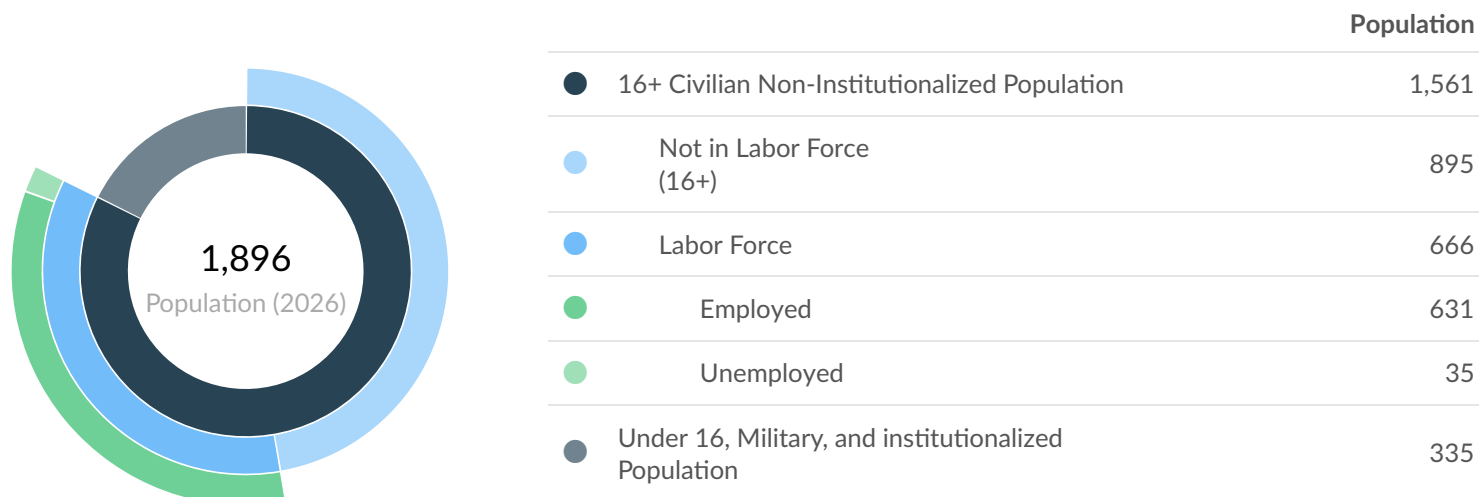
Median household income is **\$10.3K below** the national median household income of \$80.7K.

- From 2020 to 2025, jobs **increased by 7.4%** in Eureka County, NV from 4,553 to 4,892. This change **fell short of the national growth rate of 10.7% by 3.3%**. As the number of jobs increased, the **labor force participation rate decreased from 49.1% to 47.1% between 2020 and 2025**.
- Concerning educational attainment, **9.2% of Eureka County, NV residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (12.6% below the national average), and **4.8% hold an Associate's Degree** (4.1% below the national average).
- The top three industries in 2025 are Metal Ore Mining, Support Activities for Mining, and Local Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals.

