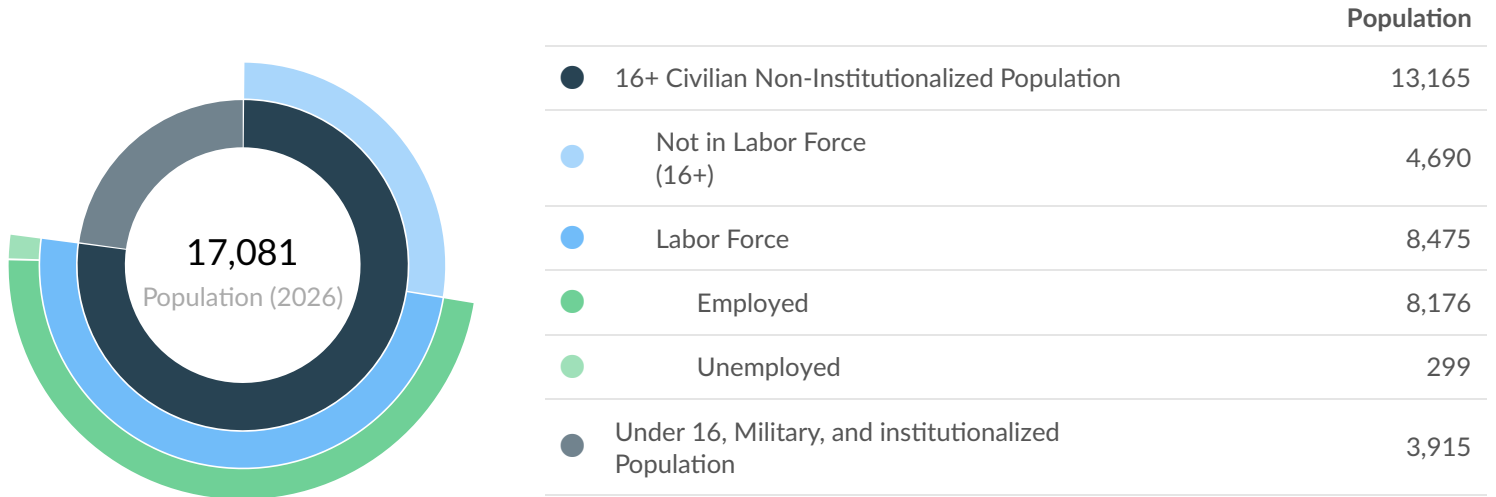
Median household income is **\$339 above** the national median household income of \$80.7K.

- From 2020 to 2025, jobs **increased by 5.0%** in Humboldt County, NV from 8,269 to **8,680**. This change **fell short of the national growth rate of 10.6% by 5.6%**. As the number of jobs increased, the **labor force participation rate decreased from 68.9% to 67.0% between 2020 and 2025**.
- Concerning educational attainment, **14.9% of Humboldt County, NV residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (6.9% below the national average), and **9.5% hold an Associate's Degree** (0.6% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2025 are Metal Ore Mining, Education and Hospitals (Local Government), and Restaurants and Other Eating Places.

