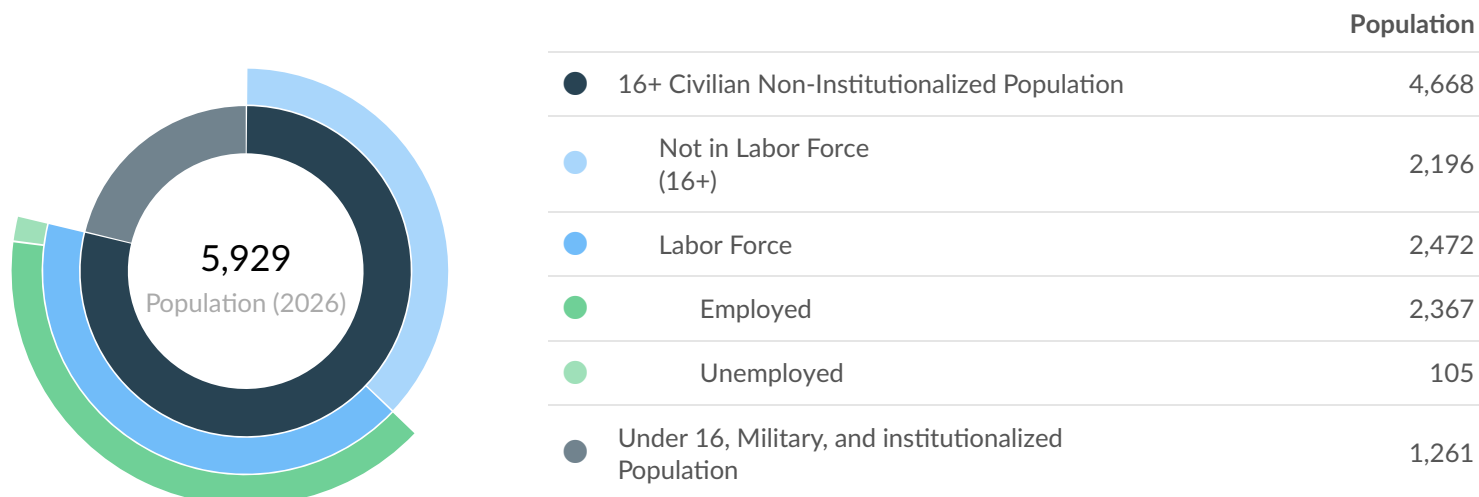
Median household income is **\$8.3K above** the national median household income of \$80.7K.

Takeaways

- As of 2025 the region's population **increased by 2.2%** since 2020, growing by 128. Population is expected to **increase by 5.0%** between 2025 and 2030, adding 296.
- From 2020 to 2025, jobs **increased by 11.8%** in Lander County, NV from 3,681 to 4,115. This change **outpaced the national growth rate of 10.7% by 1.1%**. As the number of jobs increased, the **labor force participation rate decreased from 57.6% to 55.2% between 2020 and 2025**.
- Concerning educational attainment, **7.7% of Lander County, NV residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (14.1% below the national average), and **16.2% hold an Associate's Degree** (7.3% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2025 are Metal Ore Mining, Education and Hospitals (Local Government), and Local Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals.