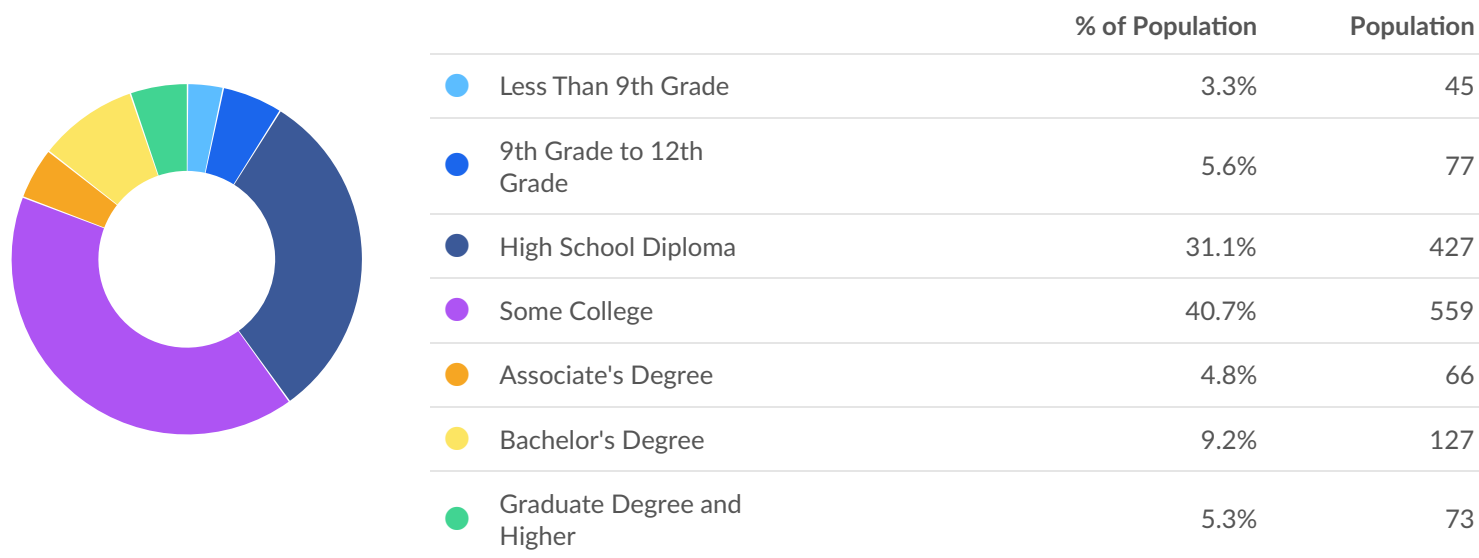

Jun 2026 Labor Force Breakdown



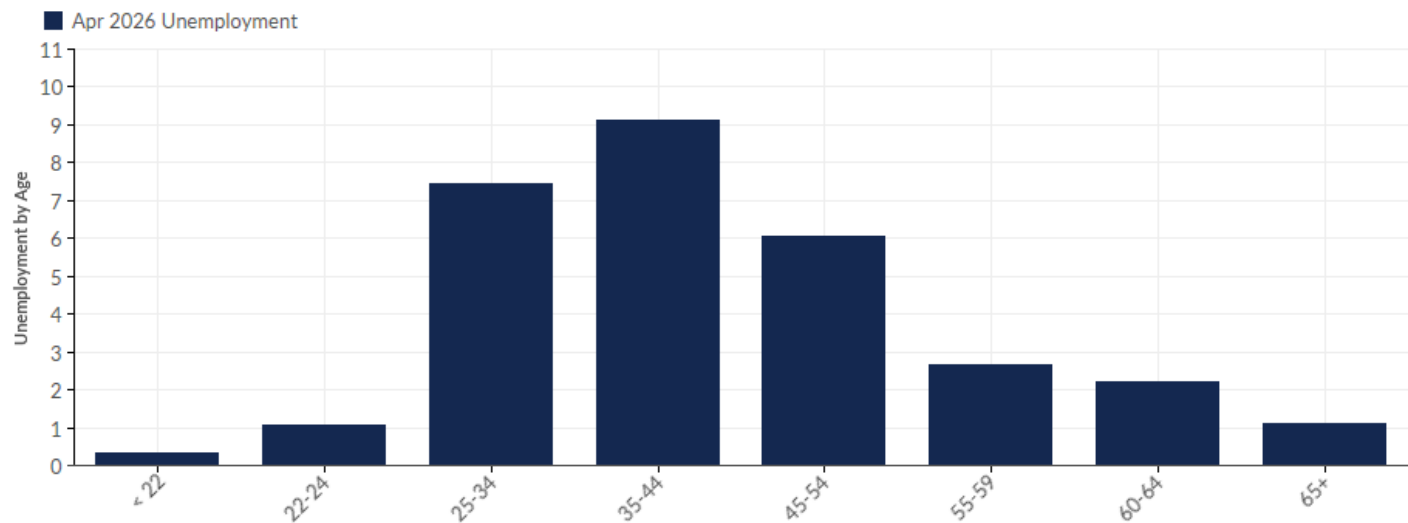
Educational Attainment

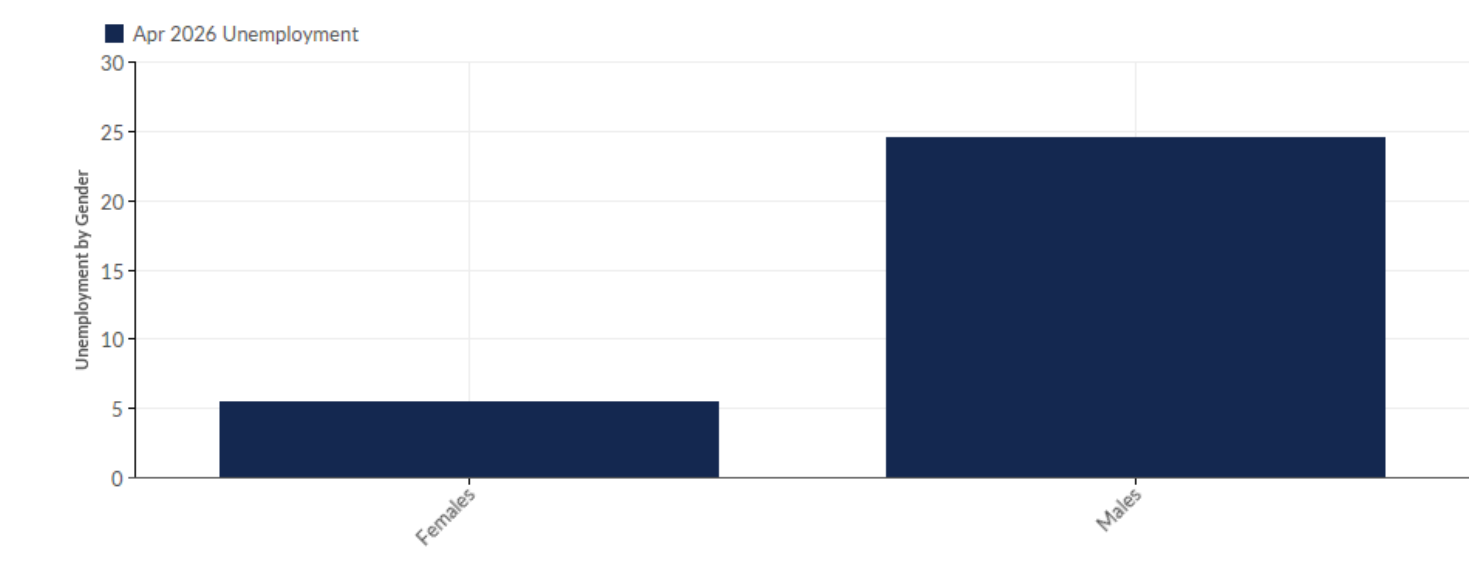

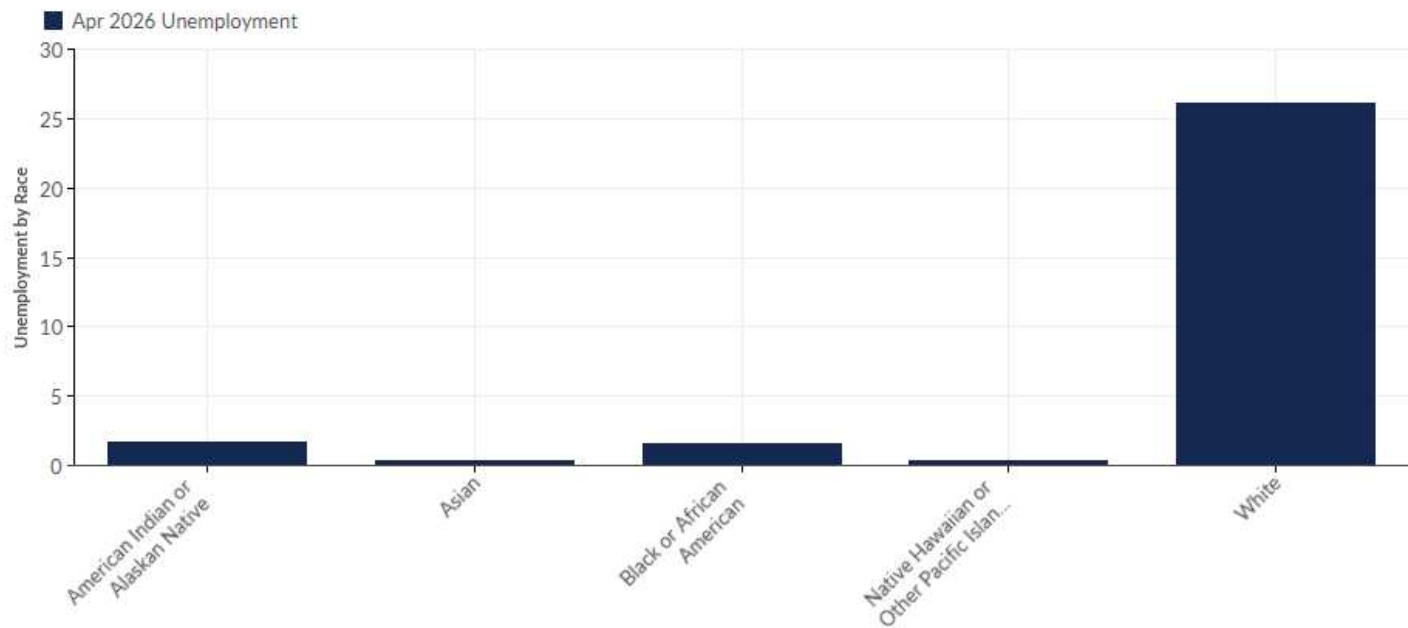

Unemployment by Gender



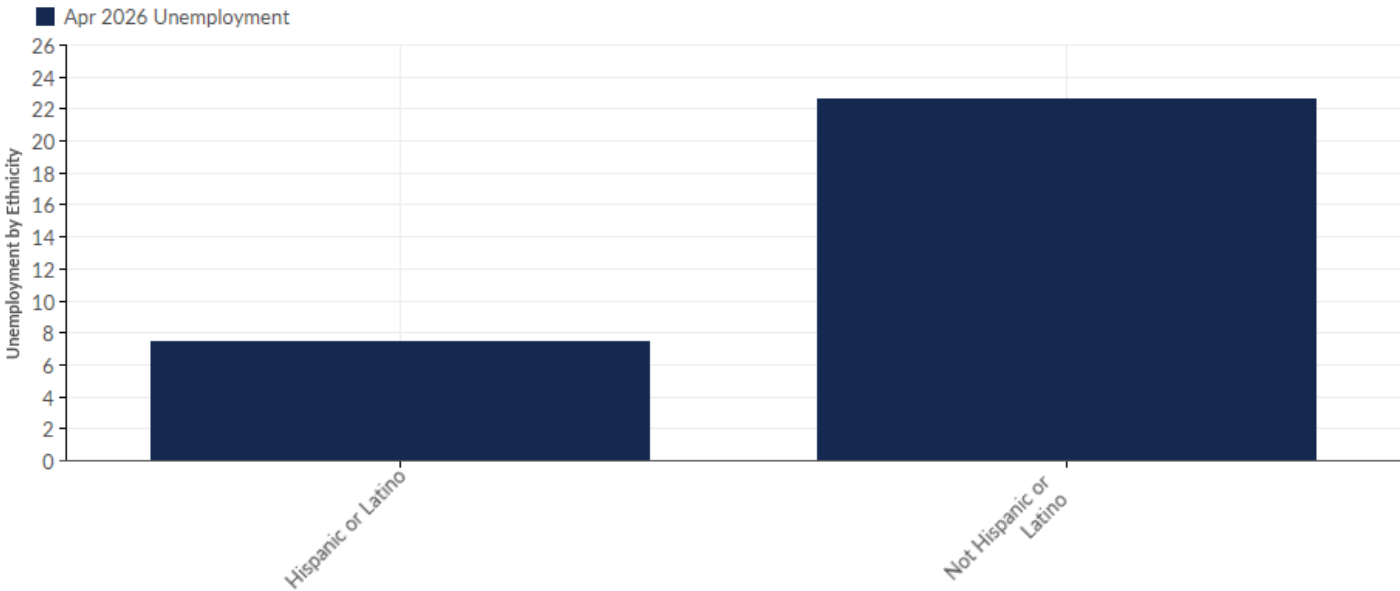

Unemployment by Ethnicity

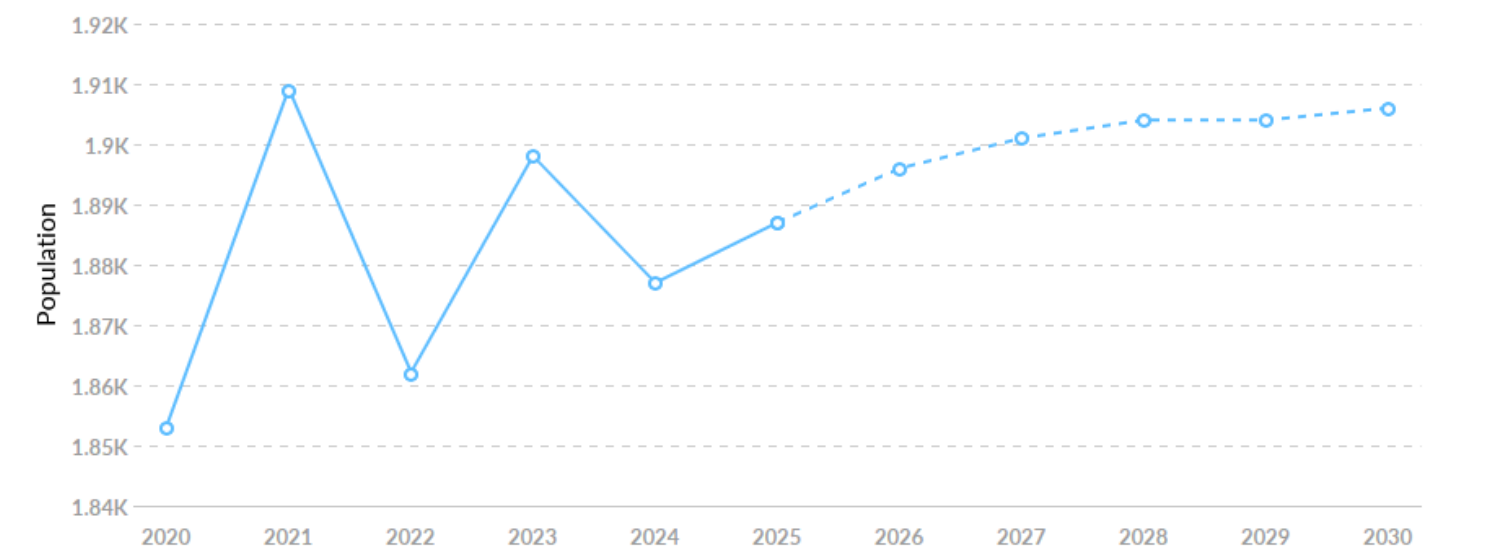

Population Trends

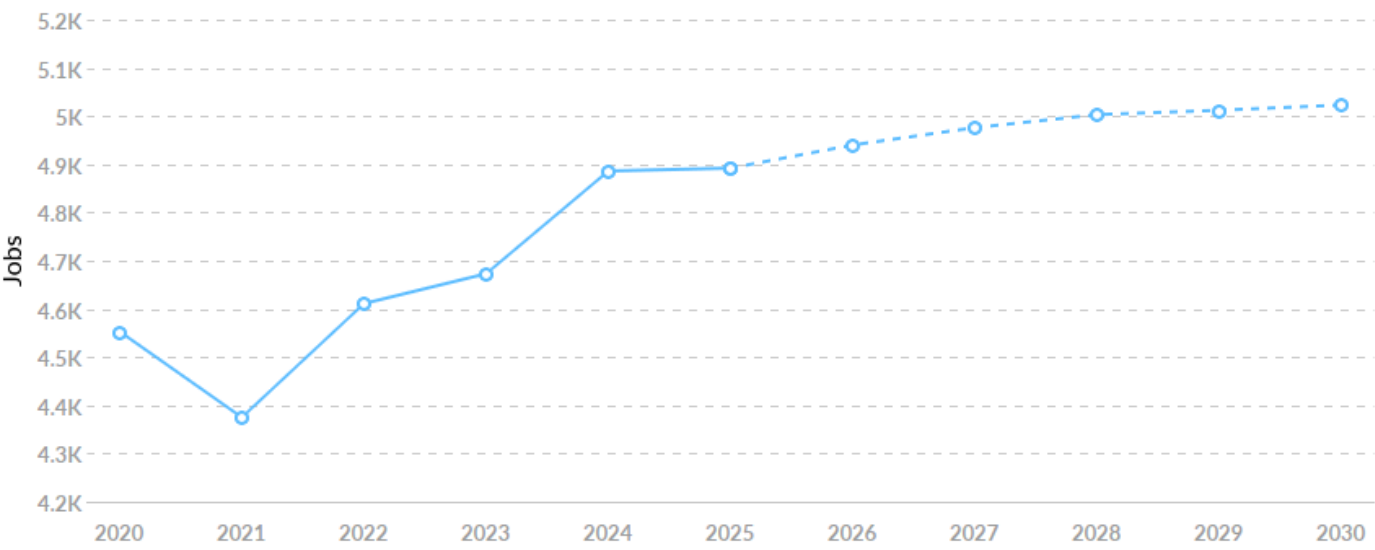

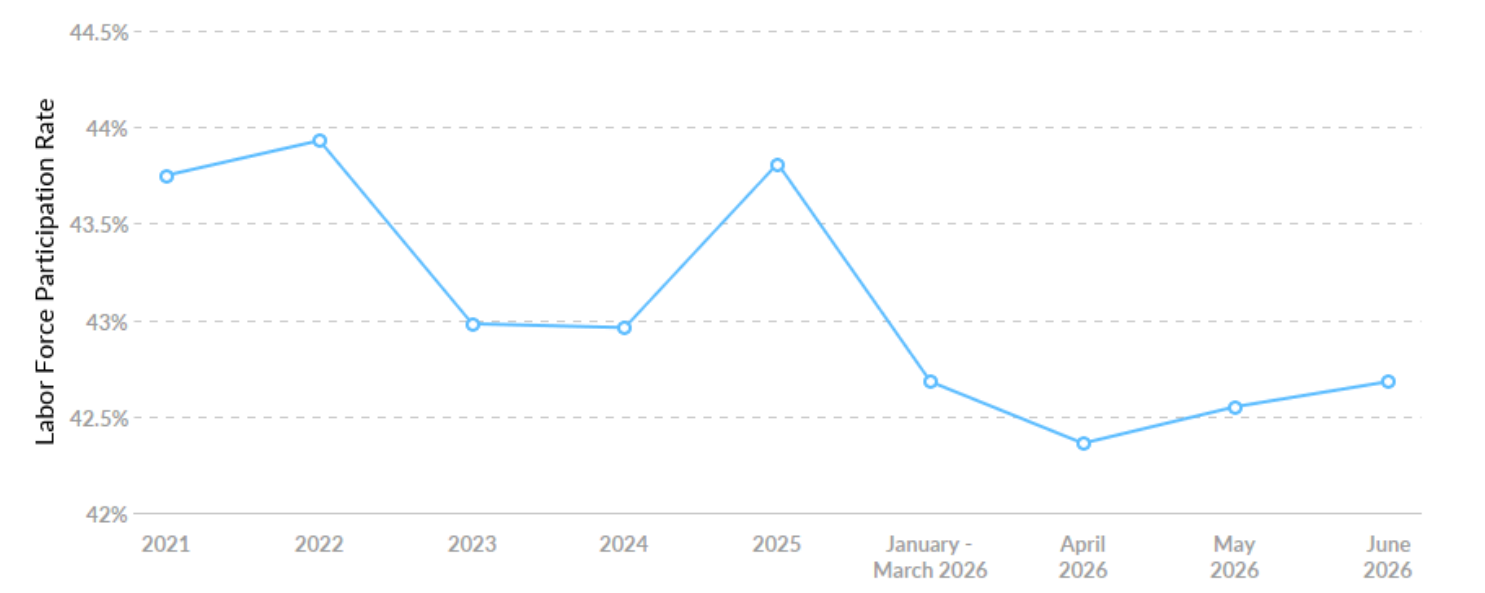
Job Trends

