- From 2020 to 2025, jobs **increased by 8.6%** in White Pine County, NV from 4,514 to **4,900**. This change **fell short of the national growth rate of 10.6% by 2.0%**. As the number of jobs increased, the **labor force participation rate increased from 63.1% to 69.9% between 2020 and 2025**.
- Concerning educational attainment, **11.2% of White Pine County, NV residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (10.6% below the national average), and **12.0% hold an Associate's Degree** (3.1% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2025 are Metal Ore Mining, Education and Hospitals (Local Government), and State Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals.



## Nov 2025 Labor Force Breakdown




## Educational Attainment





## Unemployment by Gender





## Unemployment by Ethnicity



## Population Trends




## Job Trends




## Unemployment Rate Trends

White Pine County, NV had a November 2025 unemployment rate of 3.72%, **decreasing from 5.37%** 5 years before.






**Millennials**

White Pine County, NV has 1,678 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 1,747.




**Retiring Soon**

Retirement risk is high in White Pine County, NV. The national average for an area this size is 2,580 people 55 or older, while there are 2,928 here.




**Racial Diversity**

Racial diversity is low in White Pine County, NV. The national average for an area this size is 3,630 racially diverse people, while there are 2,462 here.




**Veterans**

White Pine County, NV has 3.16 violent crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 3.38 per 1,000 people.




**Property Crime**










## Top Industry Employment Concentration




## Largest Occupations




## Top Growing Occupations




## Top Occupation Employment Concentration