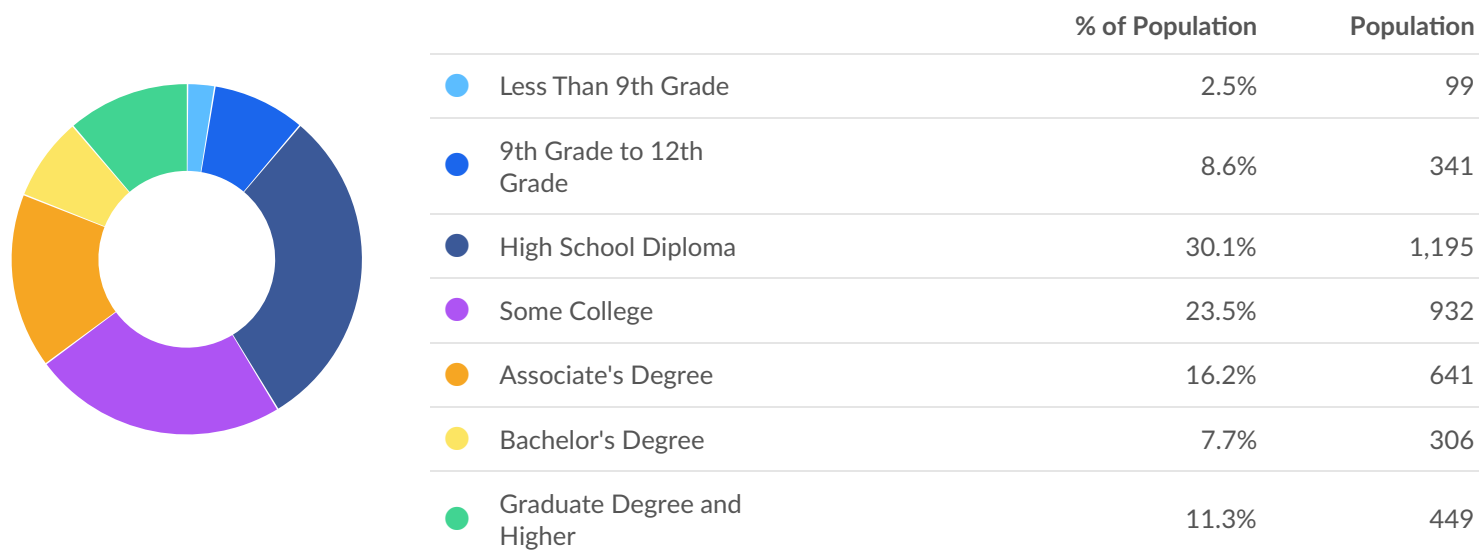

Jun 2026 Labor Force Breakdown



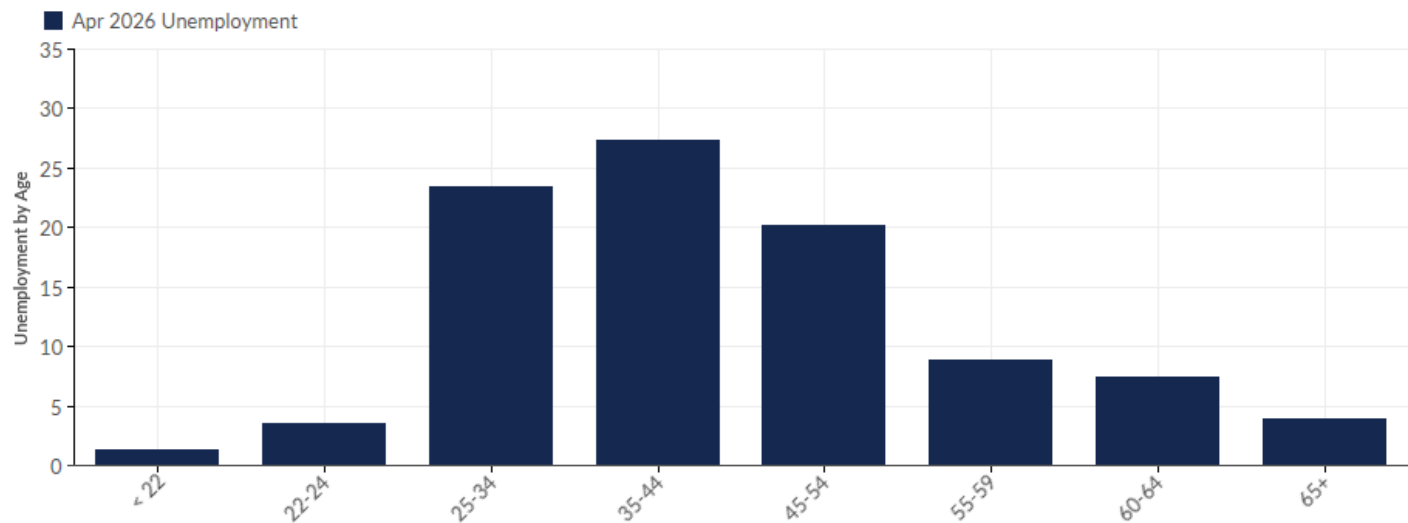
Educational Attainment

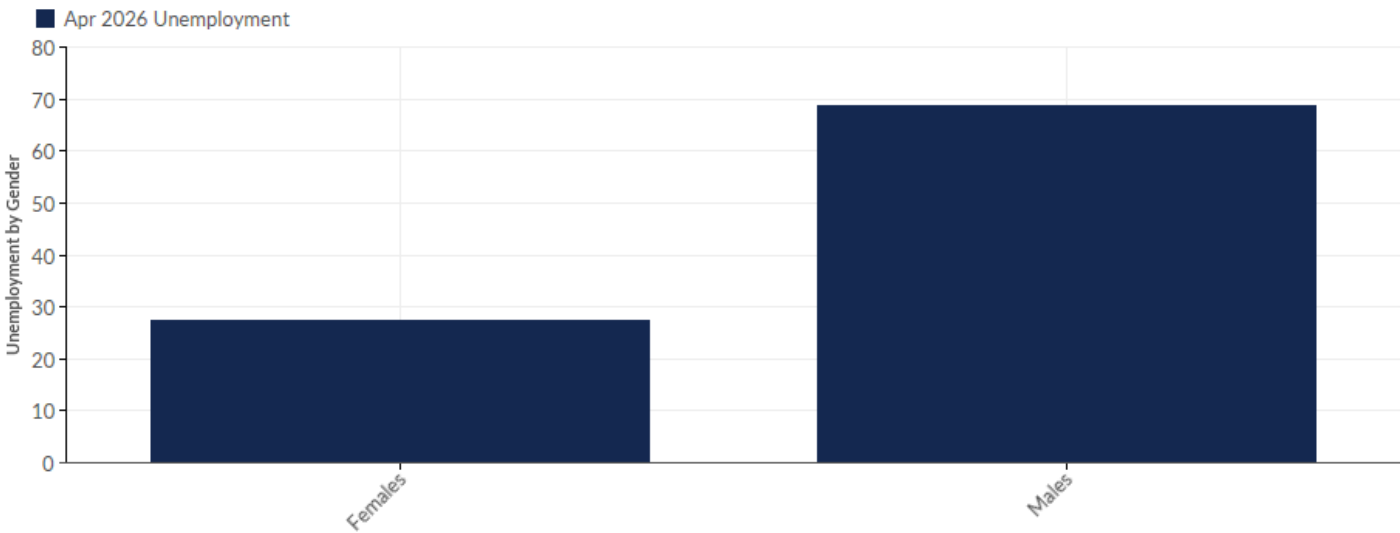

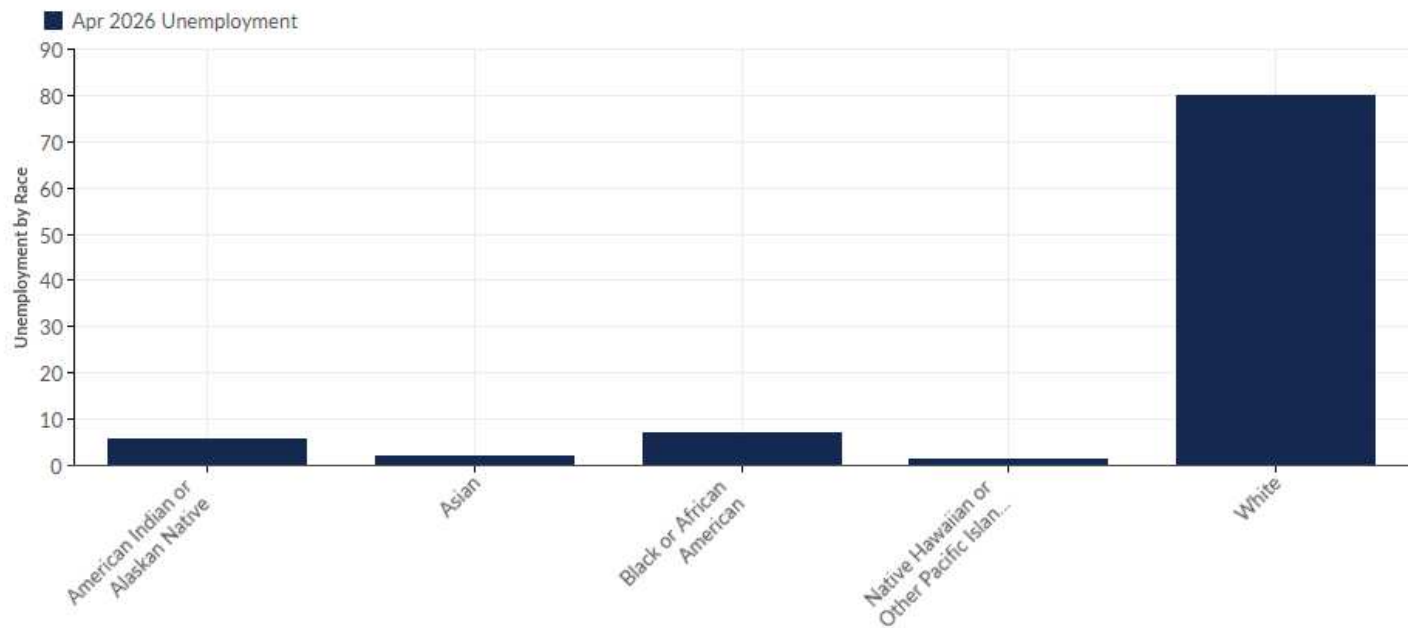

Unemployment by Gender



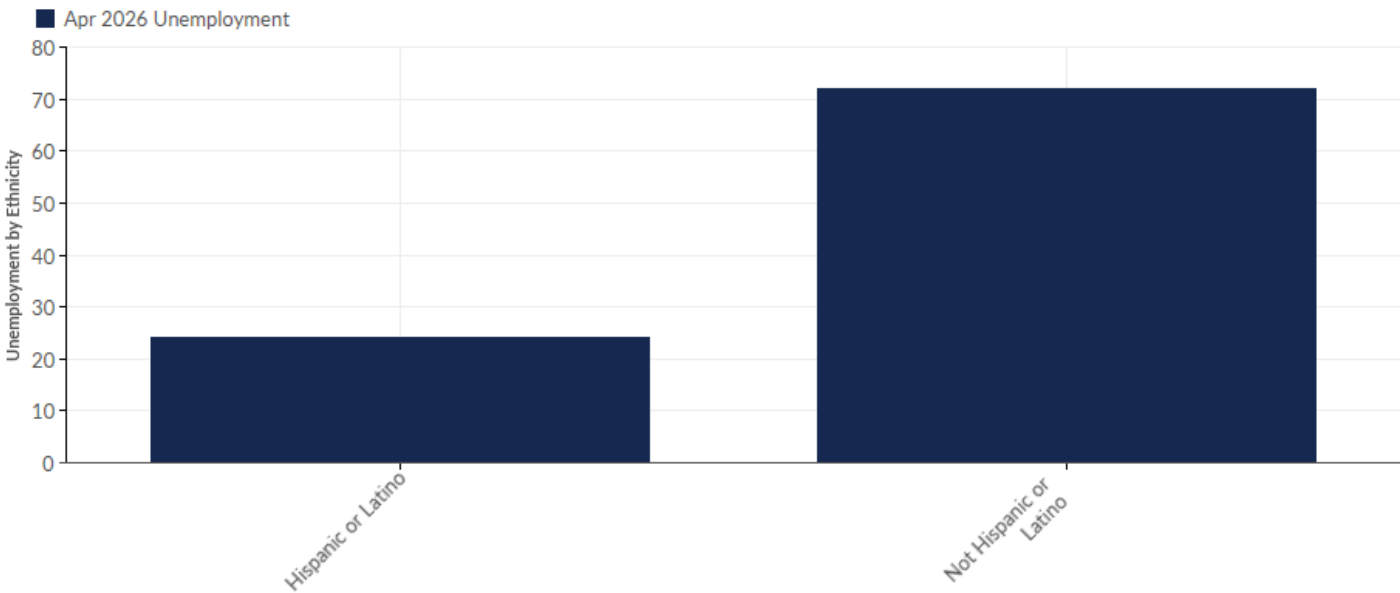

Unemployment by Ethnicity

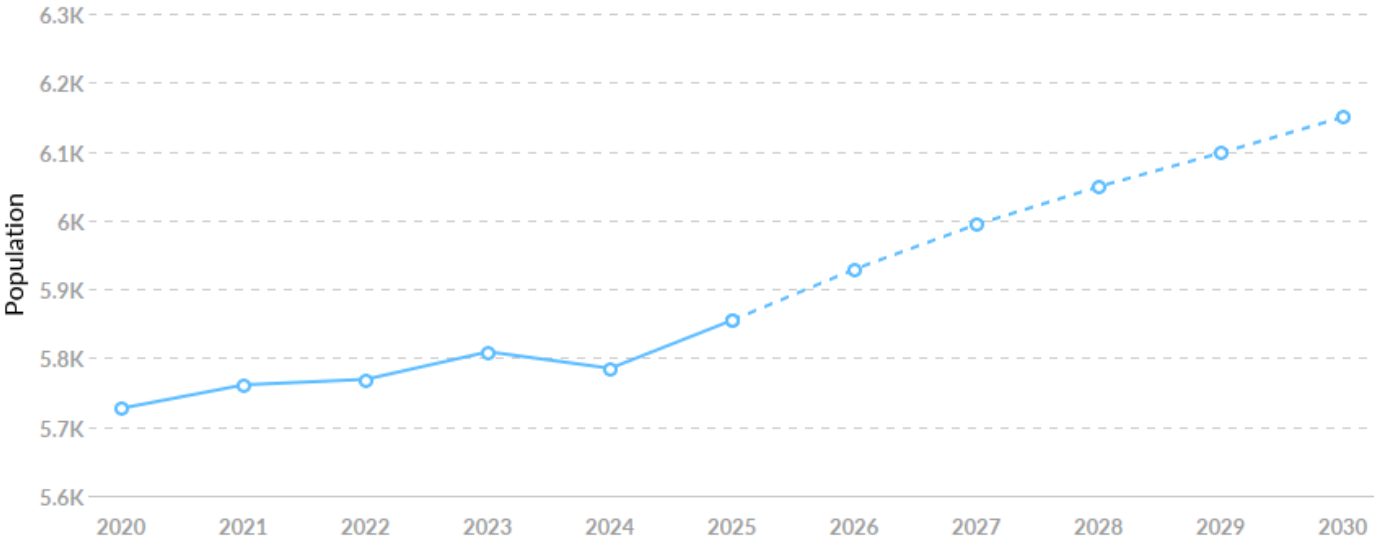

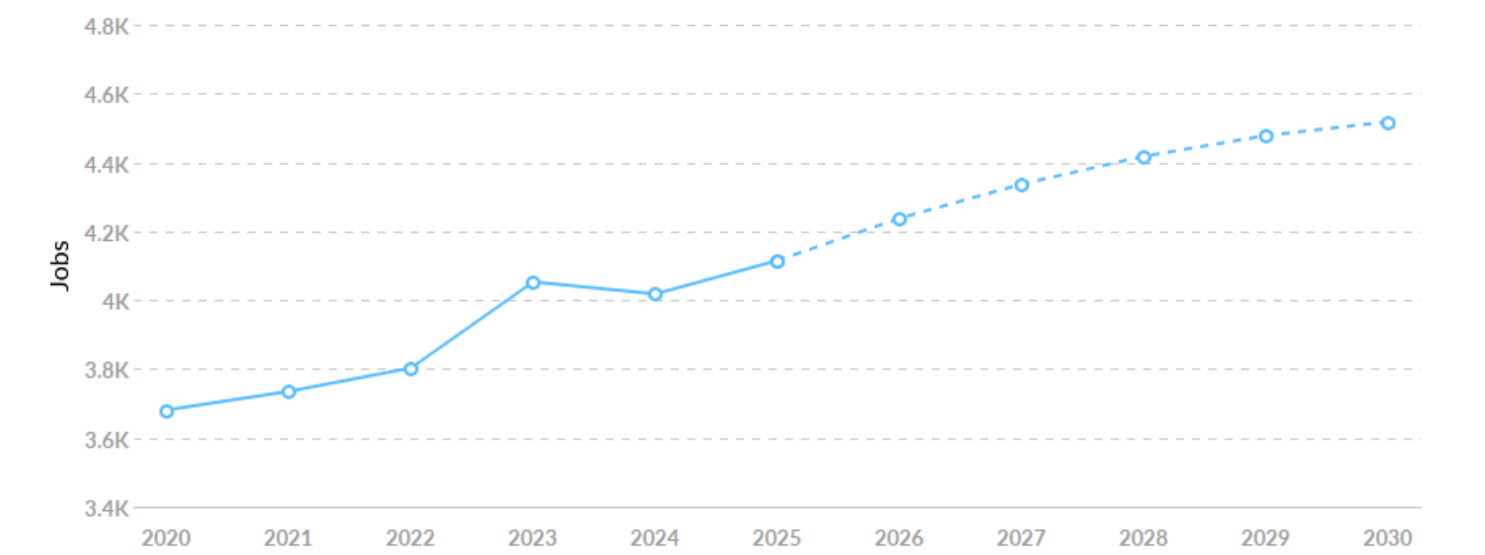

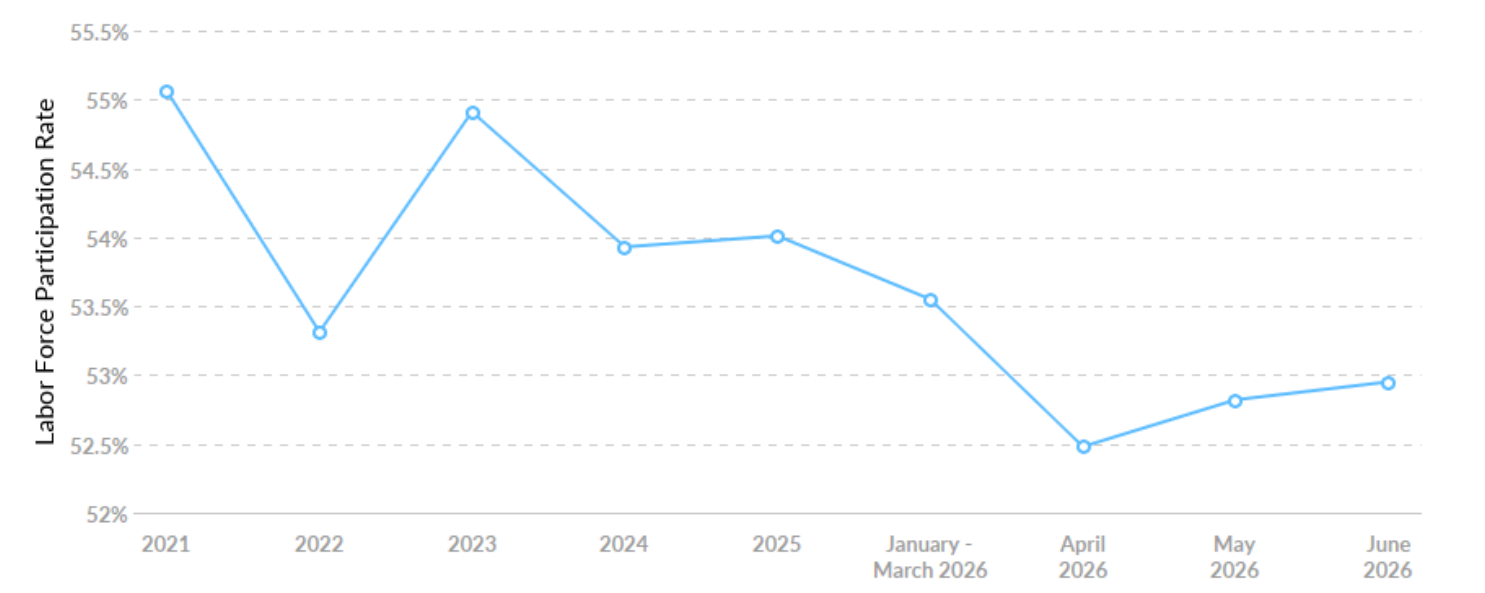
