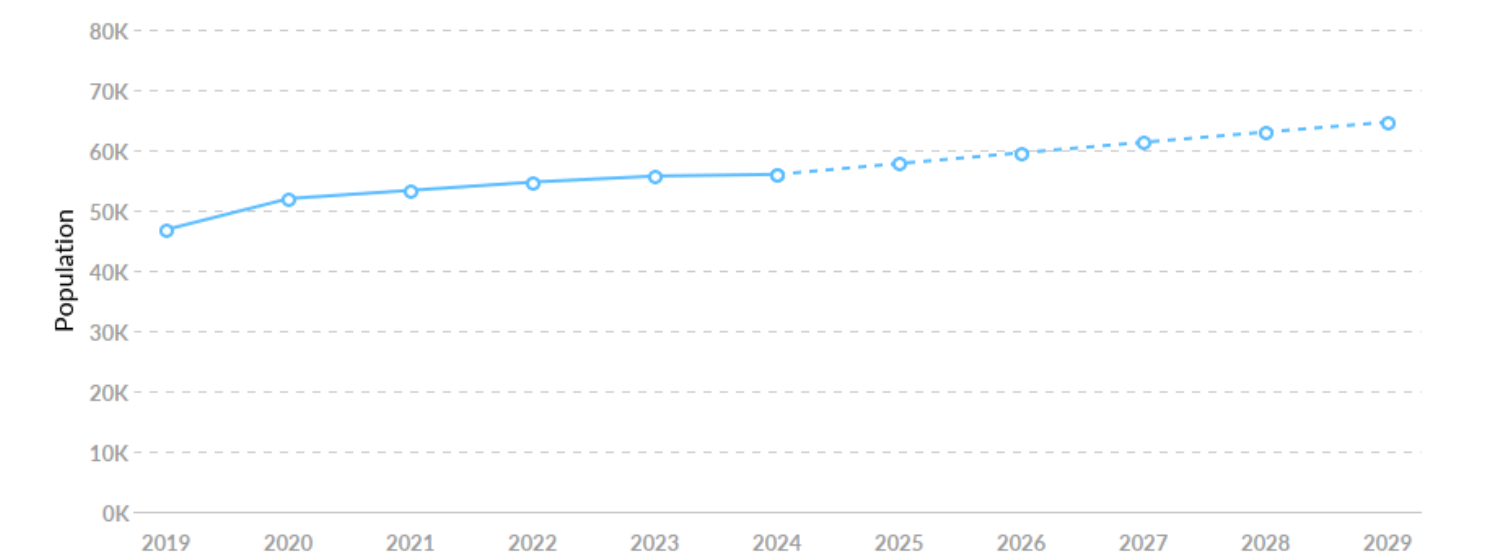

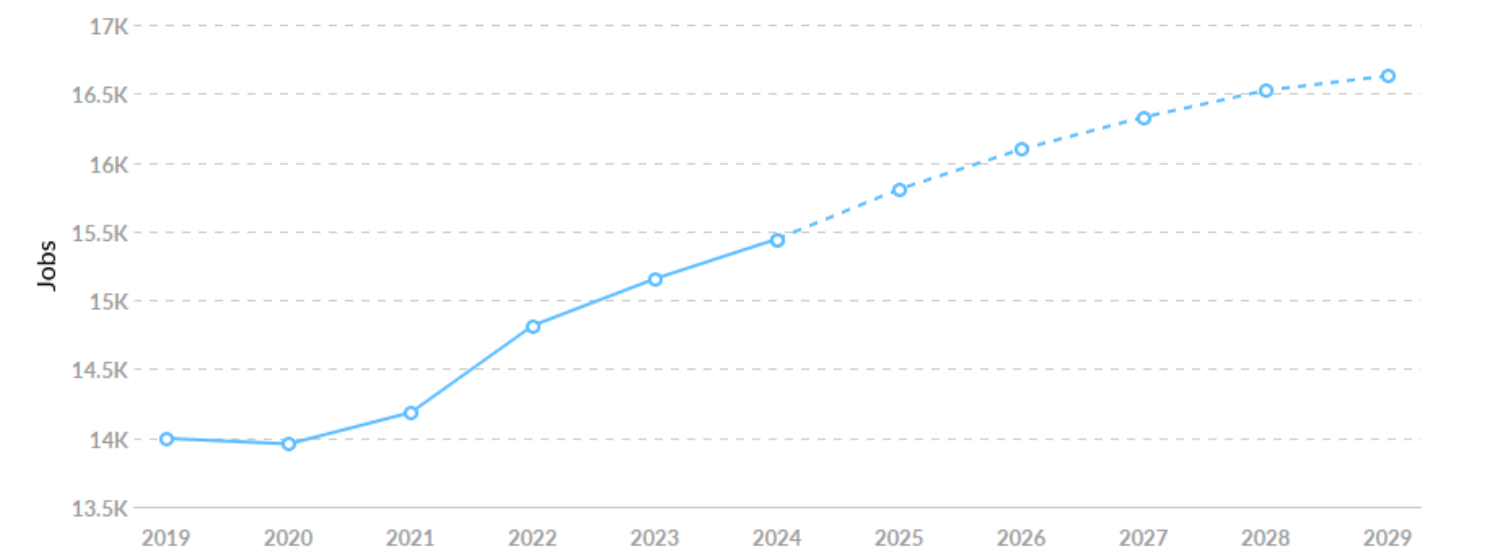

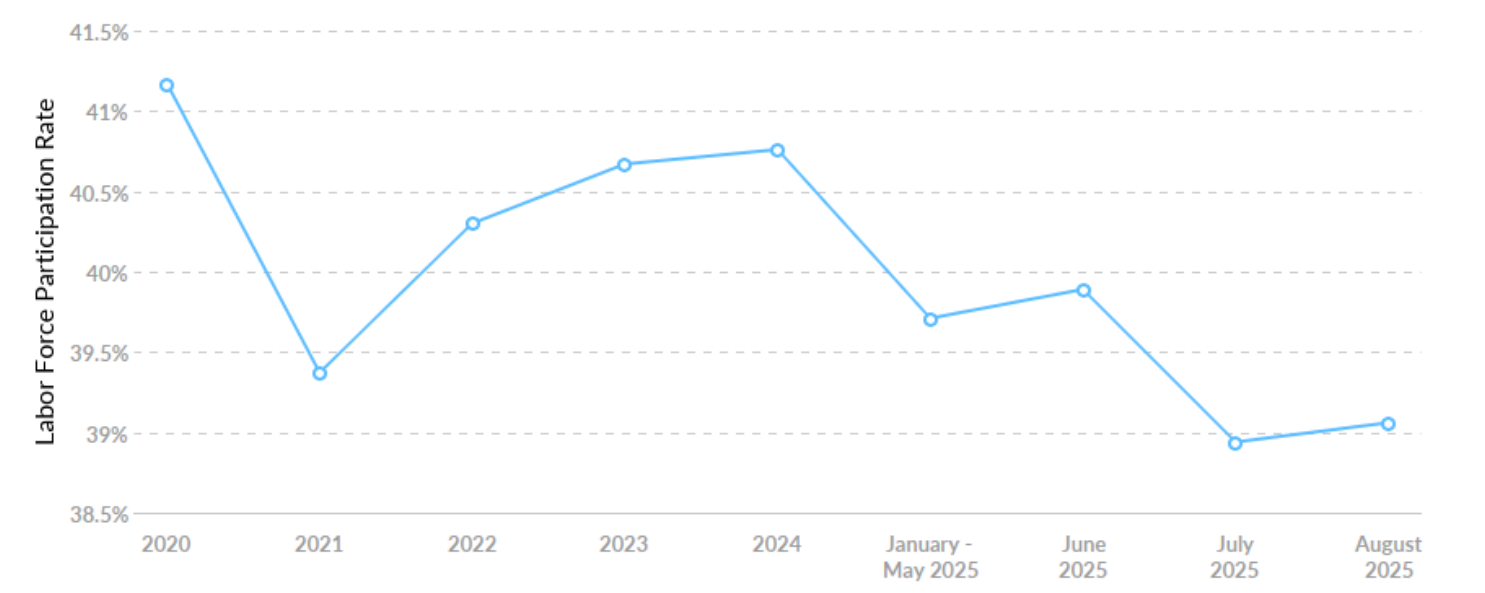
Job Trends

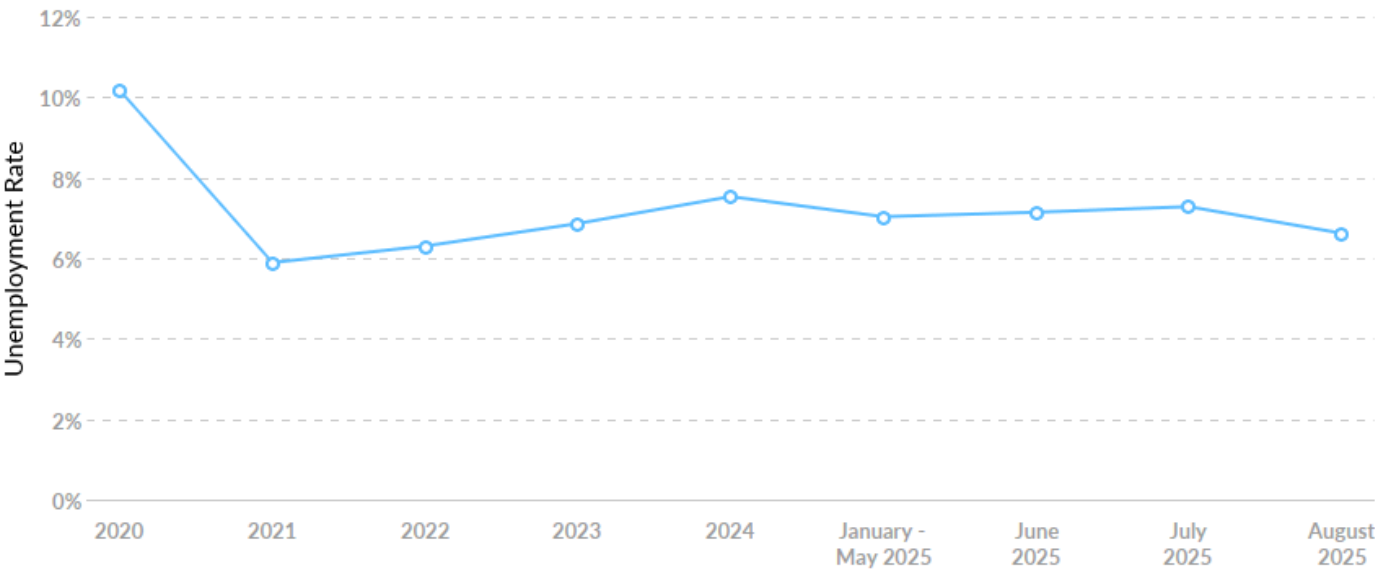

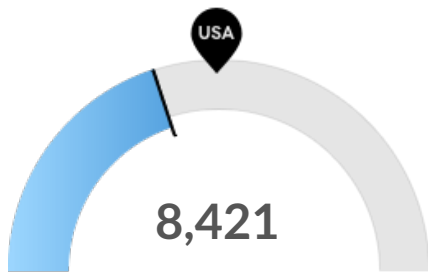
Unemployment Rate Trends

Nye County, NV had an August 2025 unemployment rate of 6.62%, **decreasing from 10.17%** 5 years before.



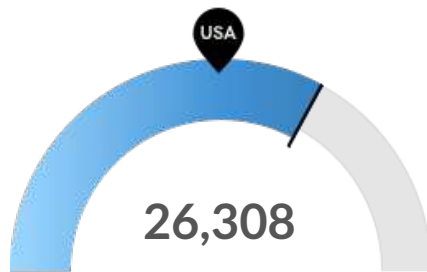

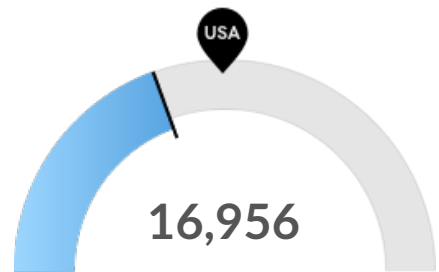
Millennials

Nye County, NV has 8,421 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 11,462.



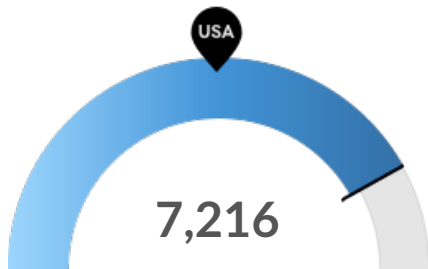
Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is high in Nye County, NV. The national average for an area this size is 16,930 people 55 or older, while there are 26,308 here.



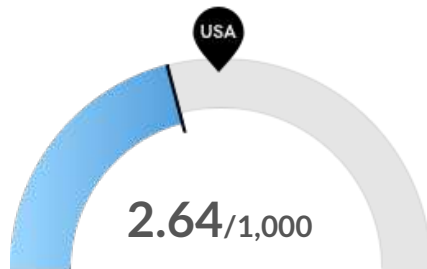
Racial Diversity

Racial diversity is low in Nye County, NV. The national average for an area this size is 23,817 racially diverse people, while there are 16,956 here.



