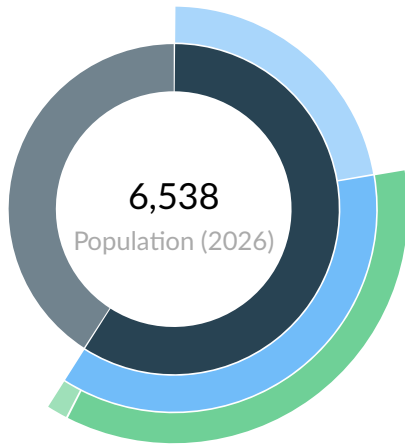
Median household income is **\$13.8K below** the national median household income of \$80.7K.

- The top three industries in 2025 are Metal Ore Mining, Education and Hospitals (Local Government), and State Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals.

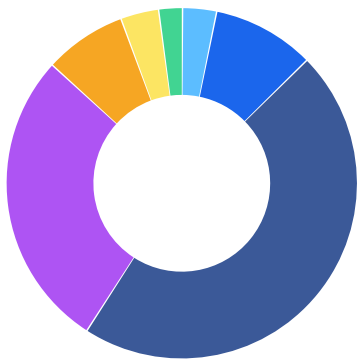
Mar 2026 Labor Force Breakdown

Educational Attainment

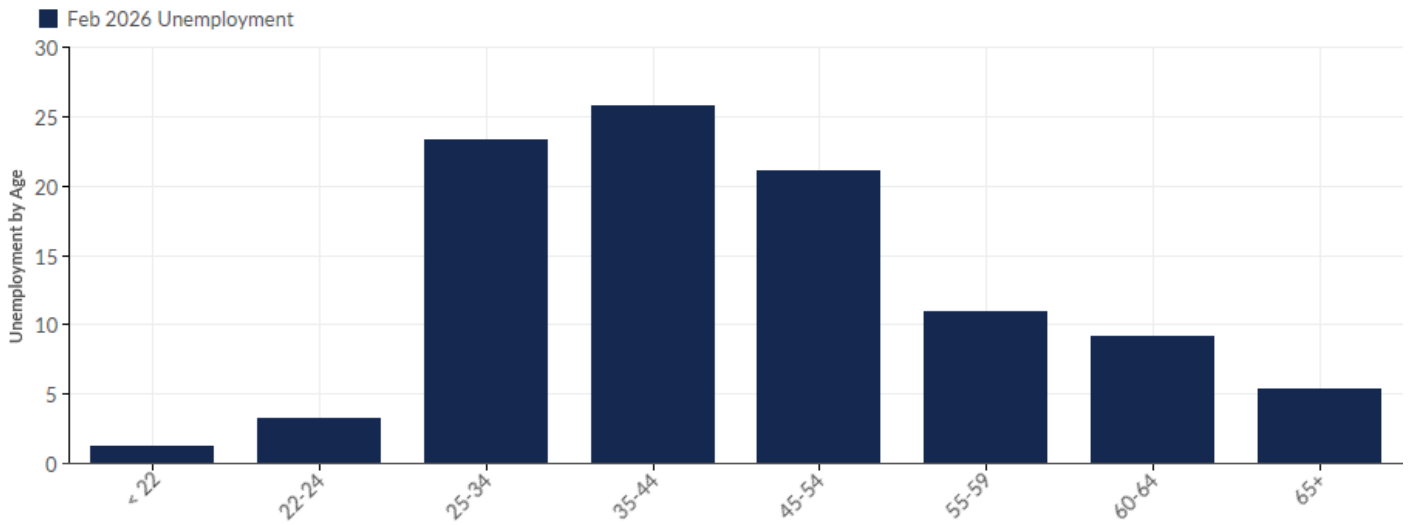