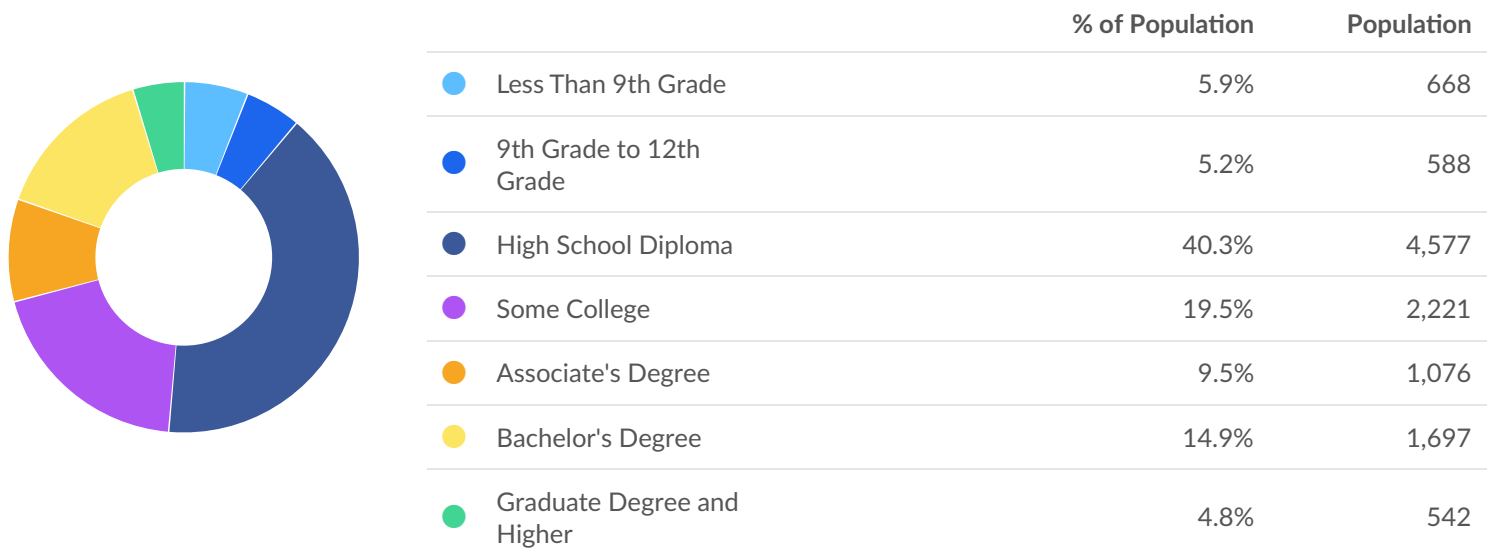

Mar 2026 Labor Force Breakdown



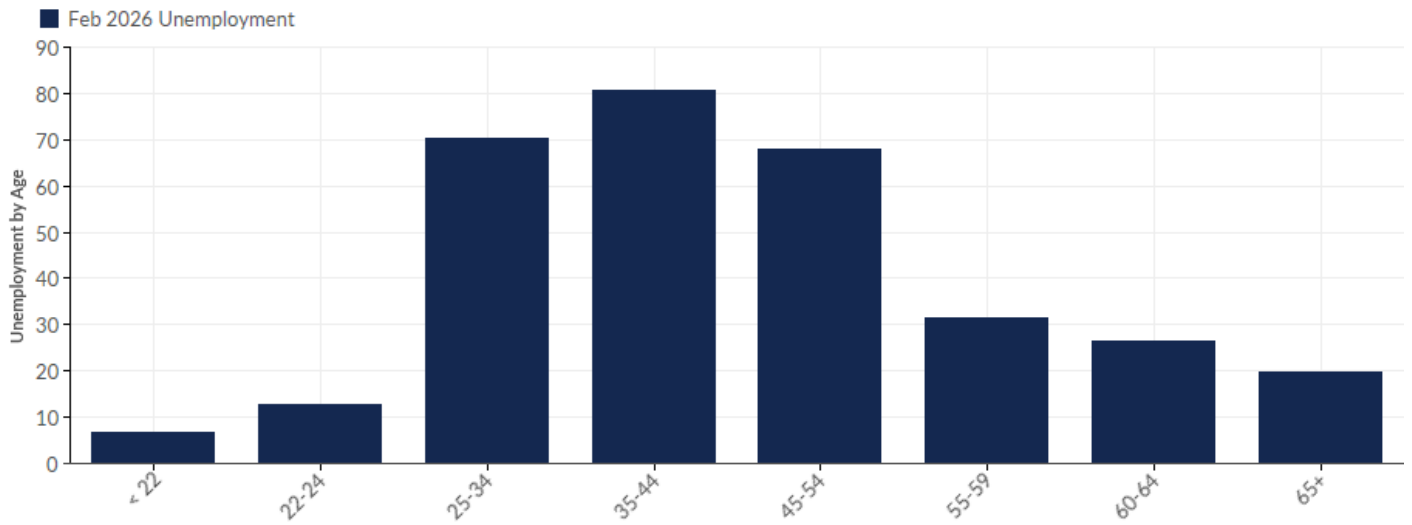
Educational Attainment

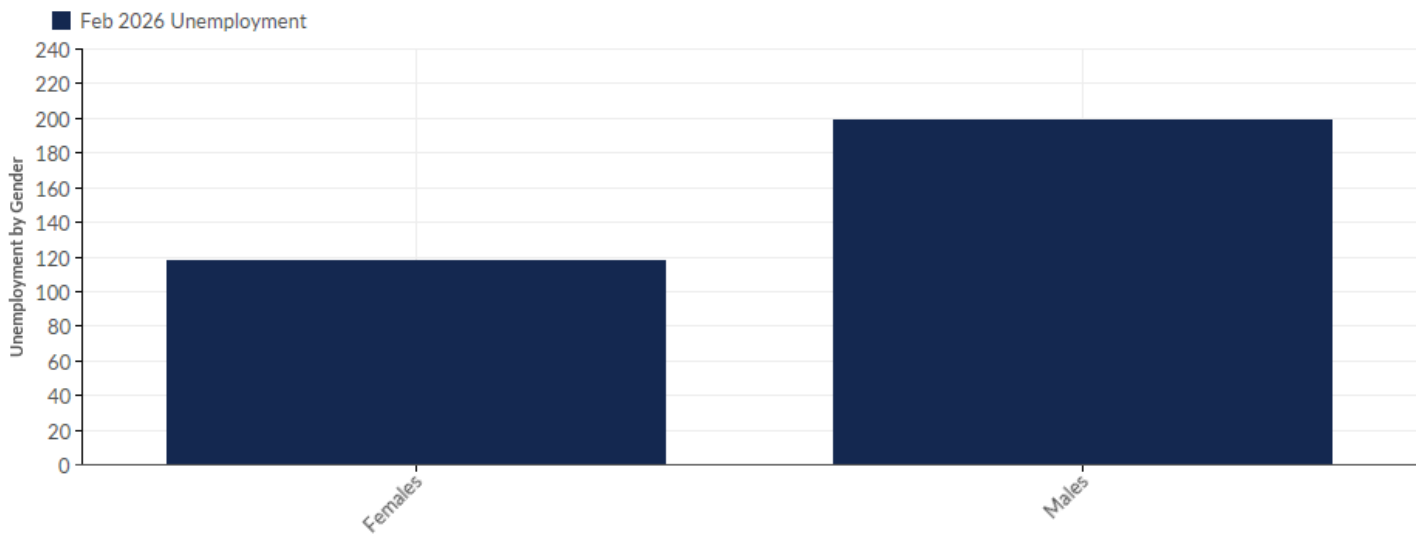

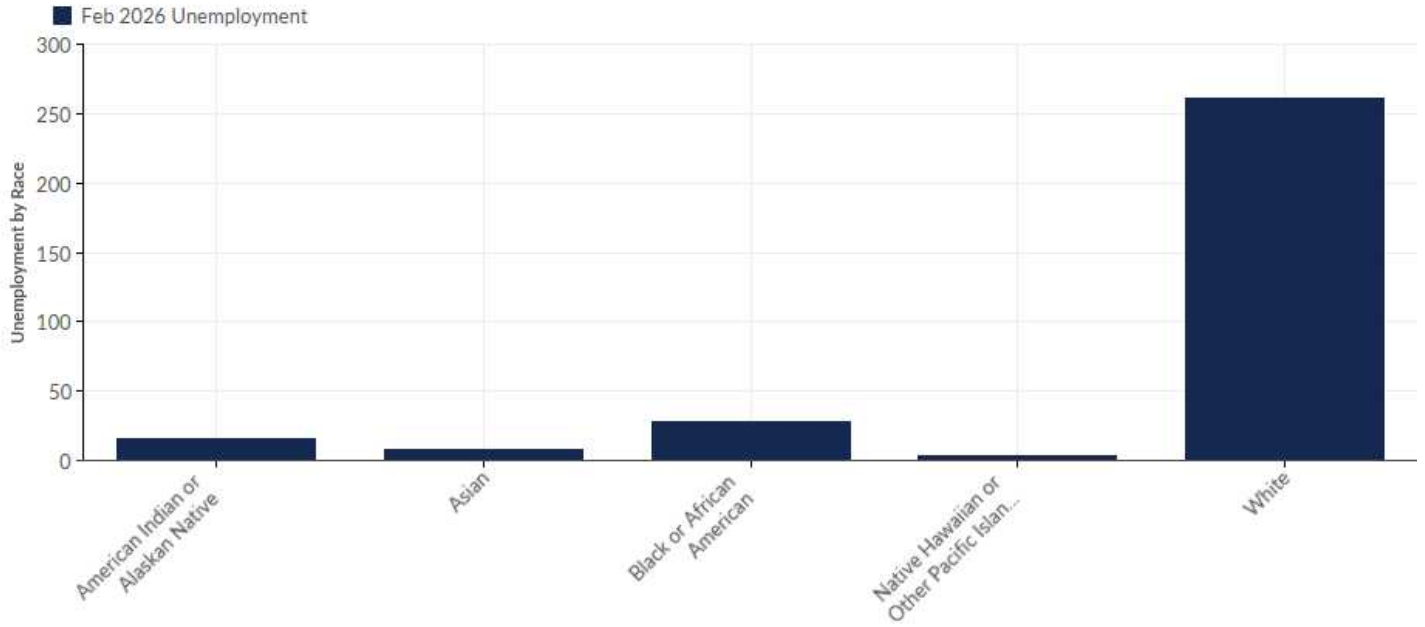

Unemployment by Gender



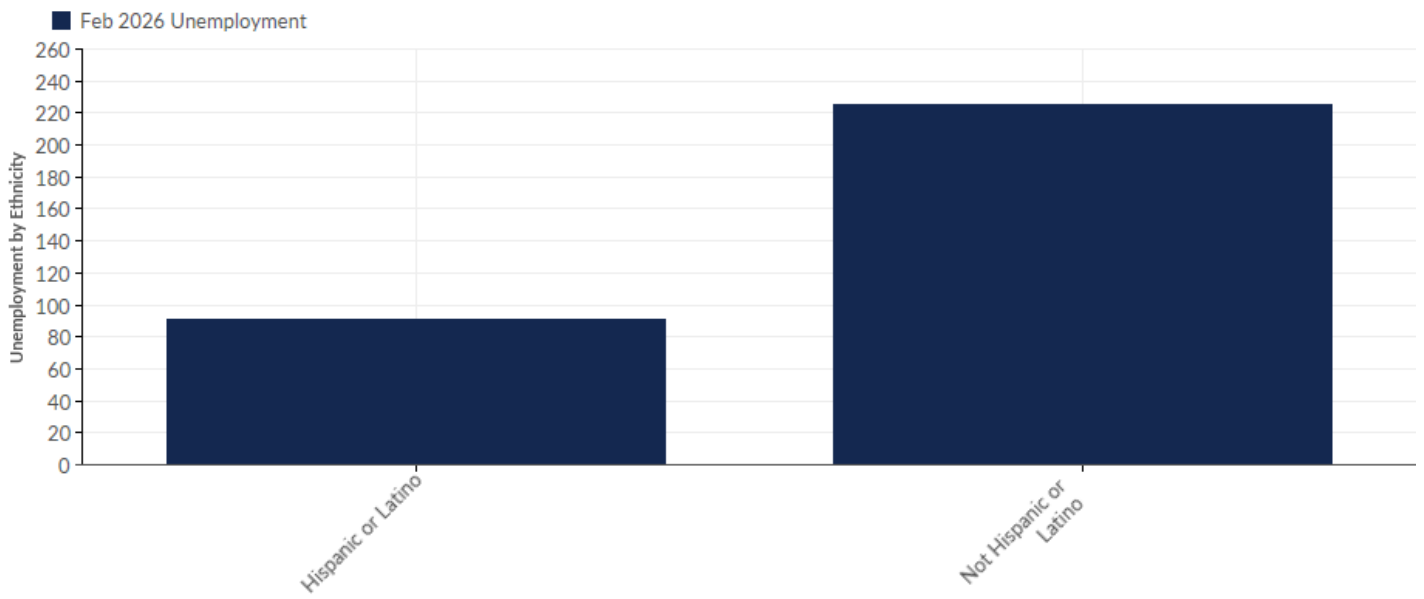

Unemployment by Ethnicity