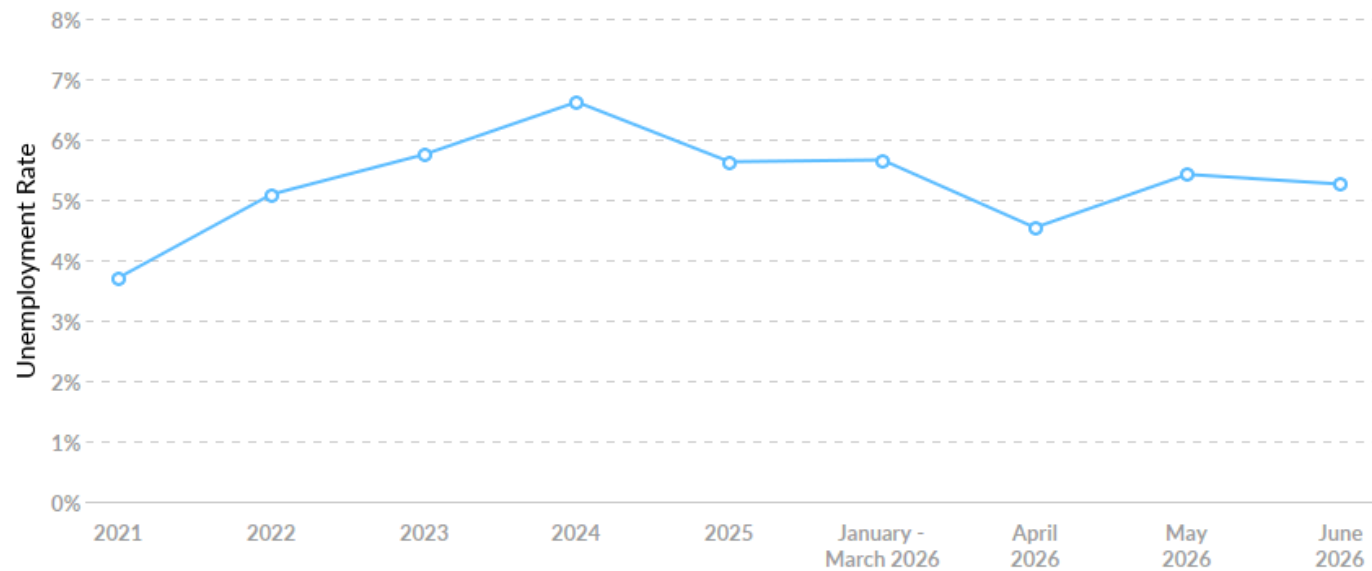

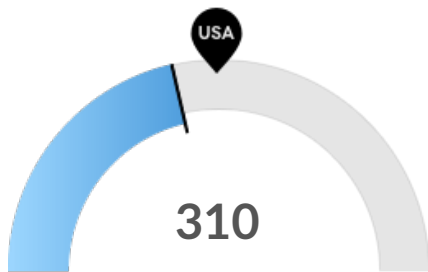
Unemployment Rate Trends

Eureka County, NV had a June 2026 unemployment rate of 5.26%, **increasing from 3.71%** 5 years before.



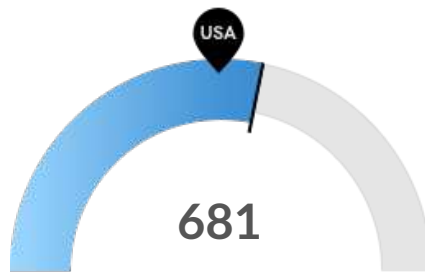

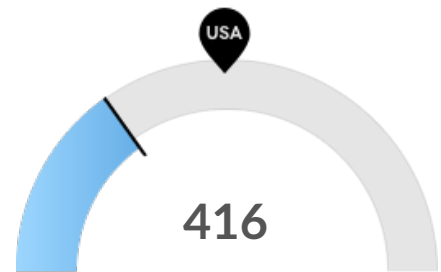
Millennials

Eureka County, NV has 310 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 384.



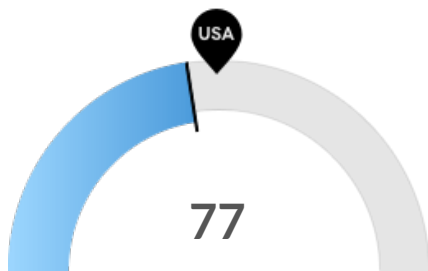
Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is high in Eureka County, NV. The national average for an area this size is 568 people 55 or older, while there are 681 here.



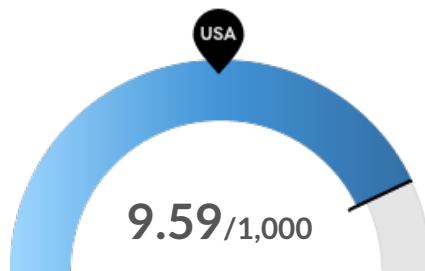
Racial Diversity

Racial diversity is low in Eureka County, NV. The national average for an area this size is 798 racially diverse people, while there are 416 here.



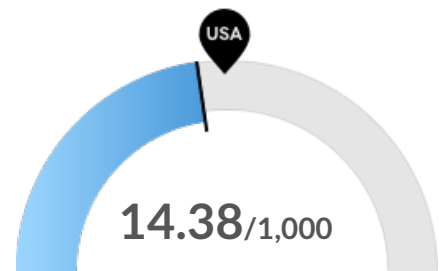
Veterans

Eureka County, NV has 9.59 violent crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 3.38 per 1,000 people.