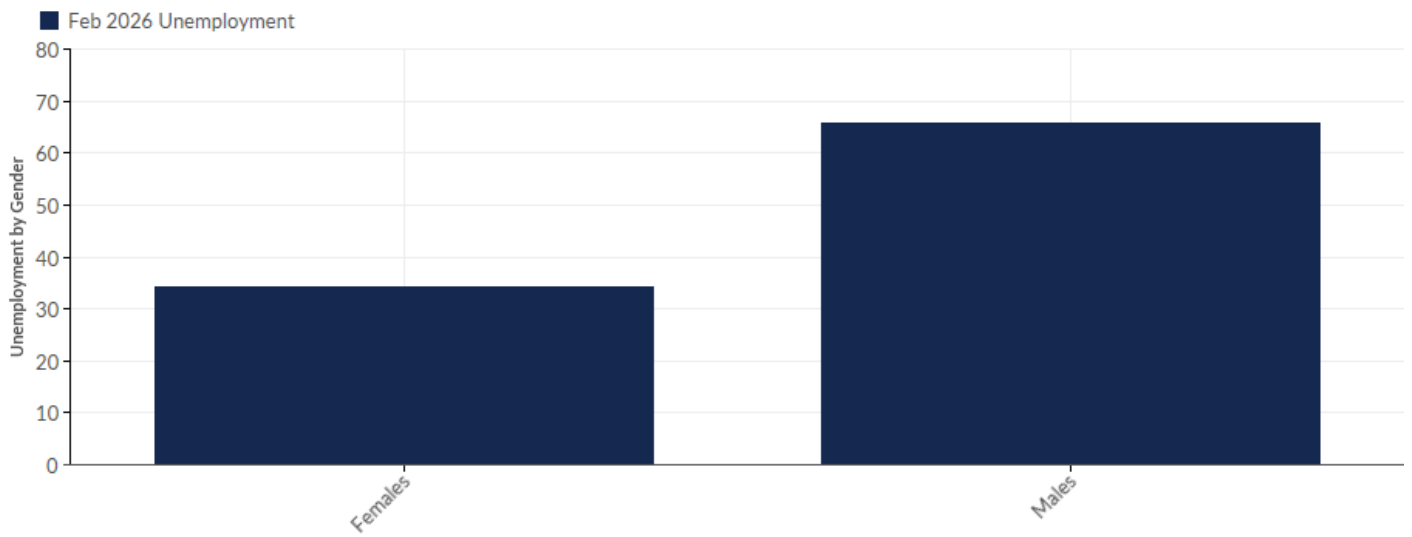

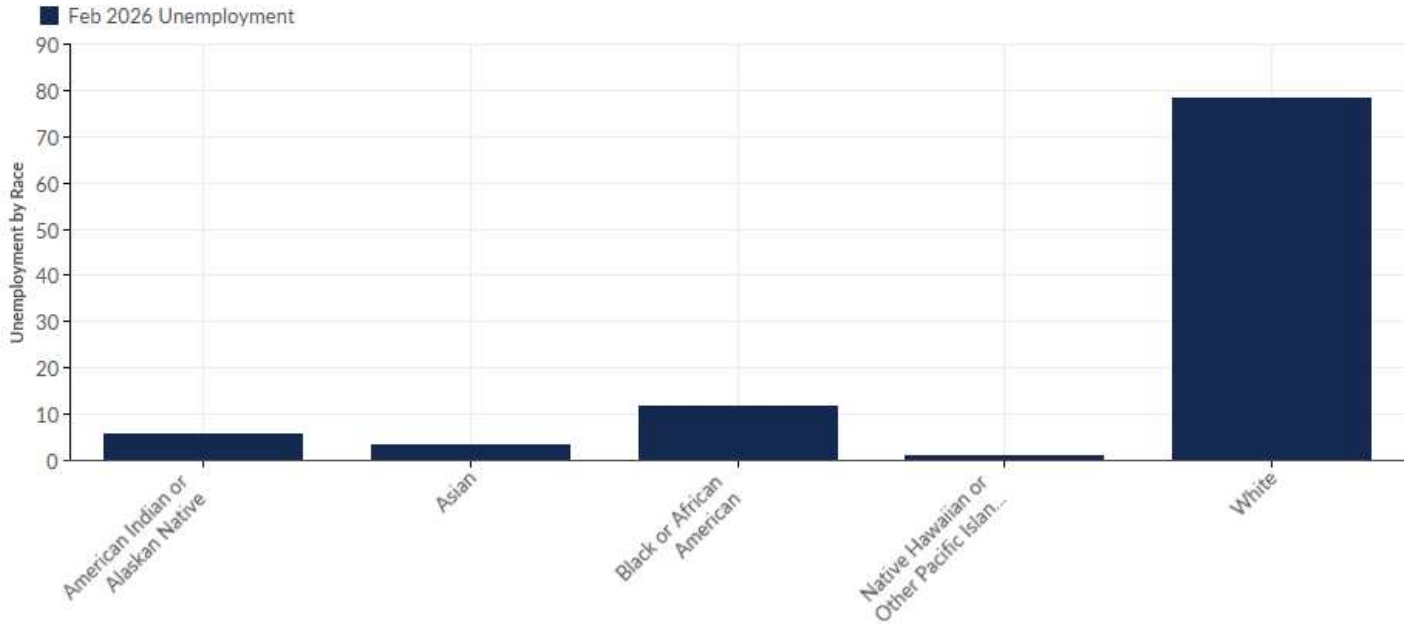

Unemployment by Gender



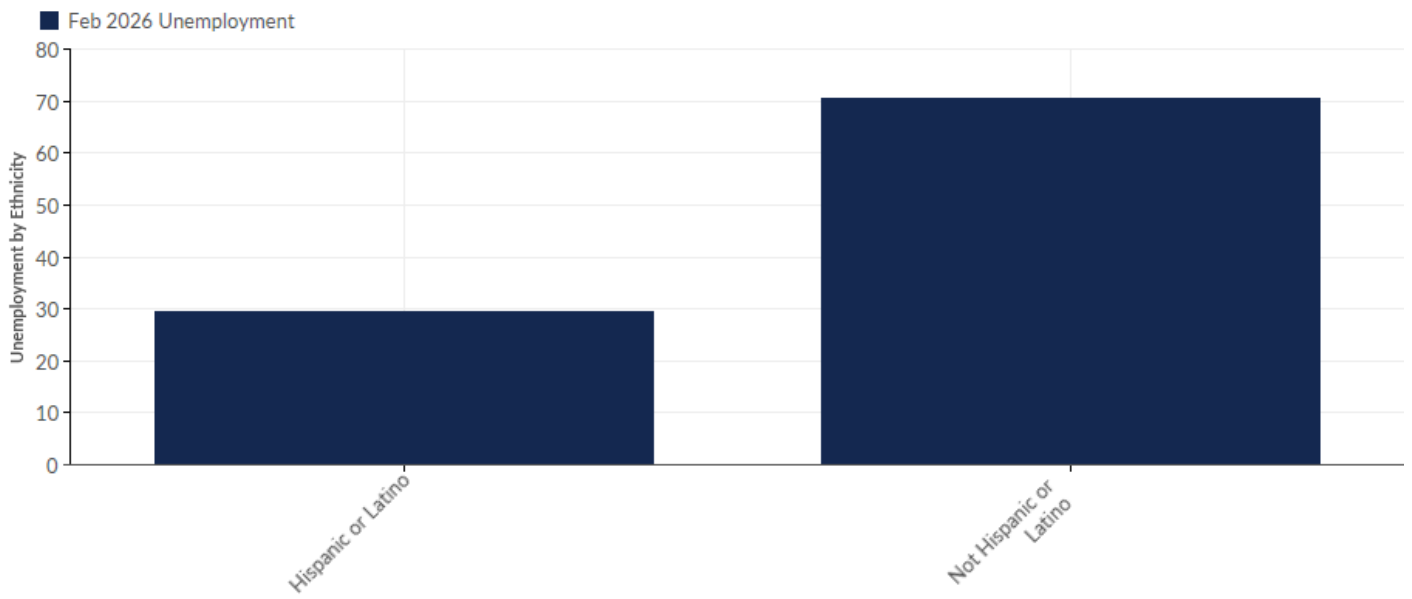

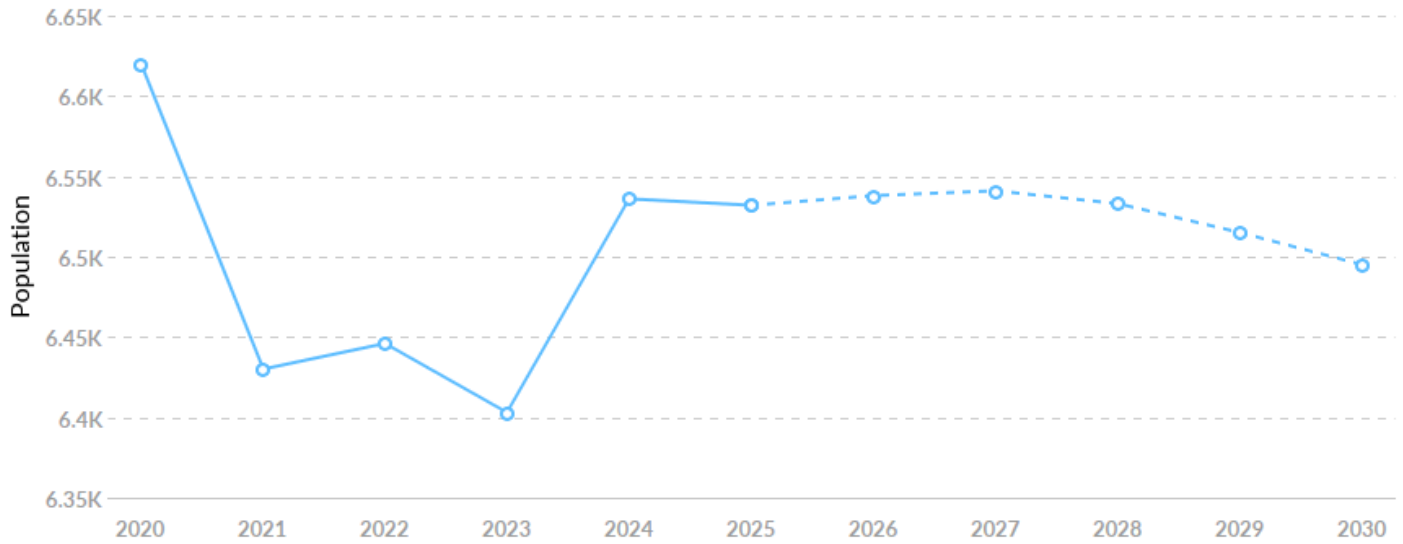

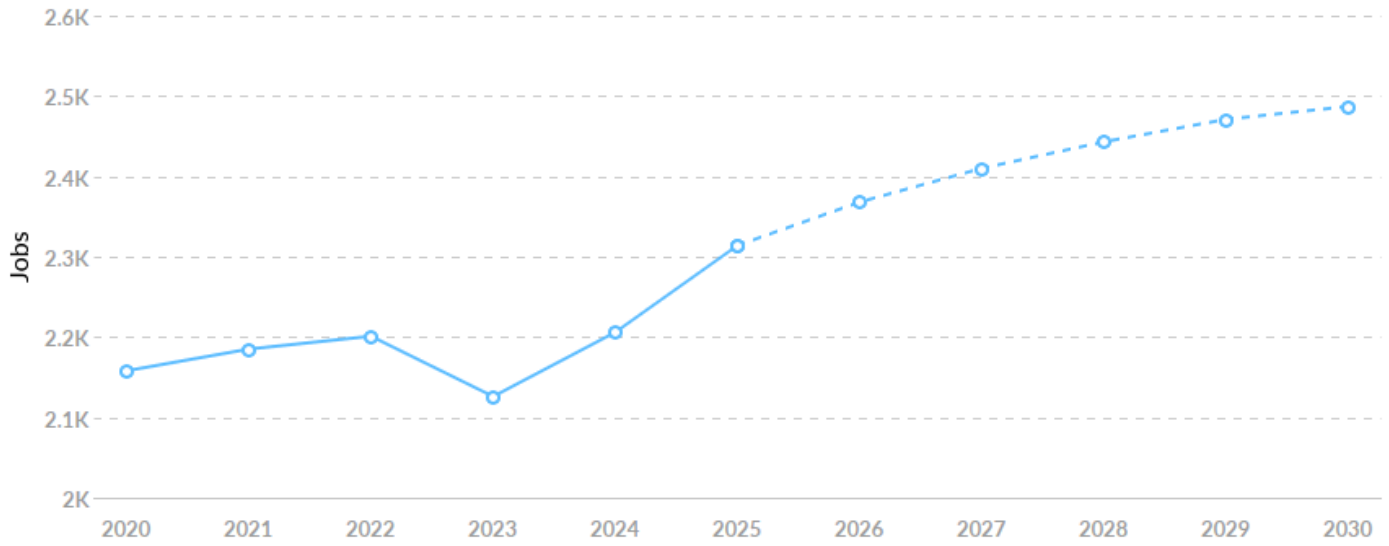

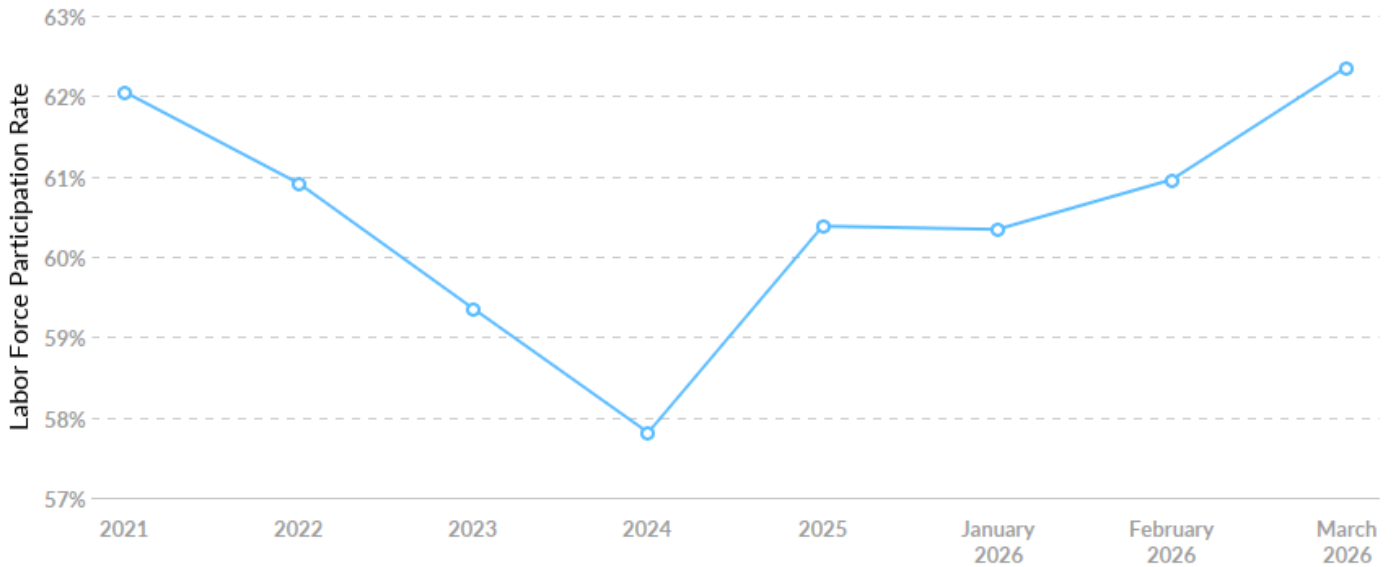
Job Trends

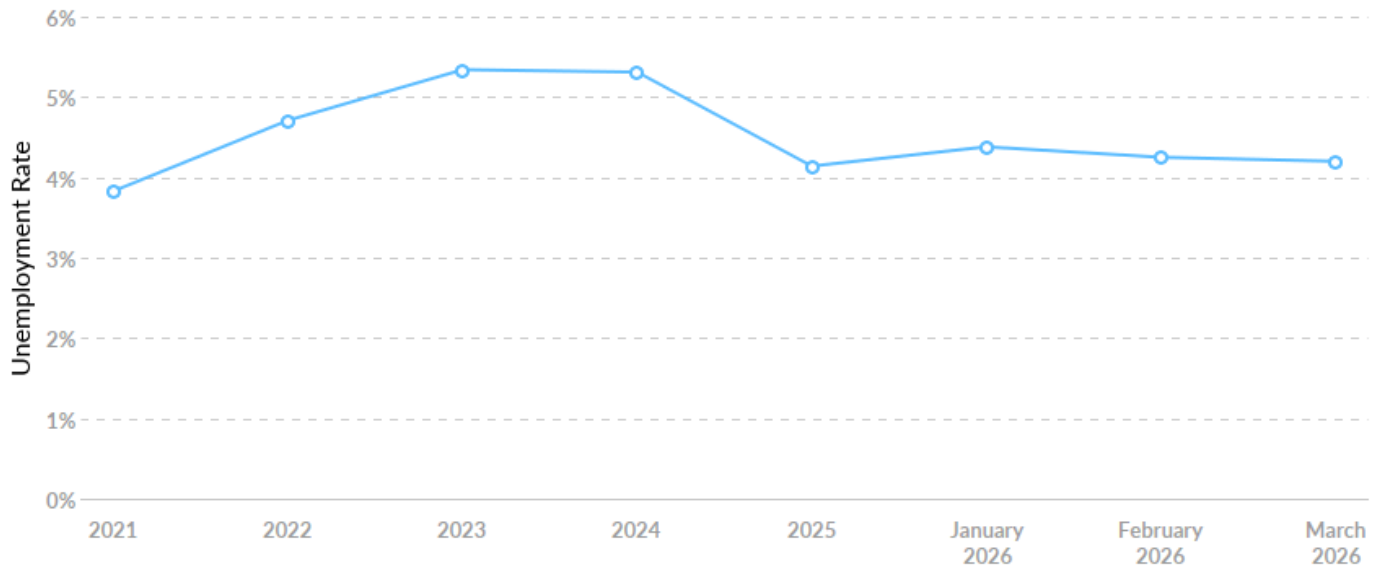

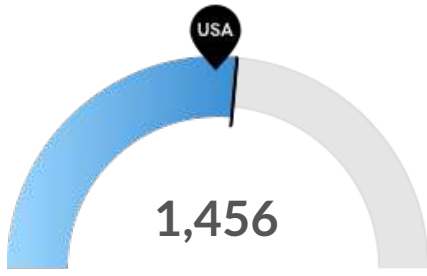
Unemployment Rate Trends

Pershing County, NV had a March 2026 unemployment rate of 4.20%, **increasing from 3.83%** 5 years before.