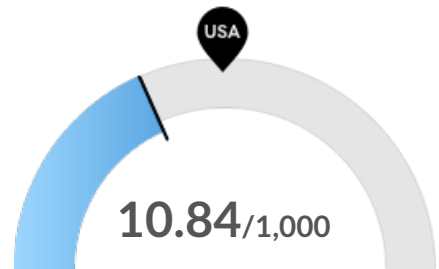
Veterans

Nye County, NV has 2.64 violent crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 3.38 per 1,000 people.

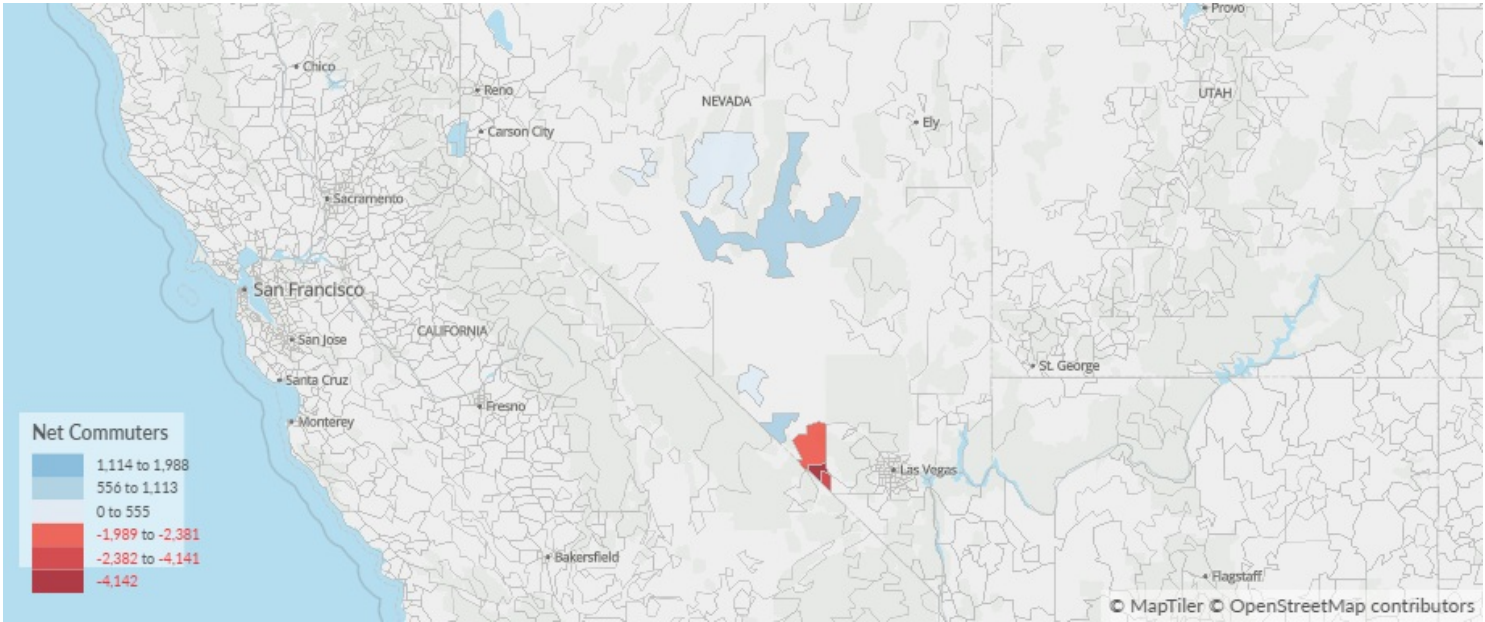


Property Crime

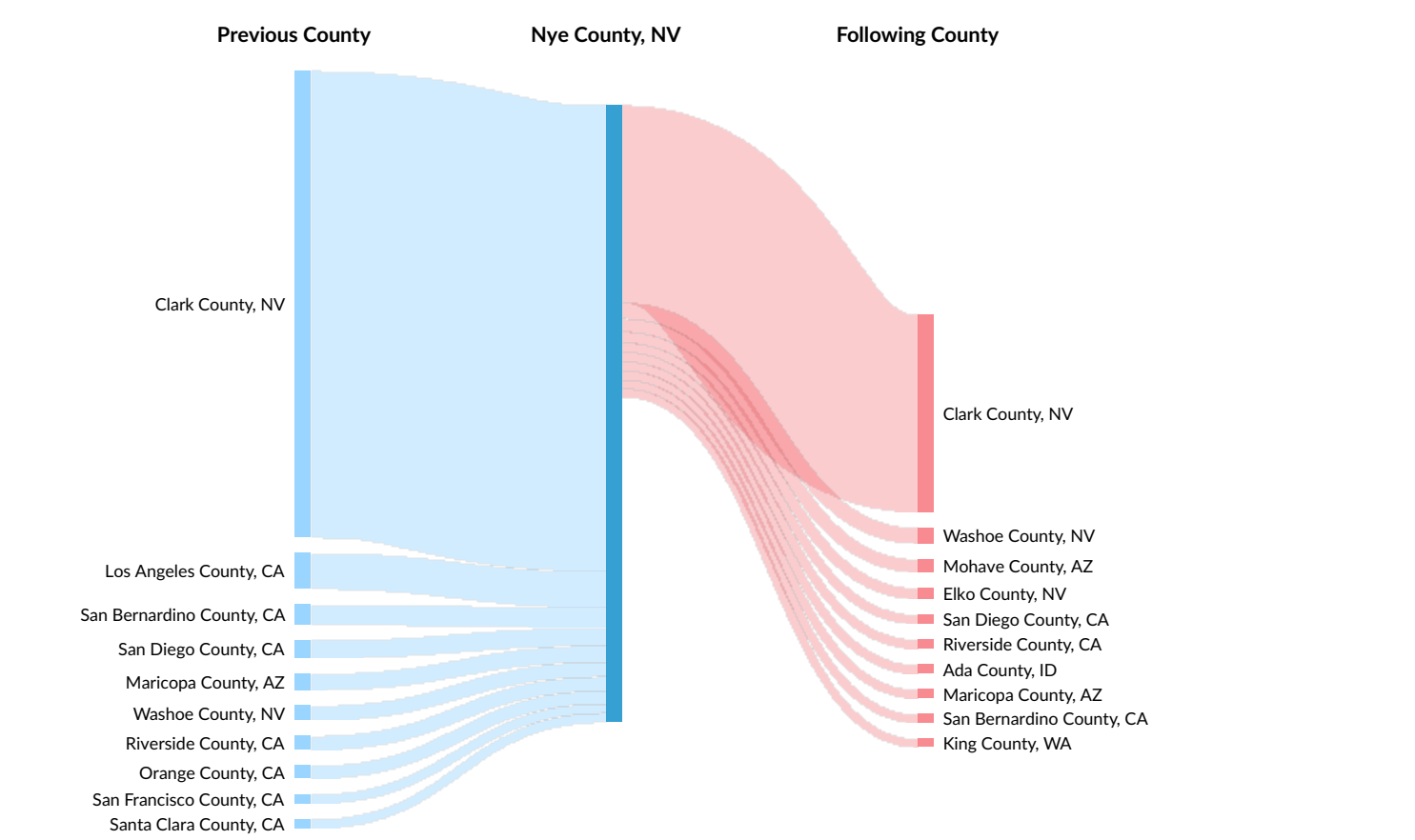