Job Trends

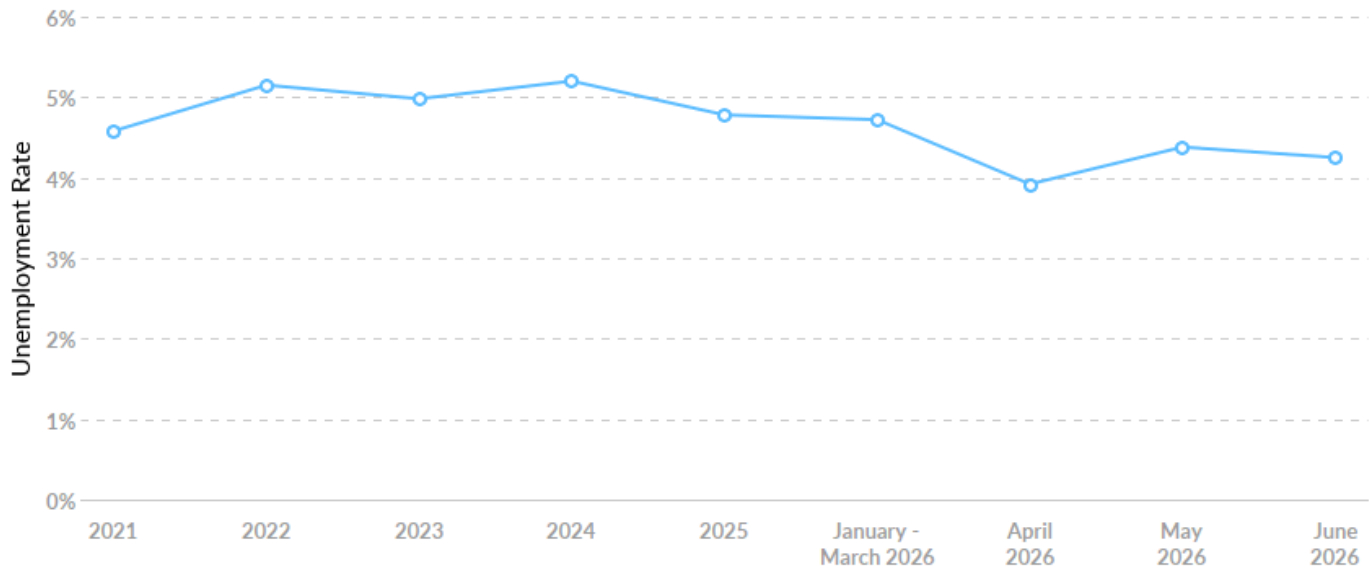

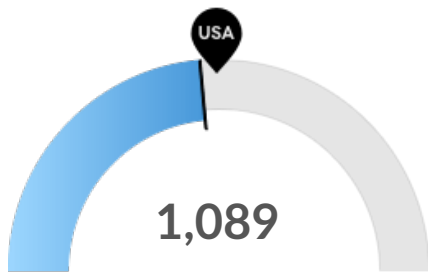
Unemployment Rate Trends

Lander County, NV had a June 2026 unemployment rate of 4.25%, **decreasing from 4.58%** 5 years before.



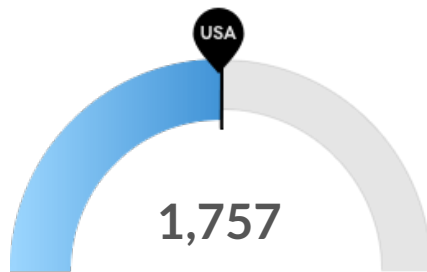

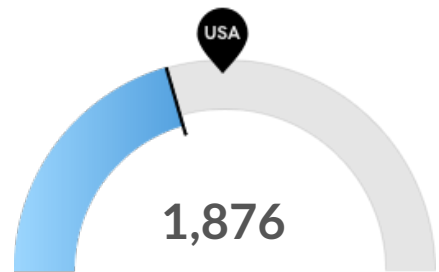
Millennials

Lander County, NV has 1,089 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 1,184.



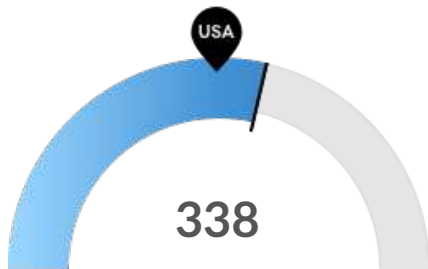
Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is about average in Lander County, NV. The national average for an area this size is 1,749 people 55 or older, while there are 1,757 here.



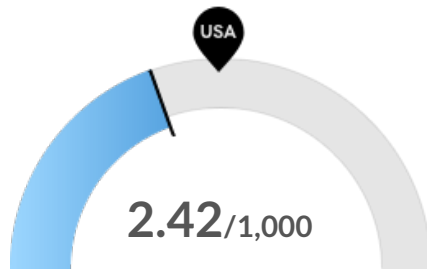
Racial Diversity

Racial diversity is low in Lander County, NV. The national average for an area this size is 2,461 racially diverse people, while there are 1,876 here.