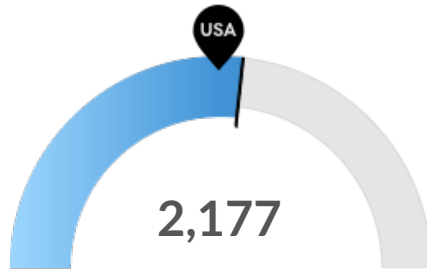

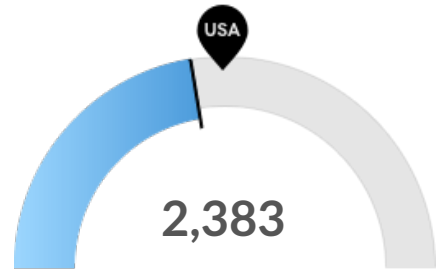
Millennials

Pershing County, NV has 1,456 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 1,338.



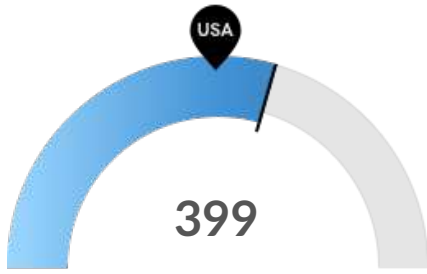
Retiring Soon

Racial diversity is low in Pershing County, NV. The national average for an area this size is 2,780 racially diverse people, while there are 2,383 here.



