### Takeaways

- As of 2025 the region's population **increased by 2.7%** since 2020, growing by 154. Population is expected to **increase by 7.2%** between 2025 and 2030, adding 425.
- From 2020 to 2025, jobs **increased by 9.8%** in Lander County, NV from 3,681 to **4,040**. This change **fell short of the national growth rate of 10.6% by 0.8%**. As the number of jobs increased, the **labor force participation rate decreased from 58.0% to 55.6% between 2020 and 2025**.
- Concerning educational attainment, **6.0% of Lander County, NV residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (15.8% below the national average), and **16.1% hold an Associate's Degree** (7.1% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2025 are Metal Ore Mining, Education and Hospitals (Local Government), and Local Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals.



## Nov 2025 Labor Force Breakdown




## Educational Attainment





## Unemployment by Gender





## Unemployment by Ethnicity



## Population Trends


As of 2025 the region's population increased by 2.7% since 2020, growing by 154. Population is expected to increase by 7.2% between 2025 and 2030, adding 425.




## Unemployment Rate Trends

Lander County, NV had a November 2025 unemployment rate of 4.51%, **decreasing from 6.52%** 5 years before.






**Millennials**

Lander County, NV has 1,089 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 1,184.




**Retiring Soon**

Retirement risk is about average in Lander County, NV. The national average for an area this size is 1,749 people 55 or older, while there are 1,757 here.




**Racial Diversity**

Racial diversity is low in Lander County, NV. The national average for an area this size is 2,461 racially diverse people, while there are 1,876 here.




**Veterans**

Lander County, NV has 2.42 violent crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 3.38 per 1,000 people.




**Property Crime**












## Largest Occupations




## Top Growing Occupations




## Top Occupation Employment Concentration




