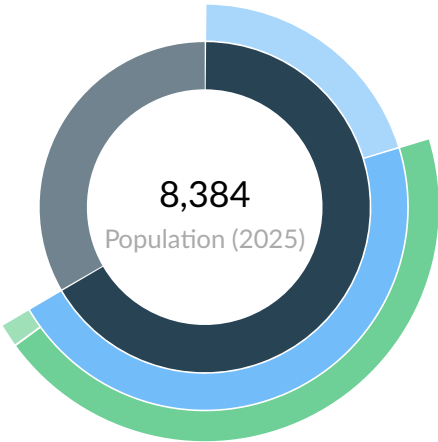

- Concerning educational attainment, **11.1% of White Pine County, NV residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (10.4% below the national average), and **11.6% hold an Associate's Degree** (2.8% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2024 are Metal Ore Mining, Education and Hospitals (Local Government), and State Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals.

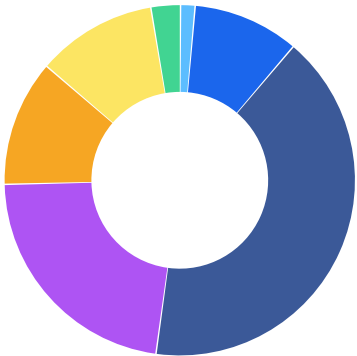

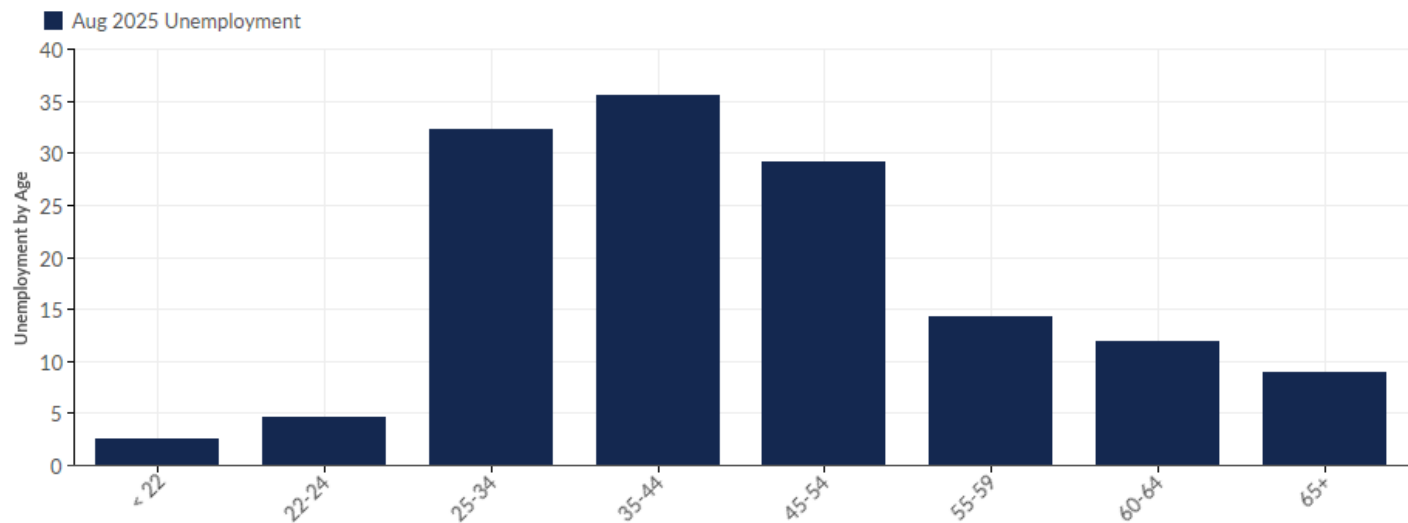

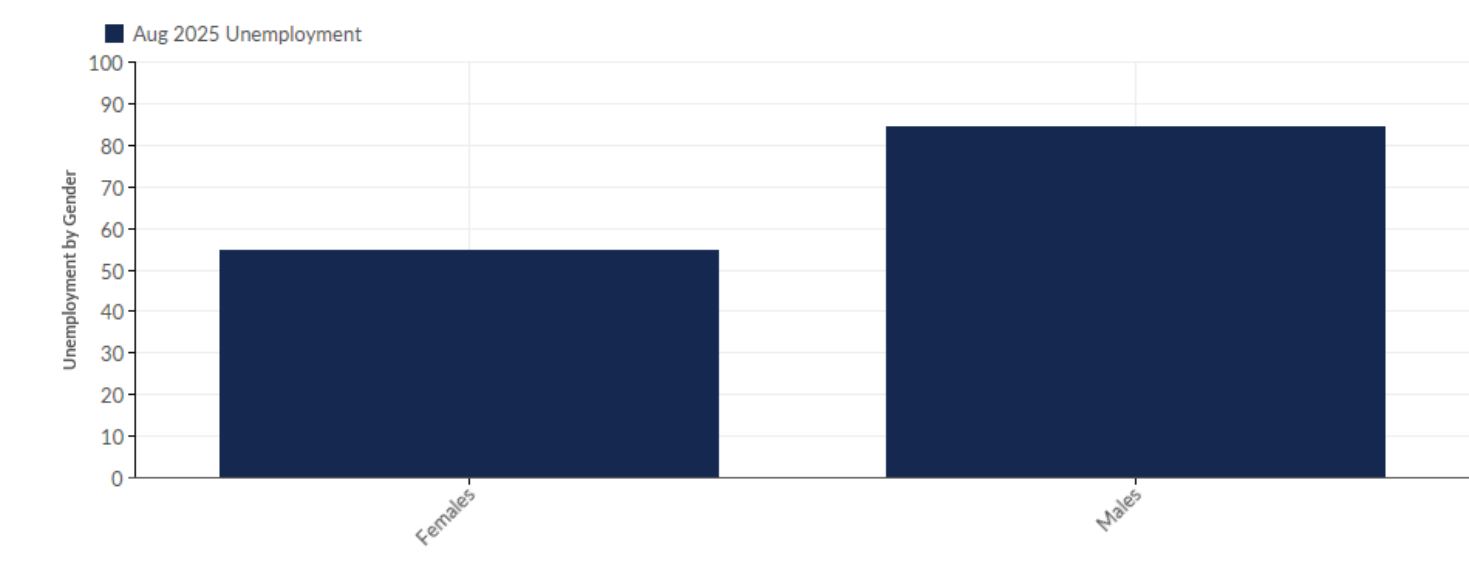

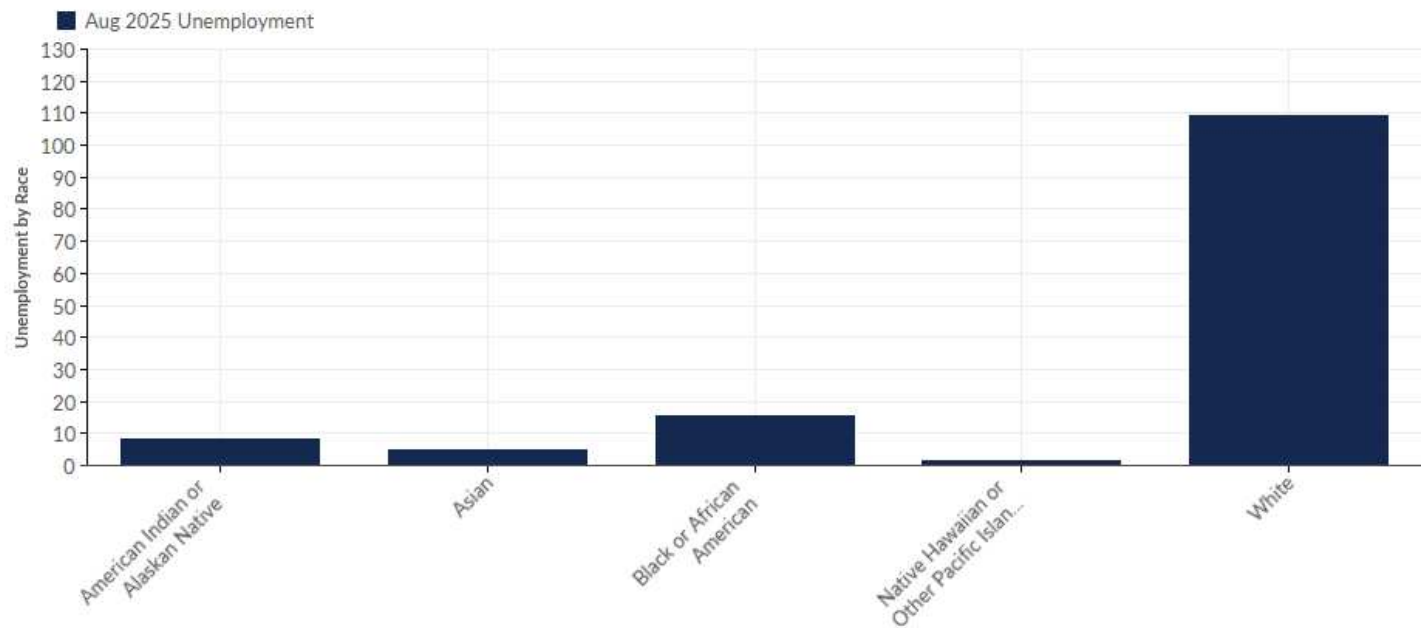

Unemployment by Gender



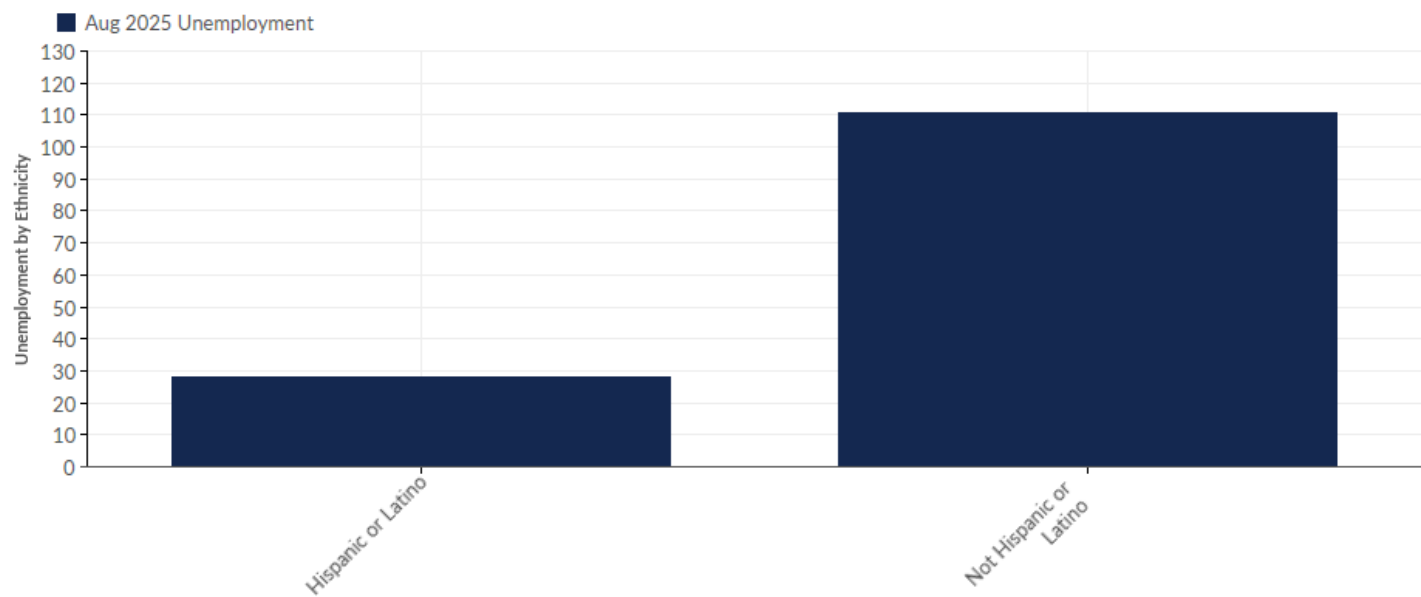

Unemployment by Ethnicity

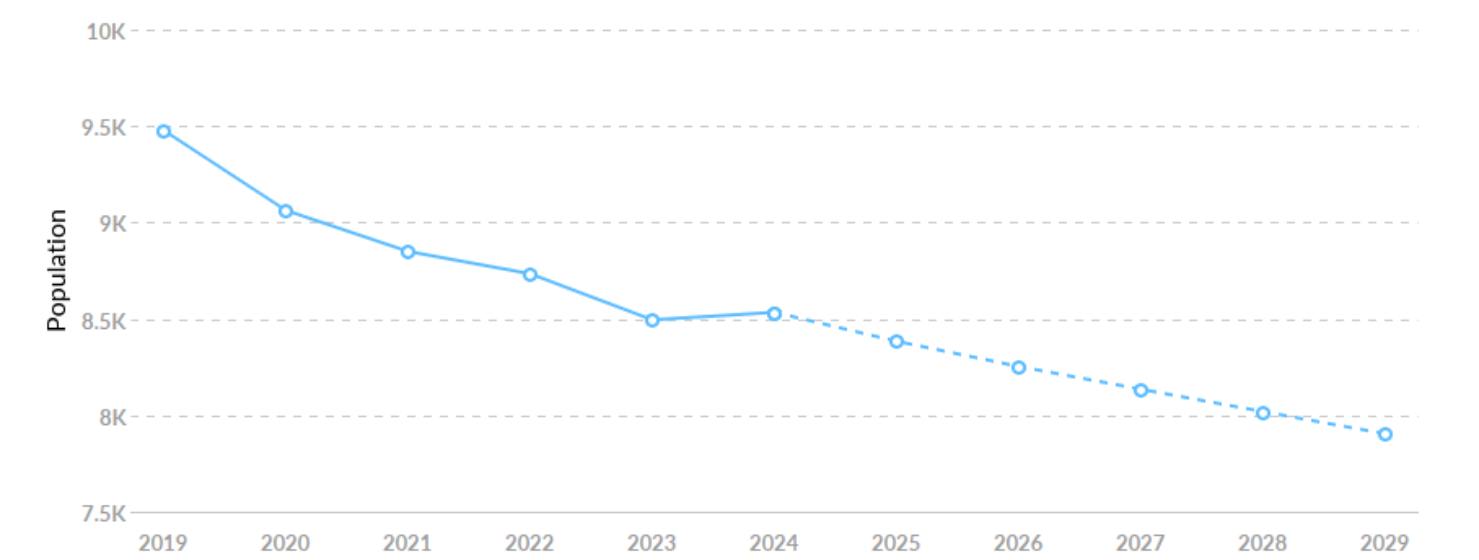

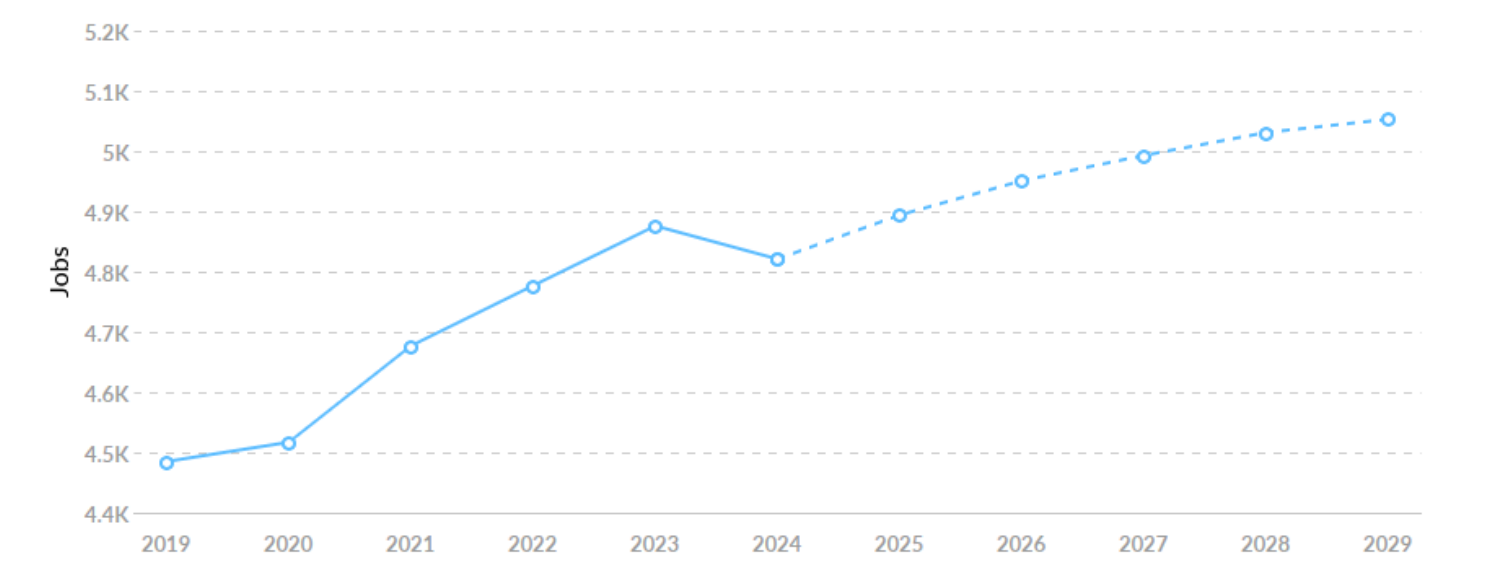

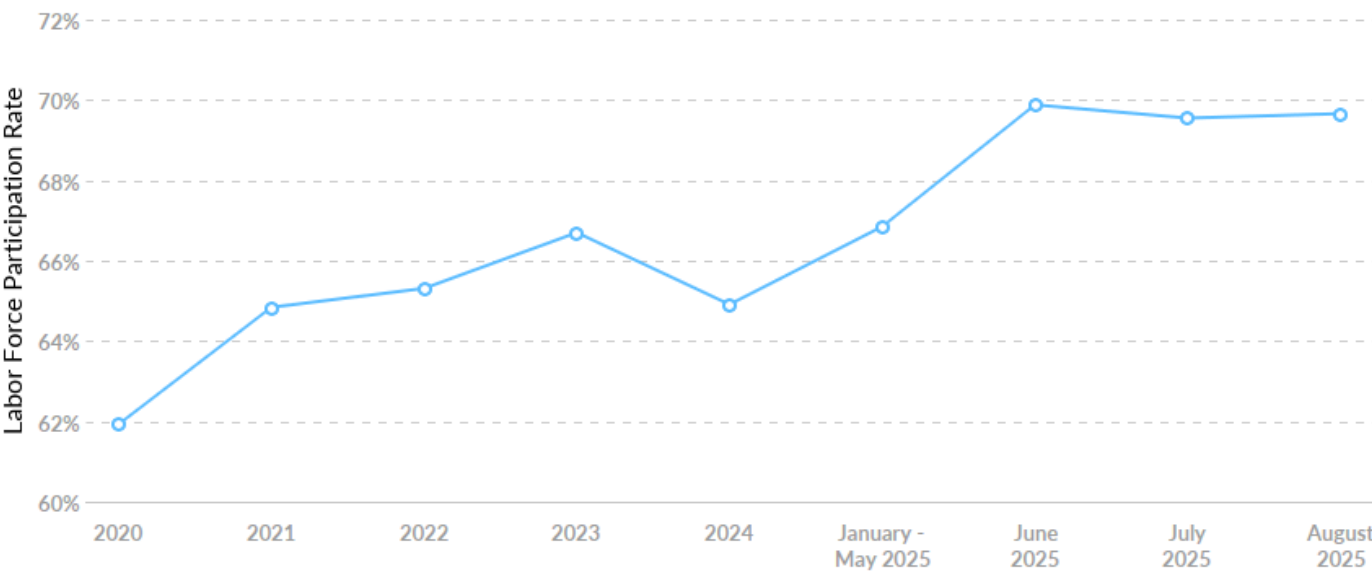
Job Trends