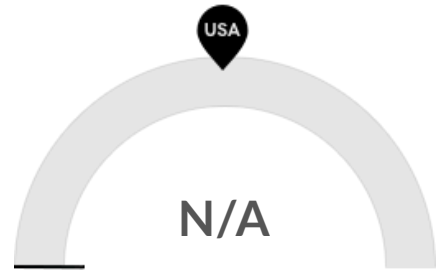
Veterans

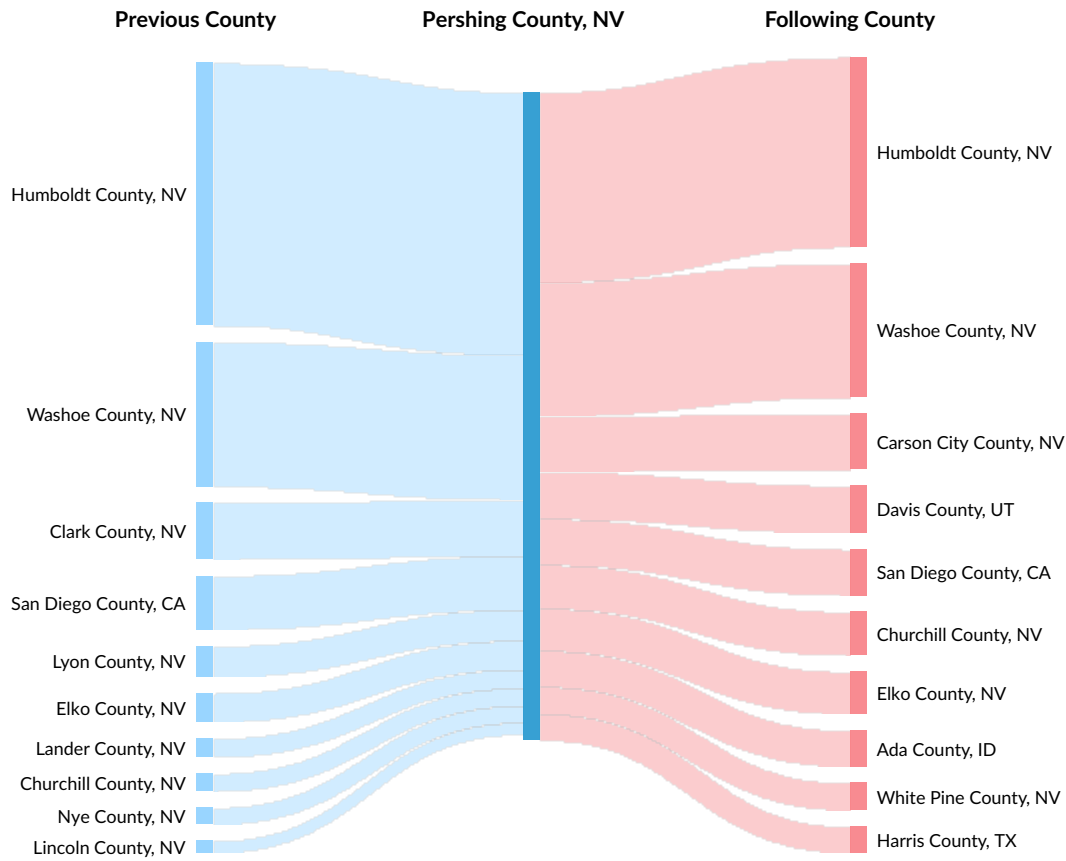

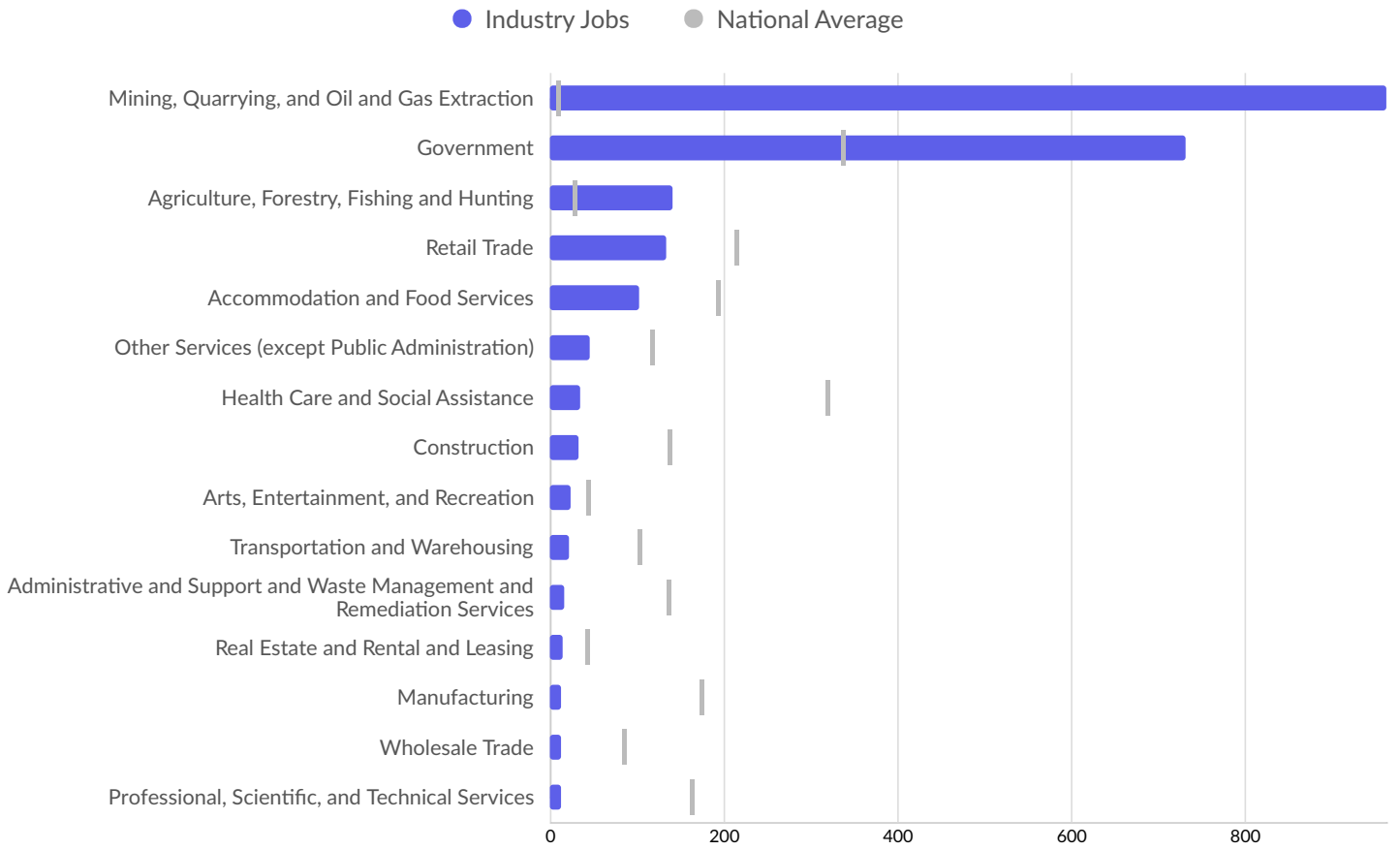

