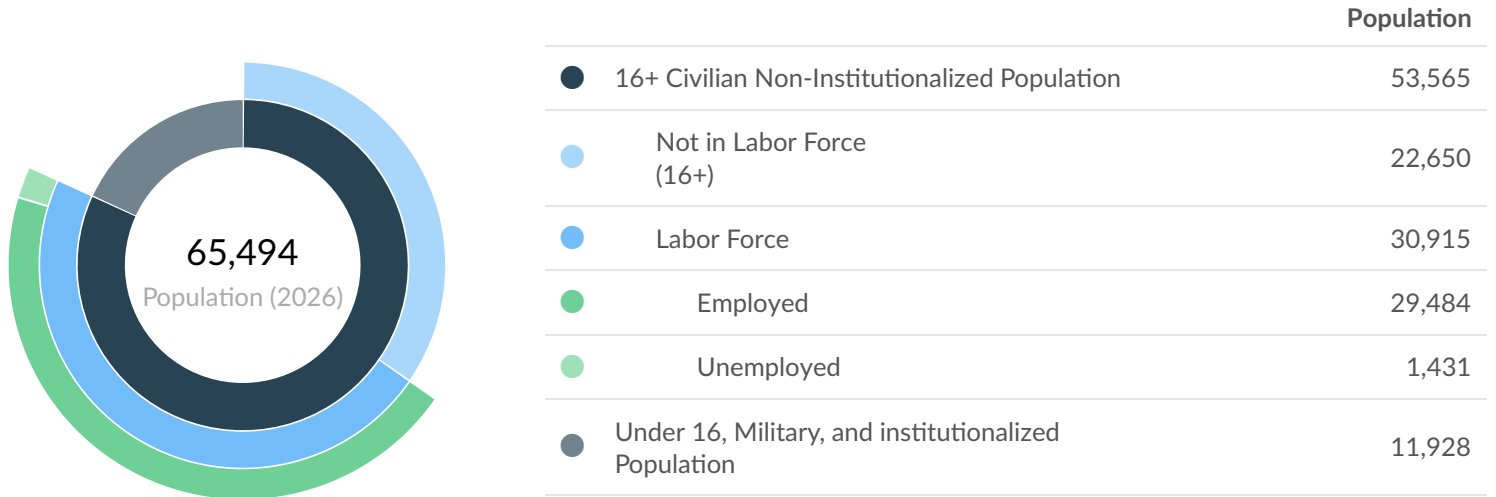
Median household income is **\$78 above** the national median household income of \$80.7K.

- From 2020 to 2025, jobs **increased by 11.4%** in Lyon County, NV from 14,072 to **15,671**. This change **outpaced the national growth rate of 10.6% by 0.8%**. As the number of jobs increased, the **labor force participation rate increased from 58.5% to 58.6% between 2020 and 2025**.
- Concerning educational attainment, **11.8% of Lyon County, NV residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (10.0% below the national average), and **11.4% hold an Associate's Degree** (2.6% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2025 are Education and Hospitals (Local Government), Warehousing and Storage, and Restaurants and Other Eating Places.