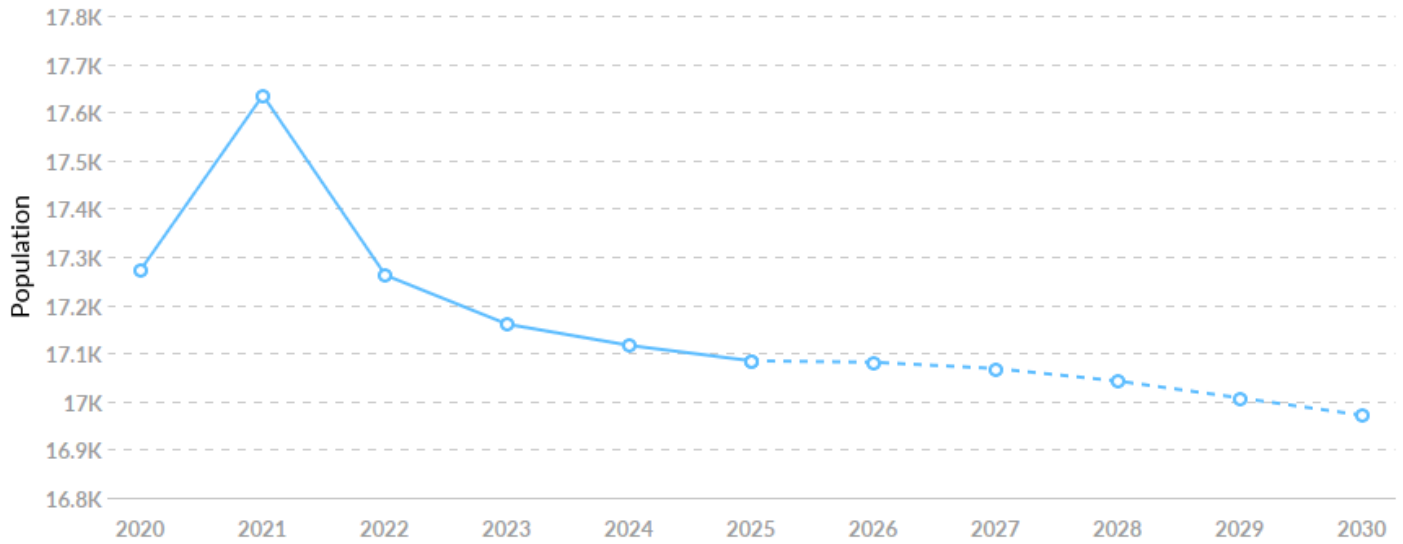

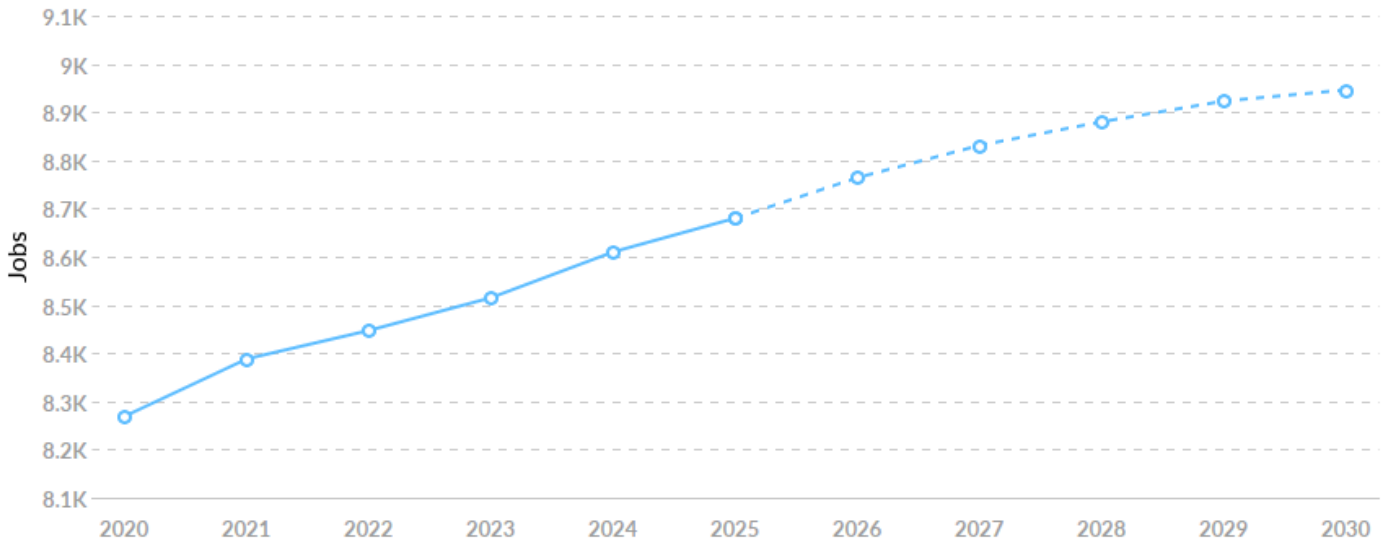

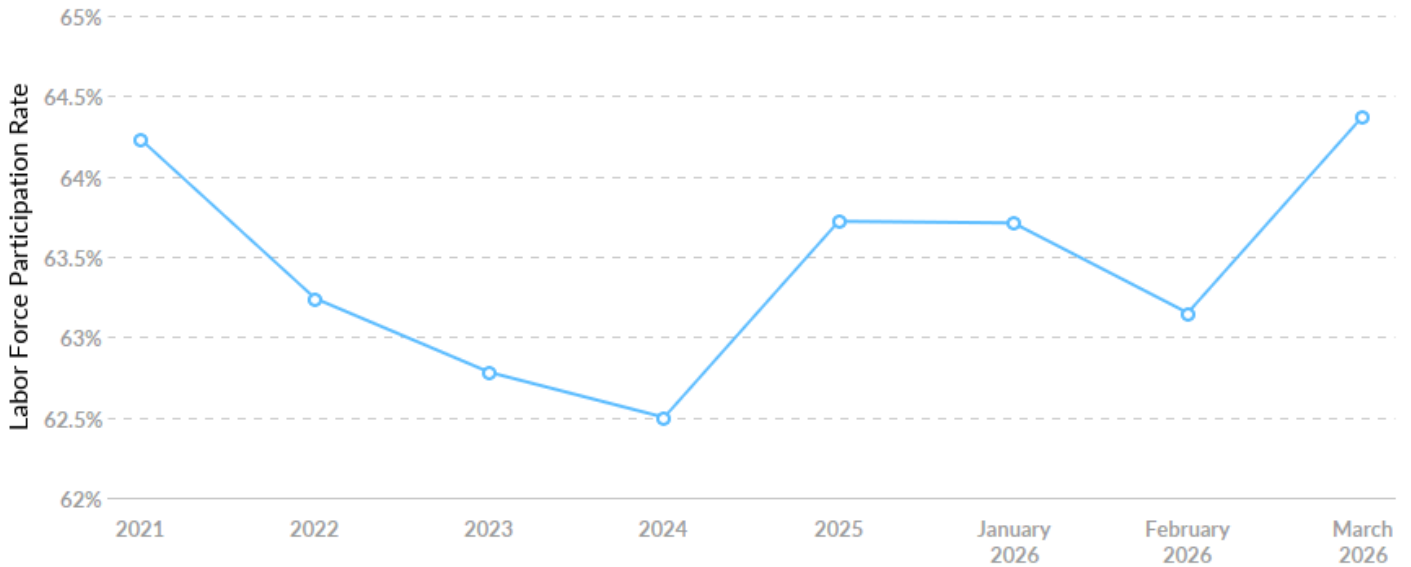
Job Trends

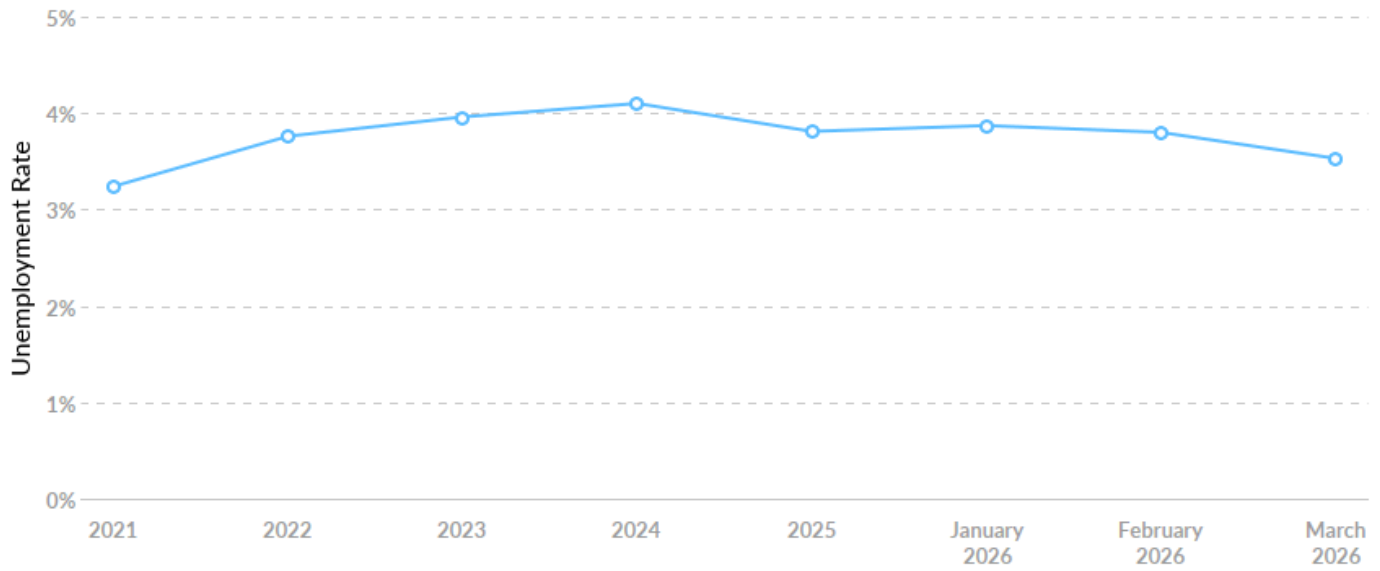

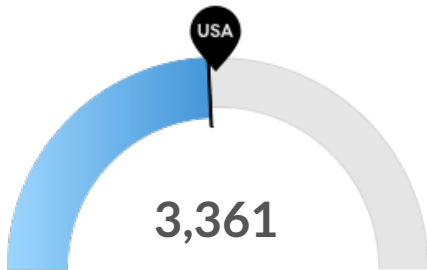
Unemployment Rate Trends

Humboldt County, NV had a March 2026 unemployment rate of 3.53%, **increasing from 3.24%** 5 years before.