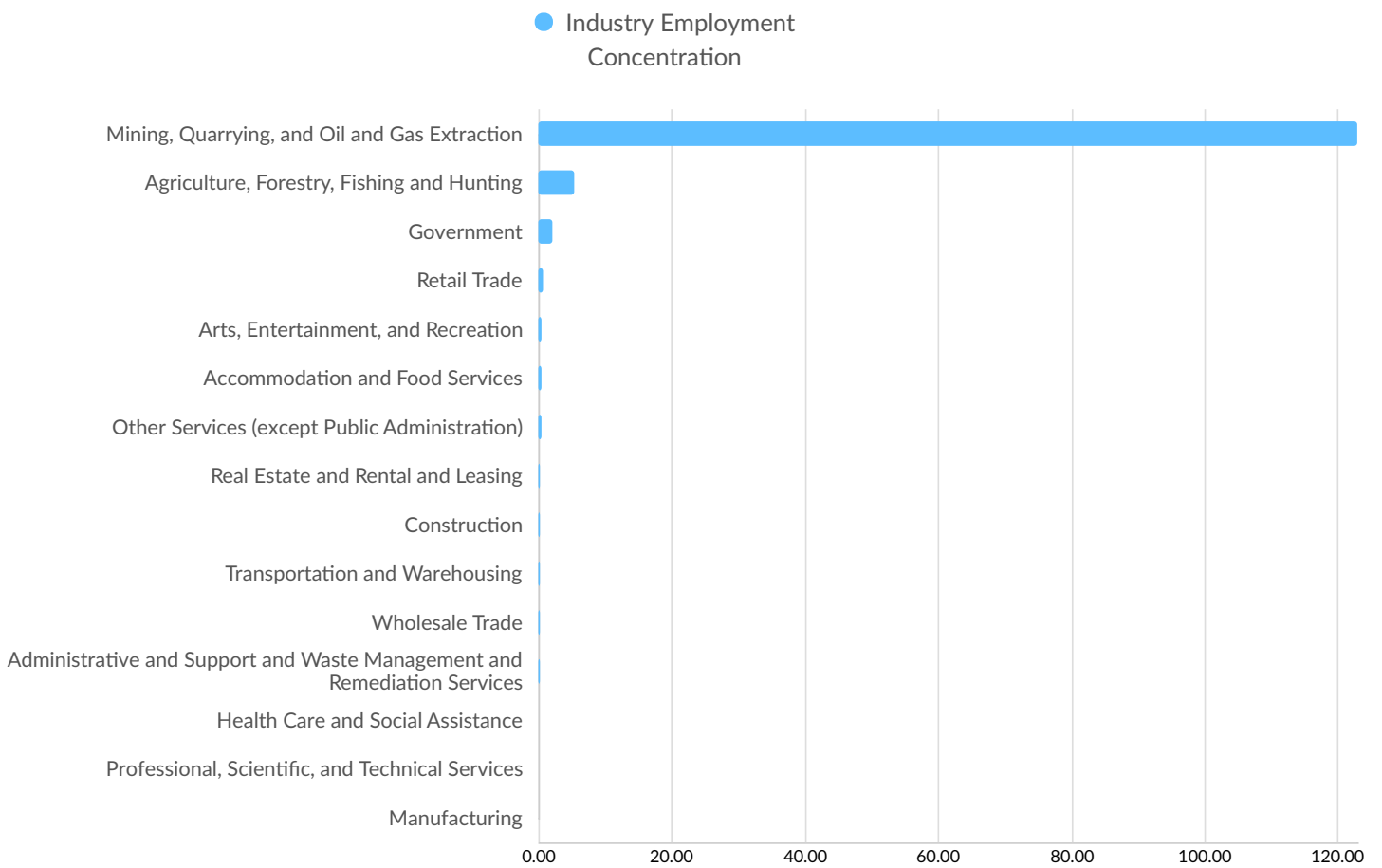

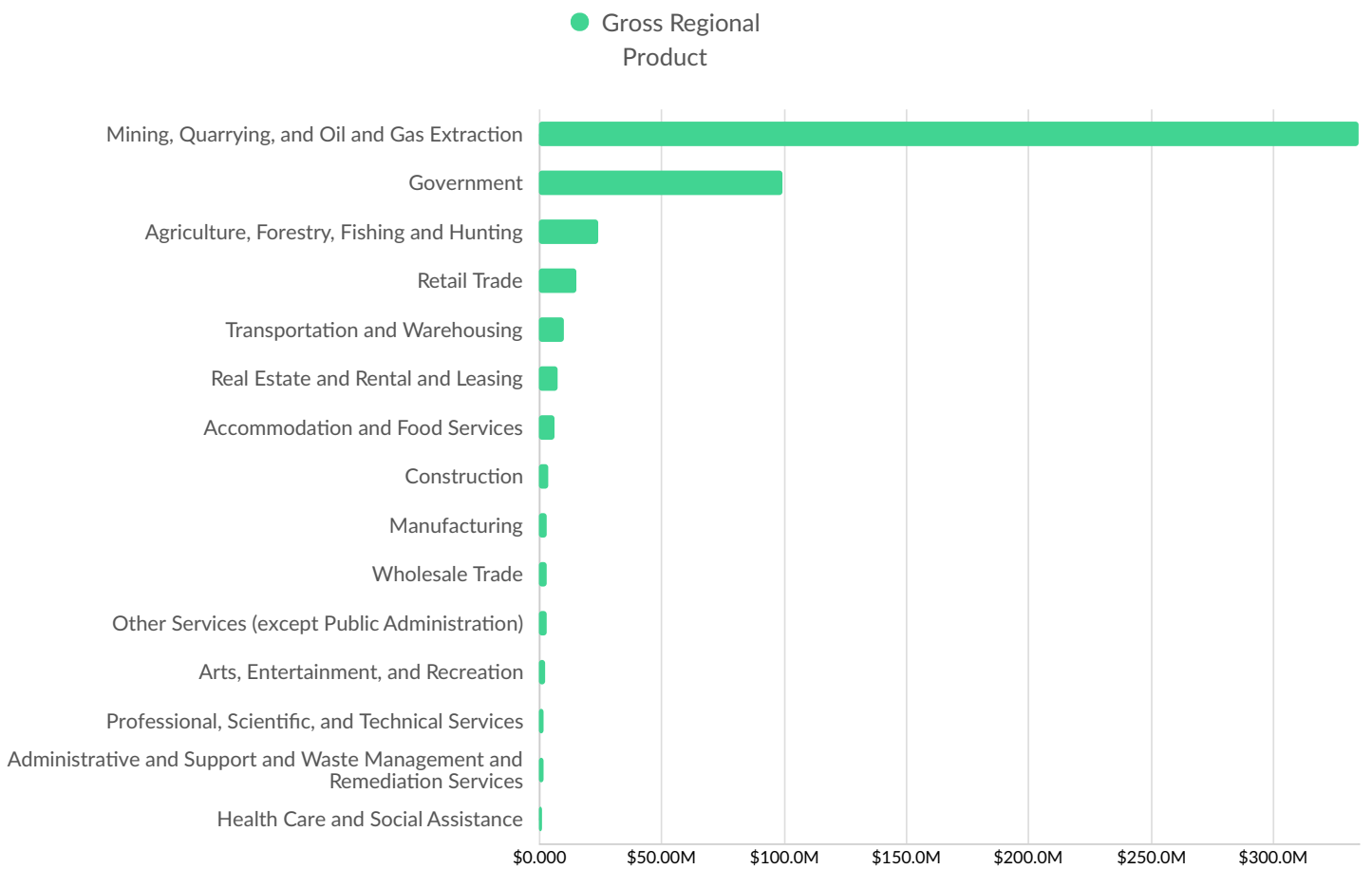
Top Growing Industries