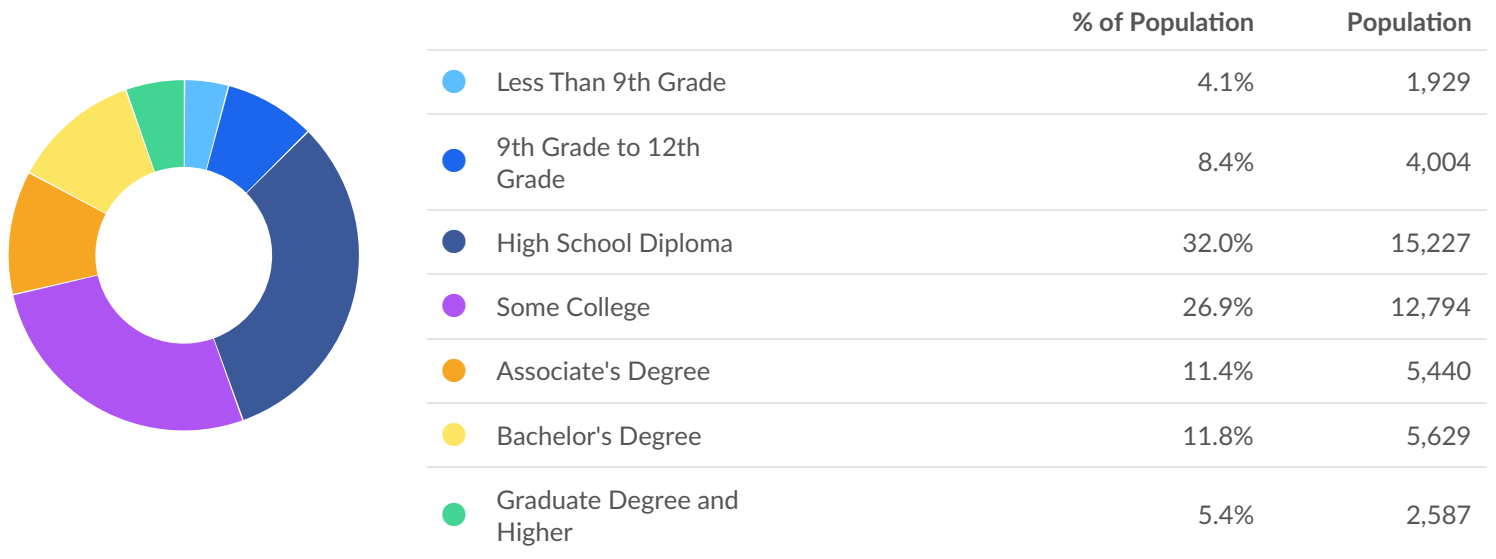

Mar 2026 Labor Force Breakdown



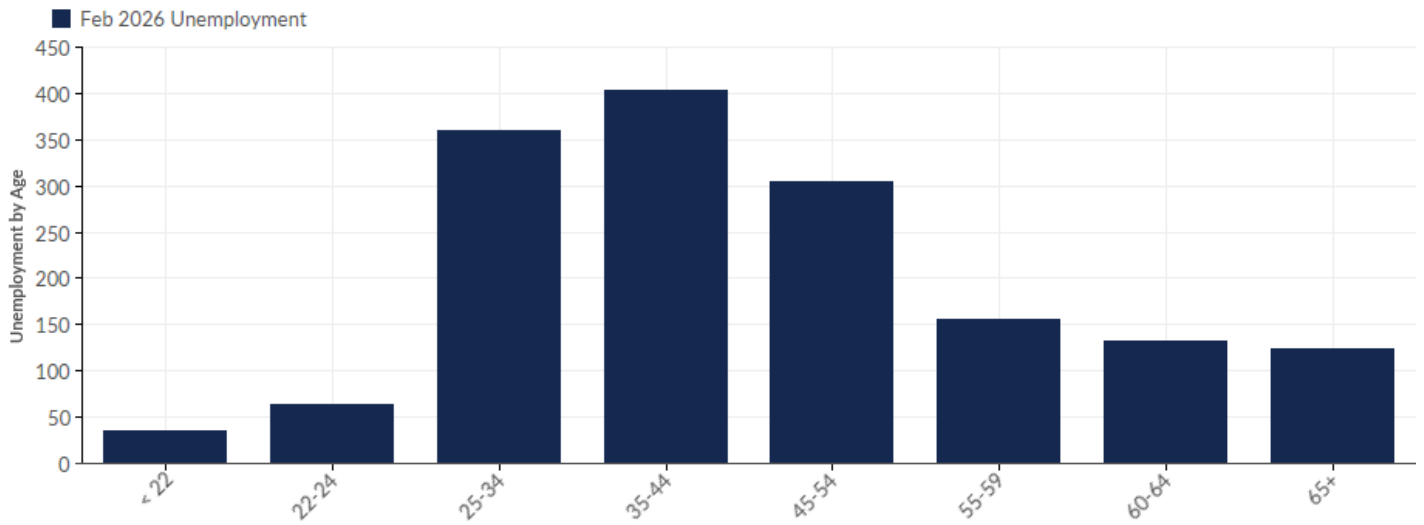
Educational Attainment

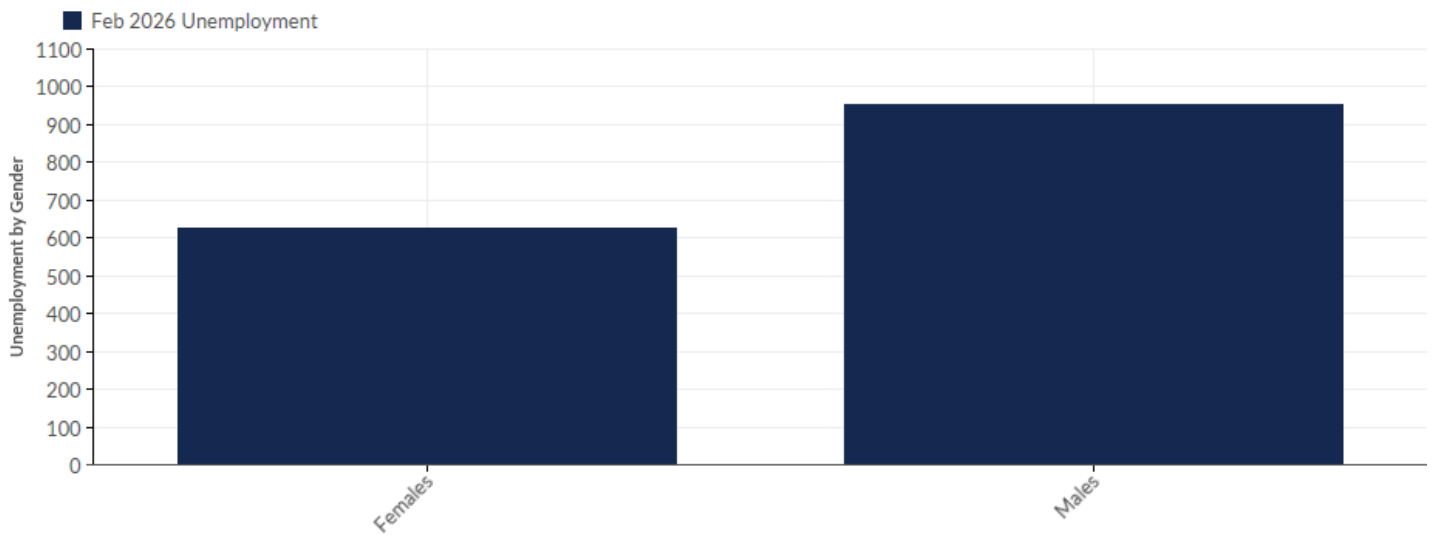

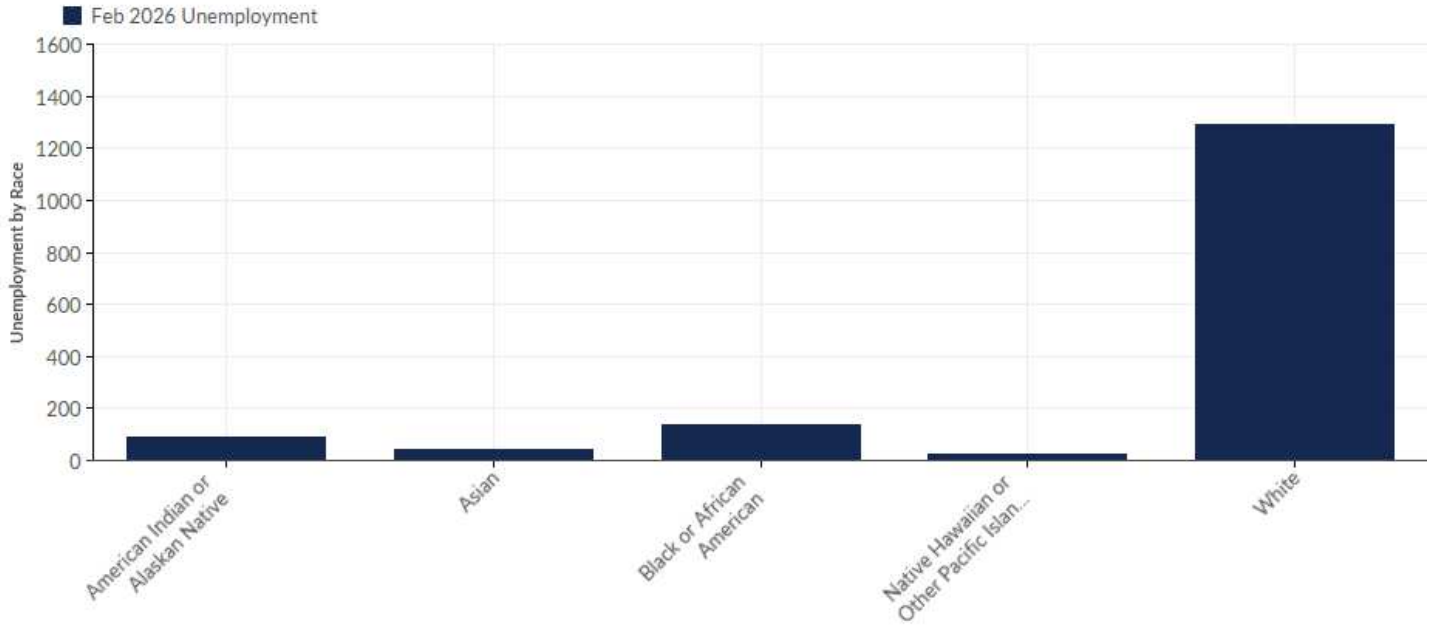

Unemployment by Gender



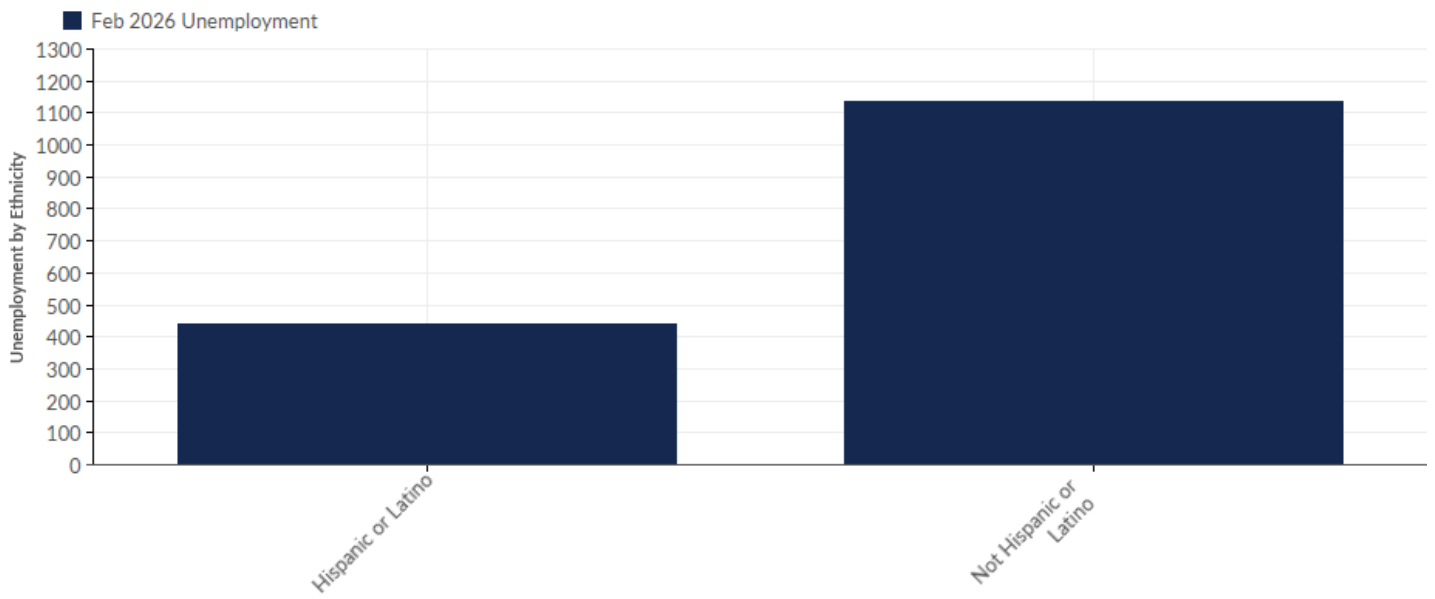

Unemployment by Ethnicity

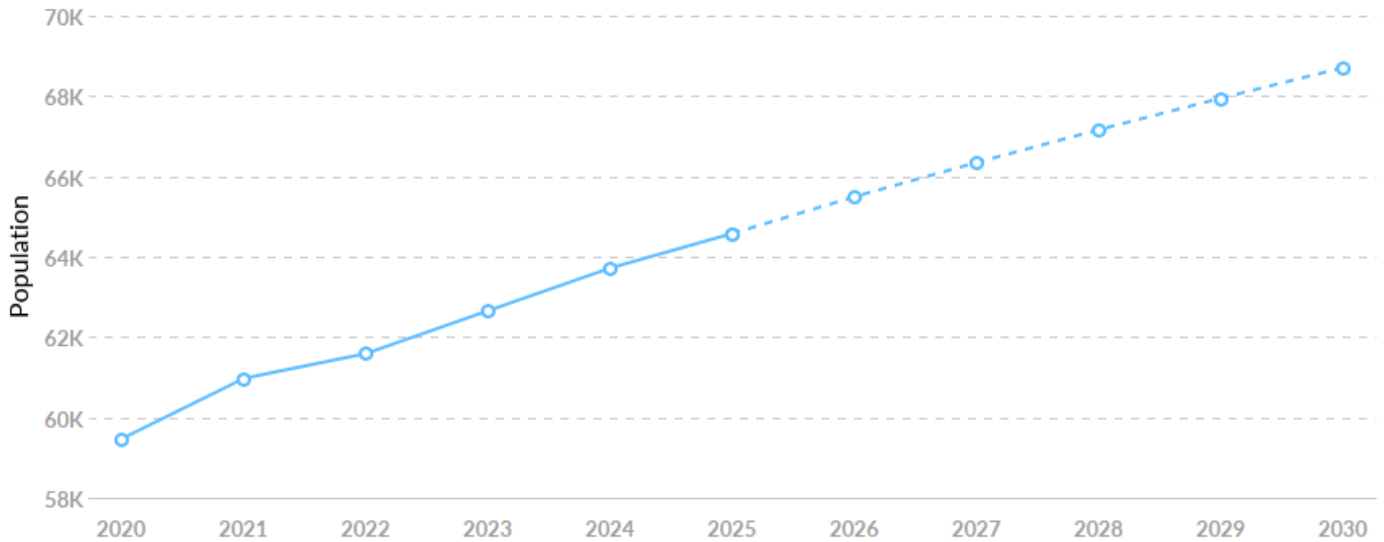