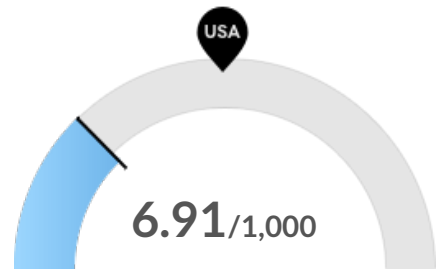
Veterans

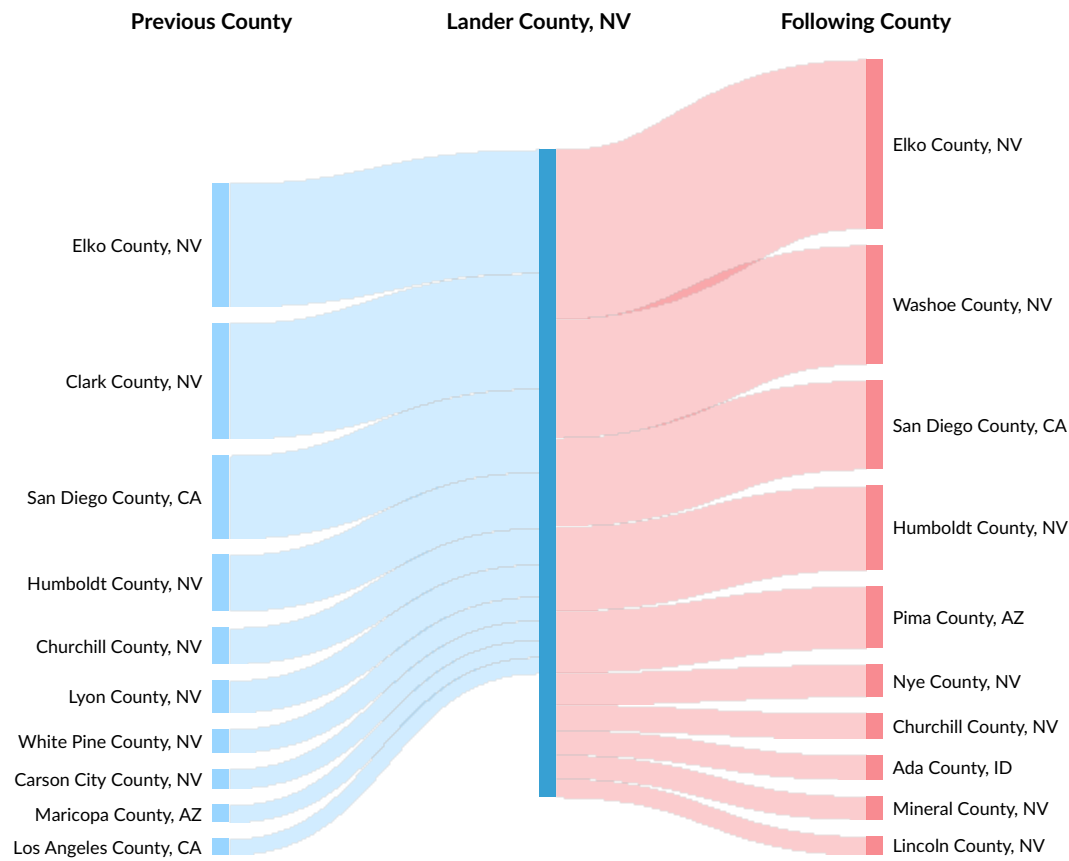

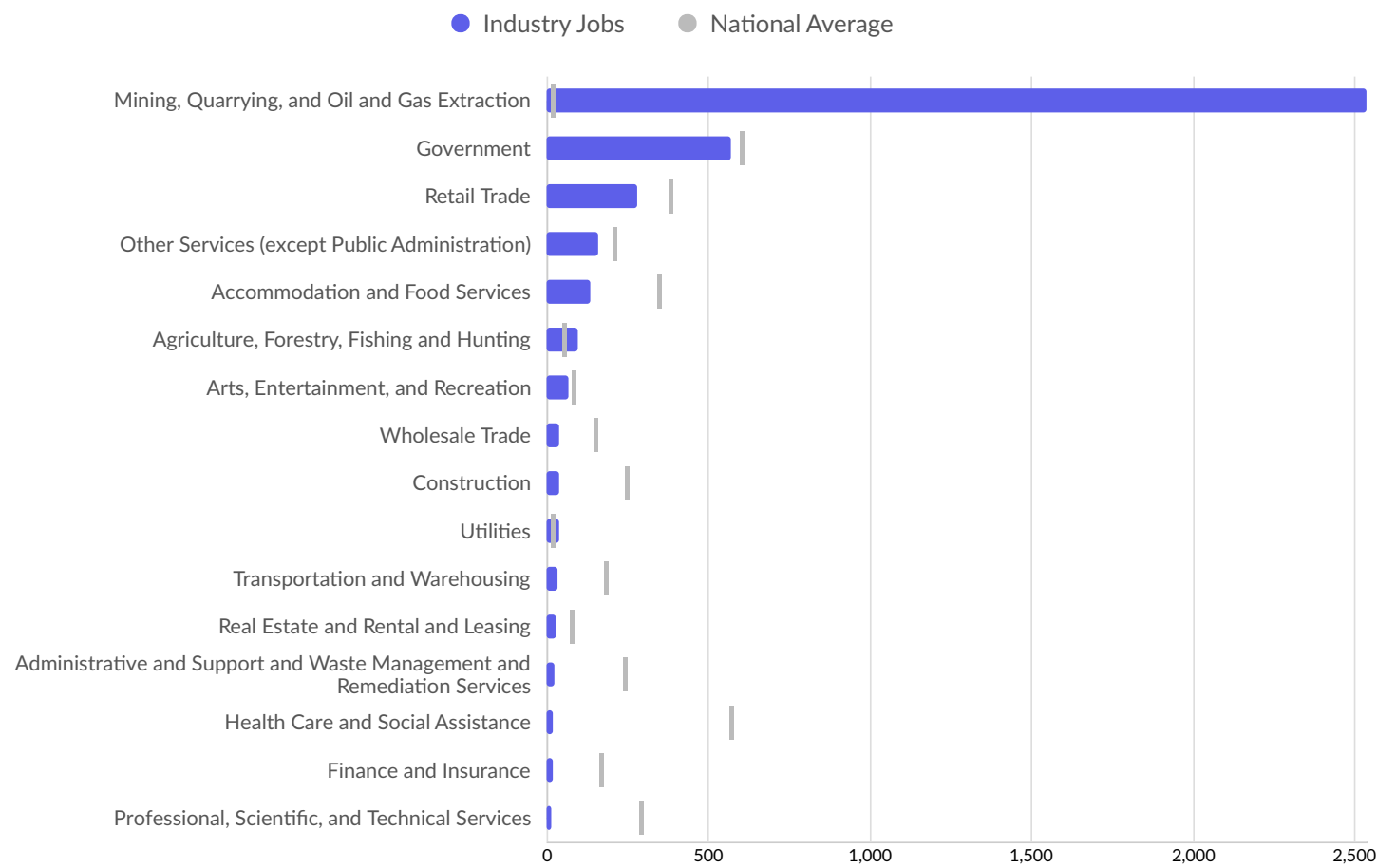

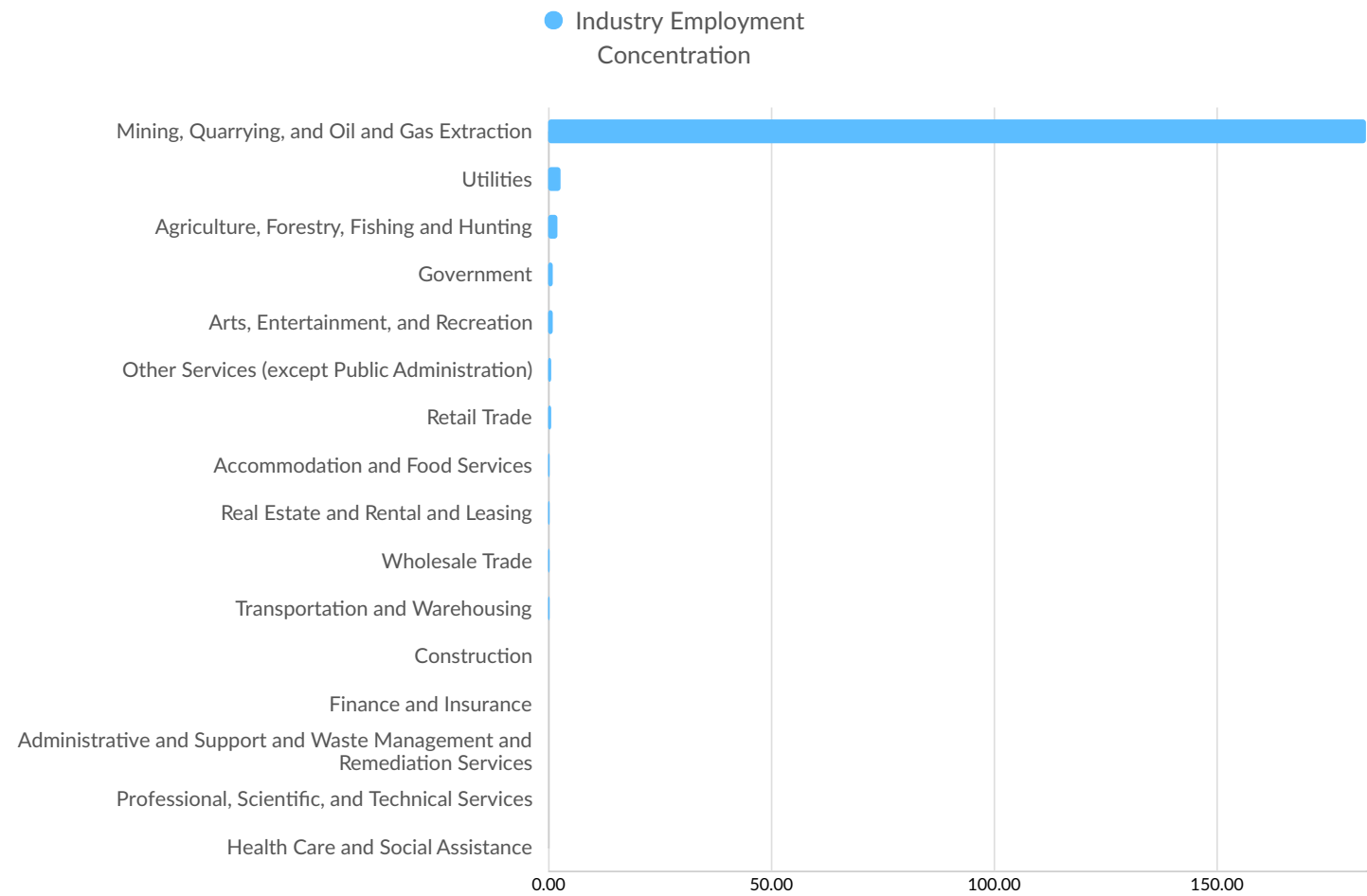