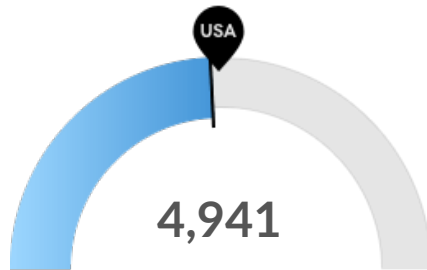

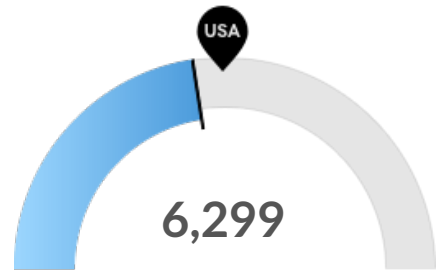
Millennials

Humboldt County, NV has 3,361 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 3,504.



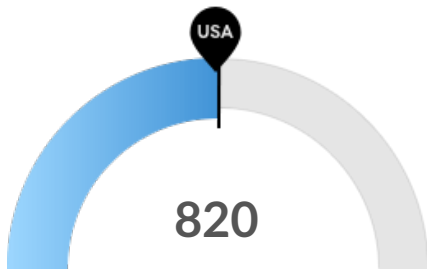
Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is about average in Humboldt County, NV. The national average for an area this size is 5,175 people 55 or older, while there are 4,941 here.



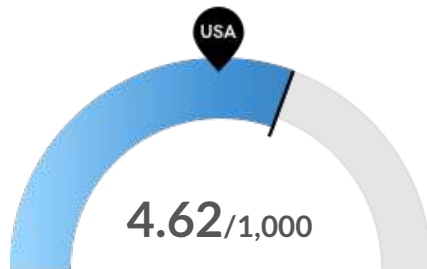
Racial Diversity

Racial diversity is low in Humboldt County, NV. The national average for an area this size is 7,281 racially diverse people, while there are 6,299 here.



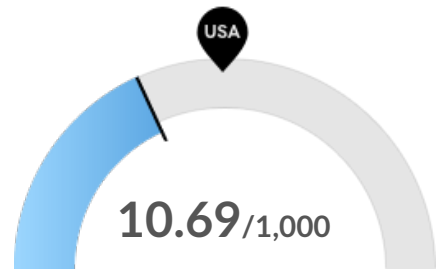
Veterans

Humboldt County, NV has 4.62 violent crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 3.38 per 1,000 people.