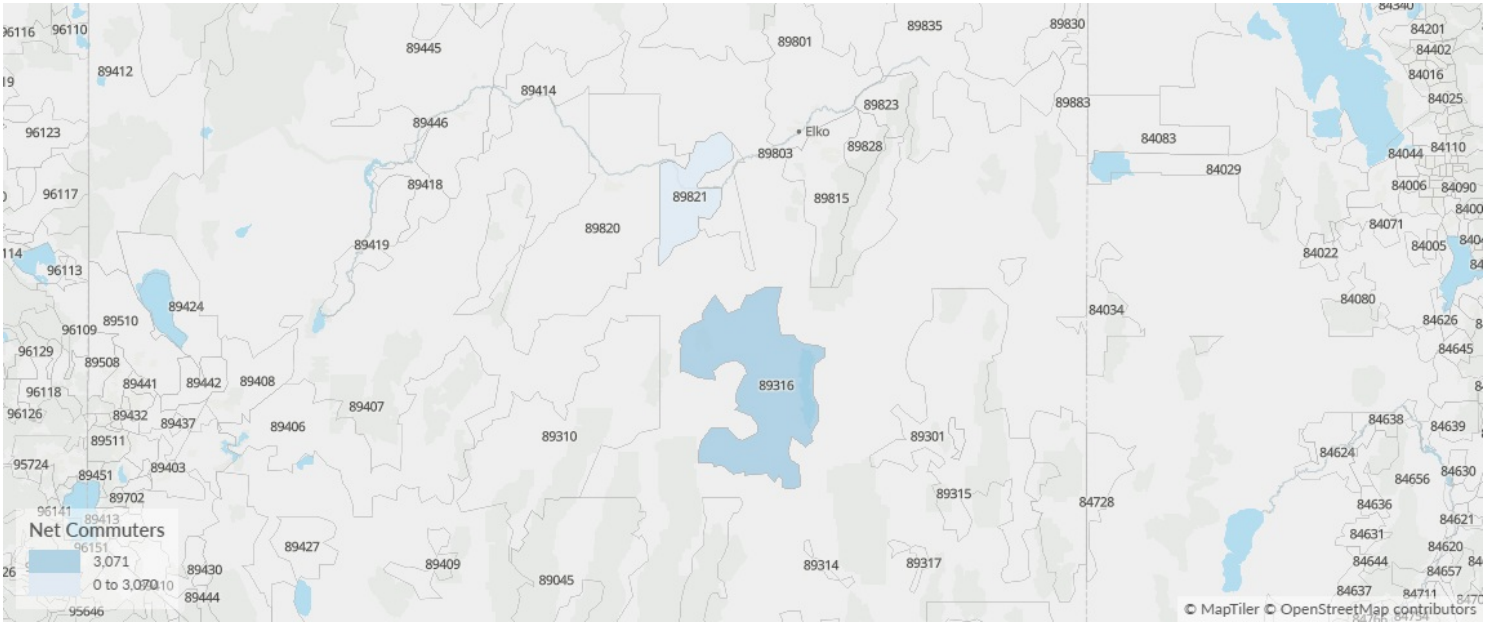


Property Crime

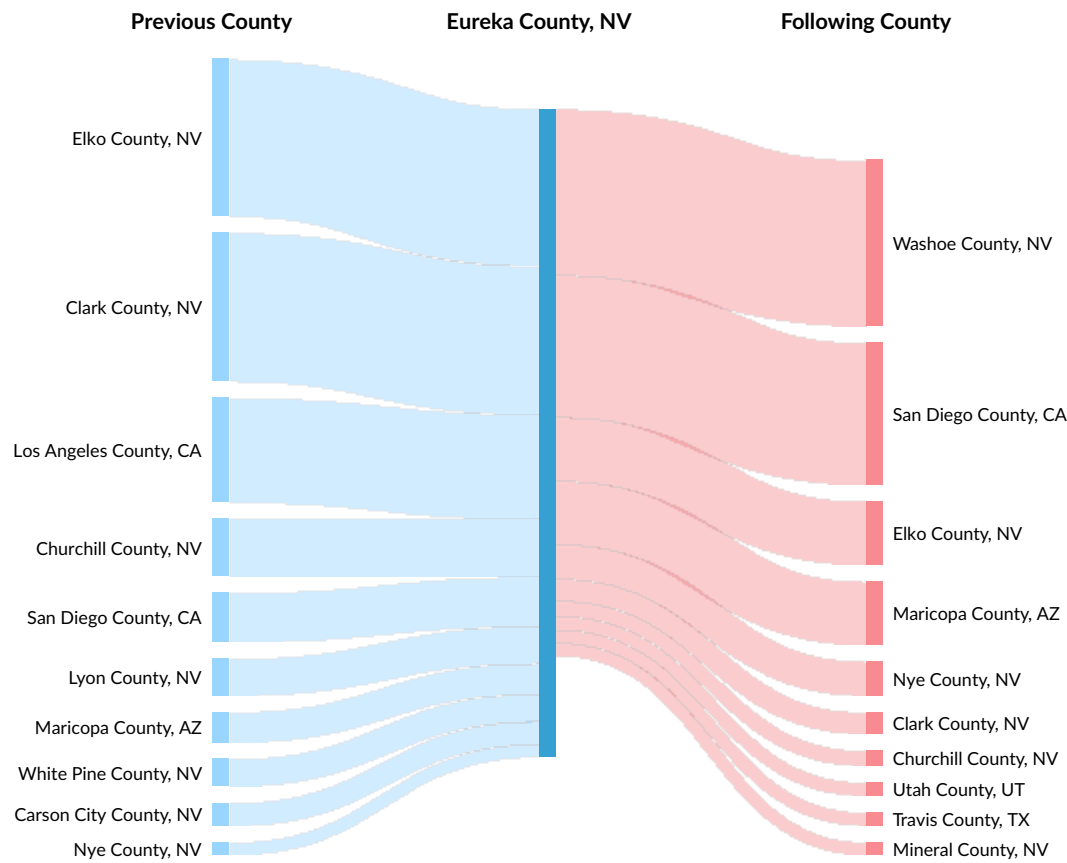

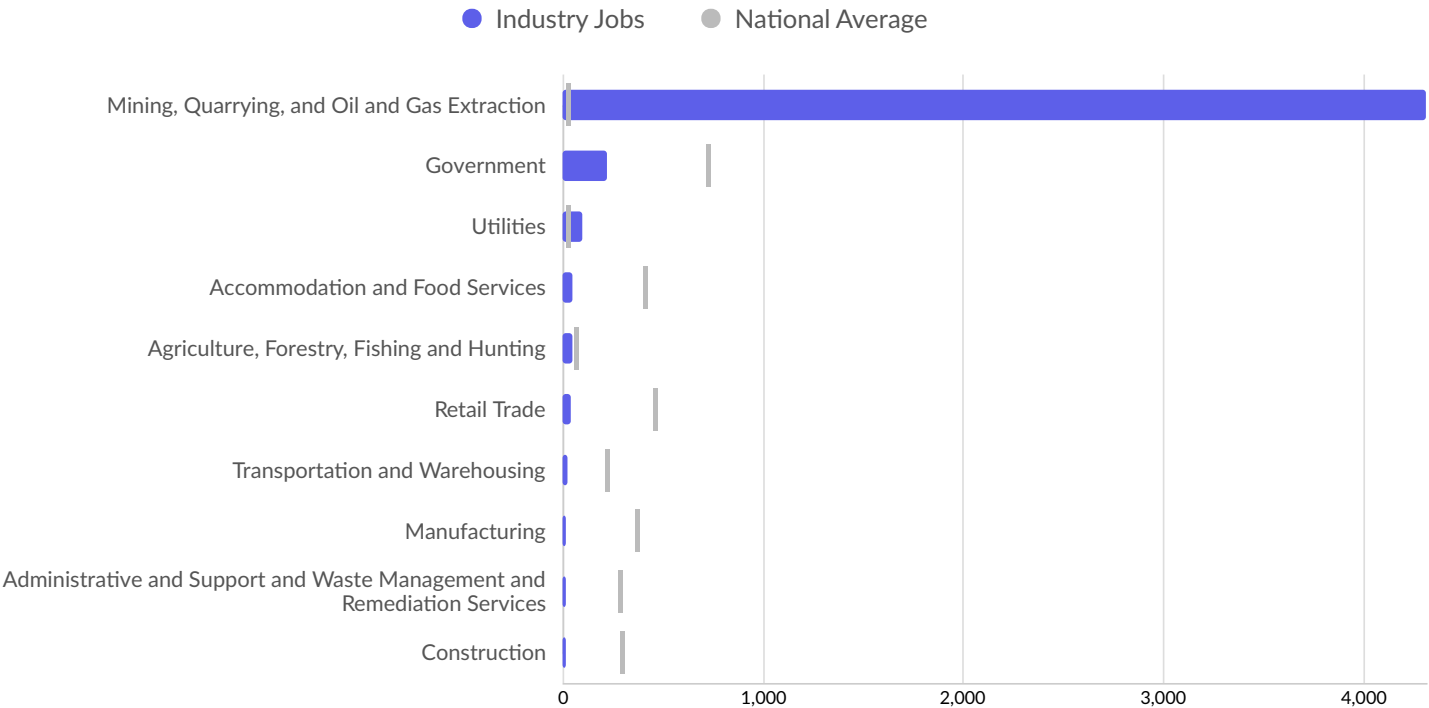

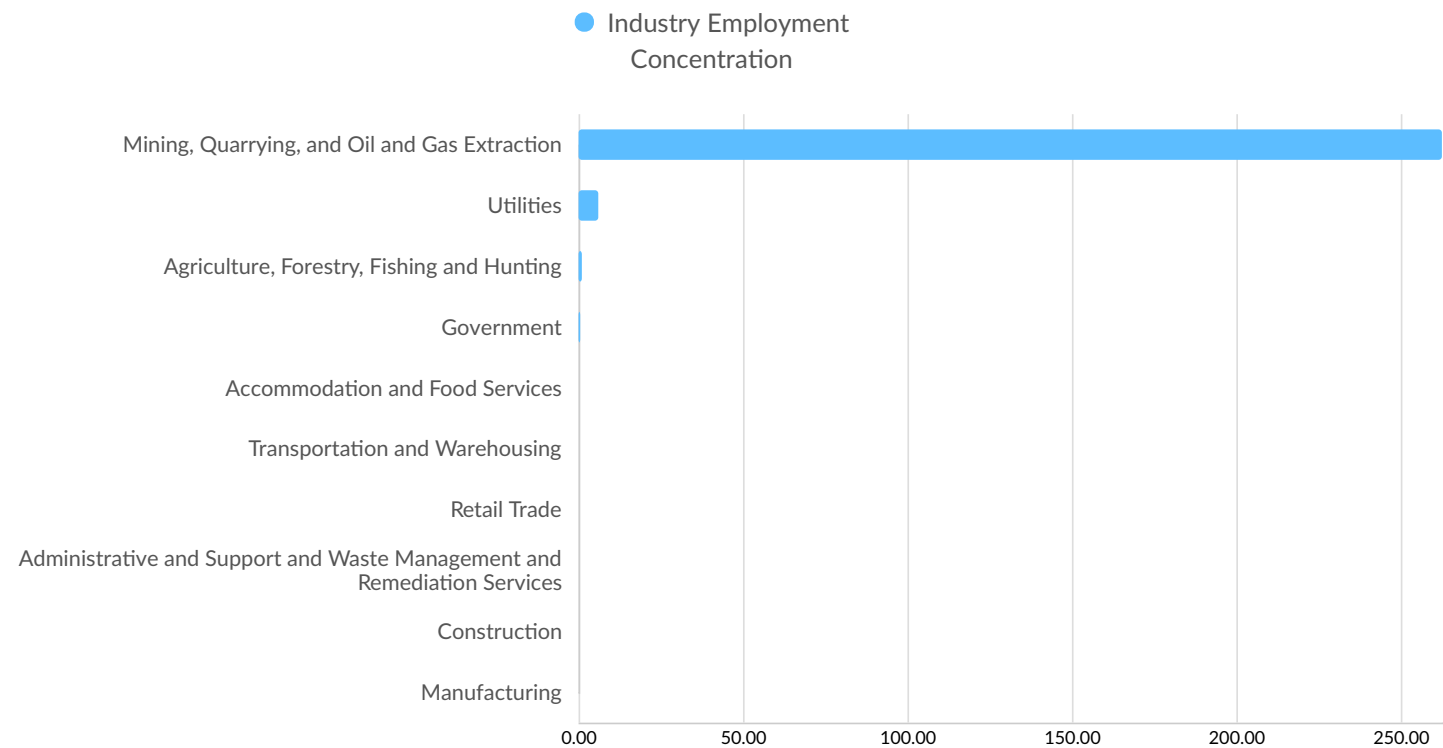