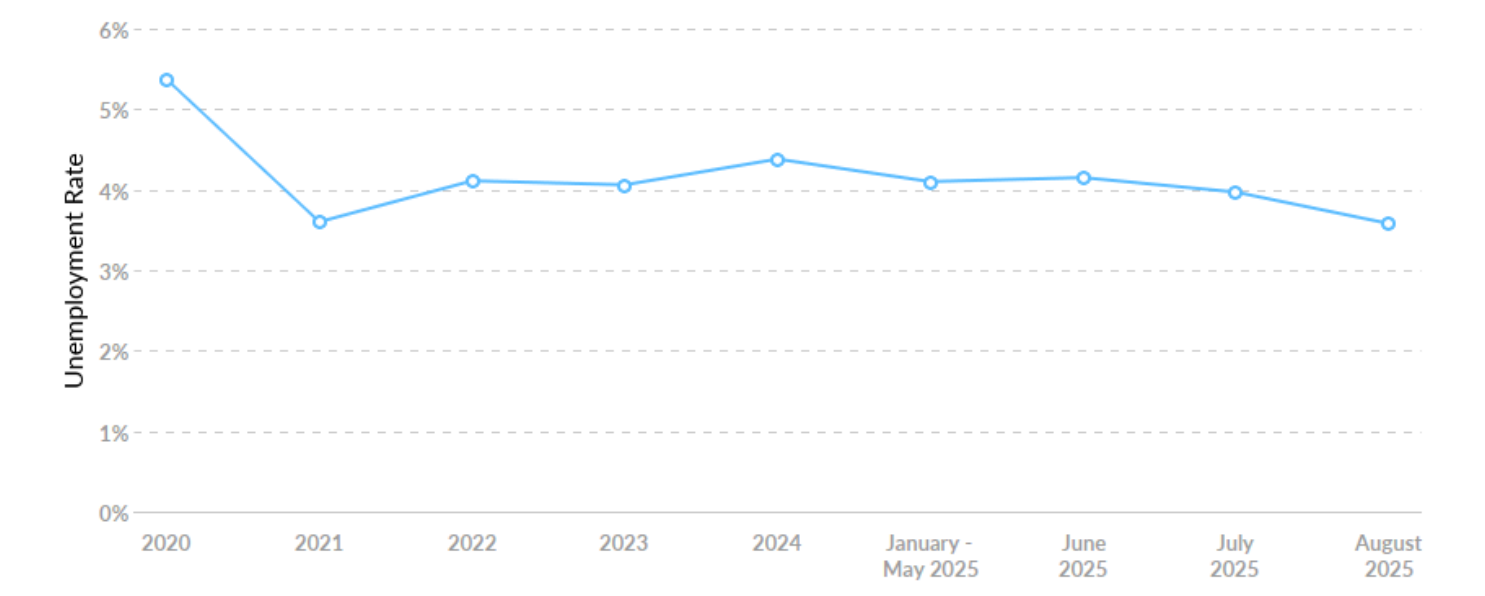

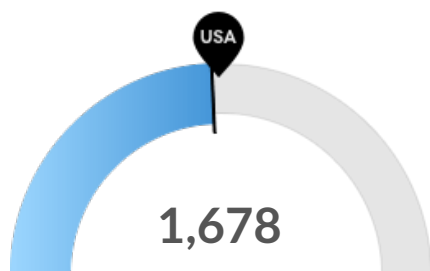
Unemployment Rate Trends

White Pine County, NV had an August 2025 unemployment rate of 3.58%, **decreasing from 5.37%** 5 years before.



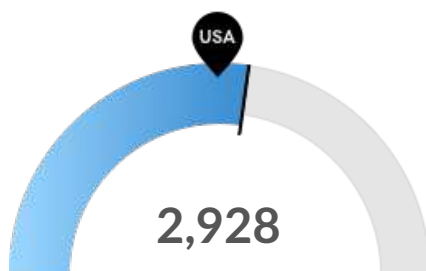

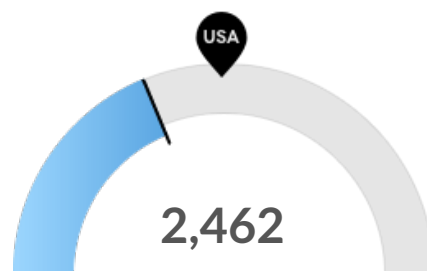
Millennials

White Pine County, NV has 1,678 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 1,747.