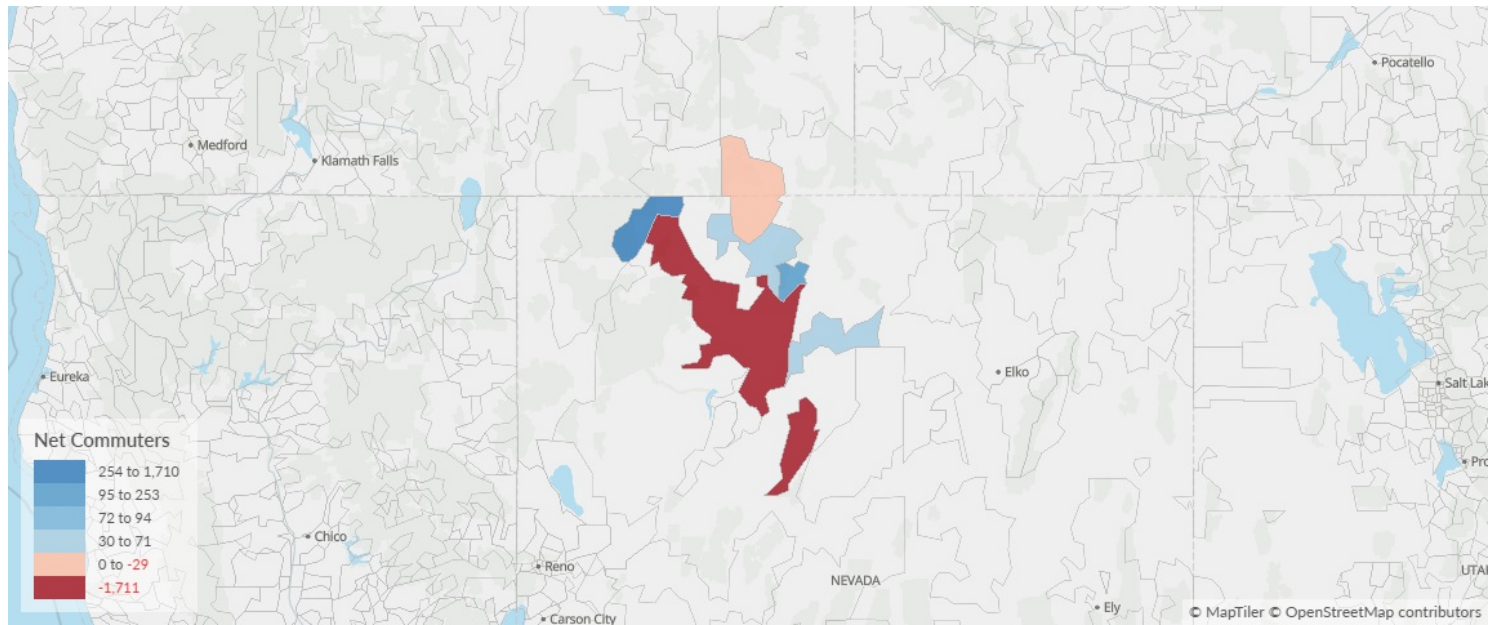


Property Crime

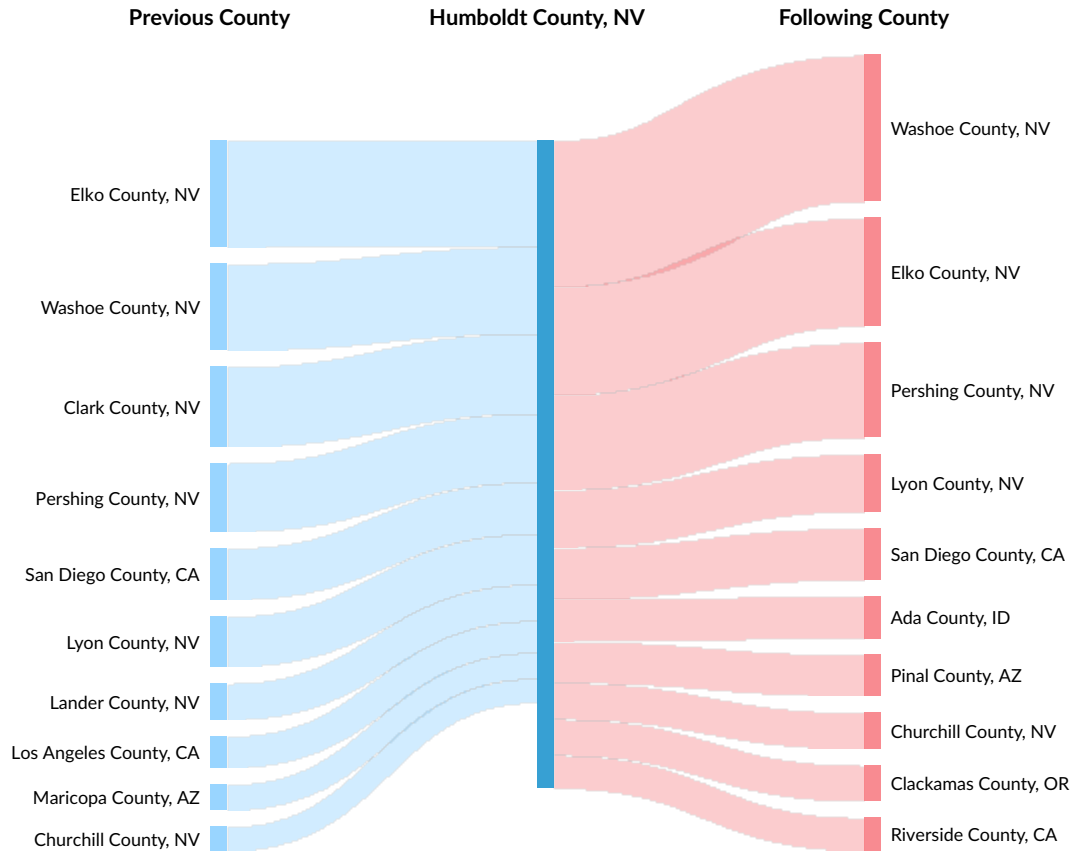

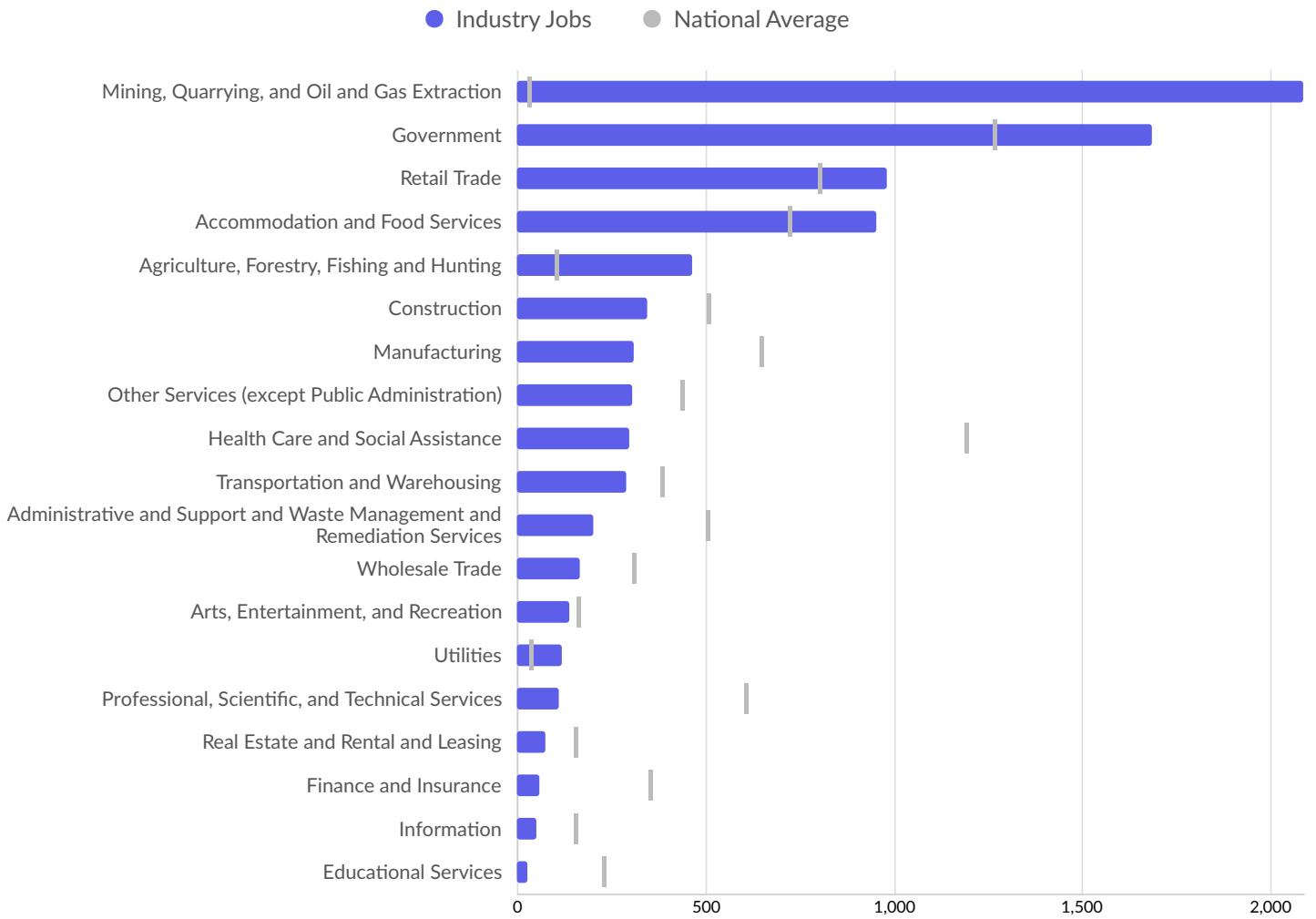

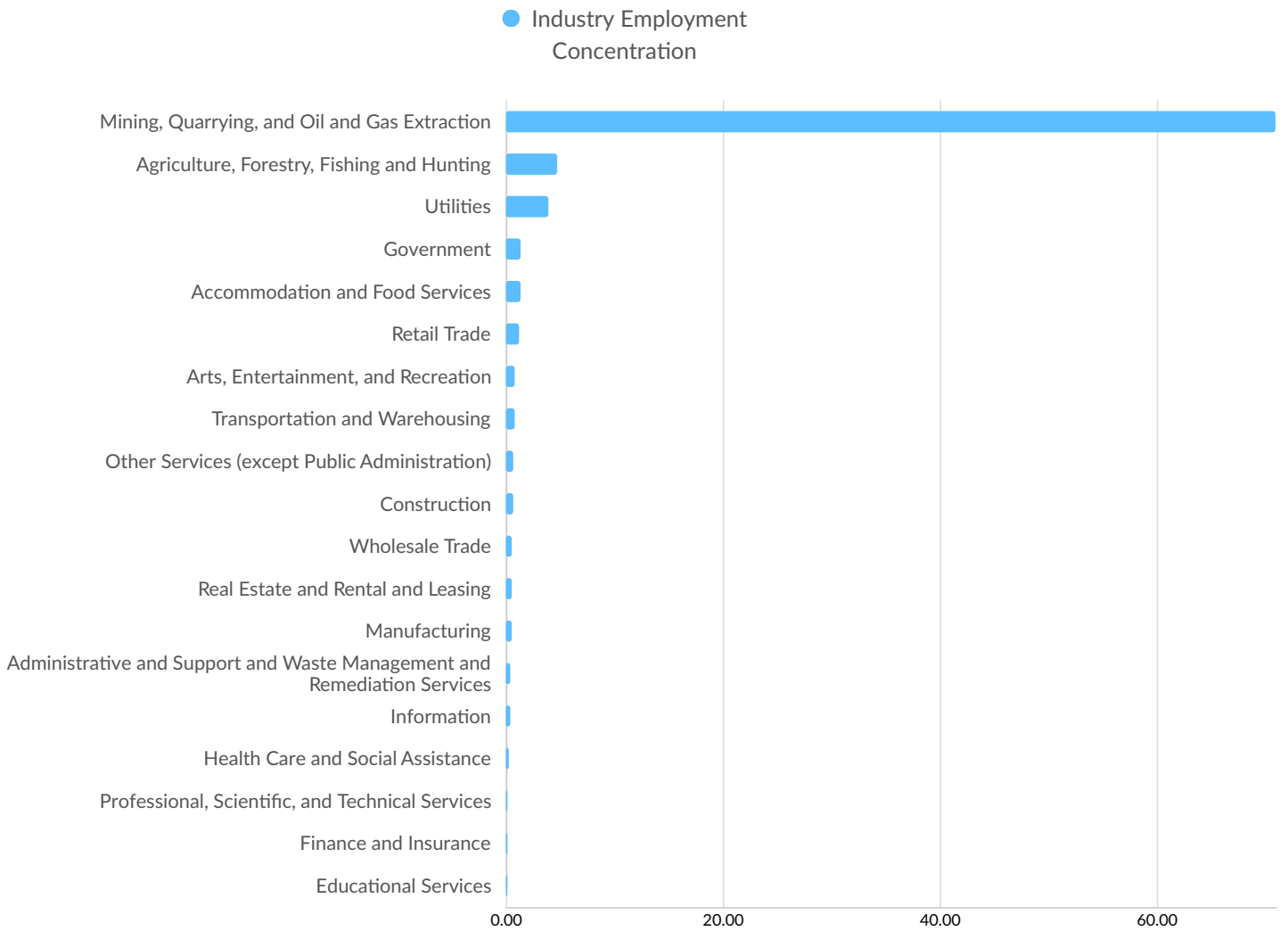

