Takeaways

- As of 2025 the region's population **increased by 2.1%** since 2020, growing by 38. Population is expected to **increase by 2.1%** between 2025 and 2030, adding 39.
- From 2020 to 2025, jobs **increased by 6.8%** in Eureka County, NV from 4,553 to **4,864**. This change **fell short of the national growth rate of 10.6% by 3.8%**. As the number of jobs increased, the **labor force participation rate increased from 45.8% to 46.3% between 2020 and 2025**.
- Concerning educational attainment, **8.0% of Eureka County, NV residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (13.8% below the national average), and **4.1% hold an Associate's Degree** (4.8% below the national average).
- The top three industries in 2025 are Metal Ore Mining, Support Activities for Mining, and Local Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals.



Nov 2025 Labor Force Breakdown




Educational Attainment





Unemployment by Gender





Unemployment by Ethnicity



Population Trends






Unemployment Rate Trends

Eureka County, NV had a November 2025 unemployment rate of 4.87%, **decreasing from 5.20%** 5 years before.






Millennials

Eureka County, NV has 310 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 384.




Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is high in Eureka County, NV. The national average for an area this size is 568 people 55 or older, while there are 681 here.




Racial Diversity

Racial diversity is low in Eureka County, NV. The national average for an area this size is 798 racially diverse people, while there are 416 here.




Veterans

Eureka County, NV has 9.59 violent crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 3.38 per 1,000 people.




Property Crime








Top Growing Industries








Top Growing Occupations




Top Occupation Employment Concentration




Top Occupation Earnings