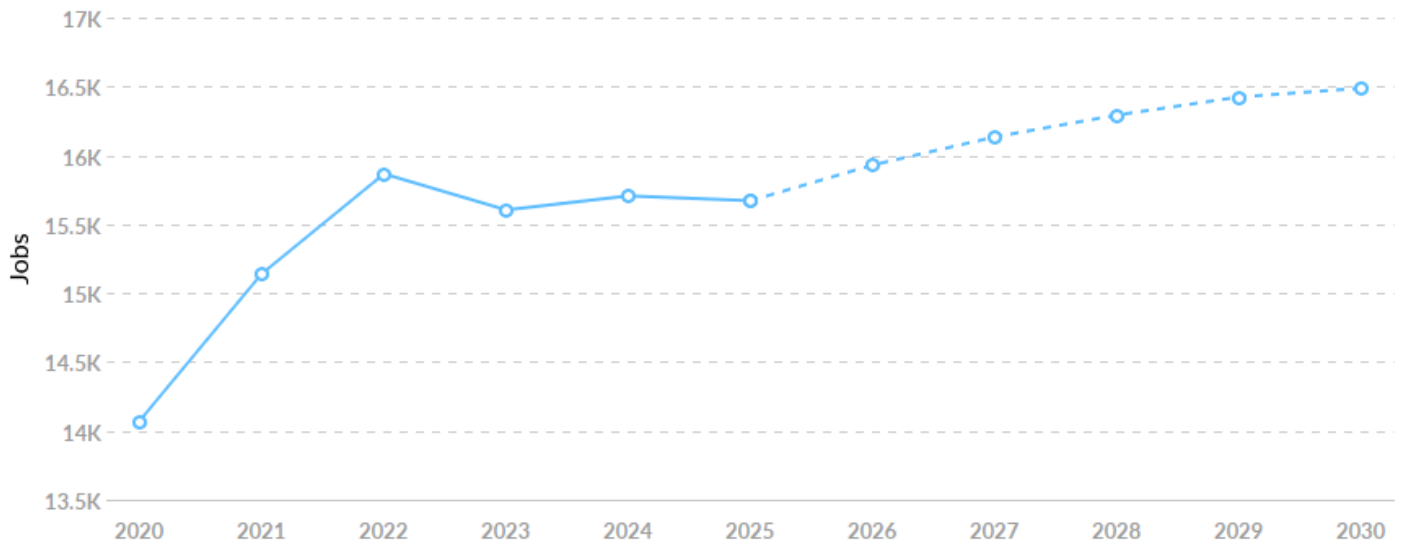

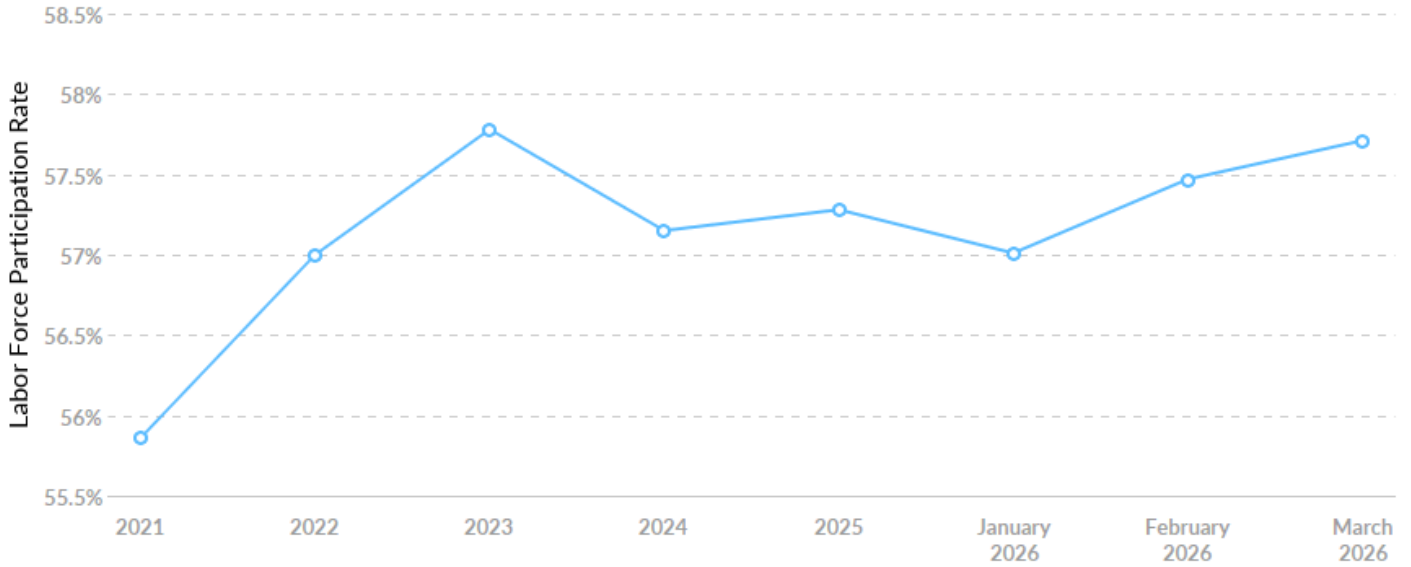
Job Trends

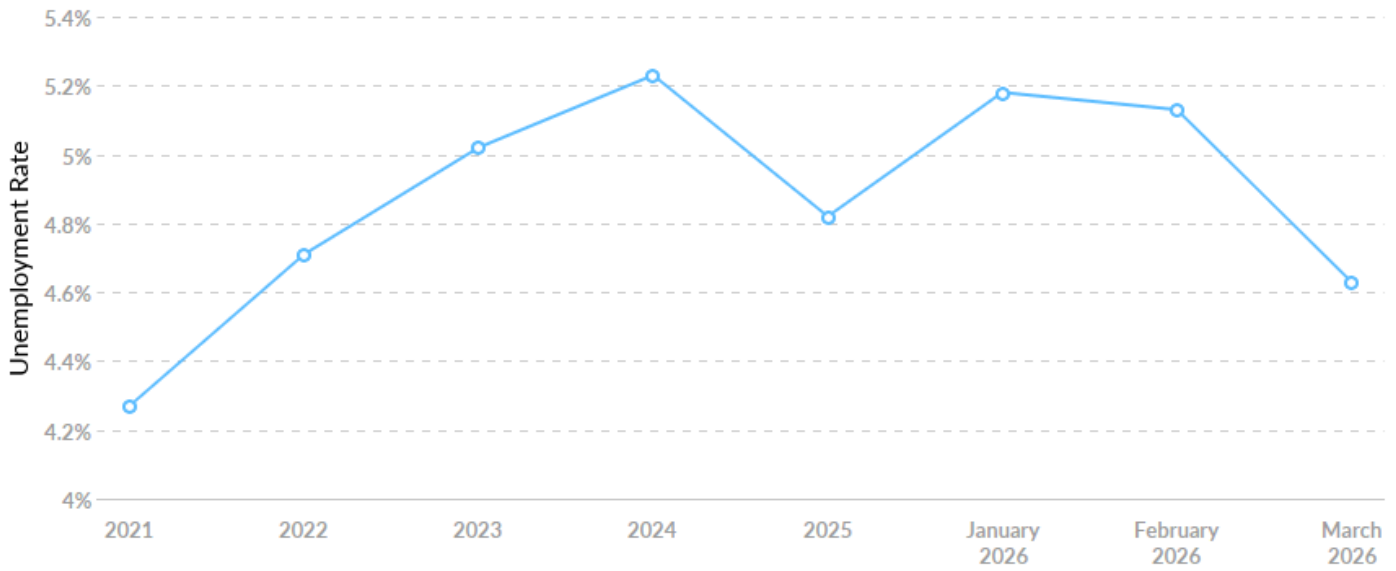
Labor Force Participation Rate Trends

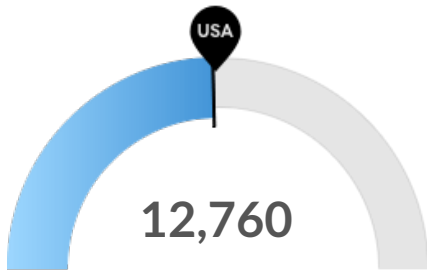
Unemployment Rate Trends

Lyon County, NV had a March 2026 unemployment rate of 4.63%, **increasing from 4.27%** 5 years before.



