## Takeaways

- As of 2025 the region's population **declined by 0.8%** since 2020, falling by 147. Population is expected to **increase by 0.5%** between 2025 and 2030, adding 78.
- From 2020 to 2025, jobs **increased by 4.0%** in Humboldt County, NV from 8,269 to **8,601**. This change **fell short of the national growth rate of 10.6% by 6.6%**. As the number of jobs increased, the **labor force participation rate increased from 66.1% to 66.6% between 2020 and 2025**.
- Concerning educational attainment, **15.6% of Humboldt County, NV residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (6.2% below the national average), and **10.1% hold an Associate's Degree** (1.2% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2025 are Metal Ore Mining, Education and Hospitals (Local Government), and Restaurants and Other Eating Places.



## Nov 2025 Labor Force Breakdown




## Educational Attainment





## Unemployment by Gender





## Unemployment by Ethnicity



## Population Trends




## Job Trends




## Unemployment Rate Trends

Humboldt County, NV had a November 2025 unemployment rate of 3.72%, **decreasing from 5.00%** 5 years before.






**Millennials**

Humboldt County, NV has 3,361 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 3,504.




**Retiring Soon**

Retirement risk is about average in Humboldt County, NV. The national average for an area this size is 5,175 people 55 or older, while there are 4,941 here.




**Racial Diversity**

Racial diversity is low in Humboldt County, NV. The national average for an area this size is 7,281 racially diverse people, while there are 6,299 here.




**Veterans**

Humboldt County, NV has 4.62 violent crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 3.38 per 1,000 people.




**Property Crime**










## Top Industry Employment Concentration





## Top Occupation Employment Concentration