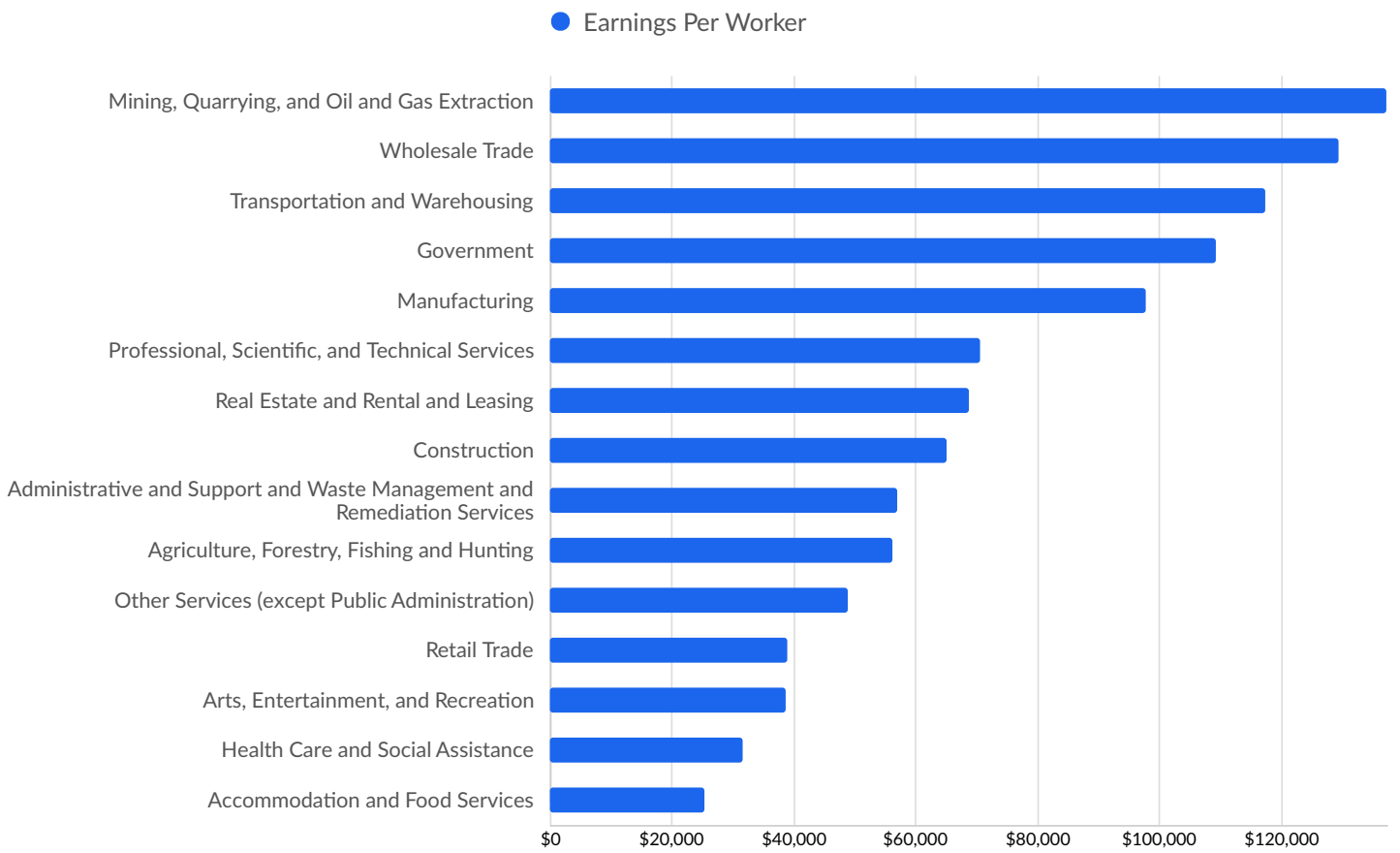
Top Industry Employment Concentration

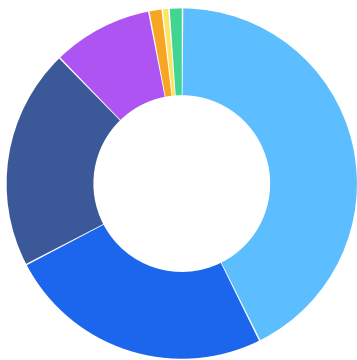