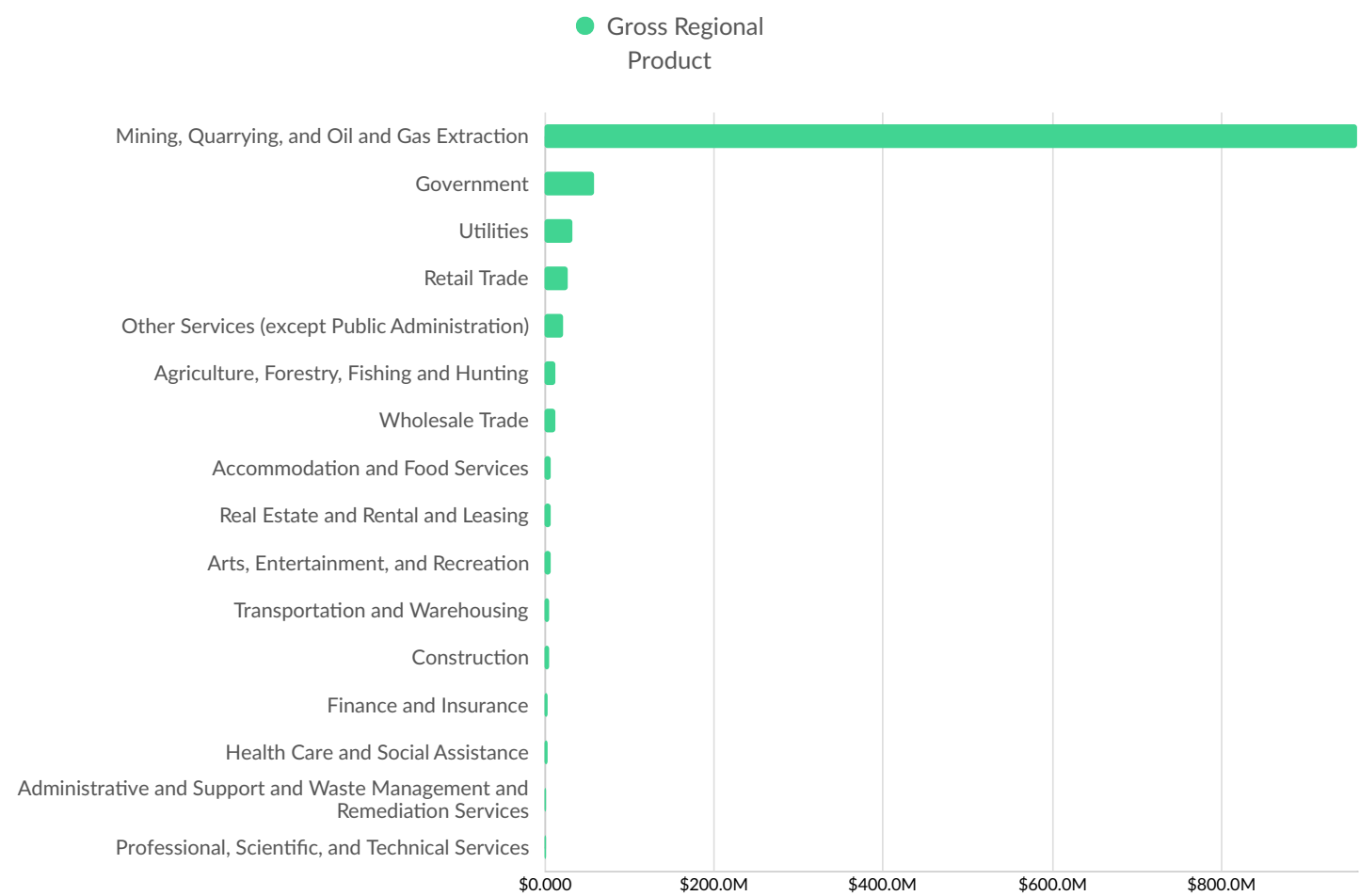
Top Growing Industries



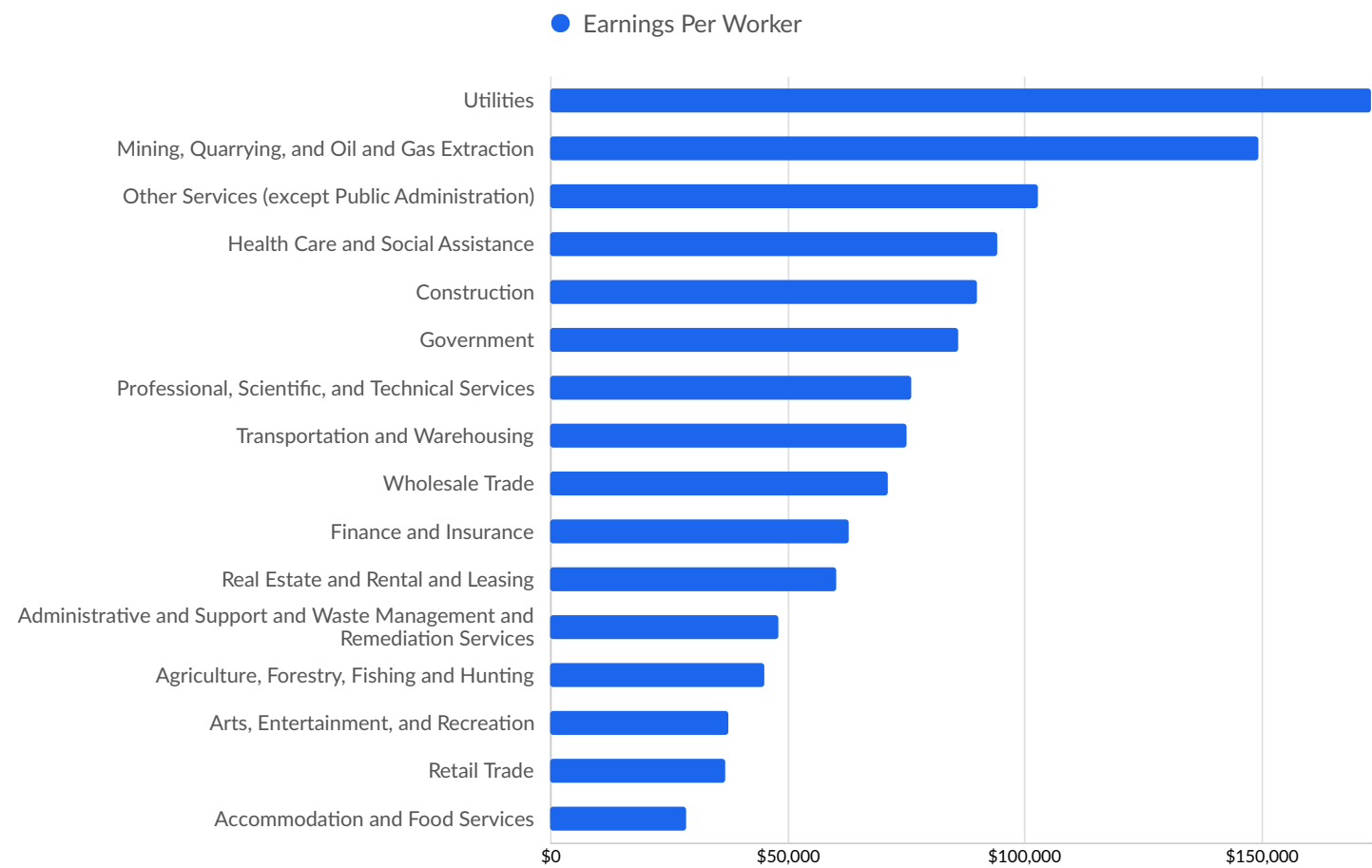
Top Industry Employment Concentration