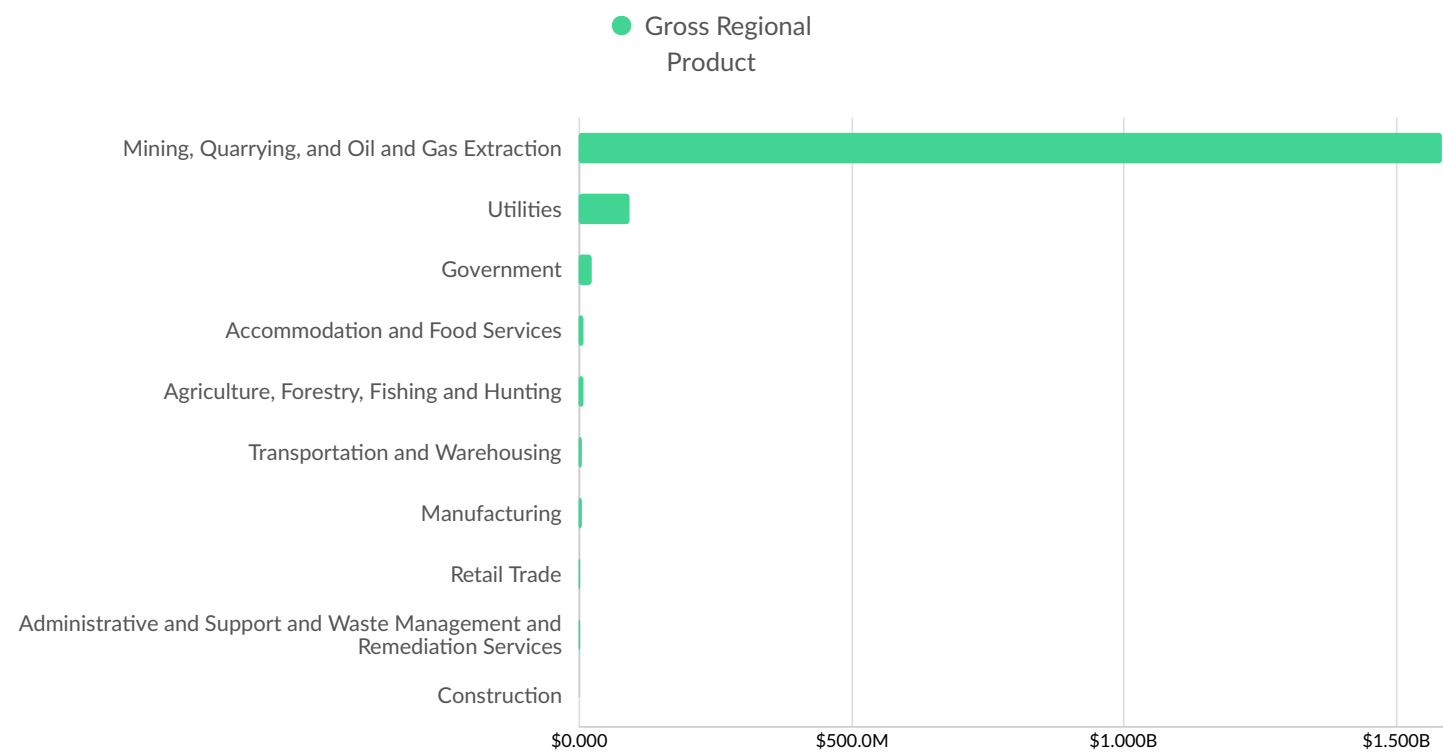
Top Growing Industries



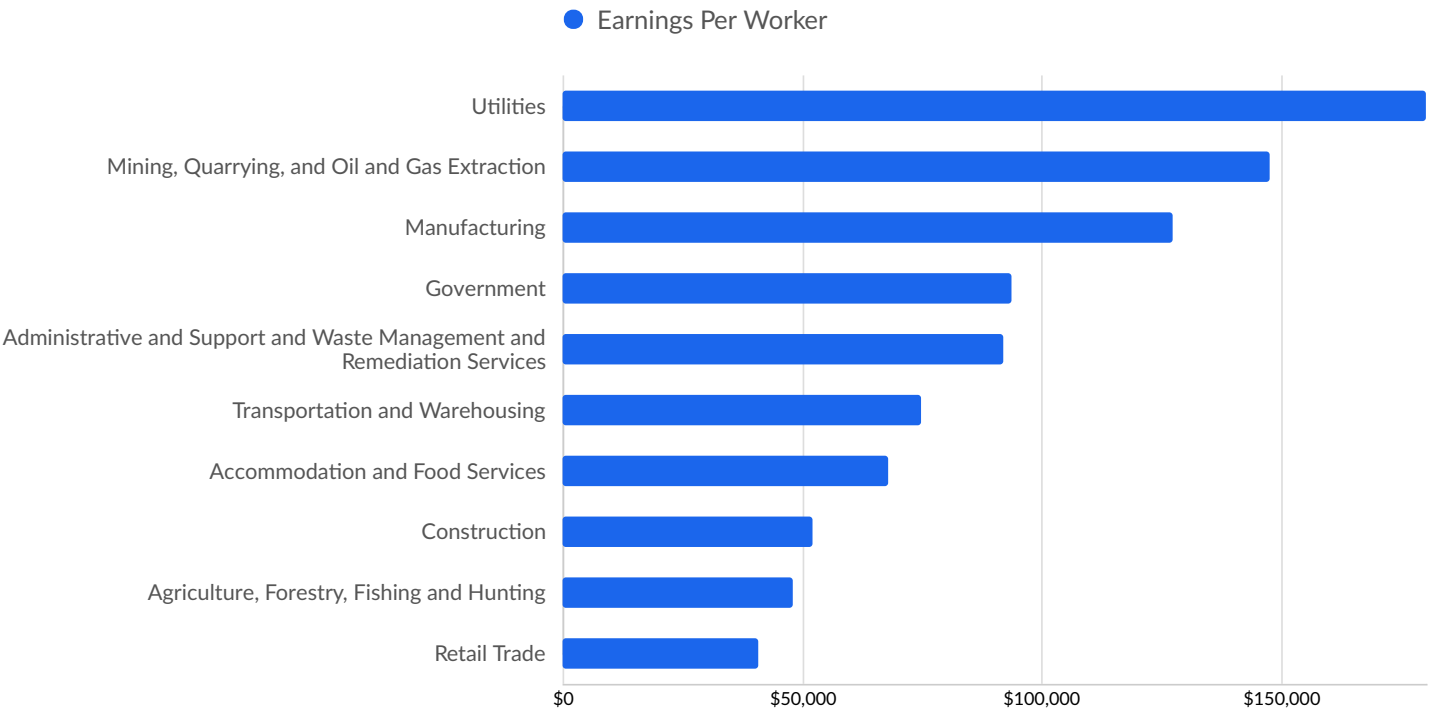
Top Industry Employment Concentration