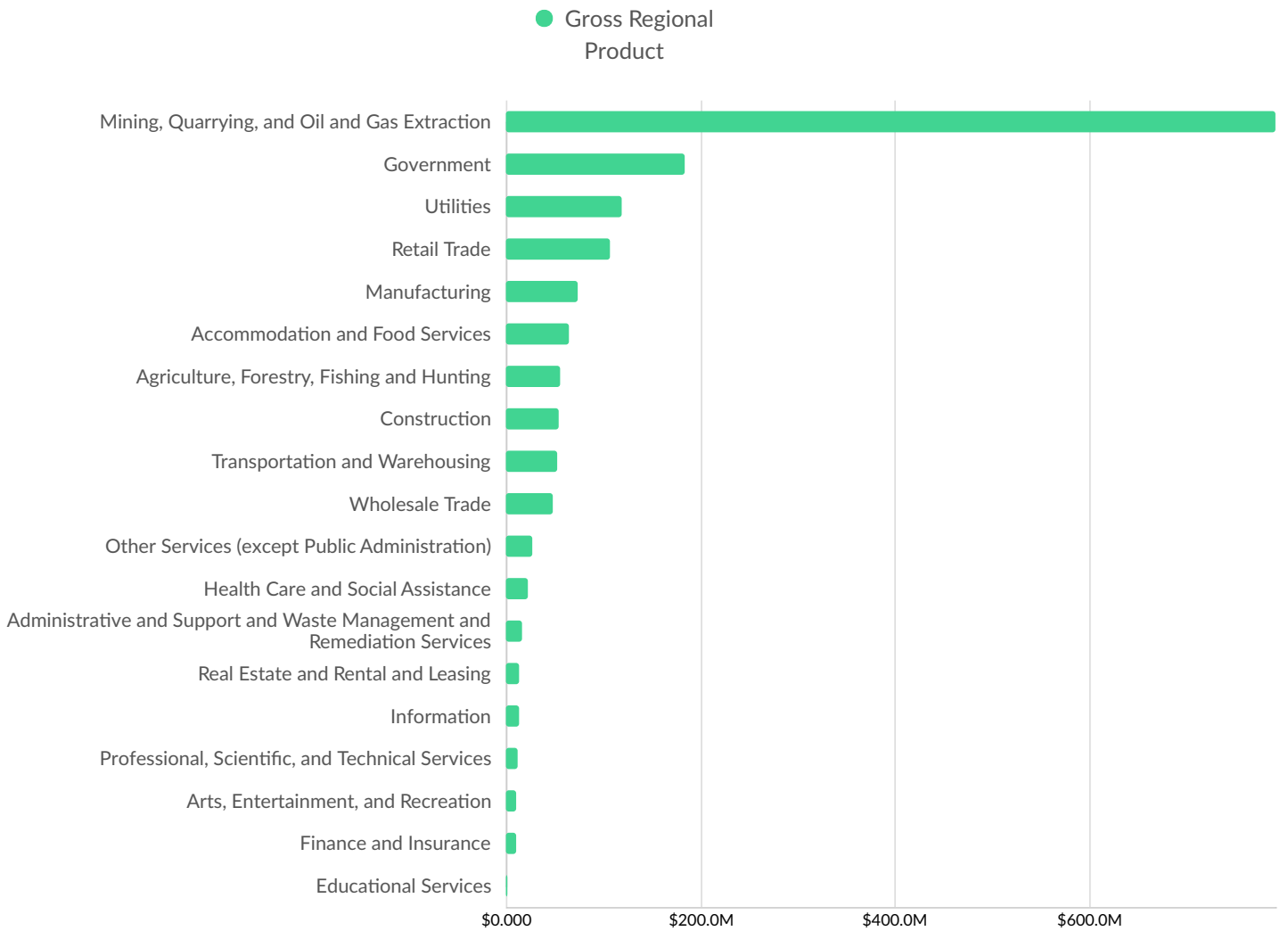
Top Growing Industries



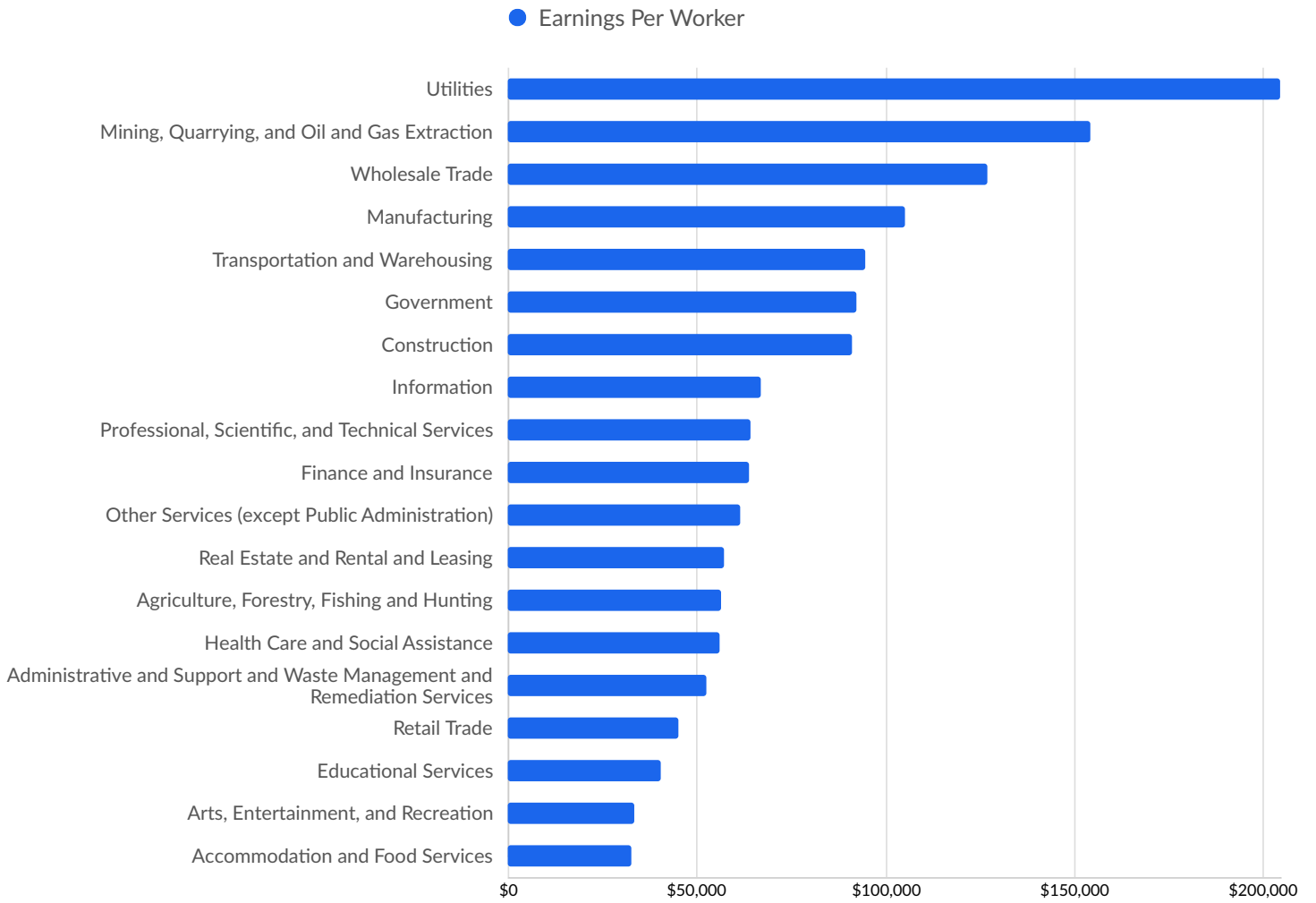
Top Industry Employment Concentration

