
#### **Takeaways**

- As of 2024 the region's population increased by 7.4% since 2019, growing by 34,899. Population is expected to increase by 4.5% between 2024 and 2029, adding 22,726.
- From 2019 to 2024, jobs increased by 6.8% in Washoe County, NV from 249,115 to 265,987. This change outpaced the national growth rate of 4.4% by 2.4%. As the number of jobs increased, the labor force participation rate decreased from 66.3% to 64.9% between 2019 and 2024.
- Concerning educational attainment, **20.1% of Washoe County, NV residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (1.5% below the national average), and **8.6% hold an Associate's Degree** (0.2% below the national average).
- The top three industries in 2024 are Restaurants and Other Eating Places, Traveler Accommodation, and Warehousing and Storage.









## **Unemployment by Ethnicity**







### **Job Trends**






Washoe County, NV had an August 2025 unemployment rate of 4.12%, decreasing from 8.43% 5 years before.




#### Millennials

Washoe County, NV has 113,199 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 103,845.




#### **Veterans**

Washoe County, NV has 30,139 veterans. The national average for an area this size is 24,605.




#### **Retiring Soon**

Retirement risk is about average in Washoe County, NV. The national average for an area this size is 153,390 people 55 or older, while there are 156,762 here.




#### **Violent Crime**

Racial diversity is about average in Washoe County, NV. The national average for an area this size is 215,789 racially diverse people, while there are 210,906 here.




#### **Property Crime**









#### Unique Average Monthly Postings





# **Educational Pipeline**

In 2024, there were 8,467 graduates in Washoe County, NV. This pipeline has shrunk by 3% over the last 5 years. The highest share of these graduates come from "Science Technologies/Technicians, Other" (Associate's), "Emergency Medical Technology/Technician (EMT Paramedic)" (Certificate), and "Psychology, General" (Bachelor's).