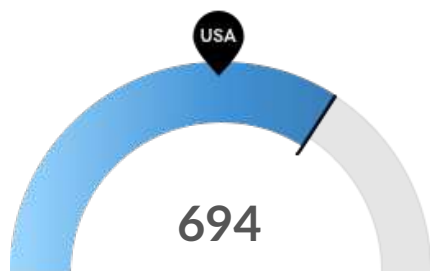
Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is high in White Pine County, NV. The national average for an area this size is 2,580 people 55 or older, while there are 2,928 here.



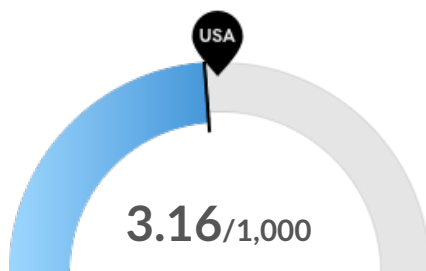
Racial Diversity

Racial diversity is low in White Pine County, NV. The national average for an area this size is 3,630 racially diverse people, while there are 2,462 here.



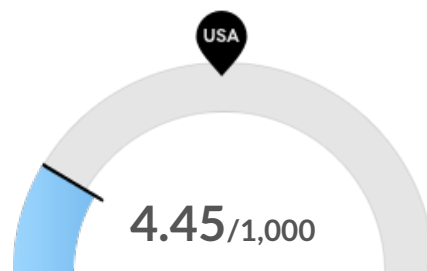
Veterans

White Pine County, NV has 3.16 violent crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 3.38 per 1,000 people.