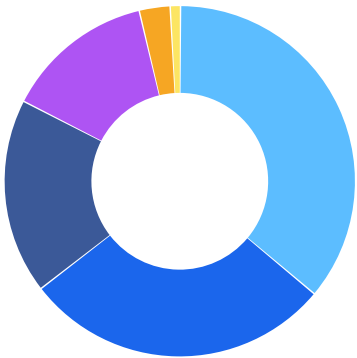

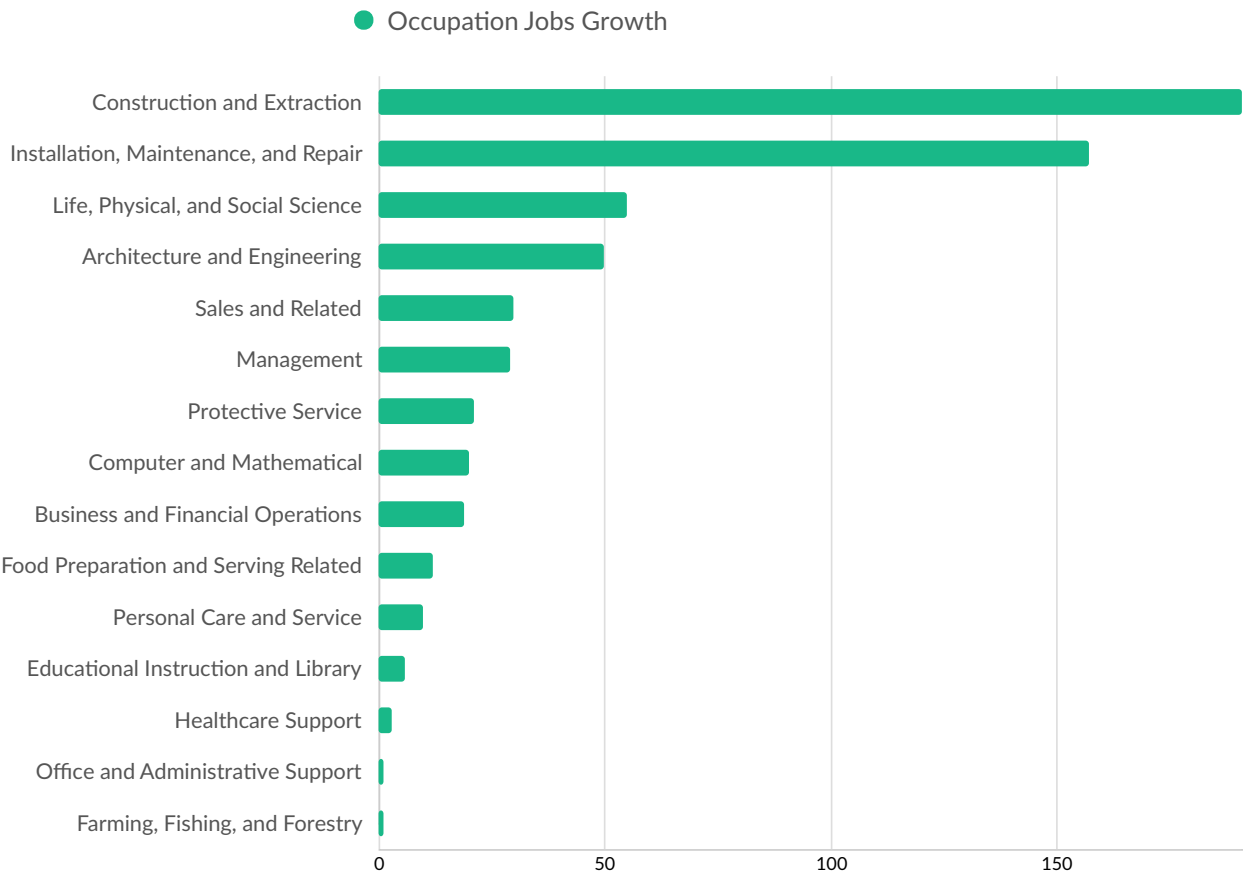

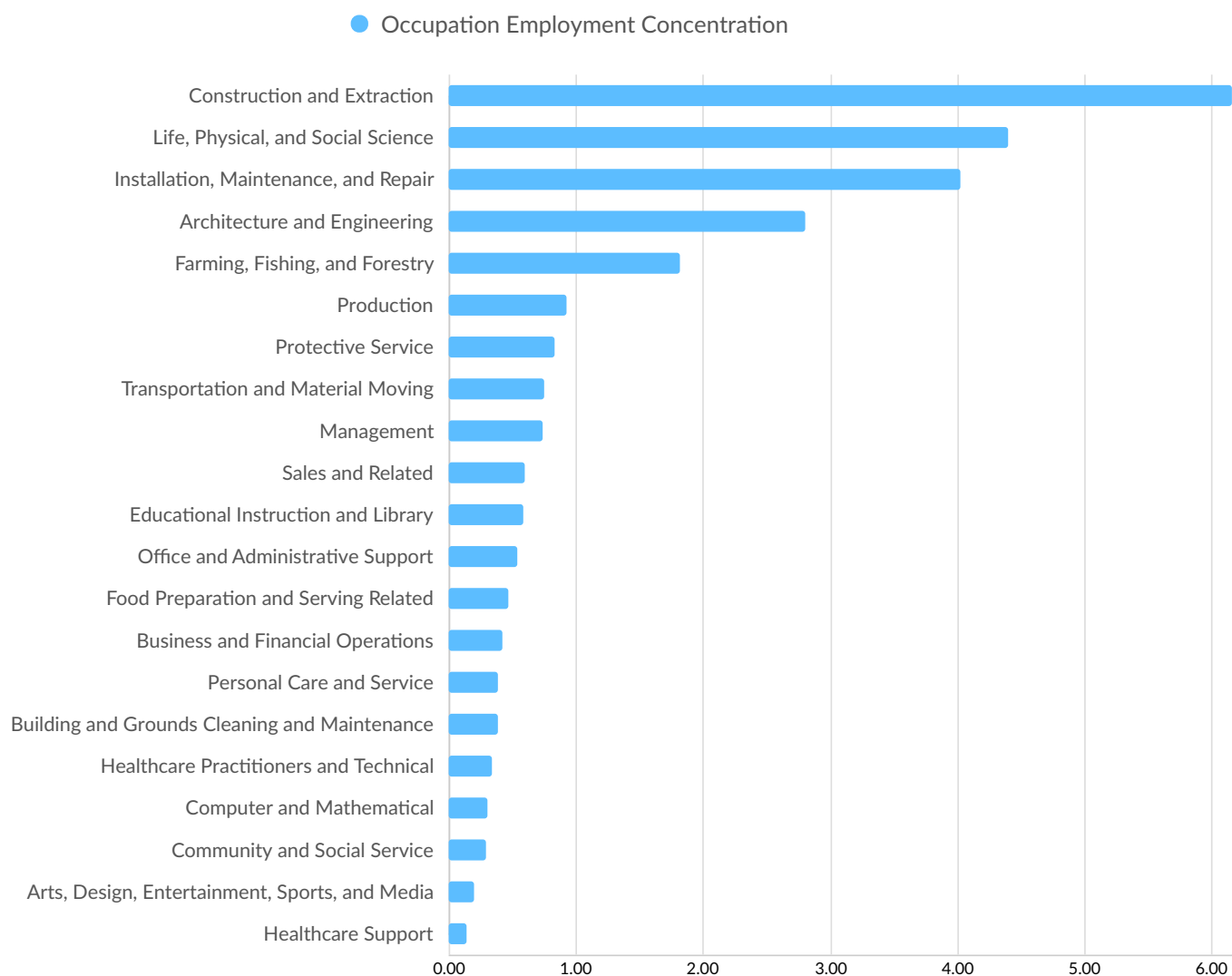
Largest Occupations



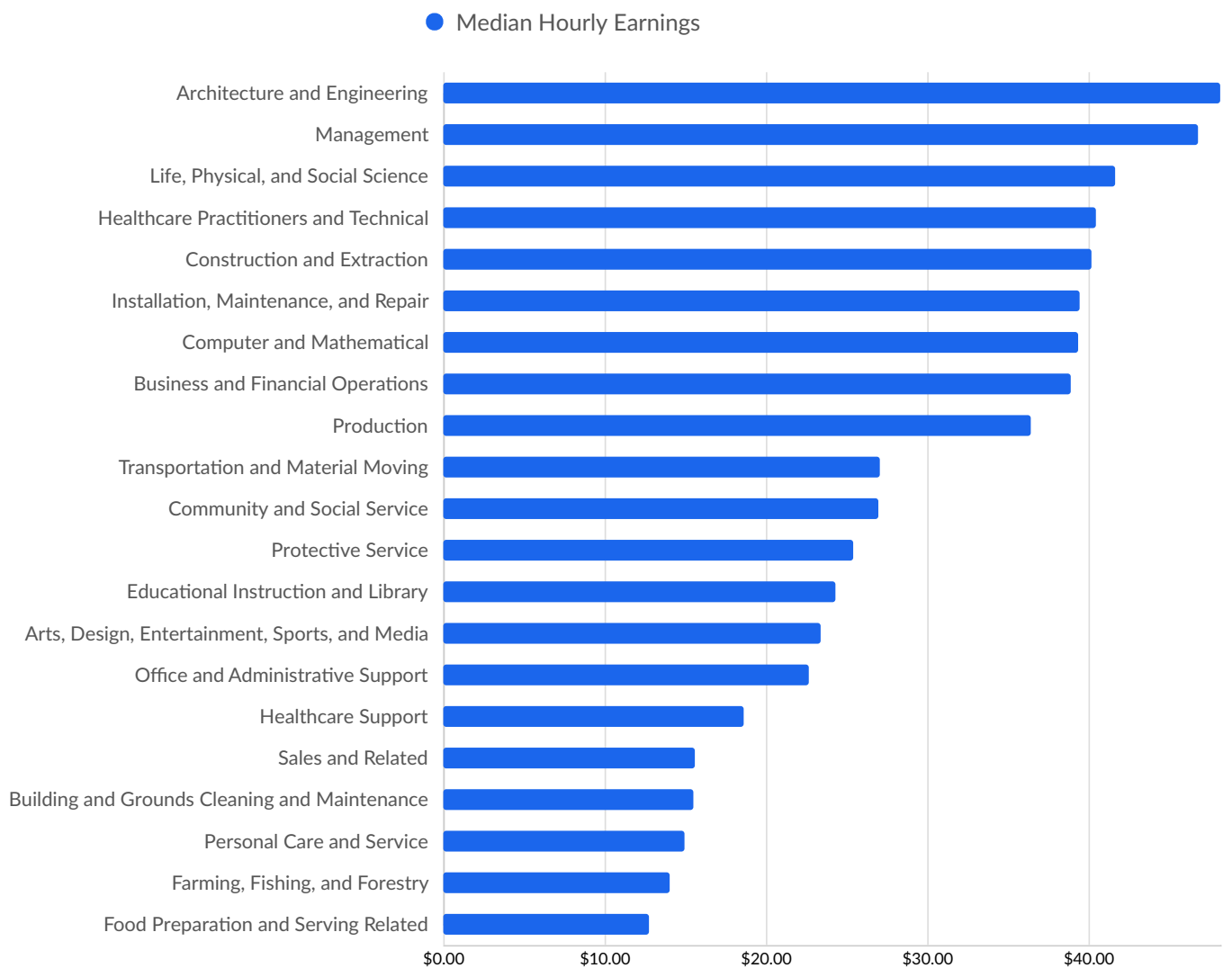