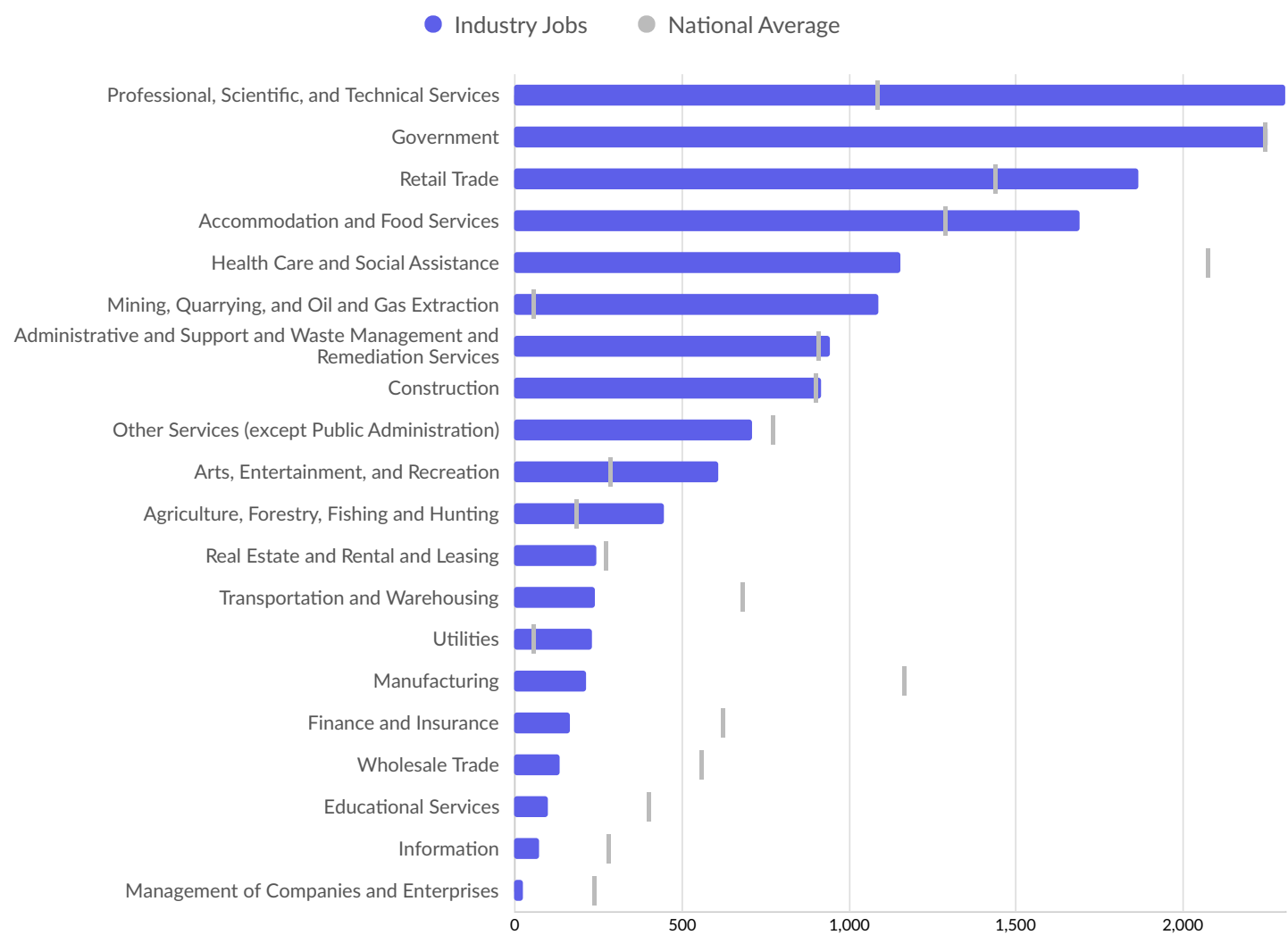

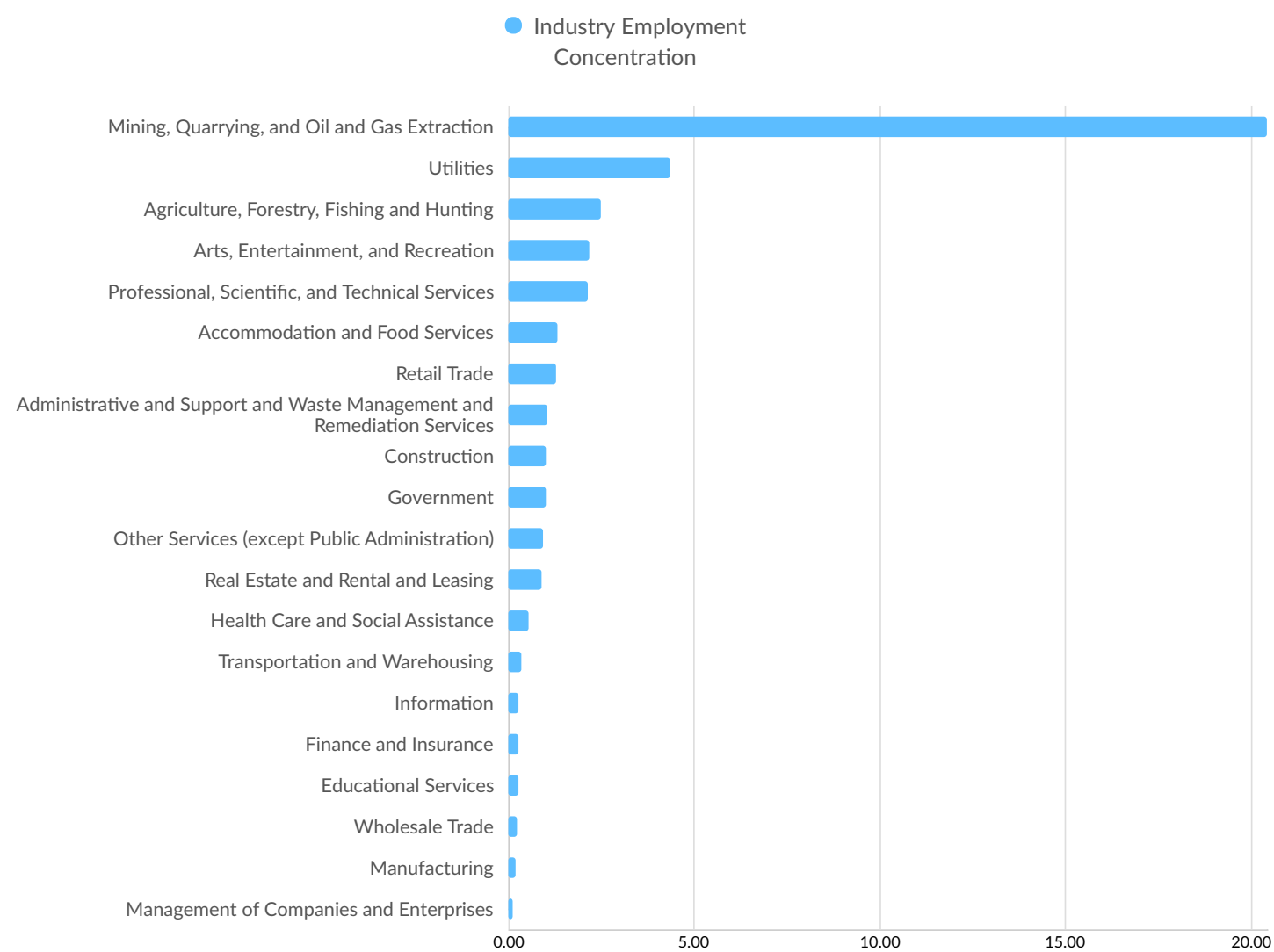

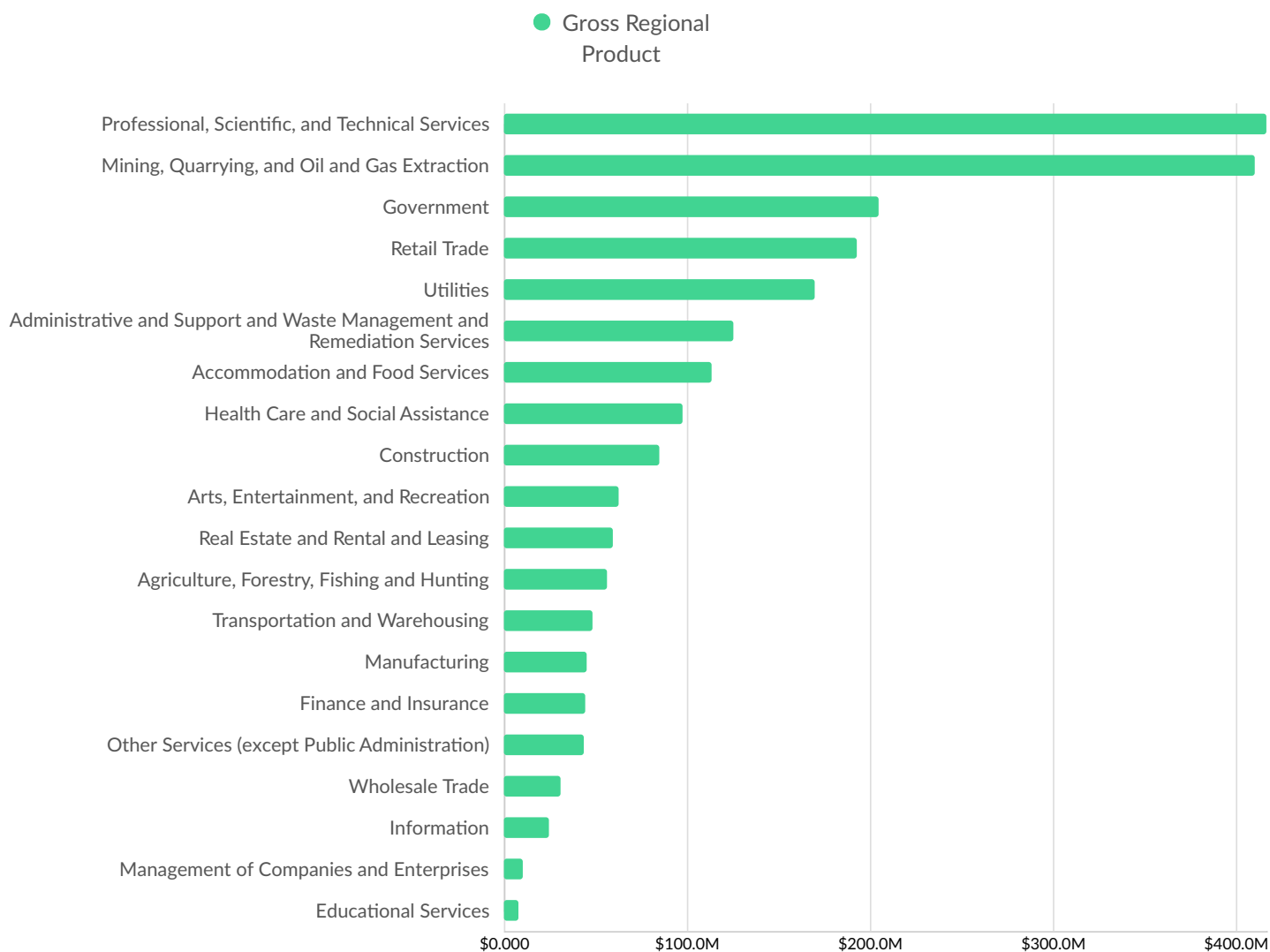
Top Growing Industries



