
Median household income is **\$4.7K below** the national median household income of \$78.5K.

- From 2020 to 2025, jobs **increased by 24.9%** in Clark County, NV from 1,011,548 to **1,263,188**. This change **outpaced the national growth rate of 10.6% by 14.3%**. As the number of jobs increased, the **labor force participation rate increased from 60.9% to 65.6% between 2020 and 2025**.
- Concerning educational attainment, **18.3% of Clark County, NV residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (3.5% below the national average), and **8.5% hold an Associate's Degree** (0.4% below the national average).
- The top three industries in 2025 are Traveler Accommodation, Restaurants and Other Eating Places, and Education and Hospitals (Local Government).



Nov 2025 Labor Force Breakdown




Educational Attainment





Unemployment by Gender





Unemployment by Ethnicity



Population Trends




Job Trends




Unemployment Rate Trends


Millennials

Clark County, NV has 527,855 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 491,072.




Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is about average in Clark County, NV. The national average for an area this size is 725,363 people 55 or older, while there are 684,475 here.




Racial Diversity

Racial diversity is high in Clark County, NV. The national average for an area this size is 1,020,441 racially diverse people, while there are 1,498,907 here.




Veterans

Clark County, NV has 3.95 violent crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 3.38 per 1,000 people.




Property Crime








Top Growing Industries




Top Industry Employment Concentration






Largest Occupations

Top Occupation Employment Concentration




Top Occupation Earnings