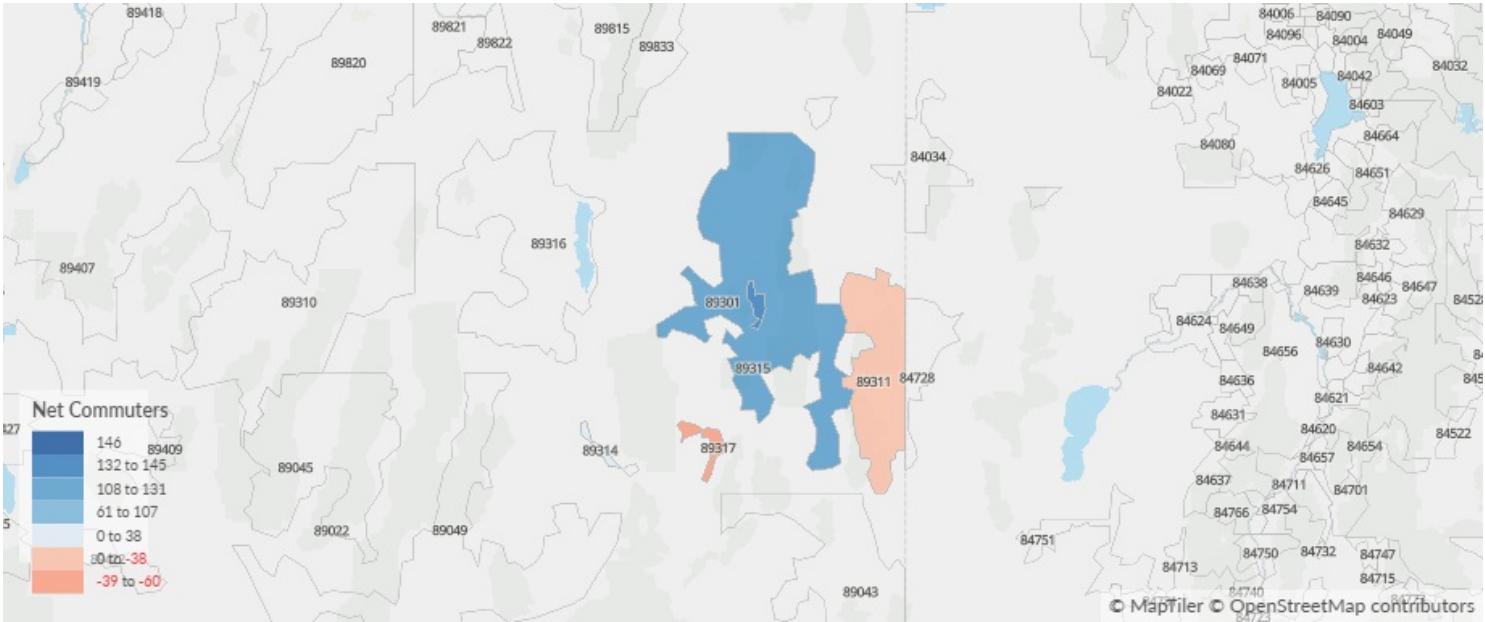


Property Crime

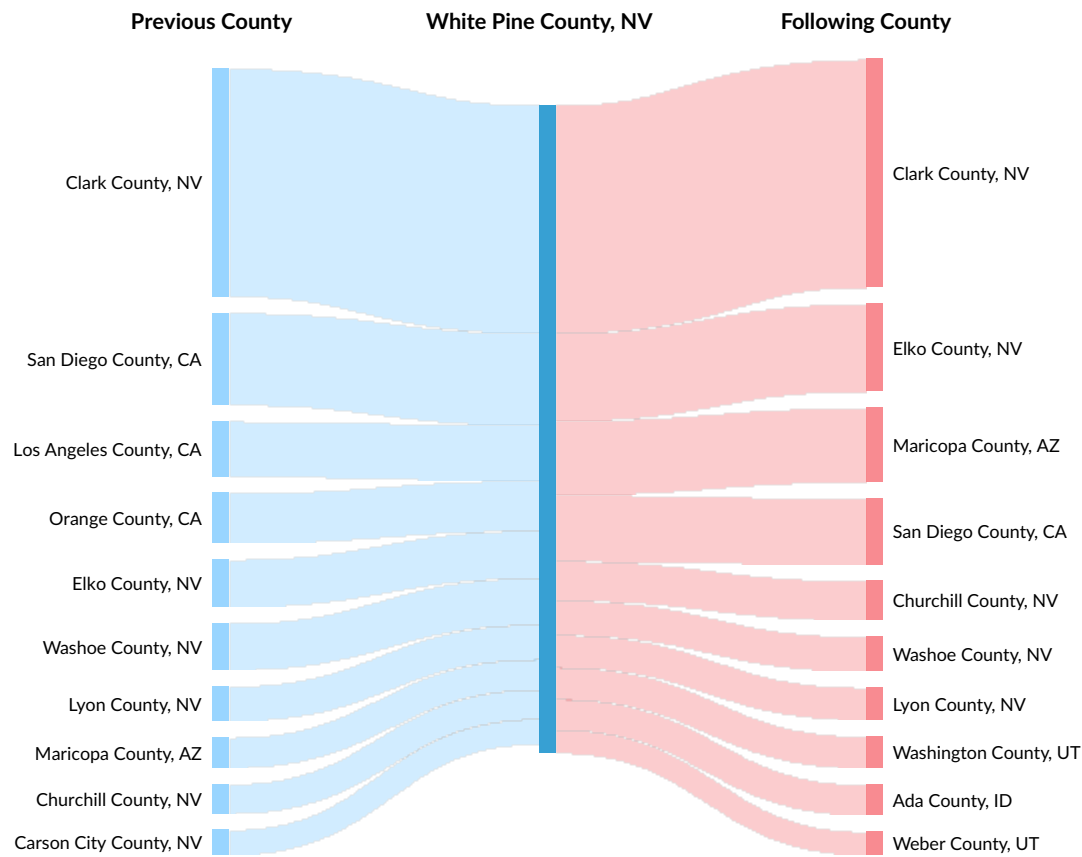

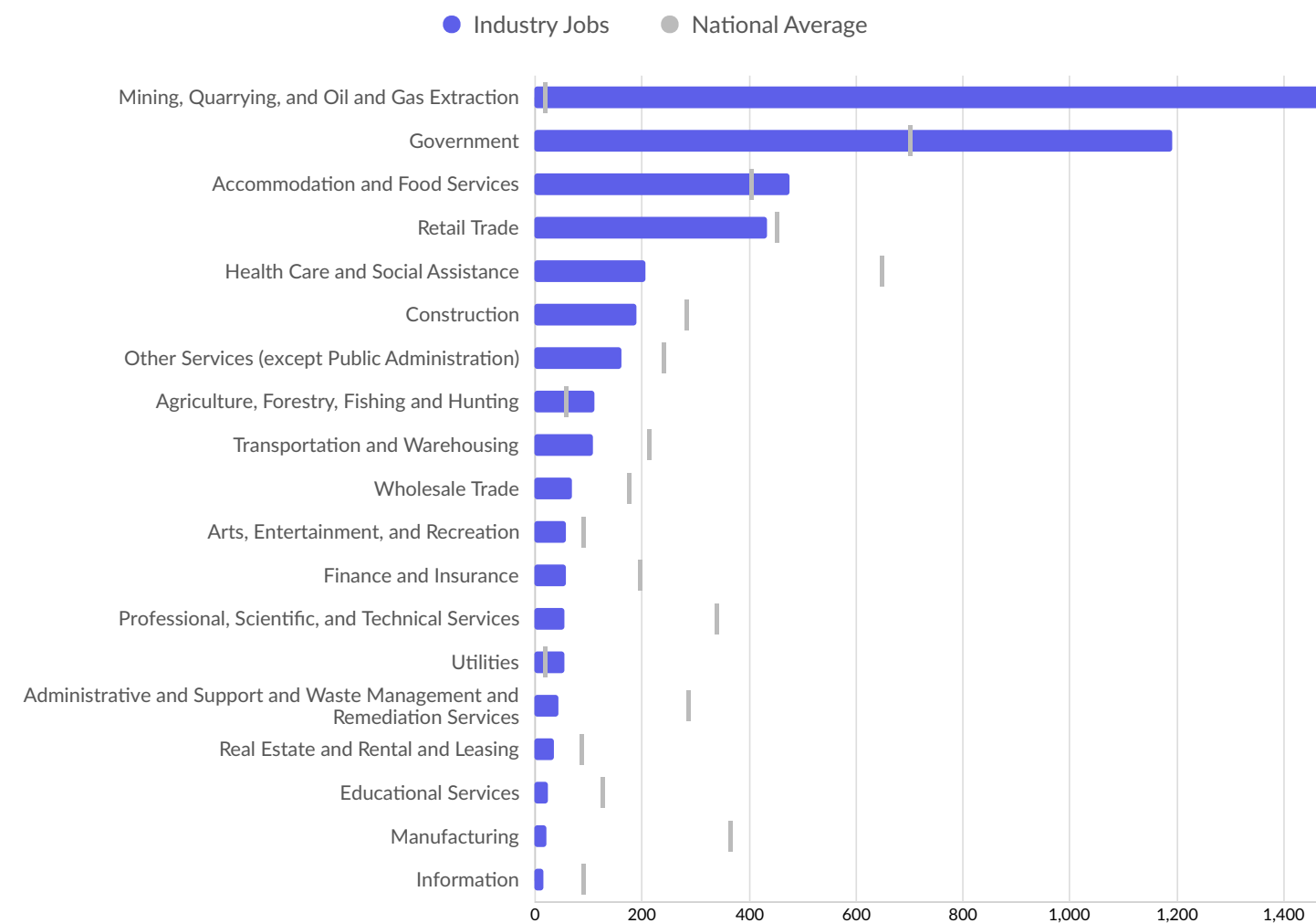