Top Growing Occupations



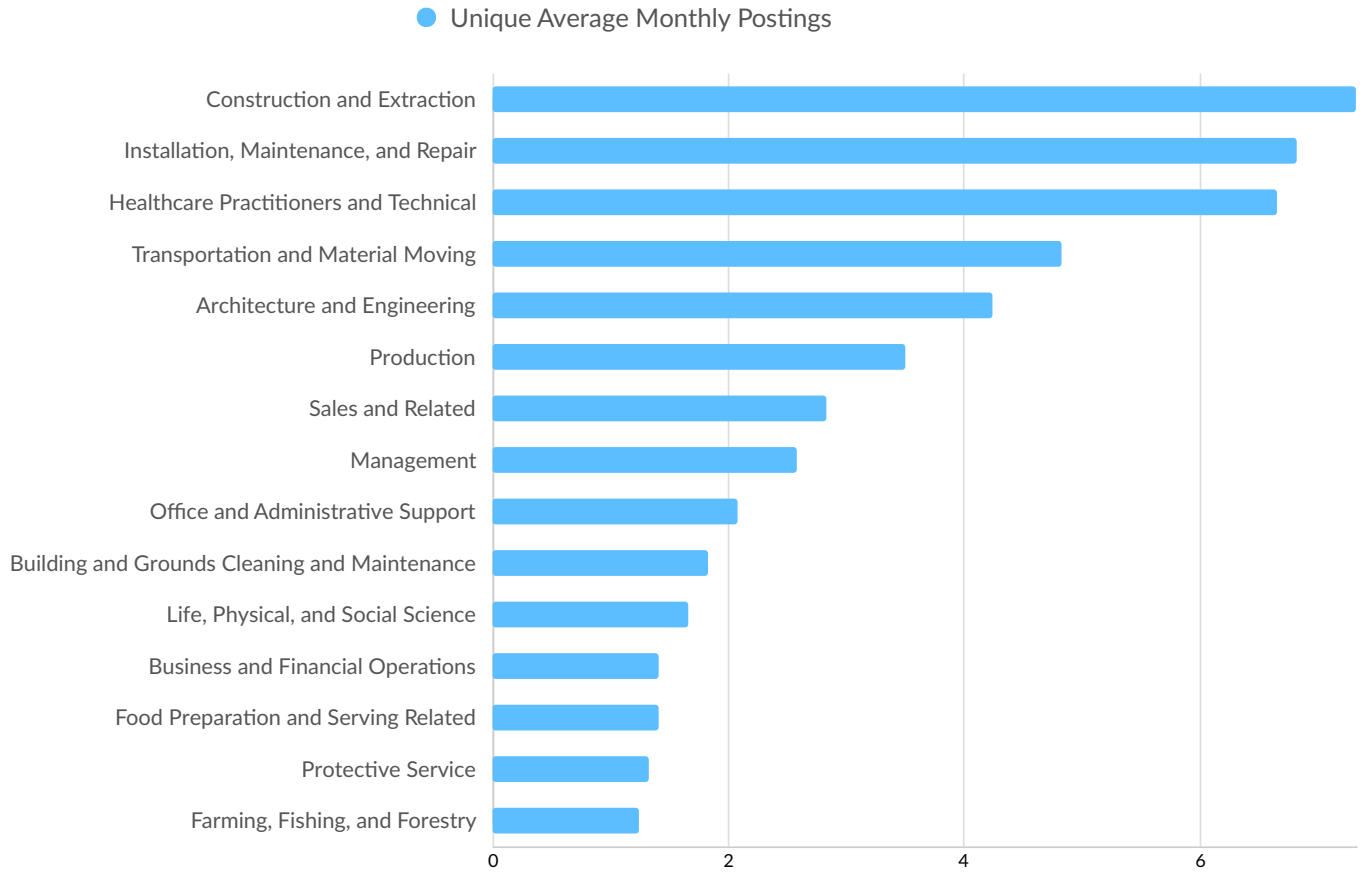
Top Occupation Employment Concentration



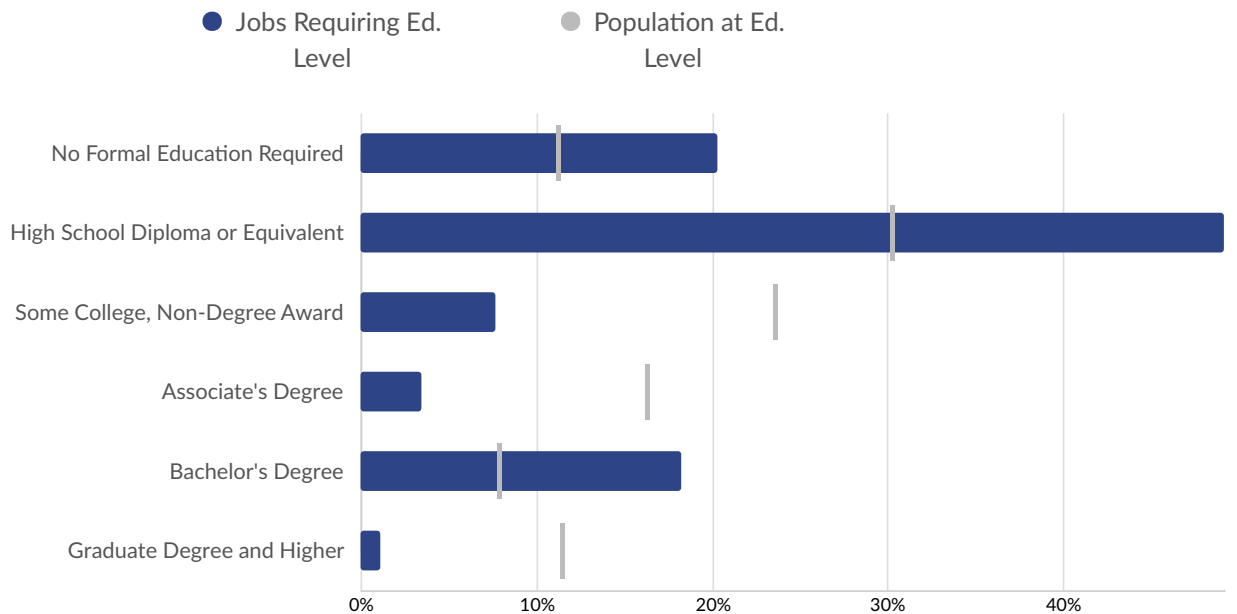
Top Occupation Earnings