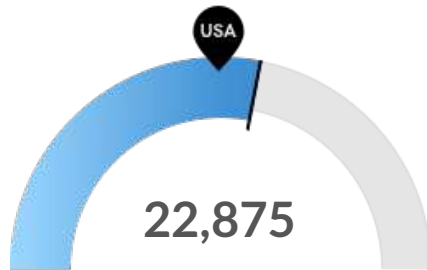

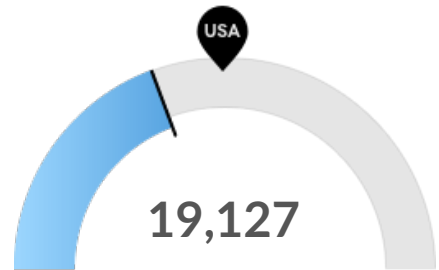
Millennials

Lyon County, NV has 12,760 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 13,044.



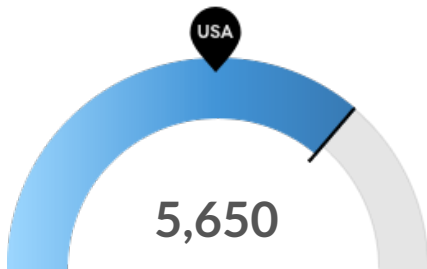
Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is high in Lyon County, NV. The national average for an area this size is 19,267 people 55 or older, while there are 22,875 here.



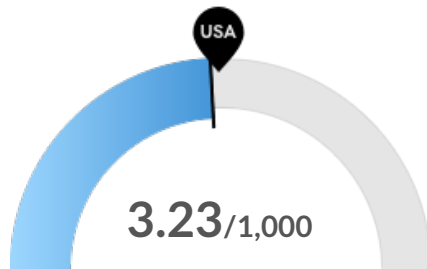
Racial Diversity

Racial diversity is low in Lyon County, NV. The national average for an area this size is 27,105 racially diverse people, while there are 19,127 here.



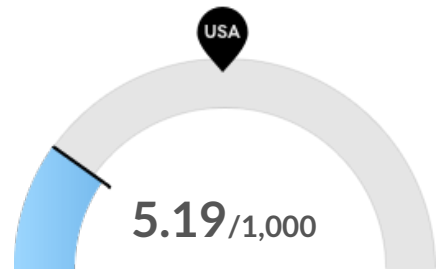
Veterans

Lyon County, NV has 3.23 violent crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 3.38 per 1,000 people.