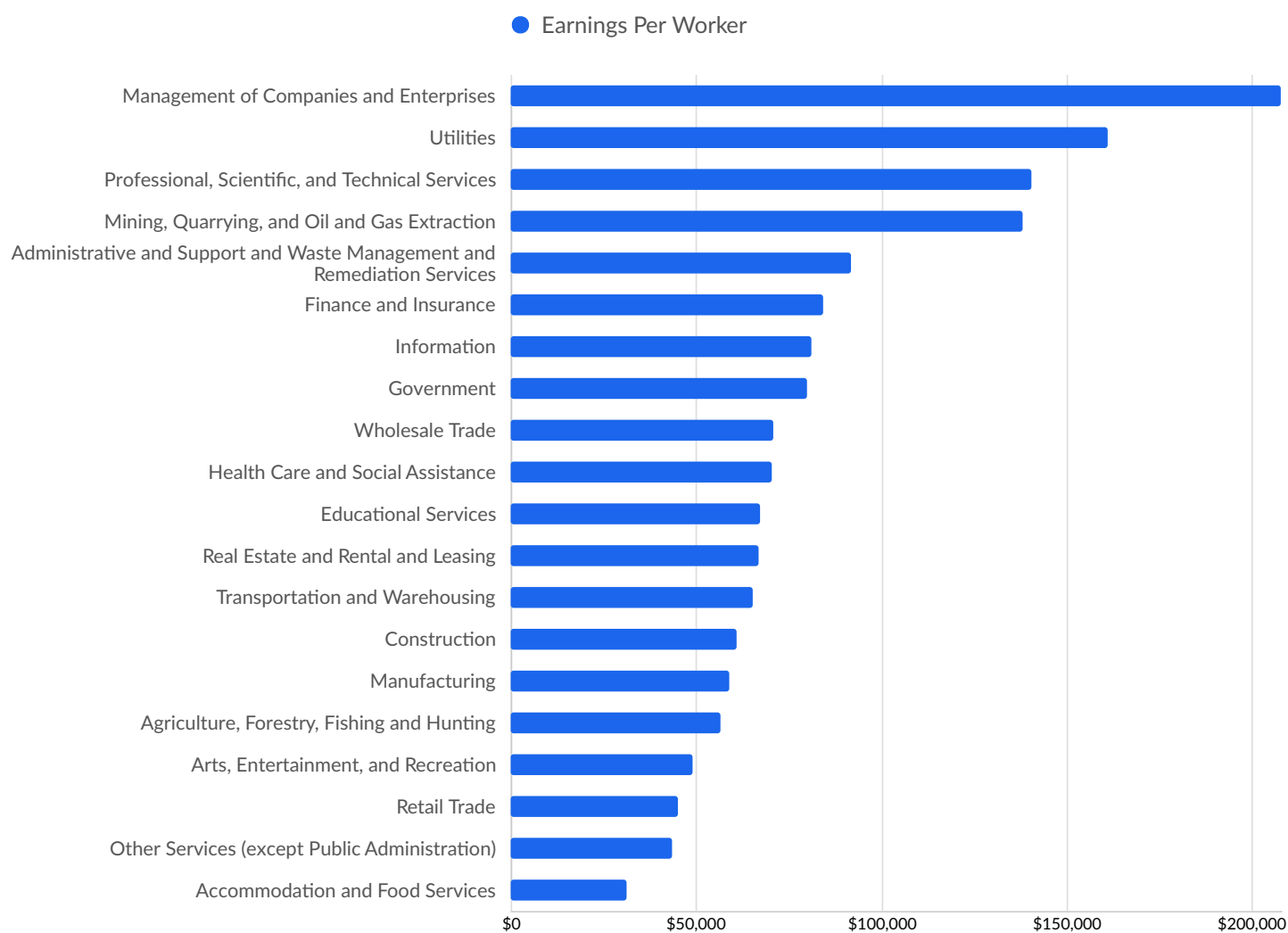
Top Industry Employment Concentration

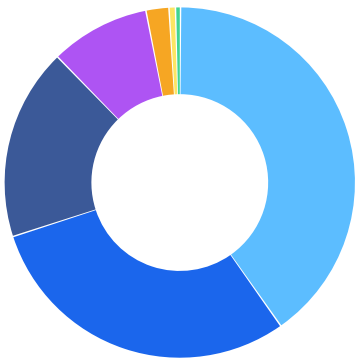