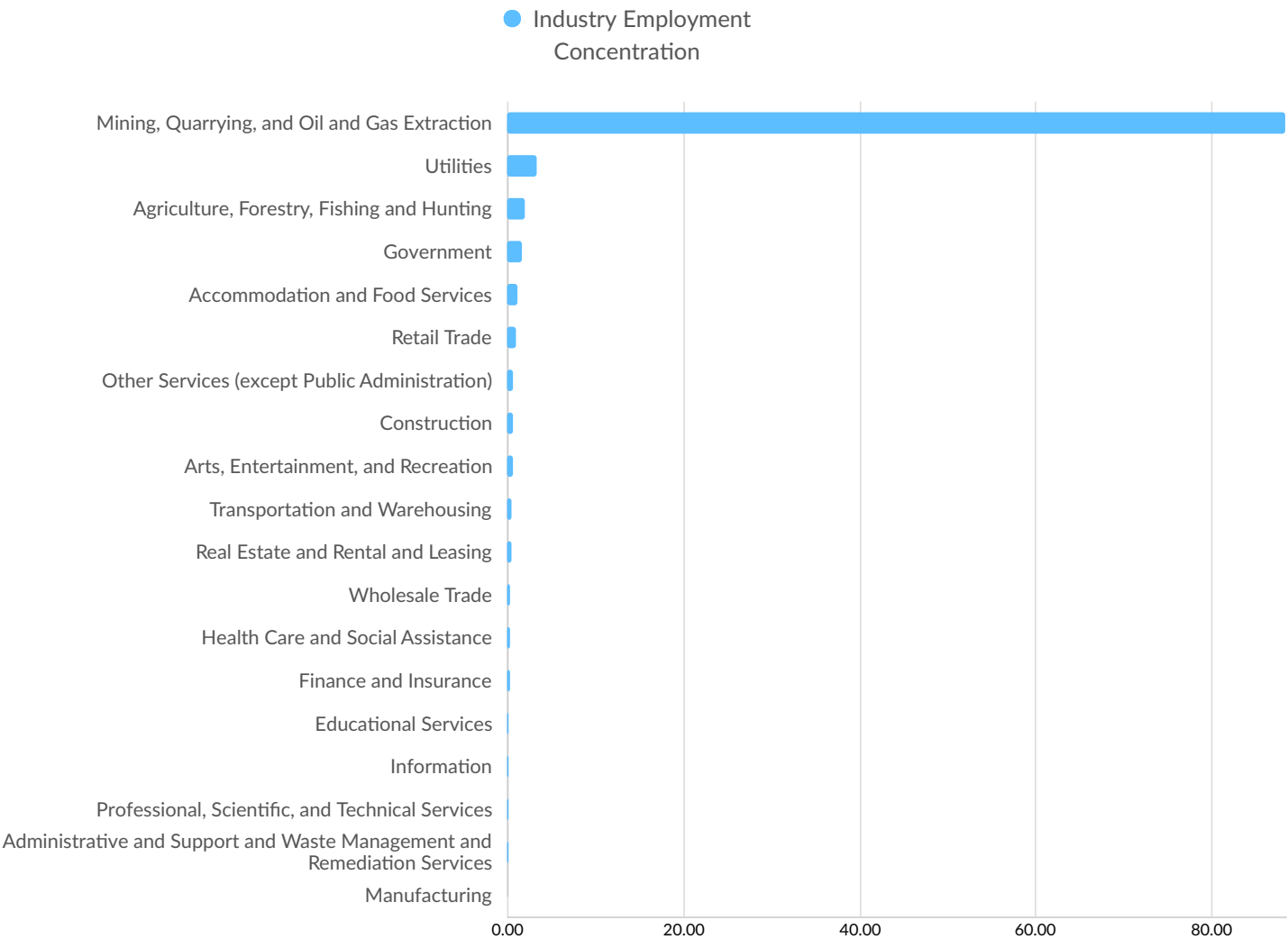

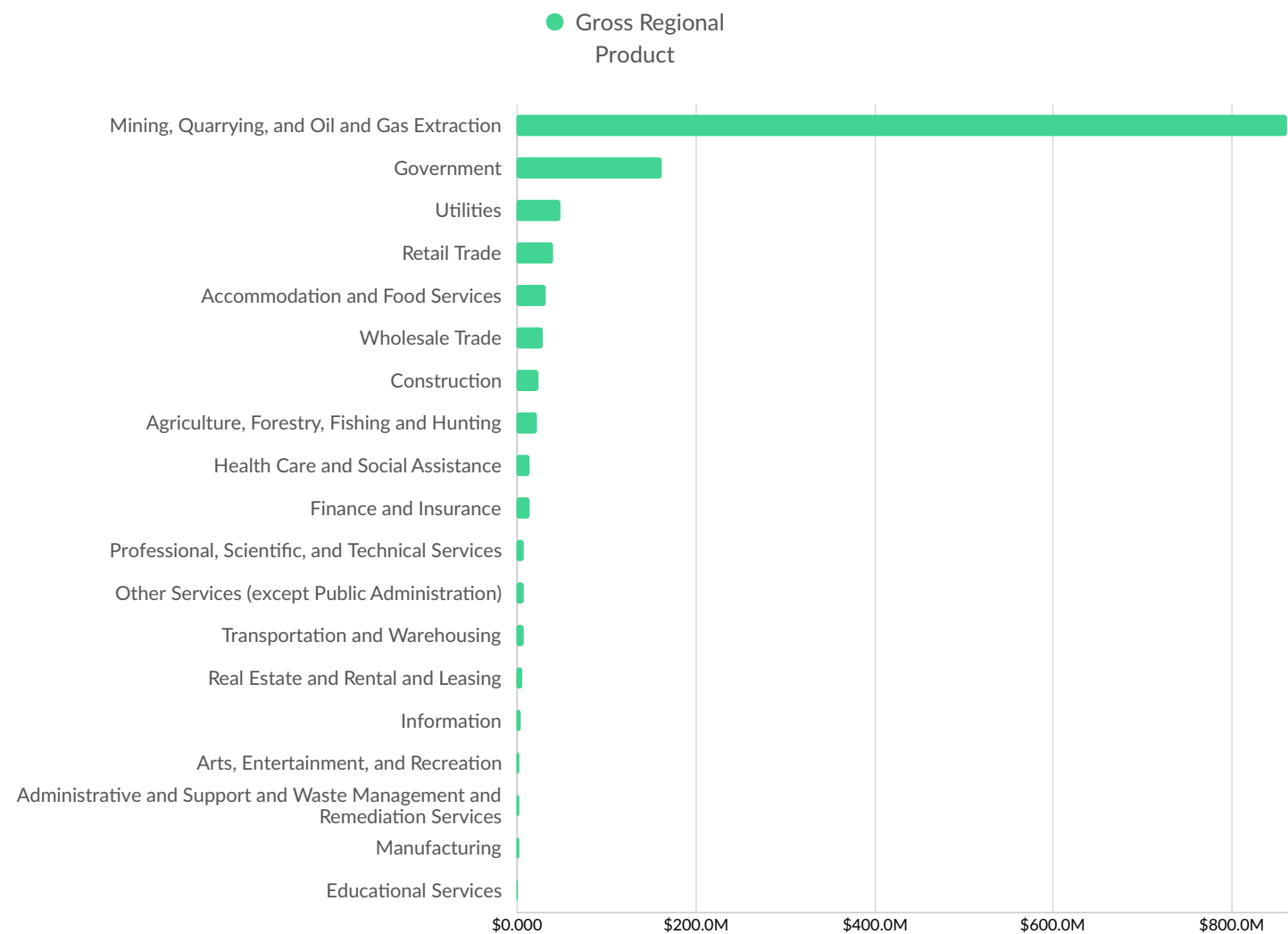
Top Growing Industries



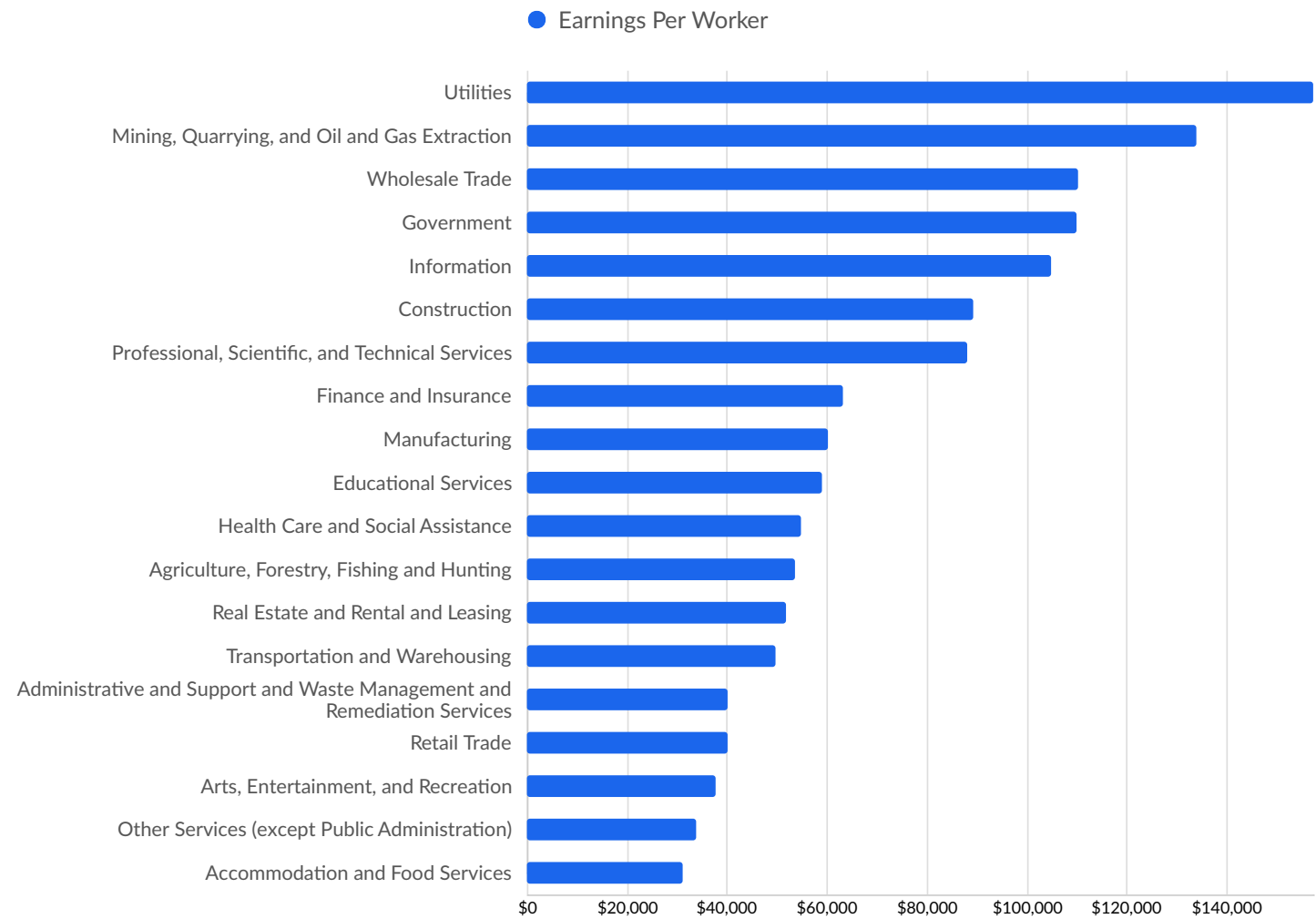