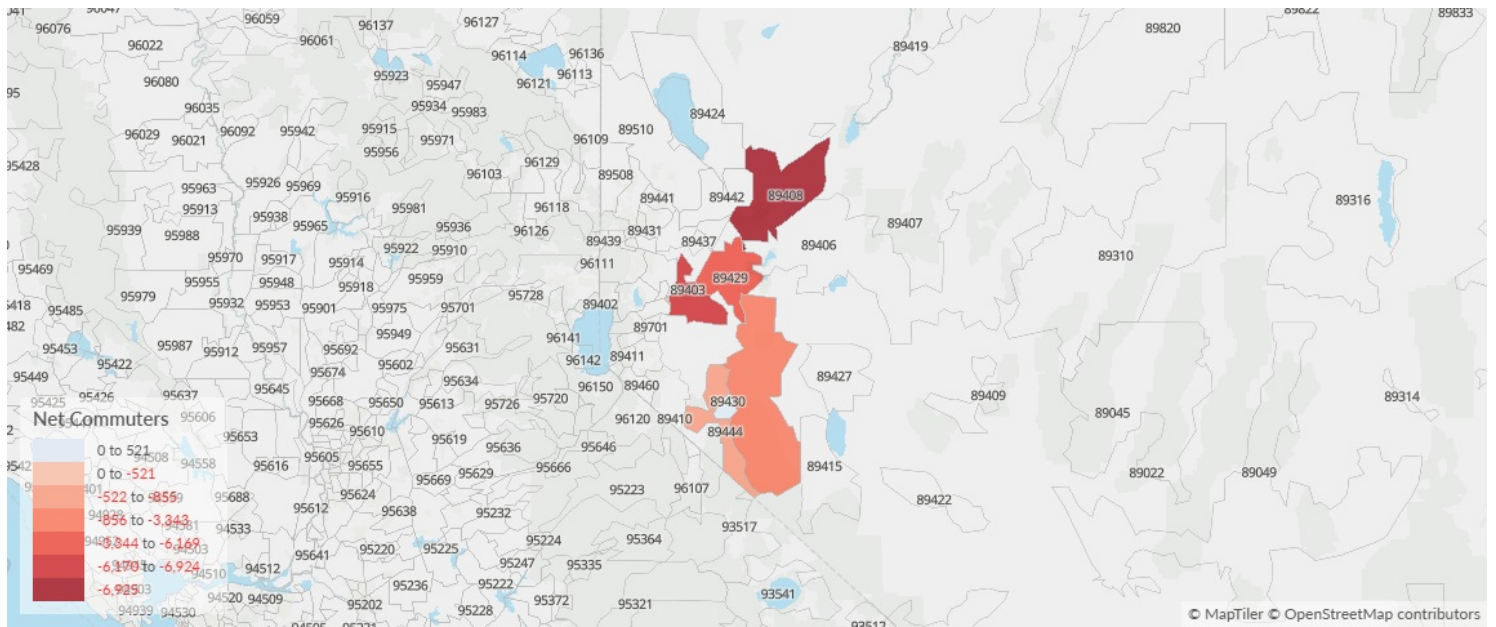


Property Crime

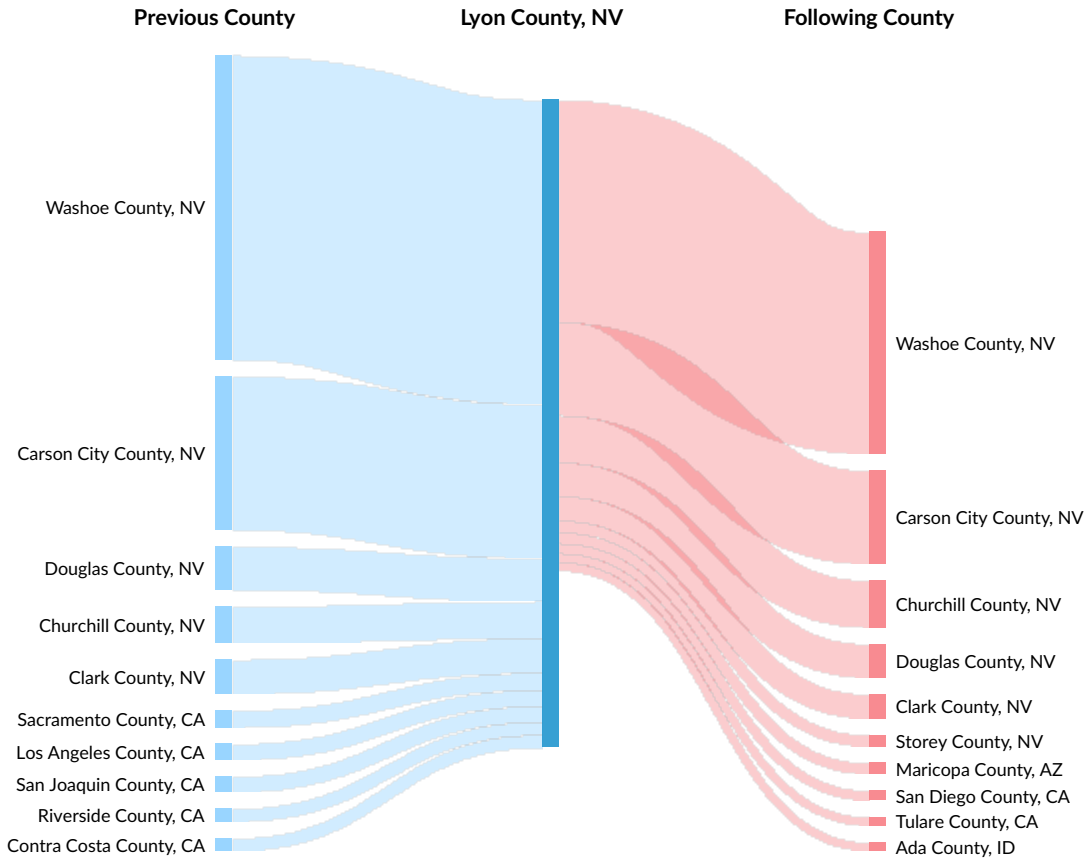

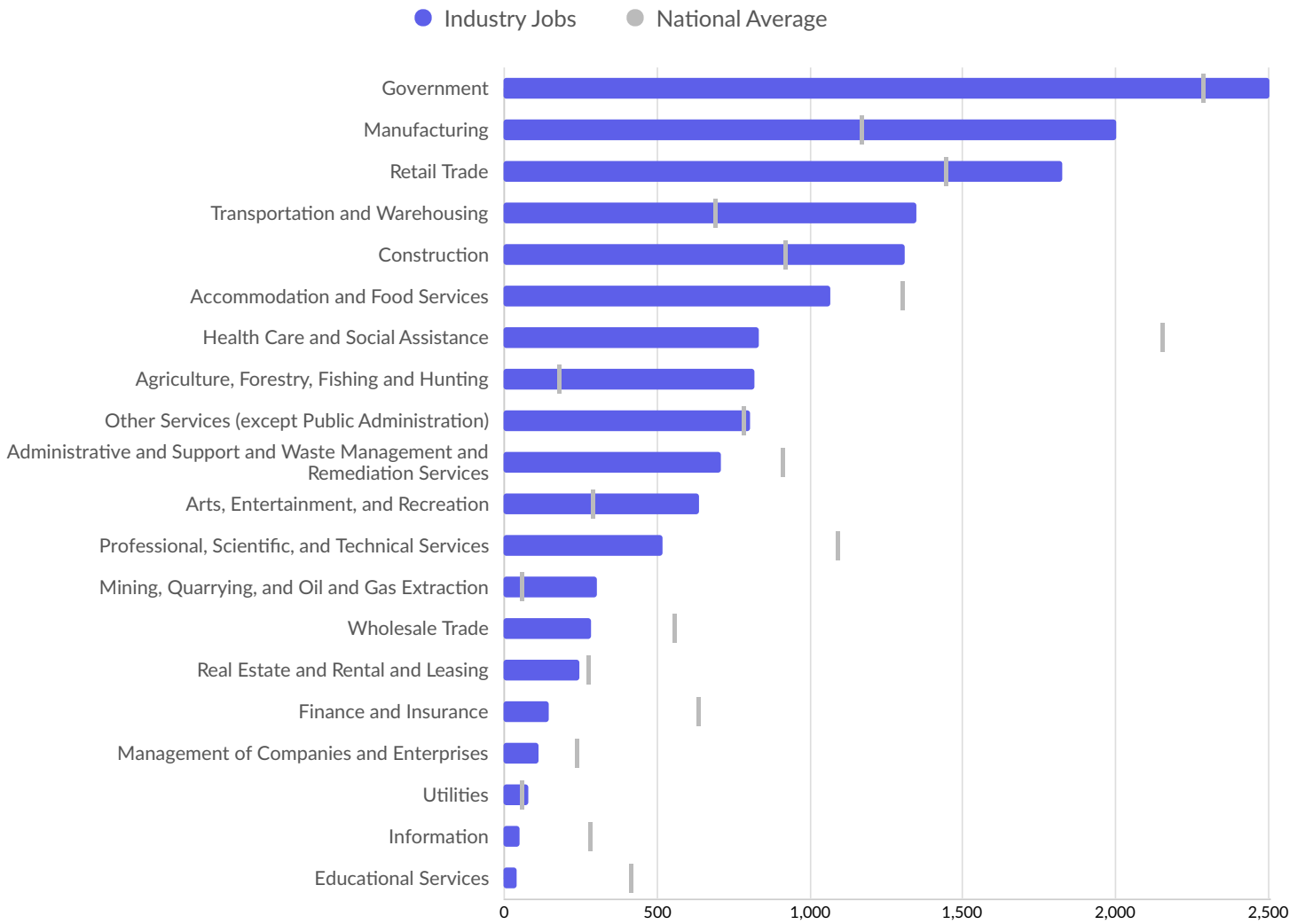