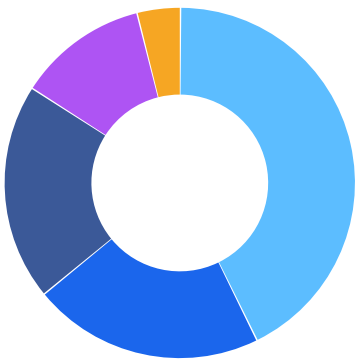

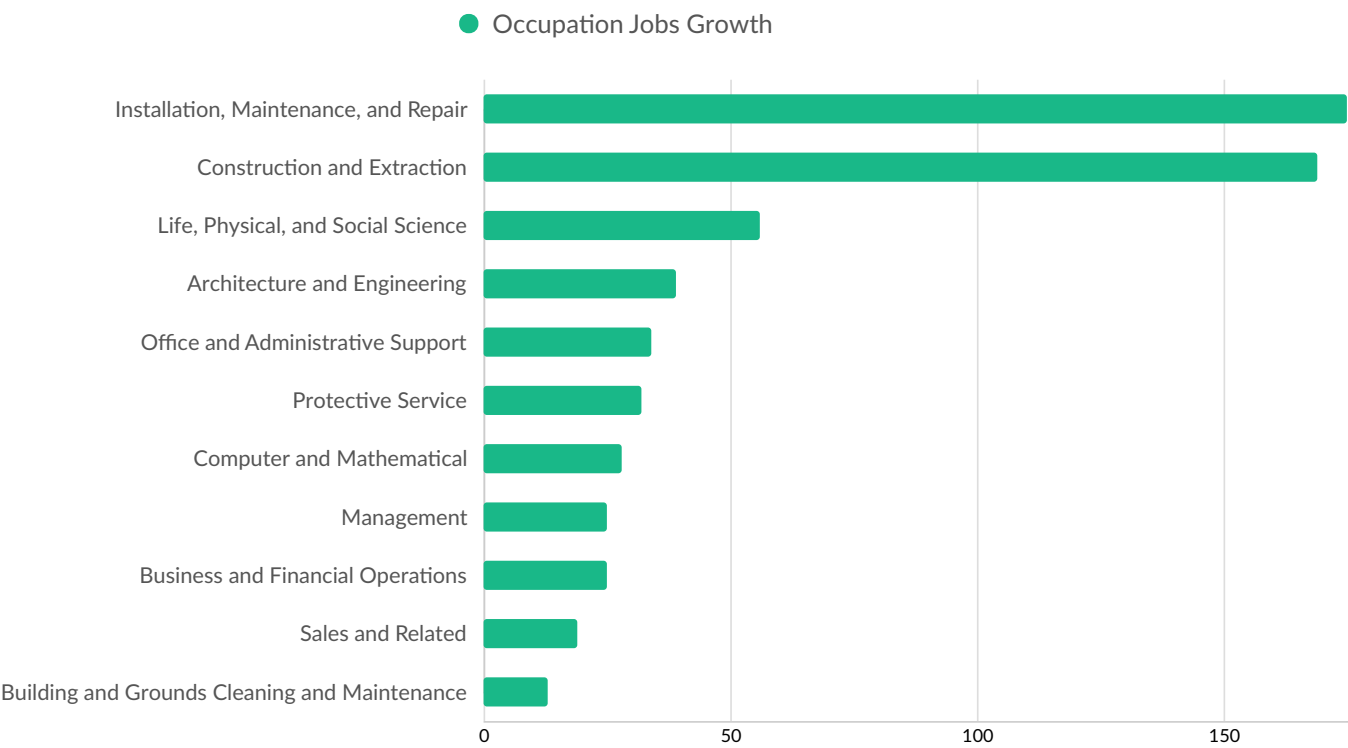

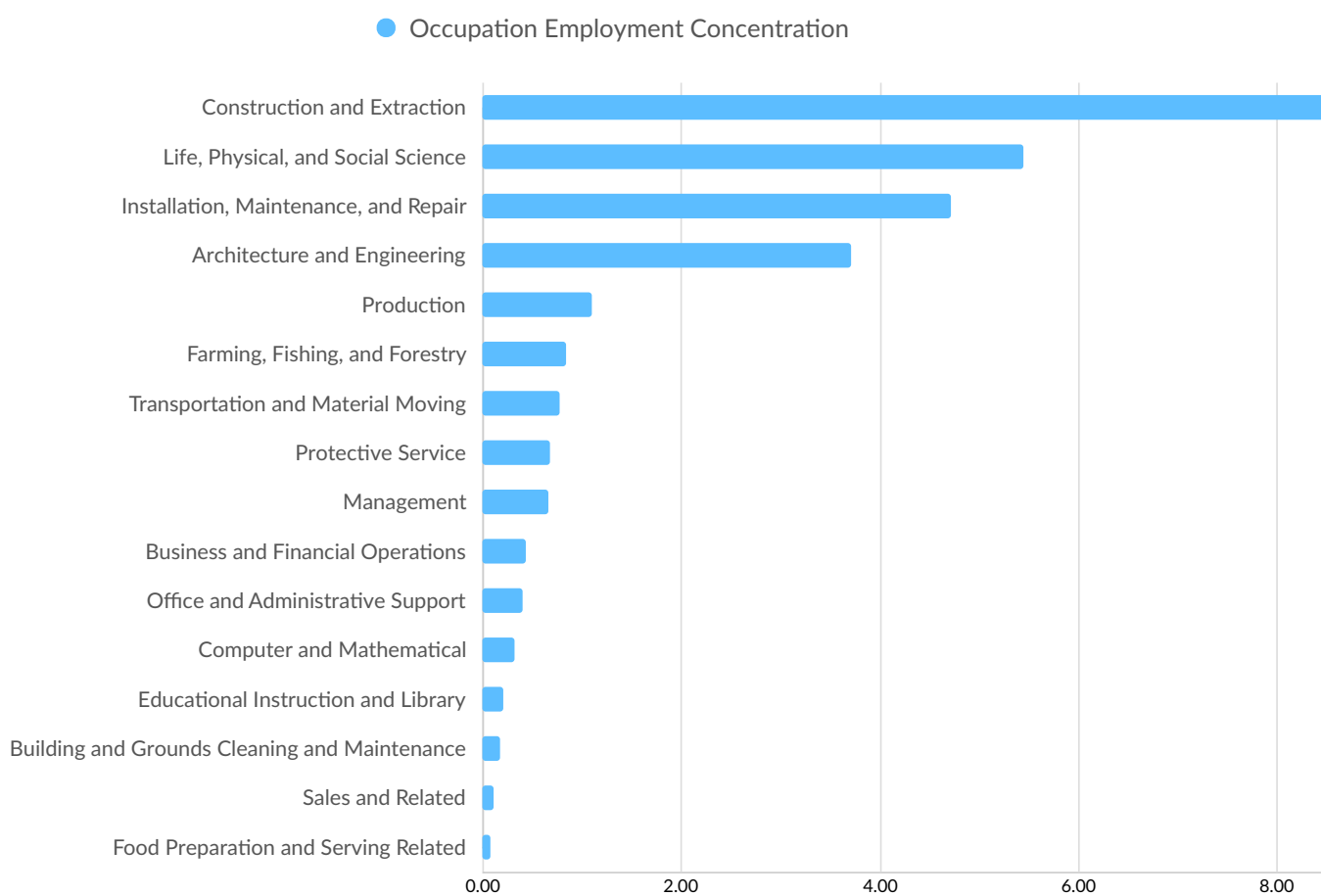
Largest Occupations



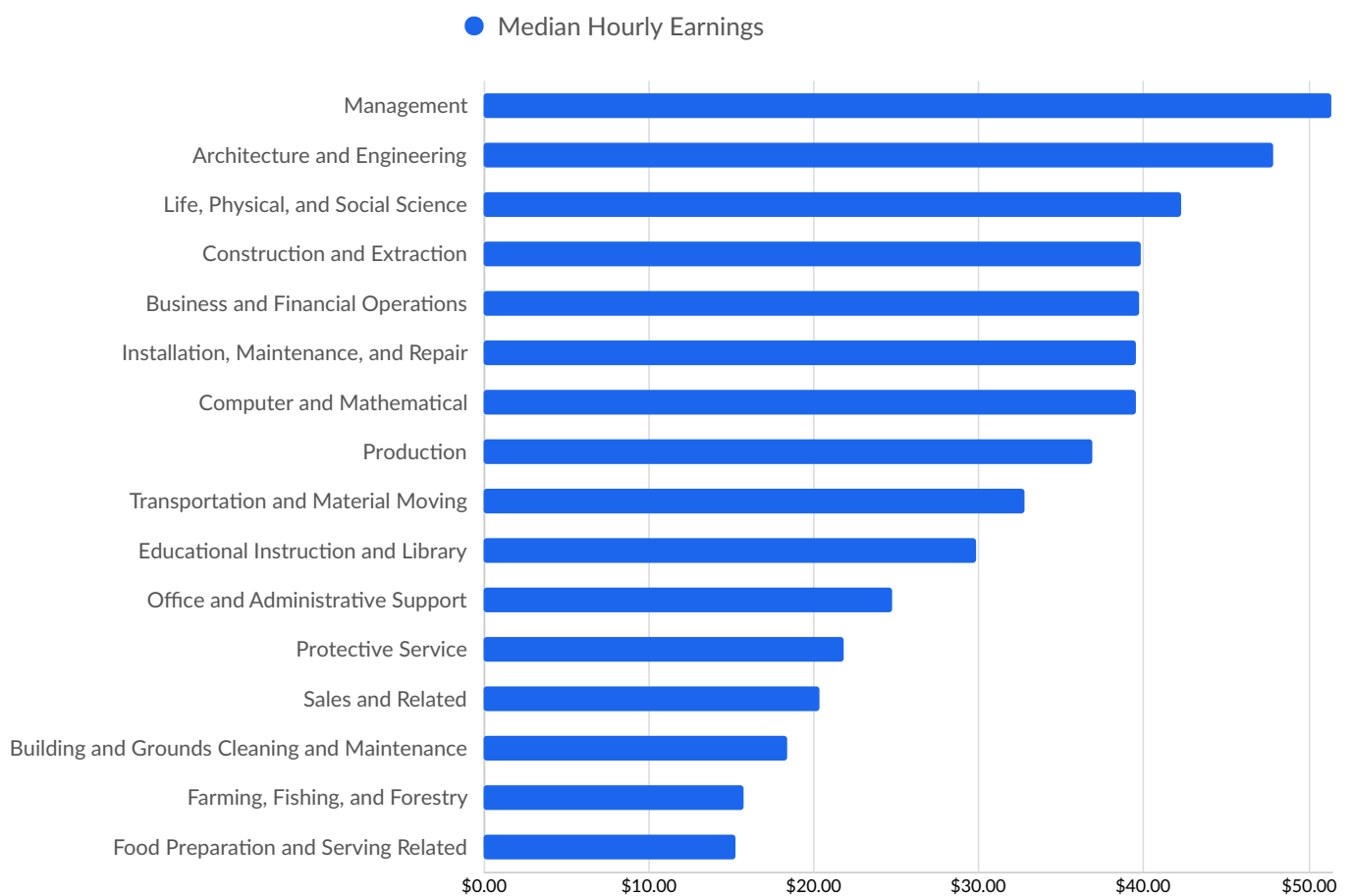