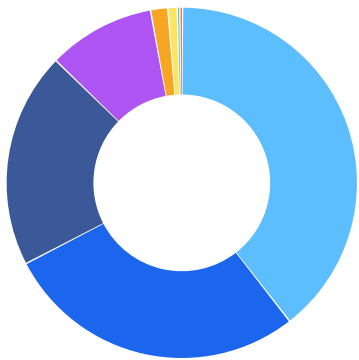

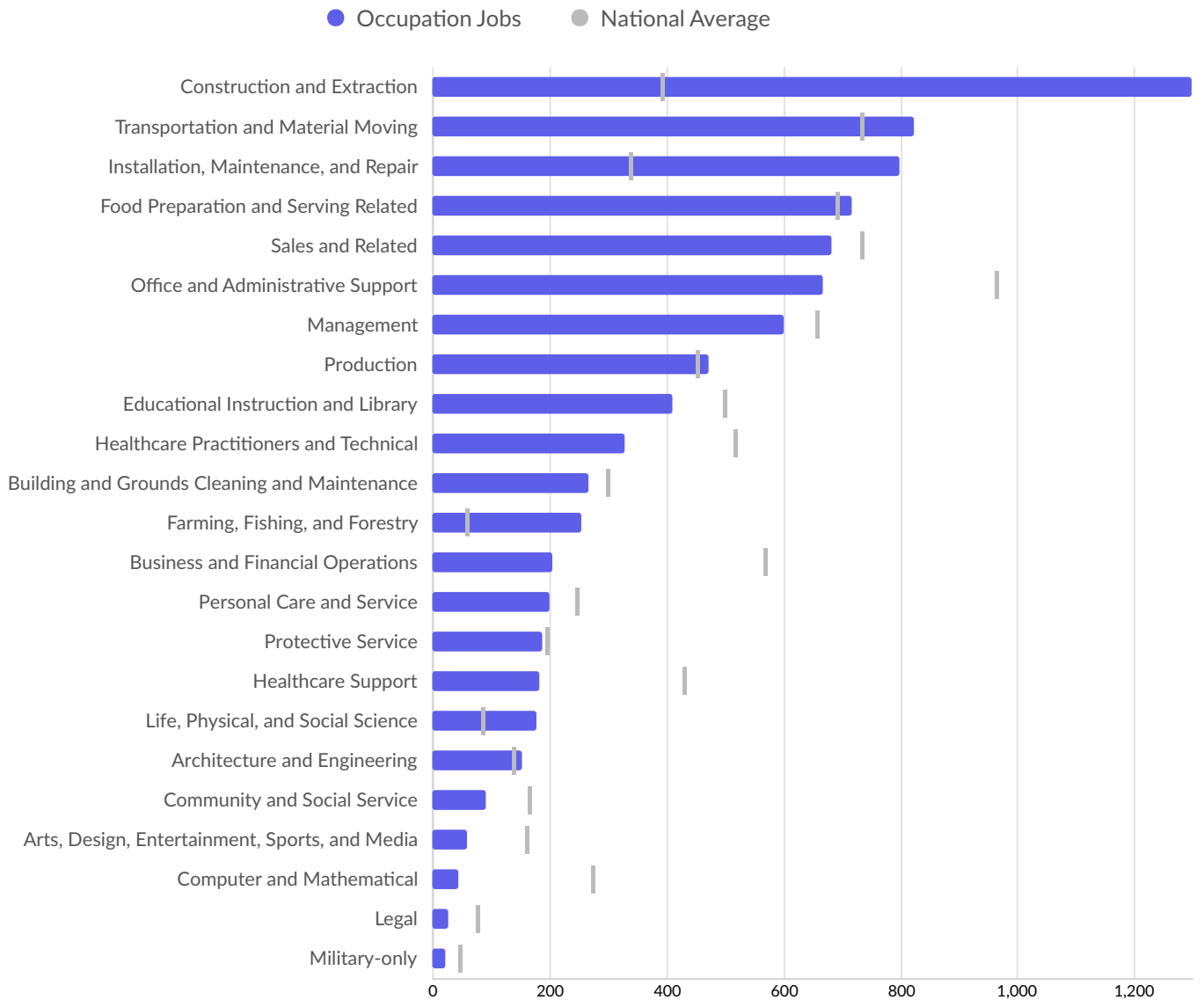

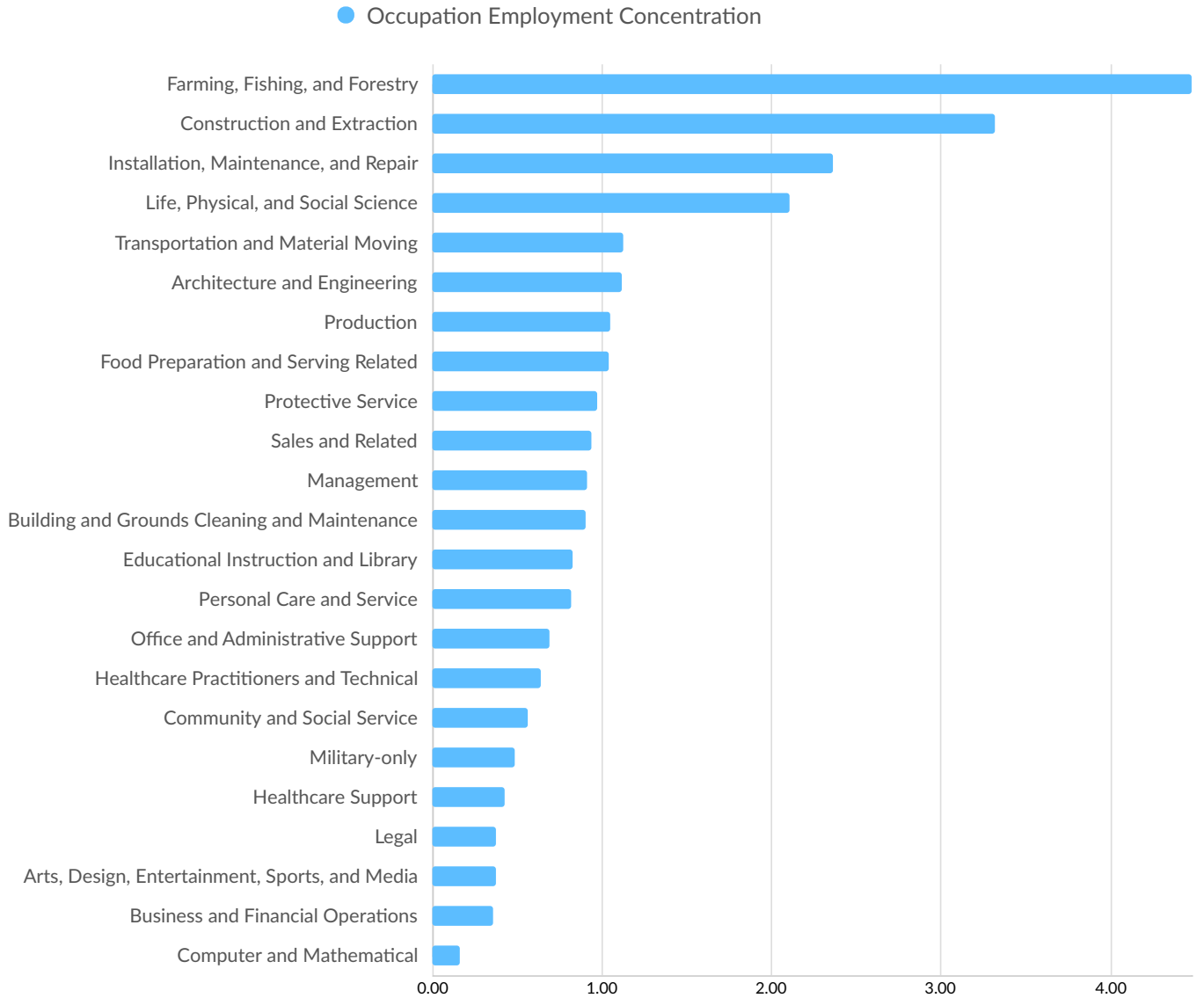

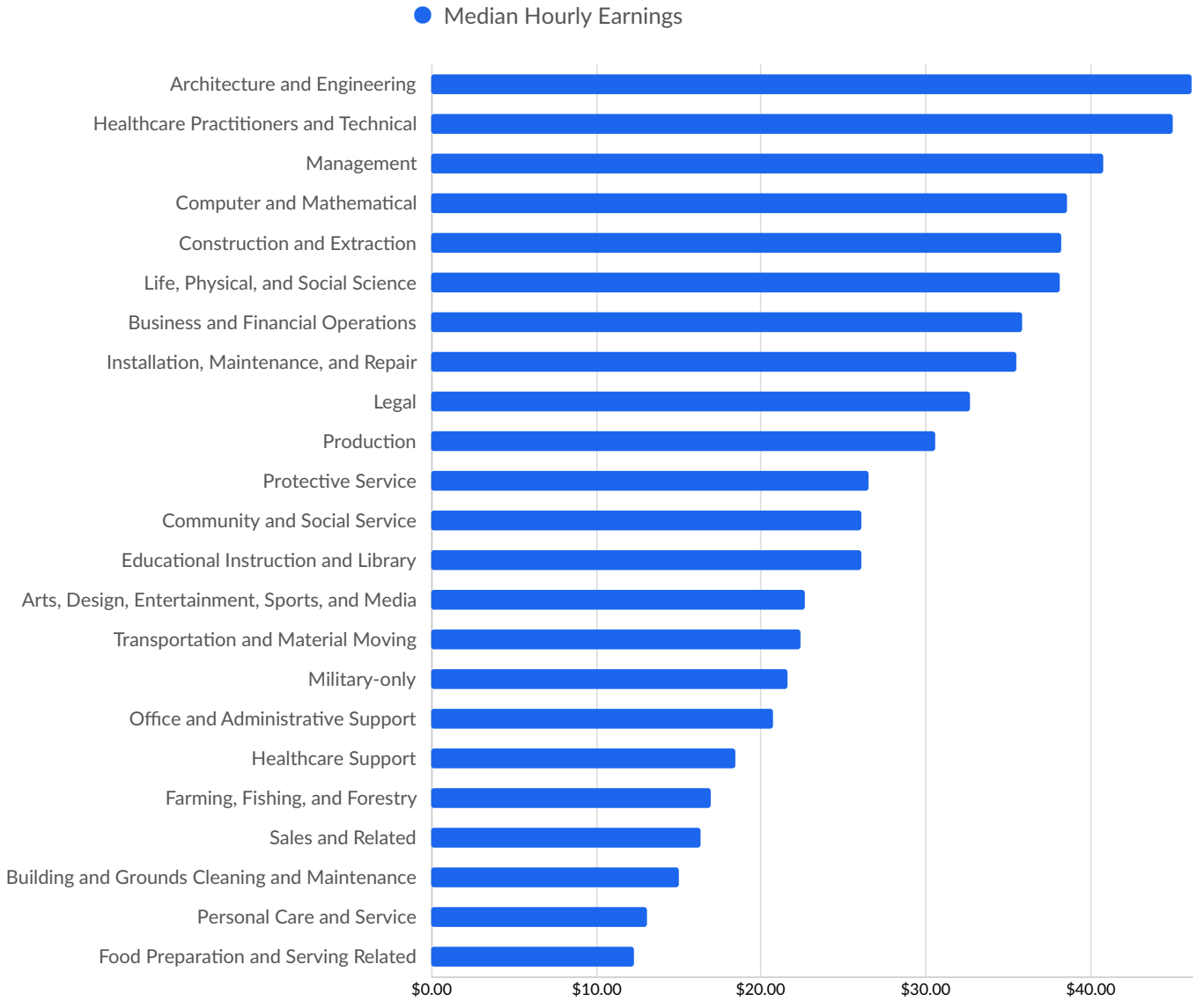