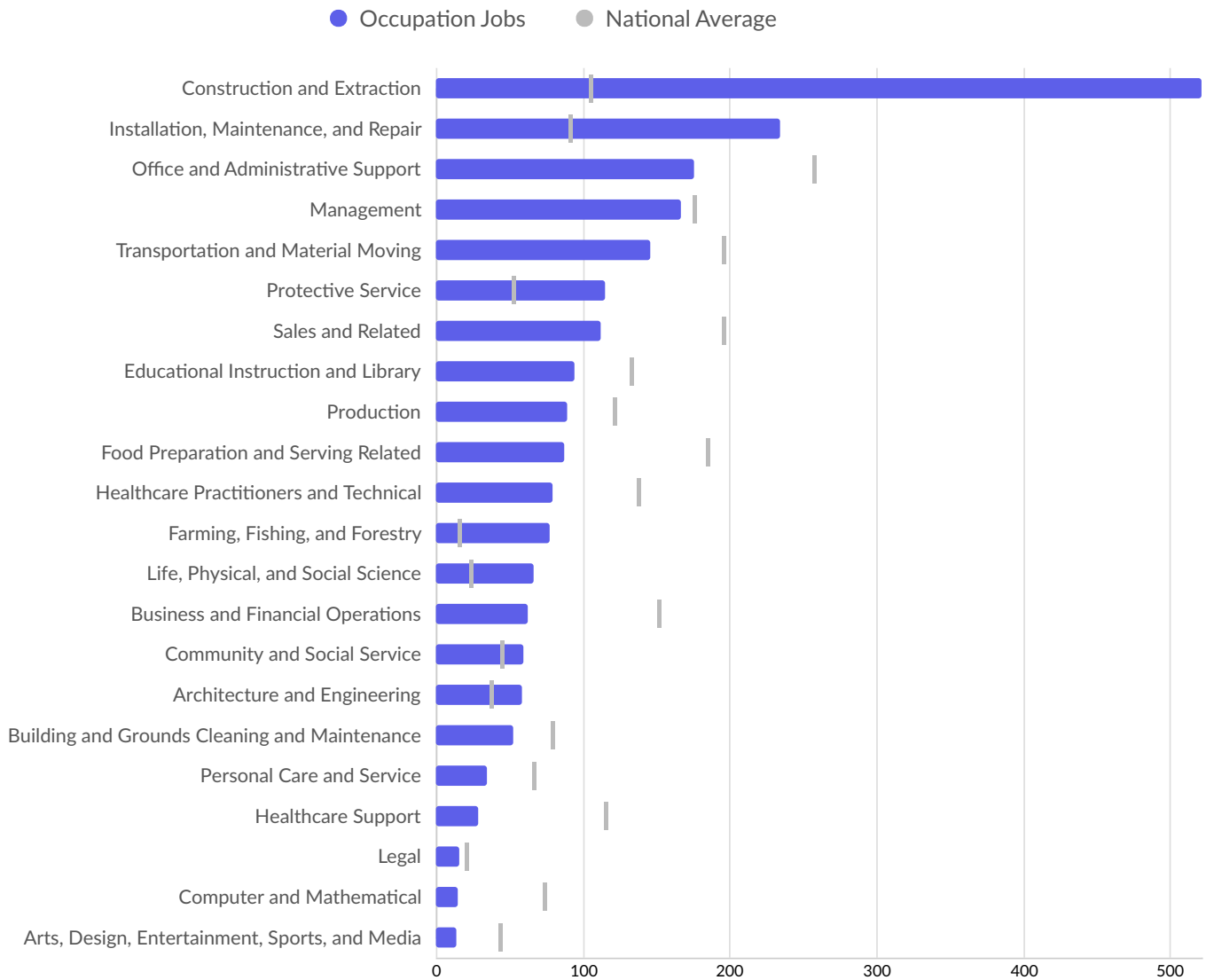

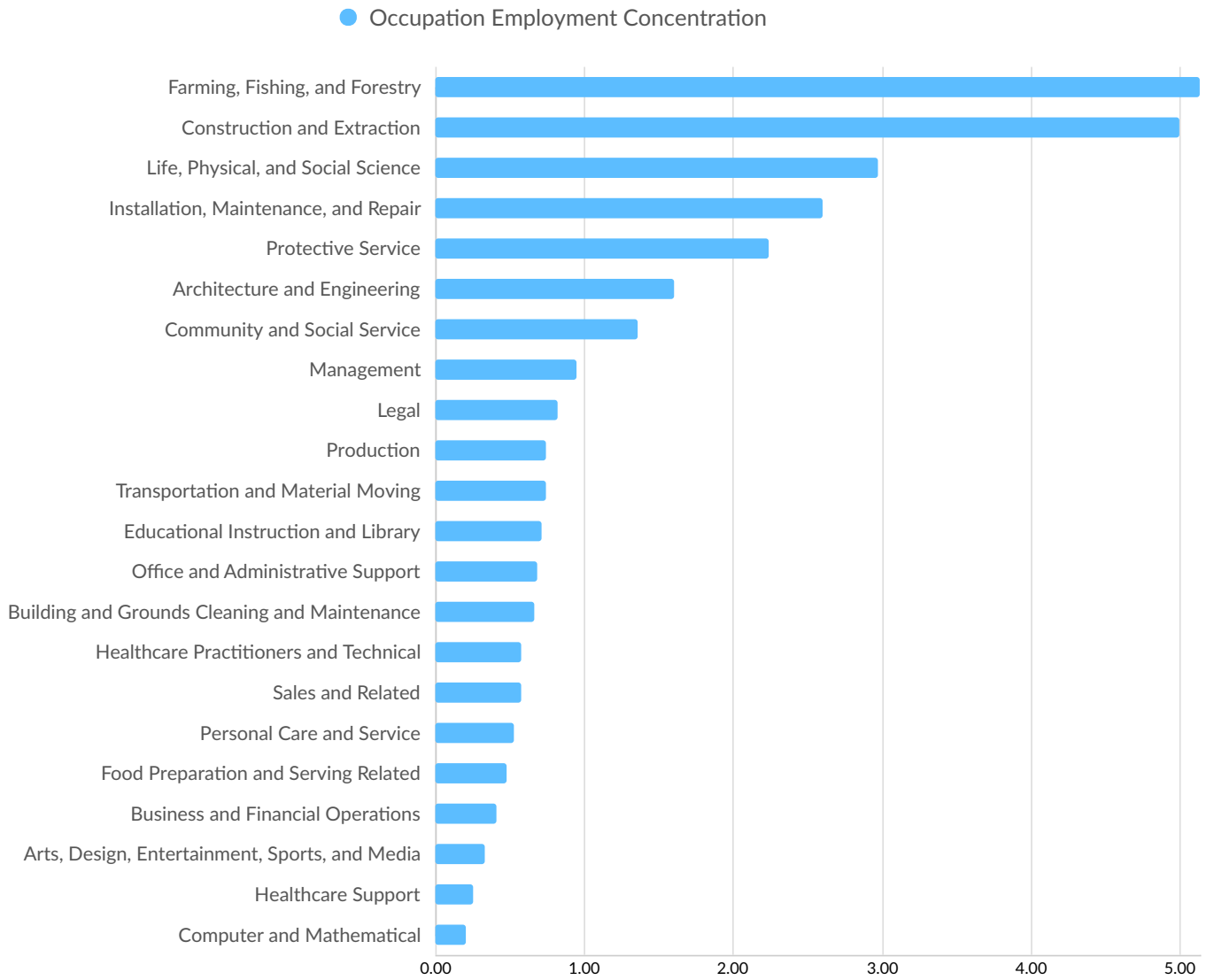

Top Growing Occupations