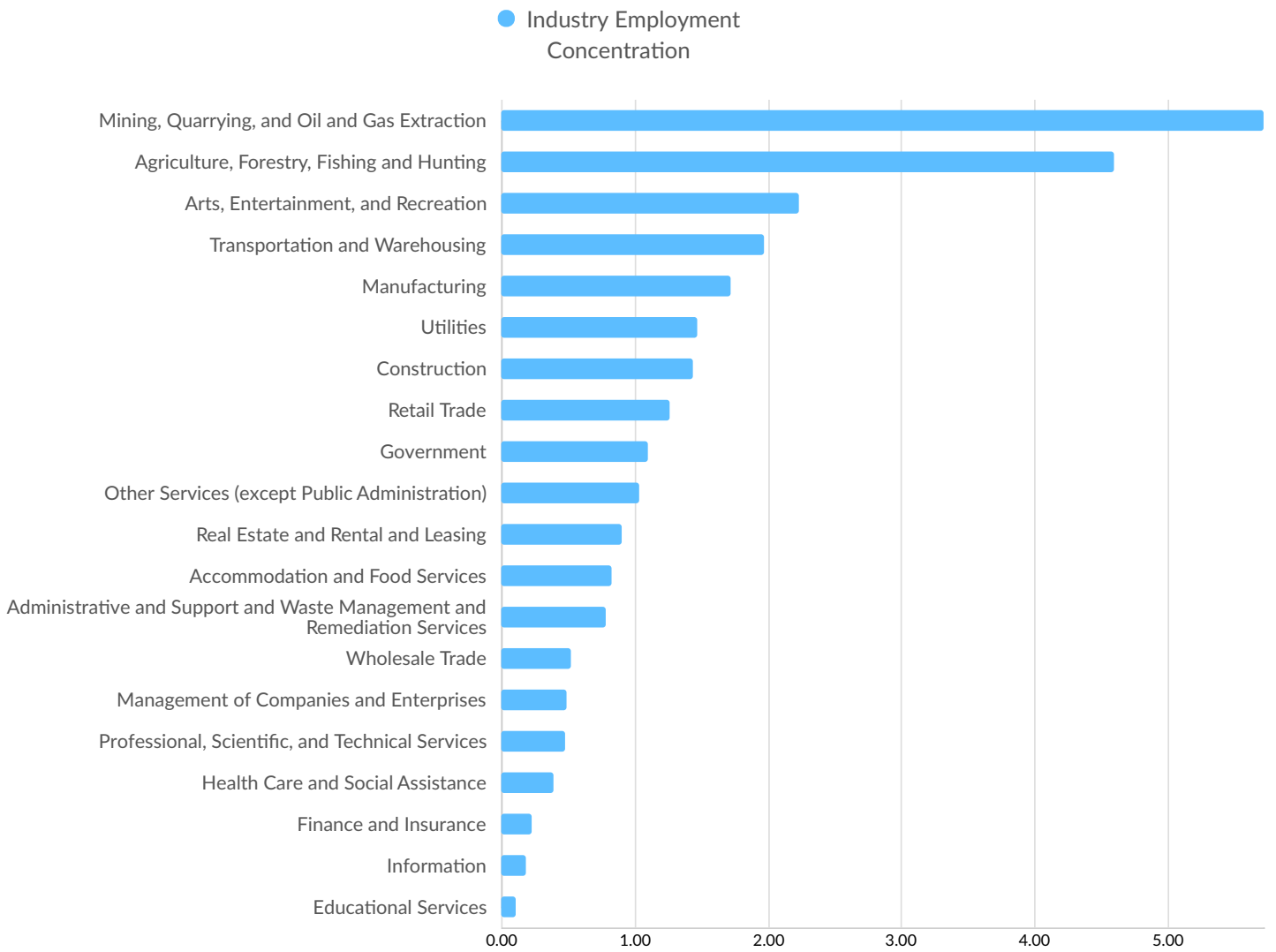

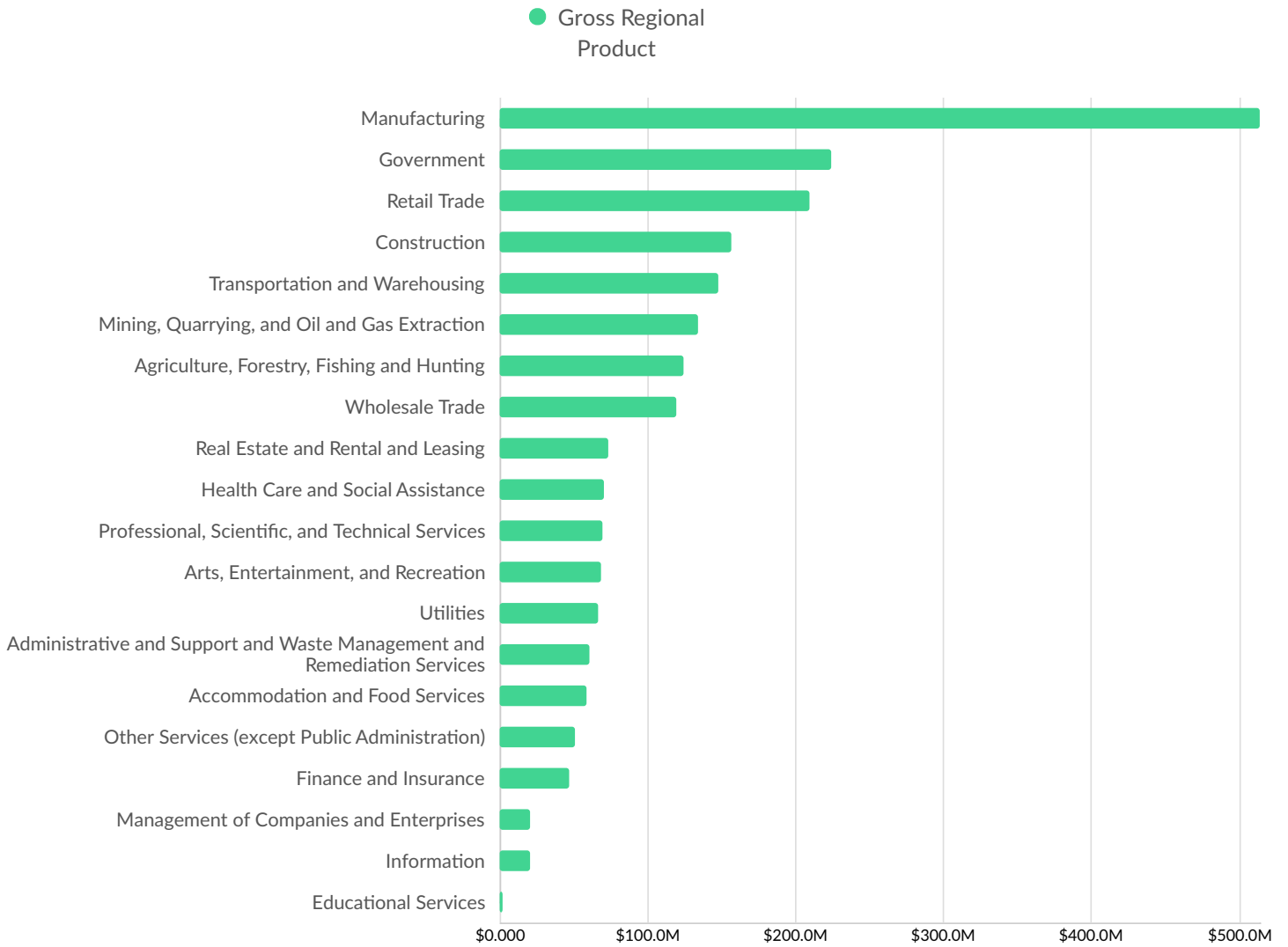
Top Growing Industries



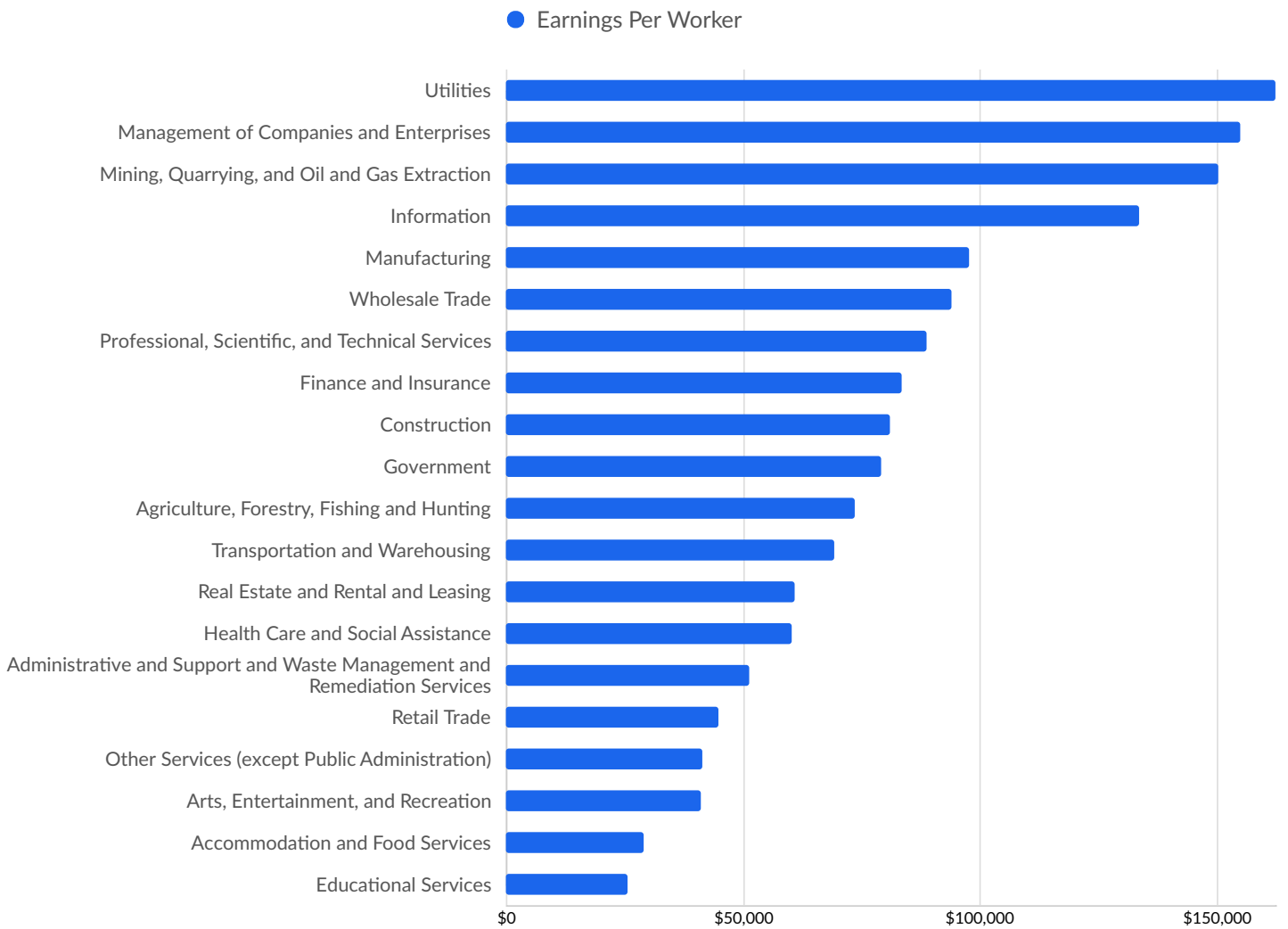