Top Industry Employment Concentration

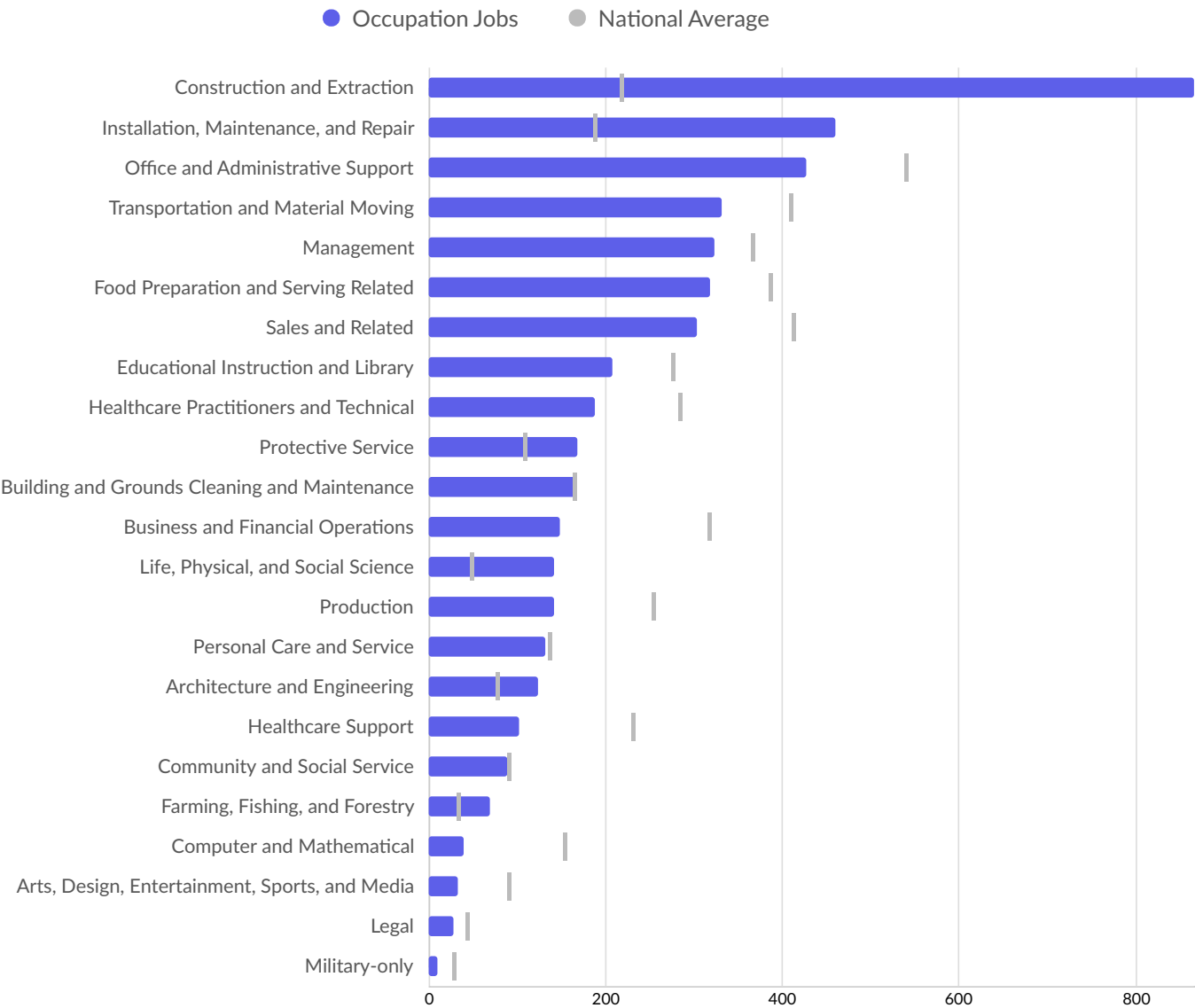

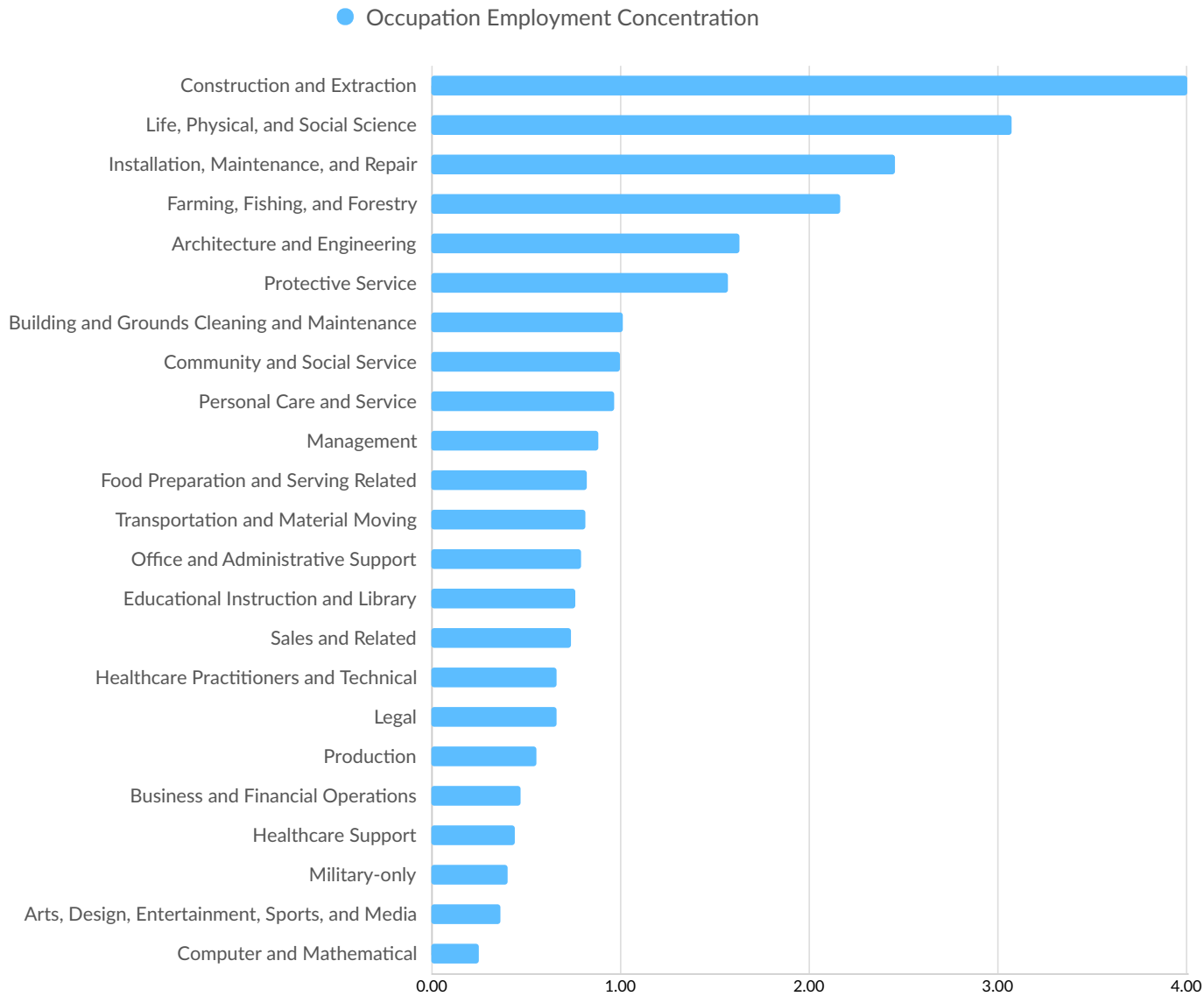

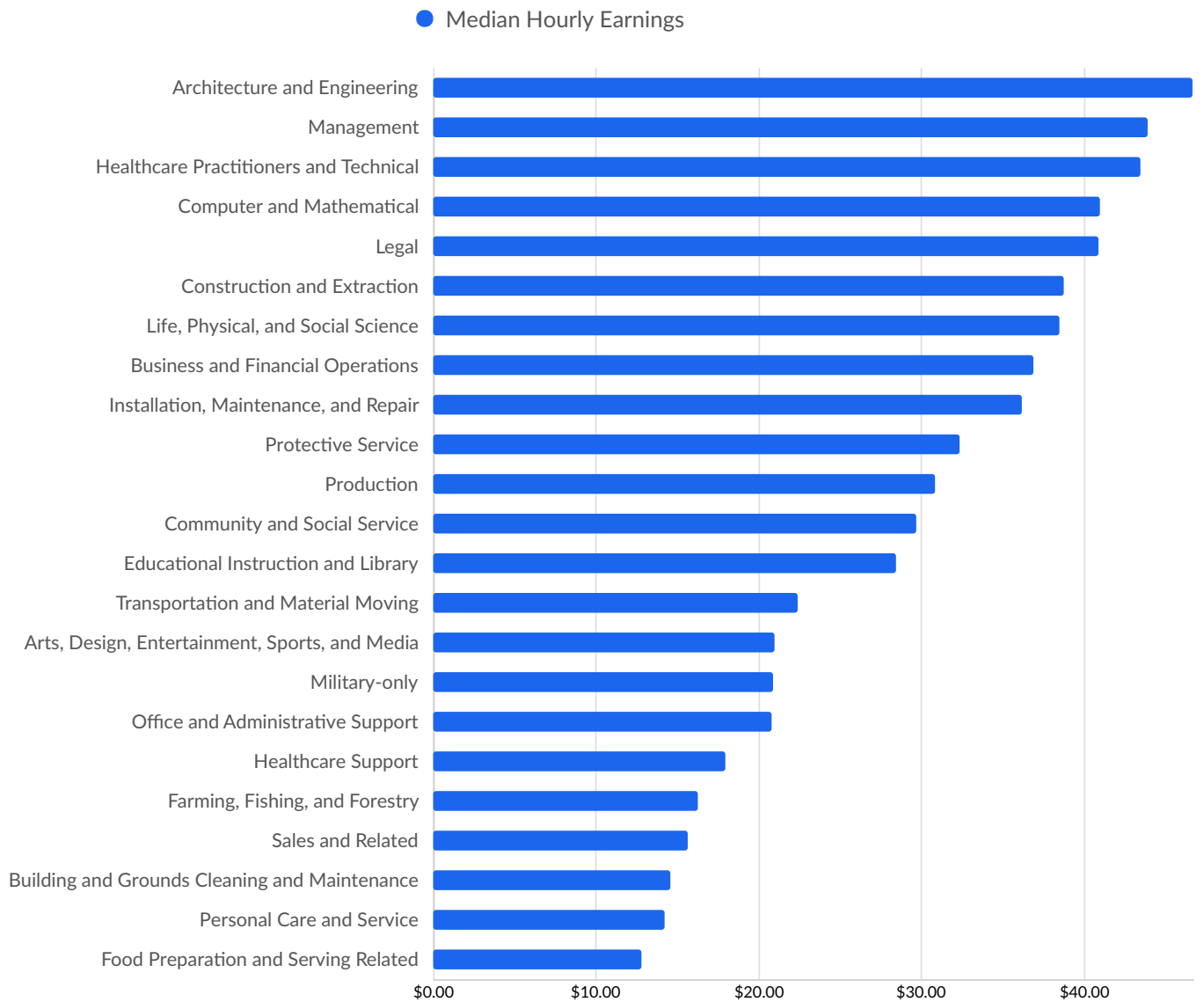