Top Growing Occupations



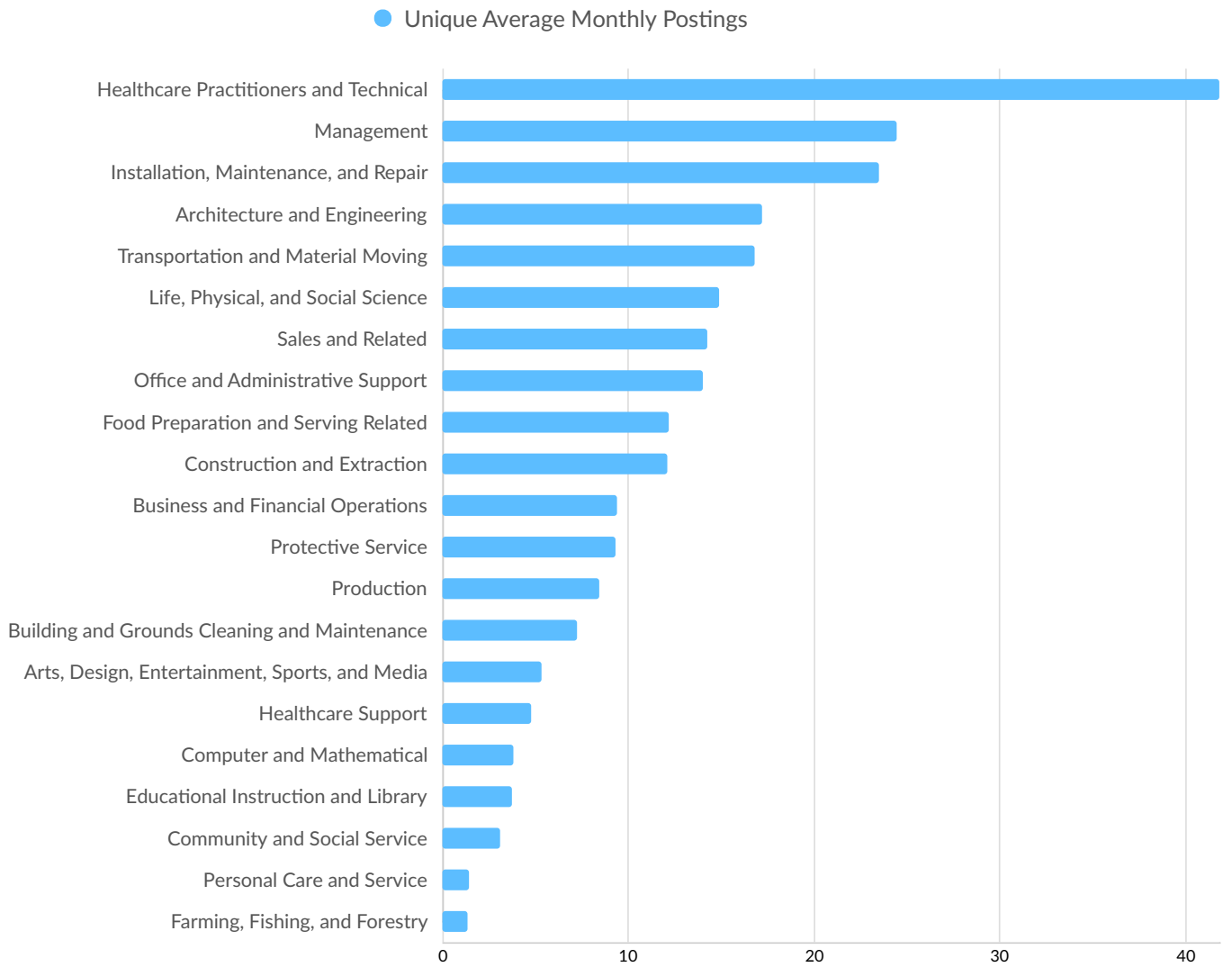
Top Occupation Employment Concentration



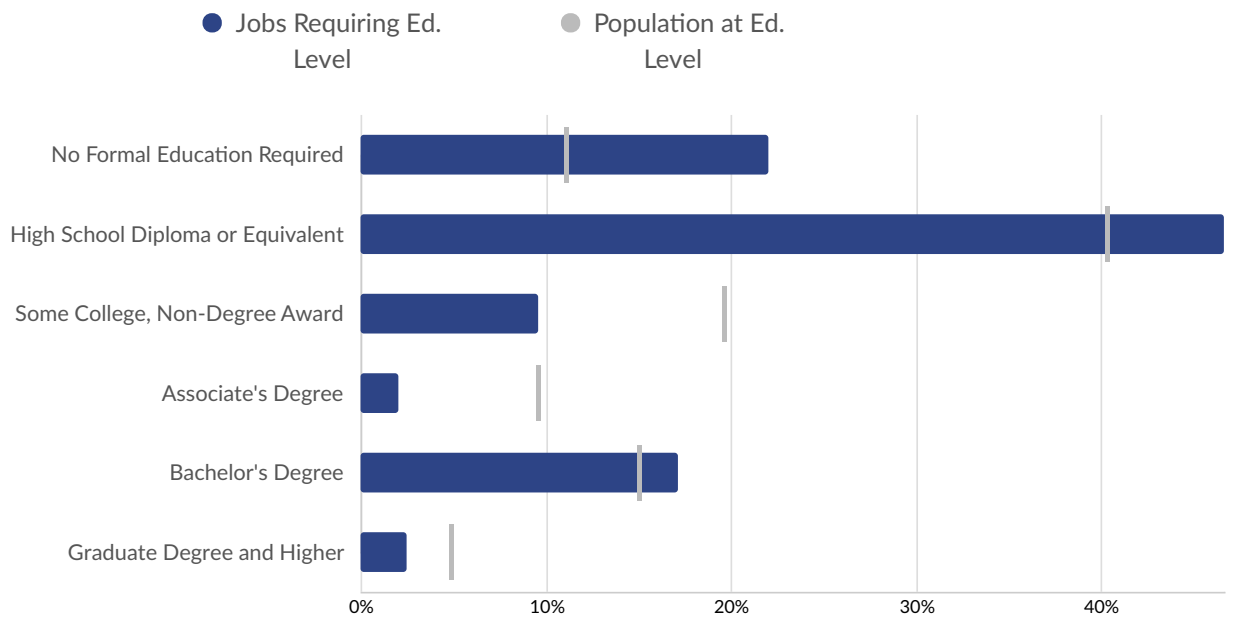
Top Occupation Earnings