Top Industry Employment Concentration

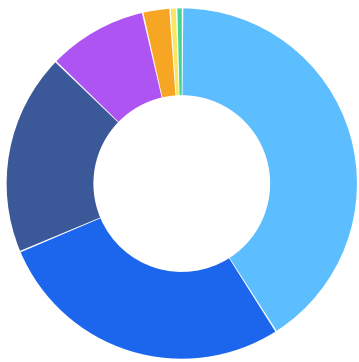

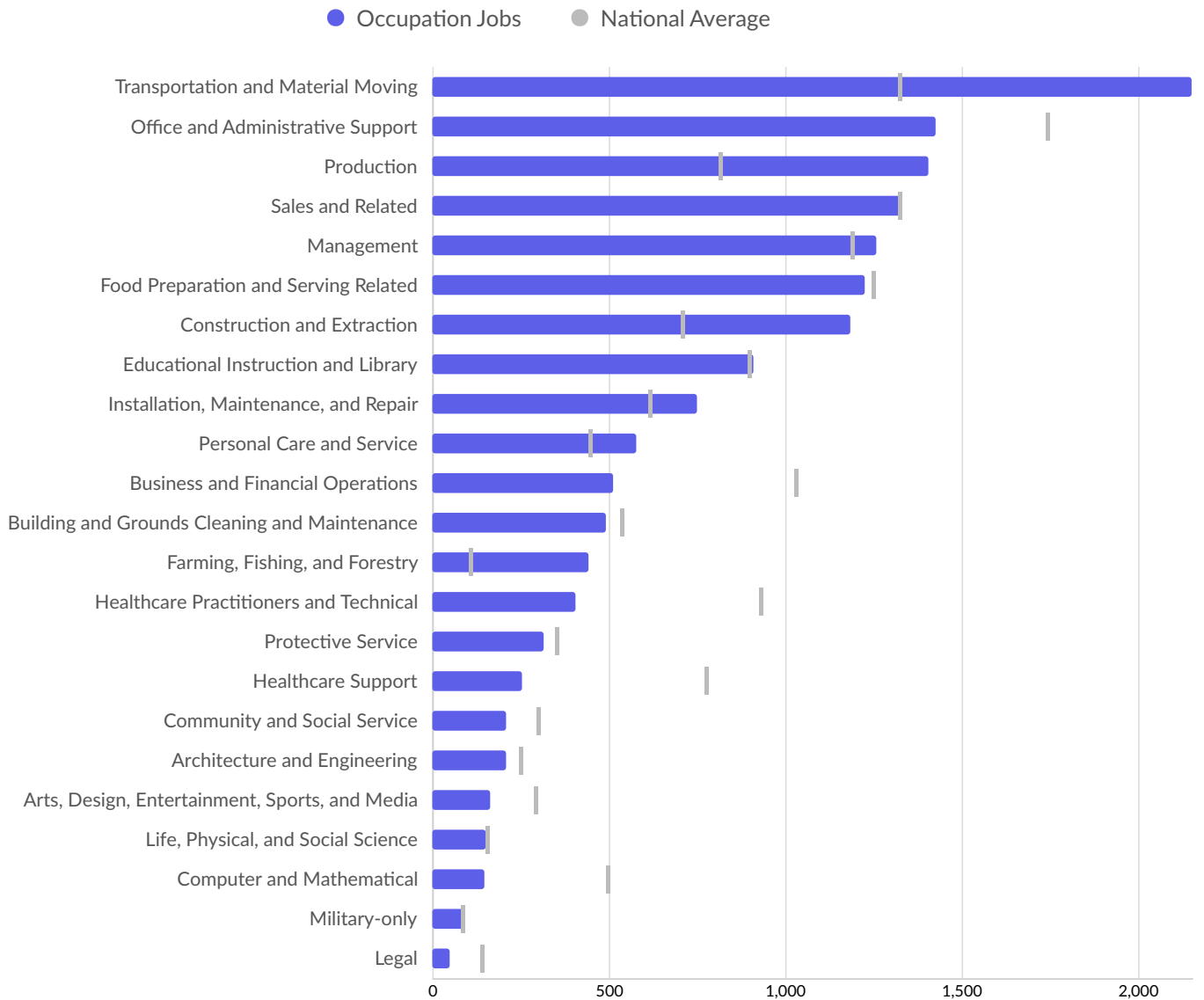

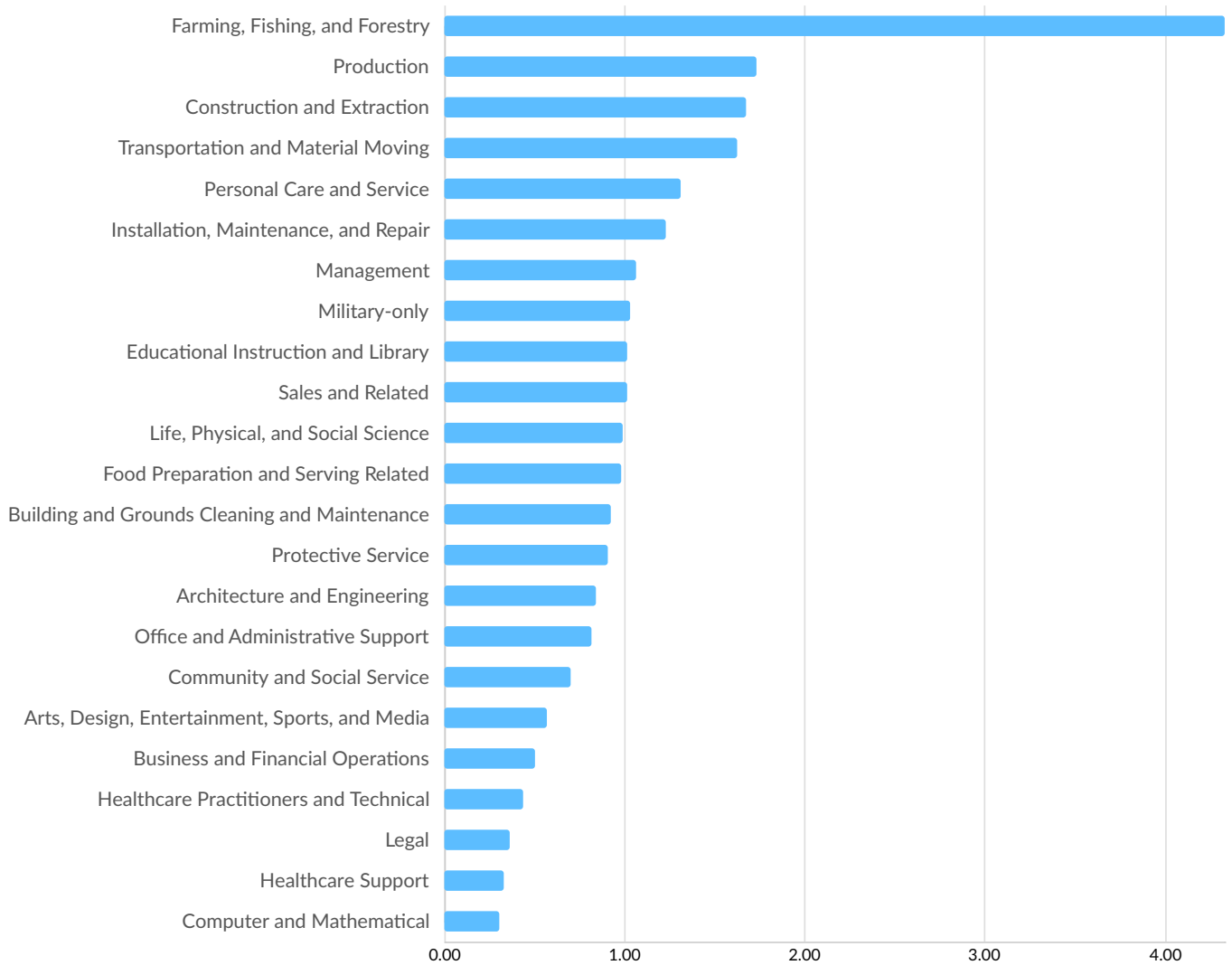