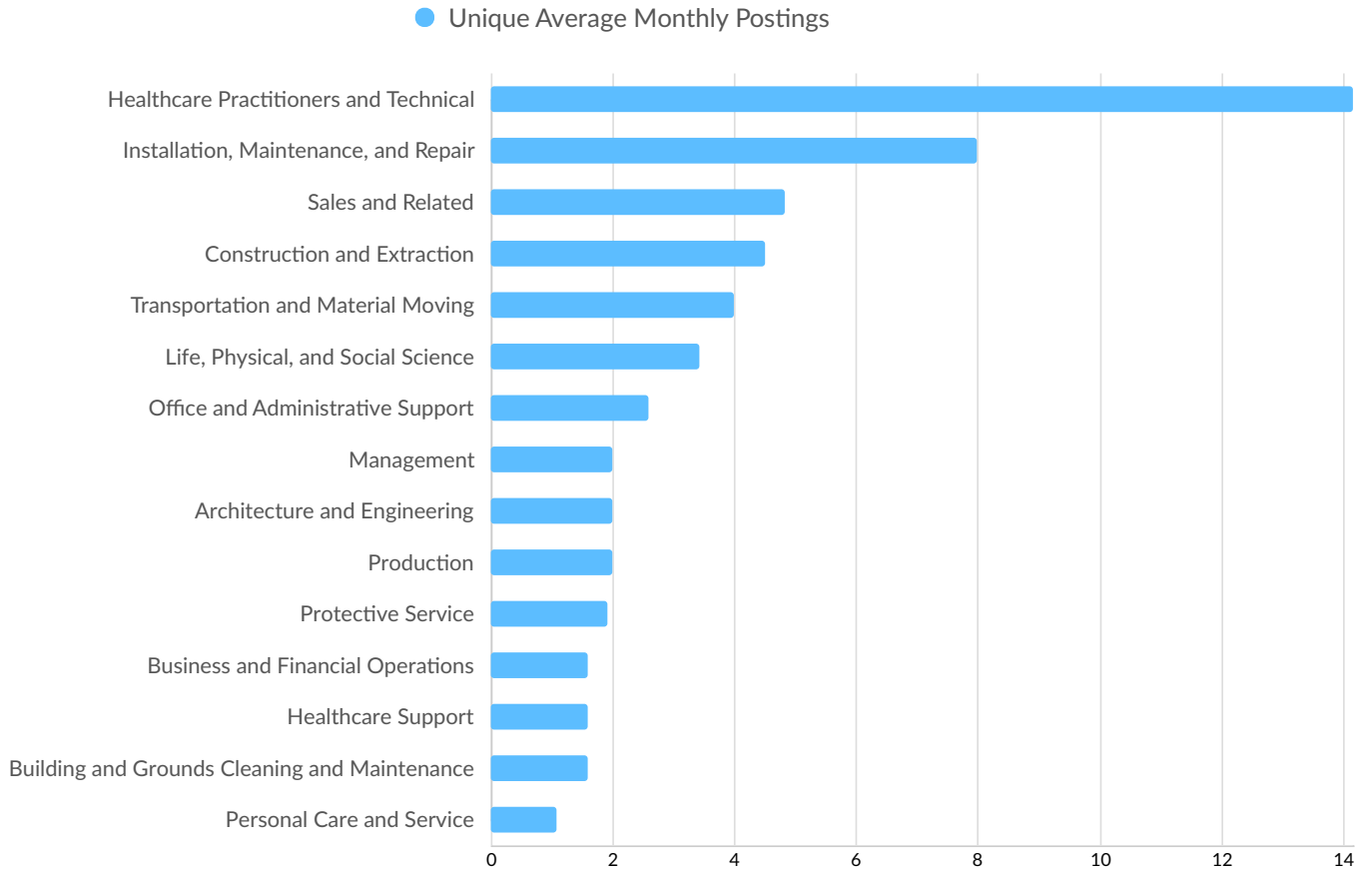
Top Occupation Employment Concentration



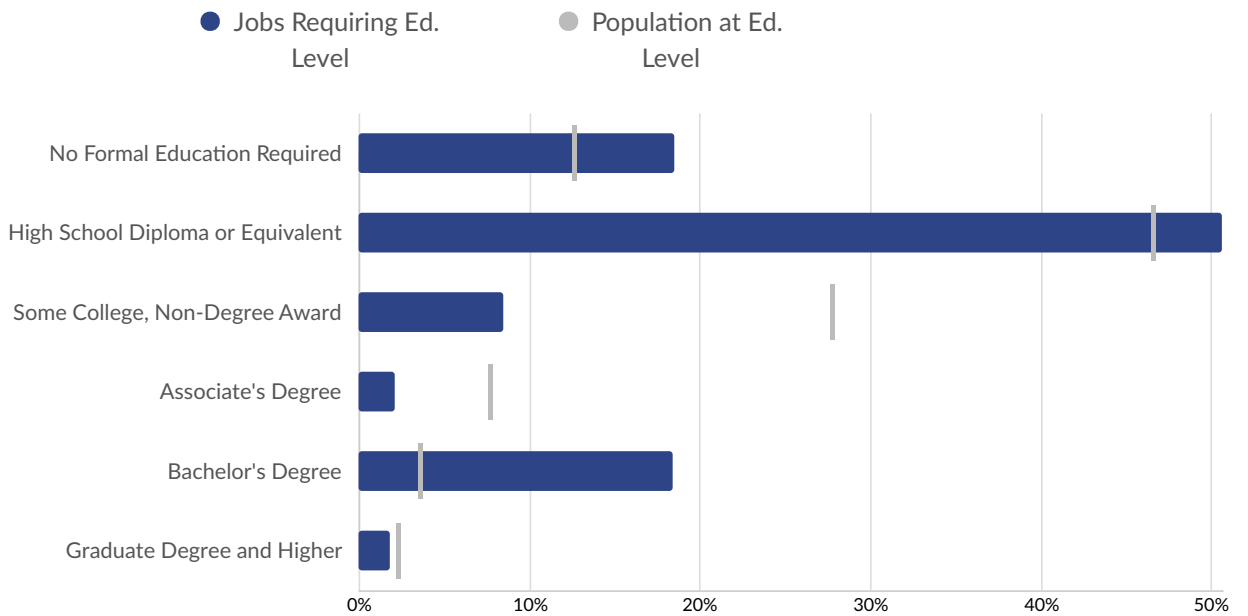