Top Growing Occupations



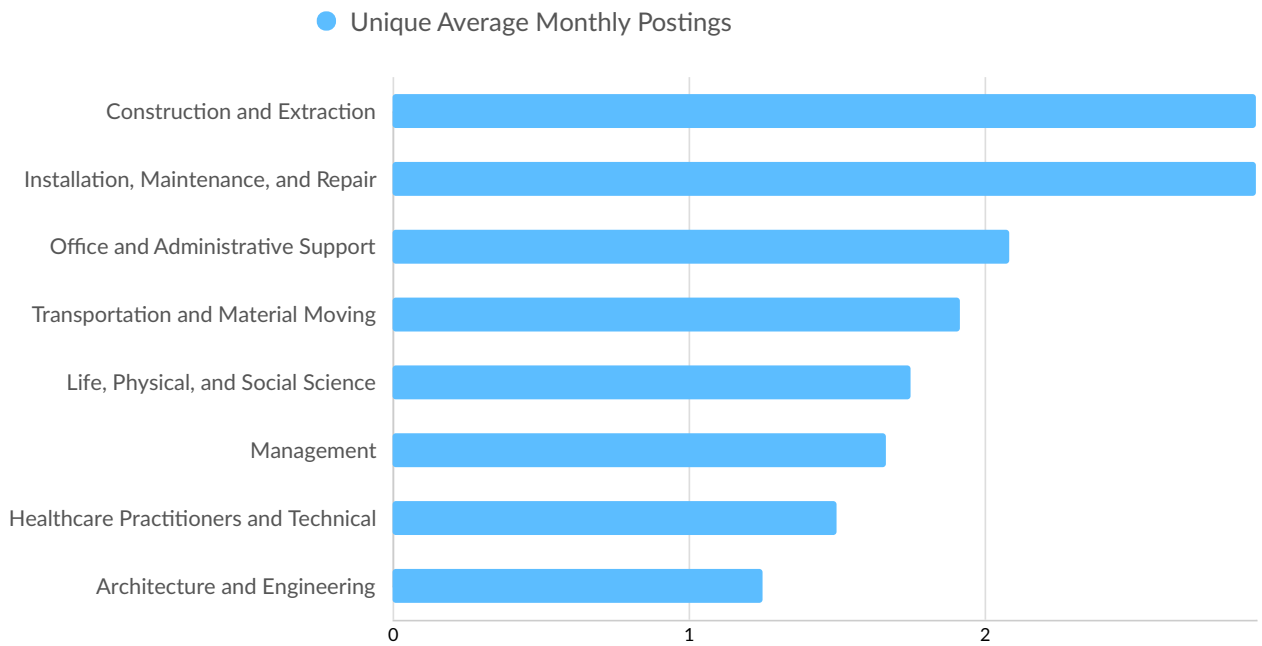
Top Occupation Employment Concentration



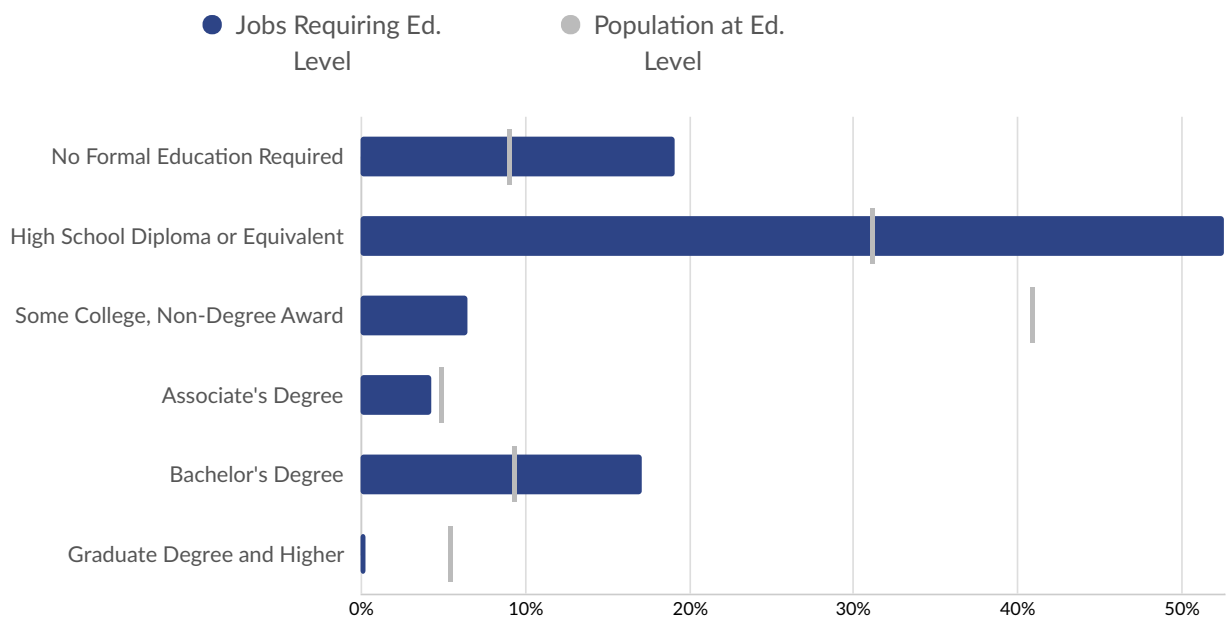