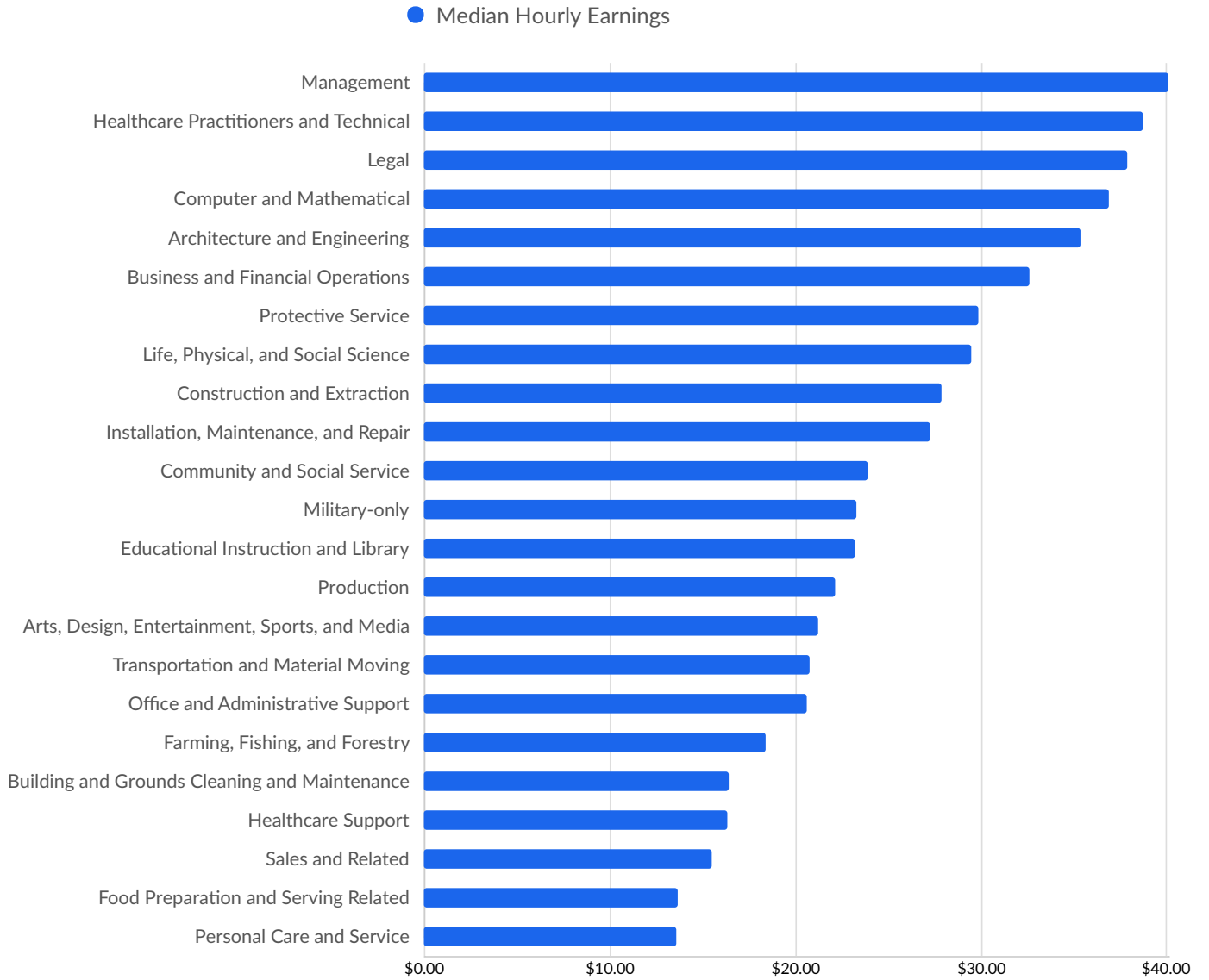


Top Occupation Employment Concentration

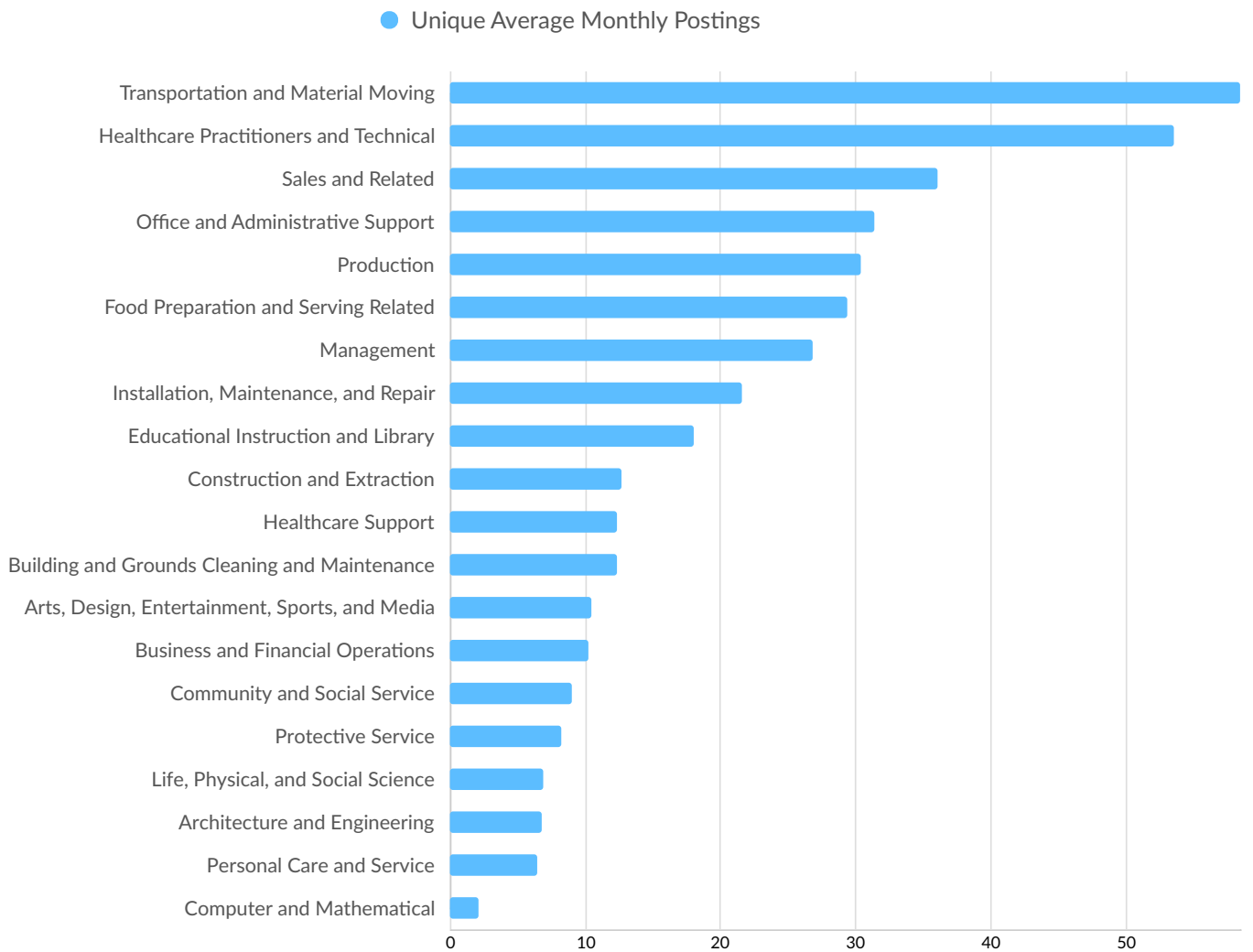

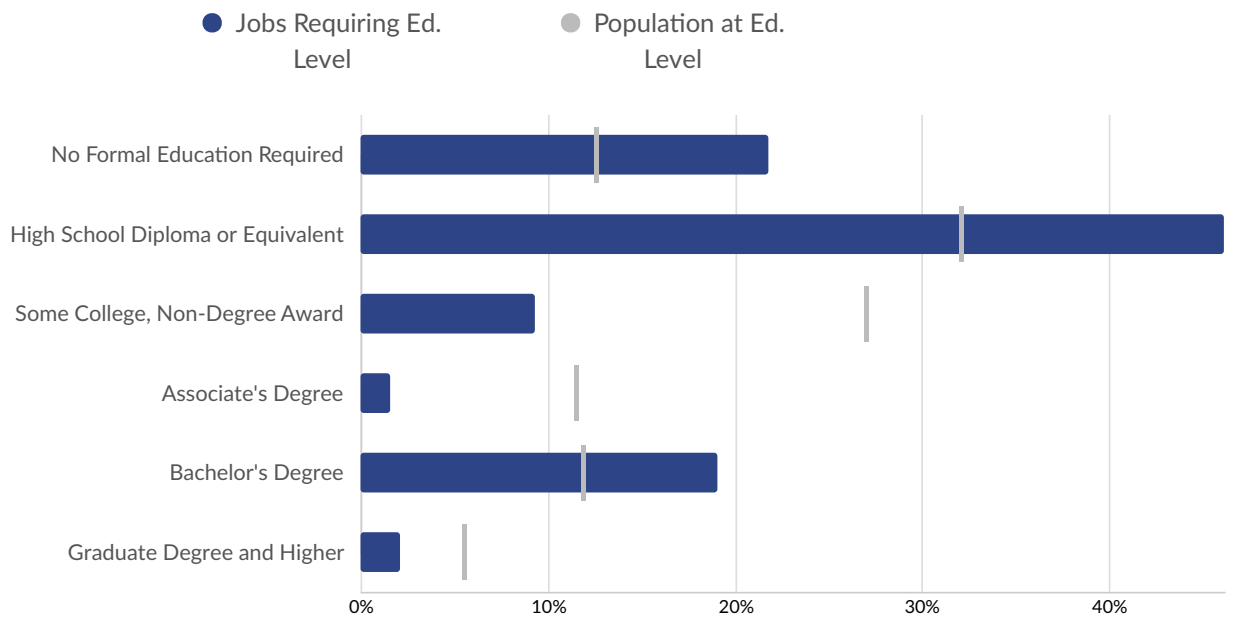