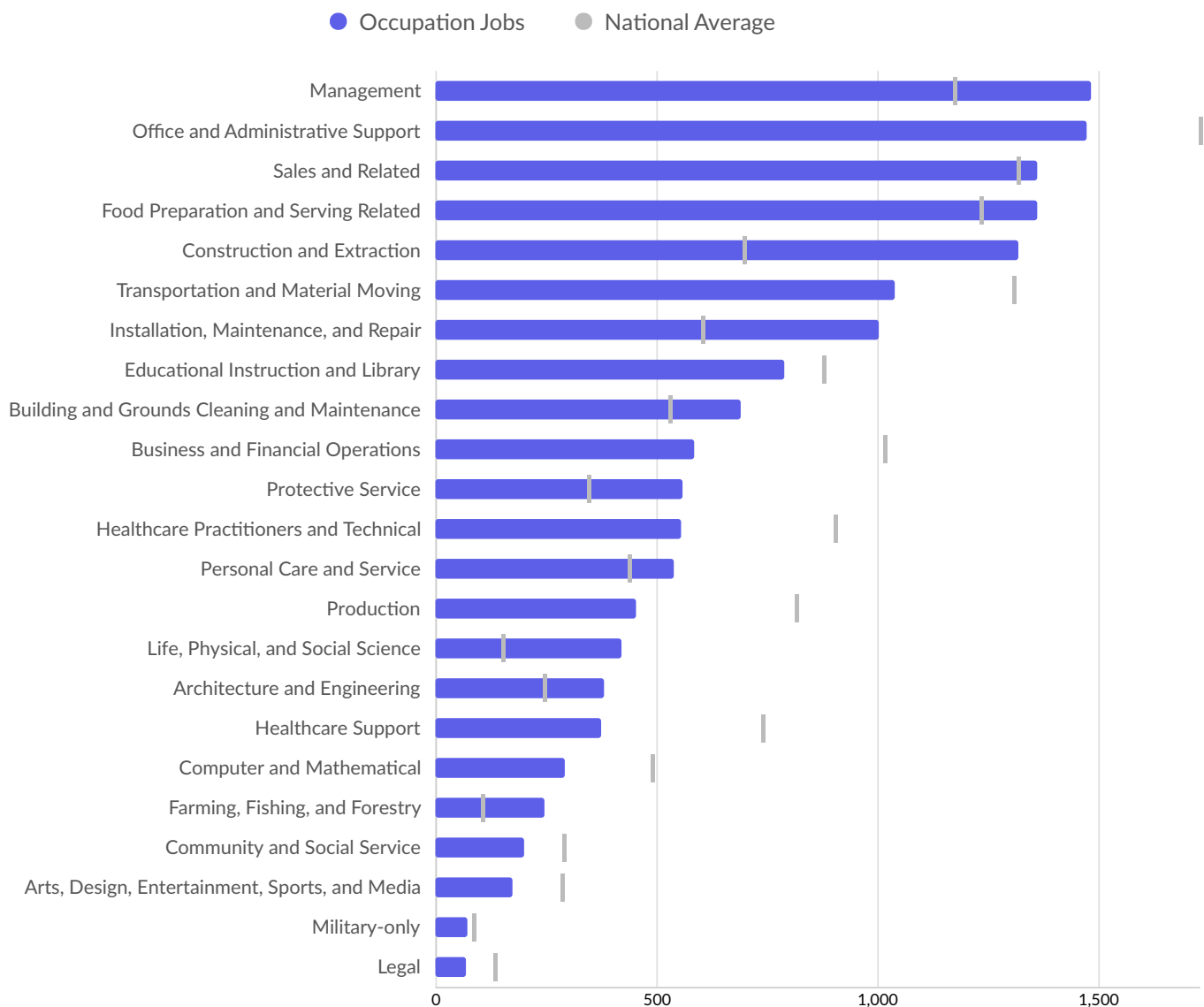

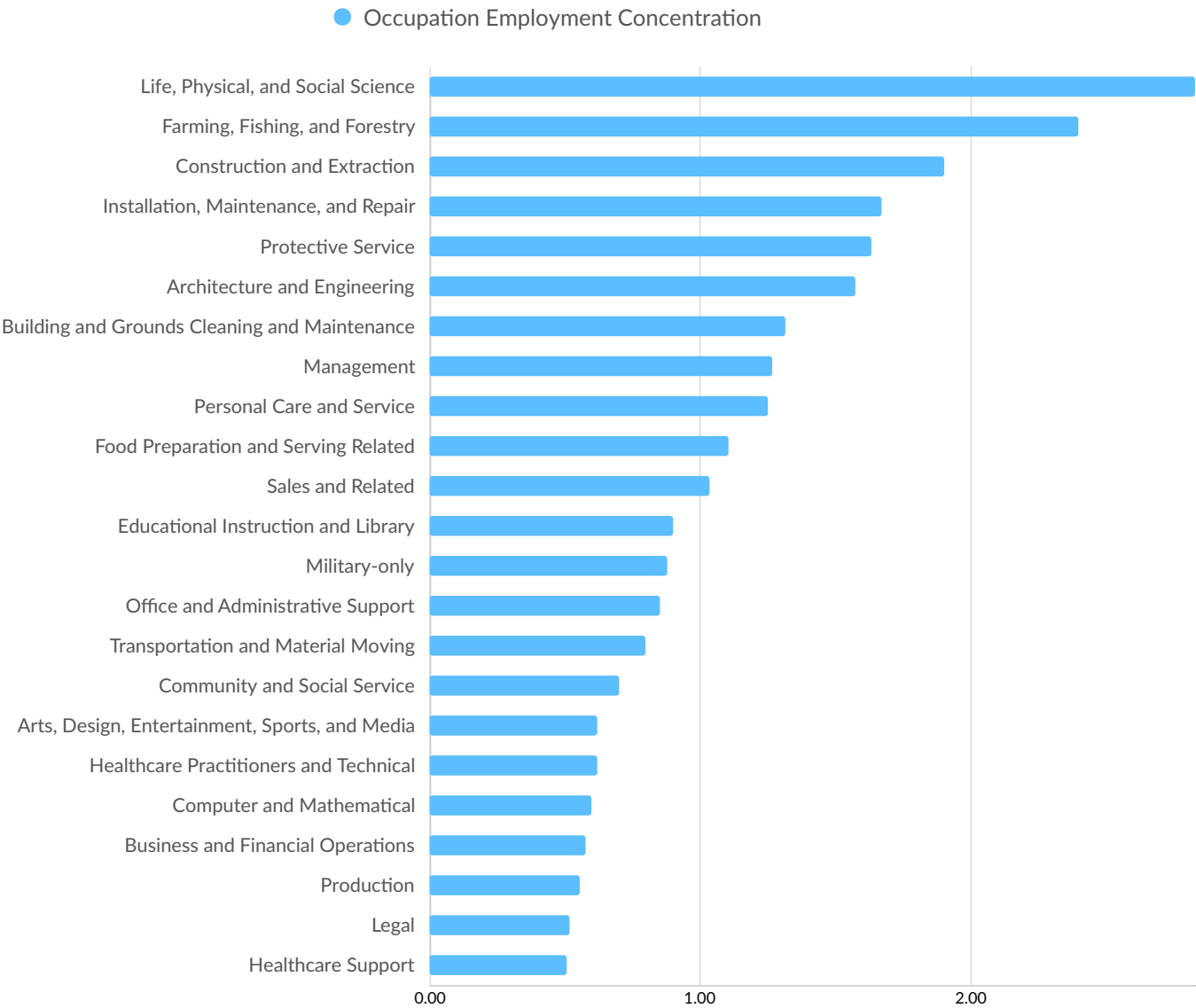

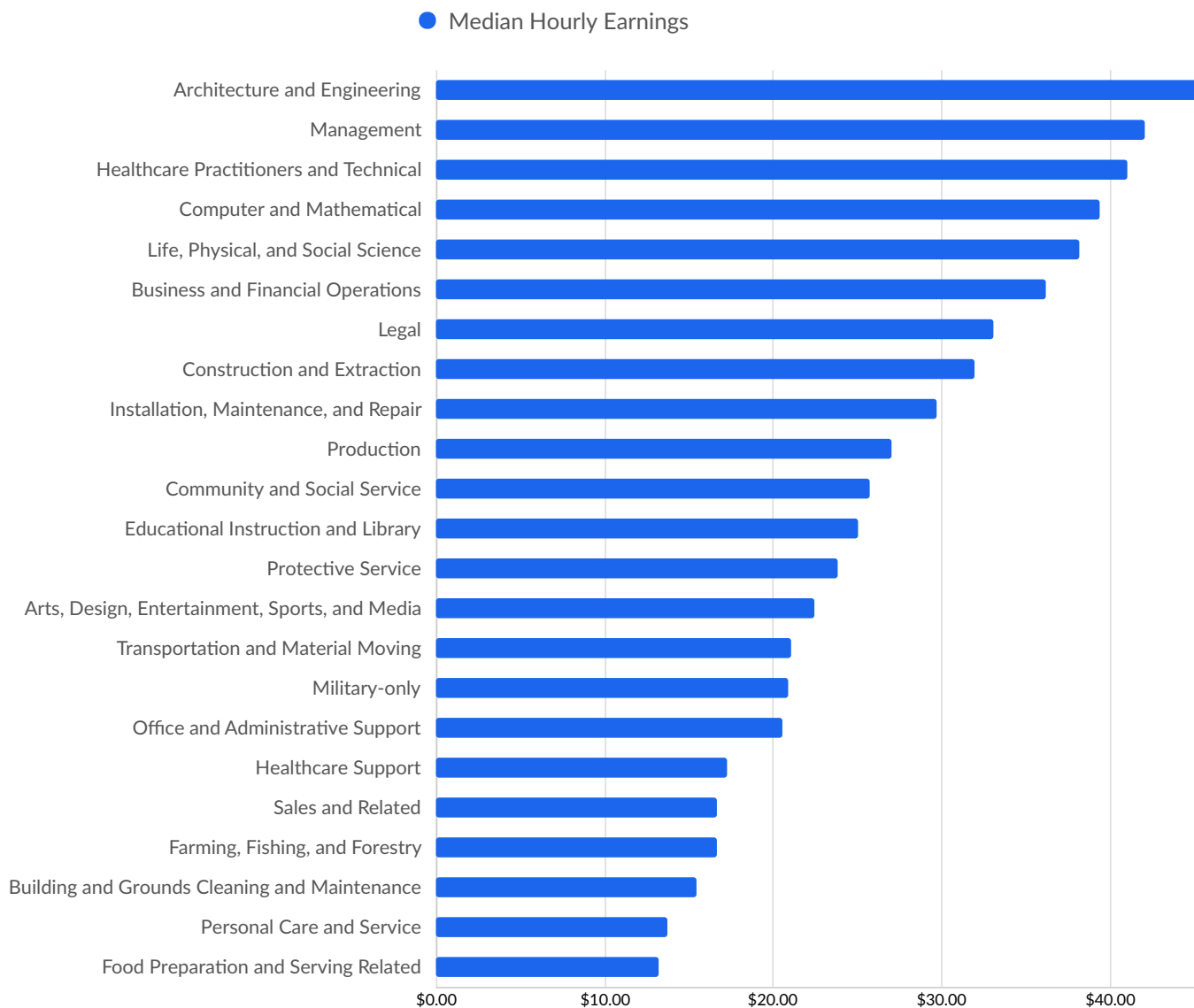
Top Growing Occupations