Top Growing Occupations



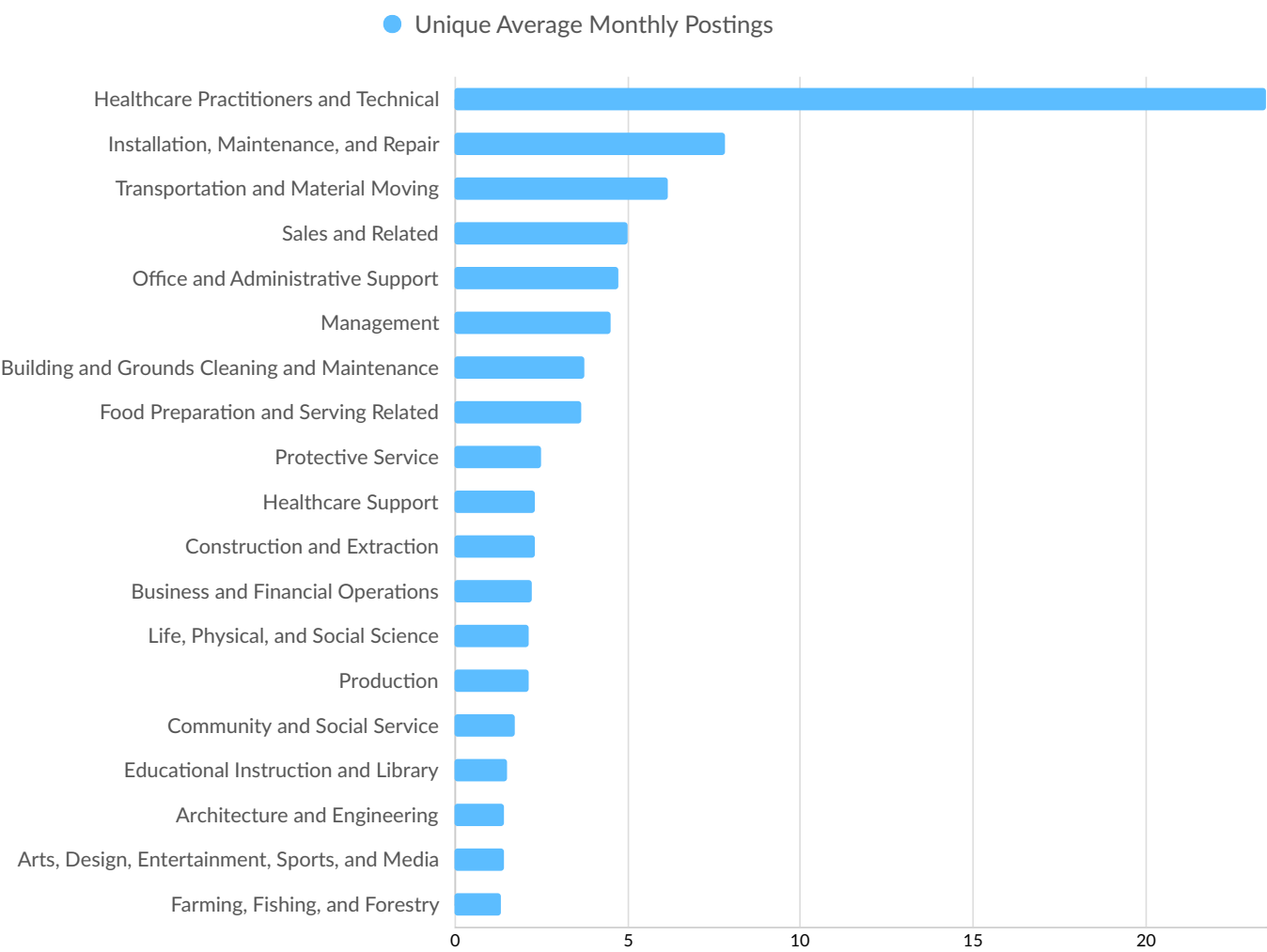
Top Occupation Employment Concentration



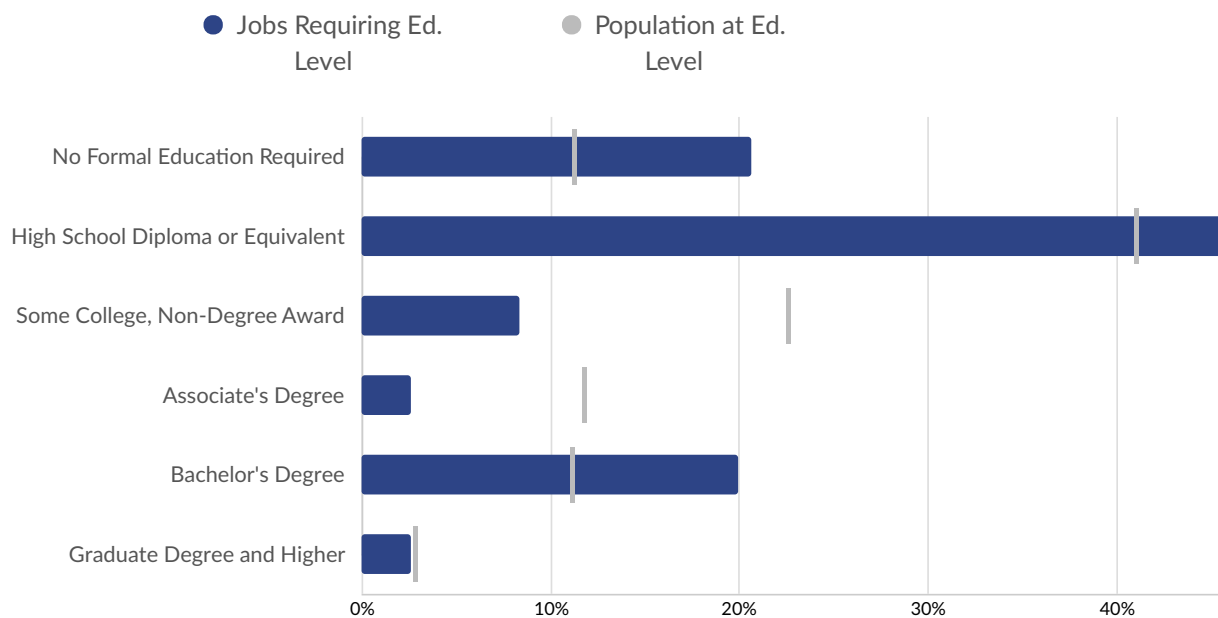