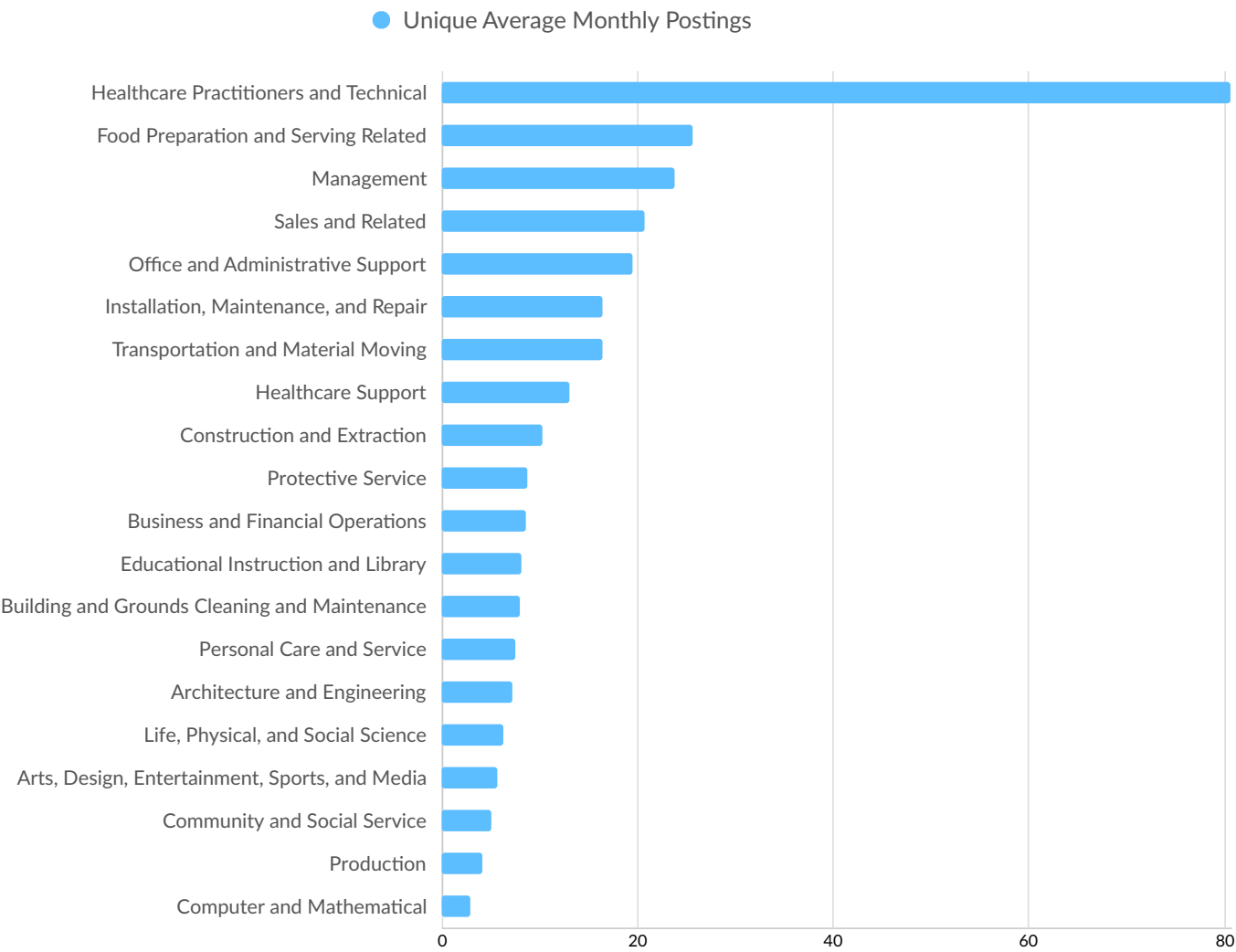
Top Occupation Employment Concentration



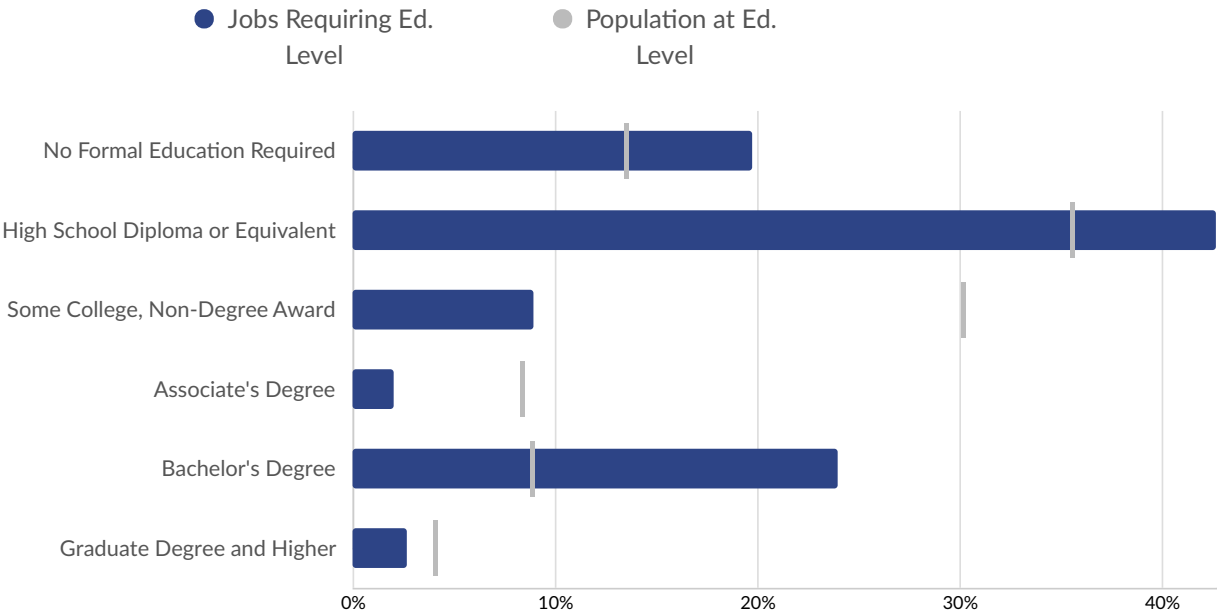
