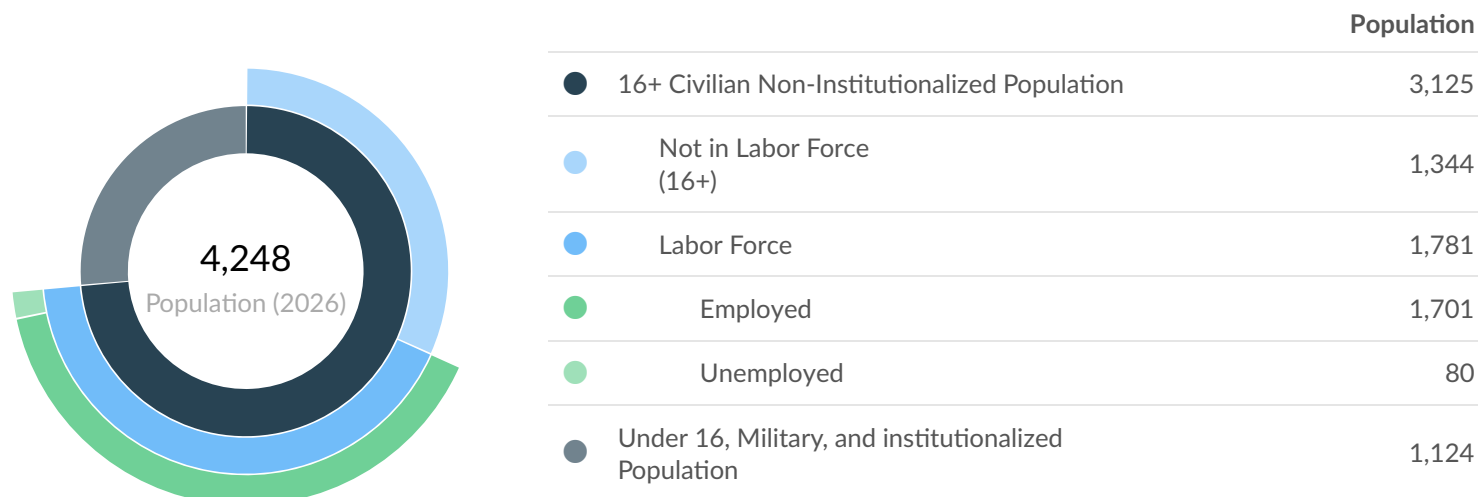
Median household income is **\$8.4K below** the national median household income of \$80.7K.

- As of 2025 the region's population **declined by 3.1%** since 2020, falling by 139. Population is expected to **decrease by 6.0%** between 2025 and 2030, losing 257.
- From 2020 to 2025, jobs **increased by 7.5%** in Lincoln County, NV from 1,500 to **1,613**. This change **fell short of the national growth rate of 10.7% by 3.2%**. As the number of jobs increased, the **labor force participation rate decreased from 57.9% to 57.0% between 2020 and 2025**.
- Concerning educational attainment, **13.1% of Lincoln County, NV residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (8.8% below the national average), and **7.1% hold an Associate's Degree** (1.7% below the national average).
- The top three industries in 2025 are Education and Hospitals (Local Government), Local Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals, and State Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals.

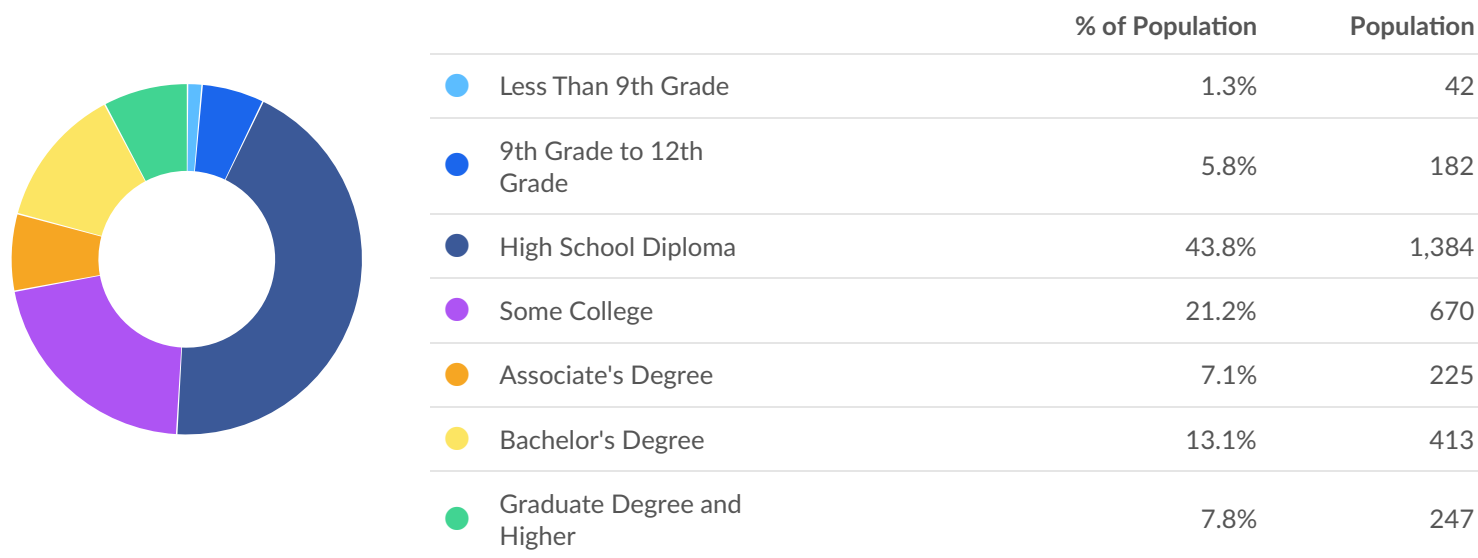

Jun 2026 Labor Force Breakdown



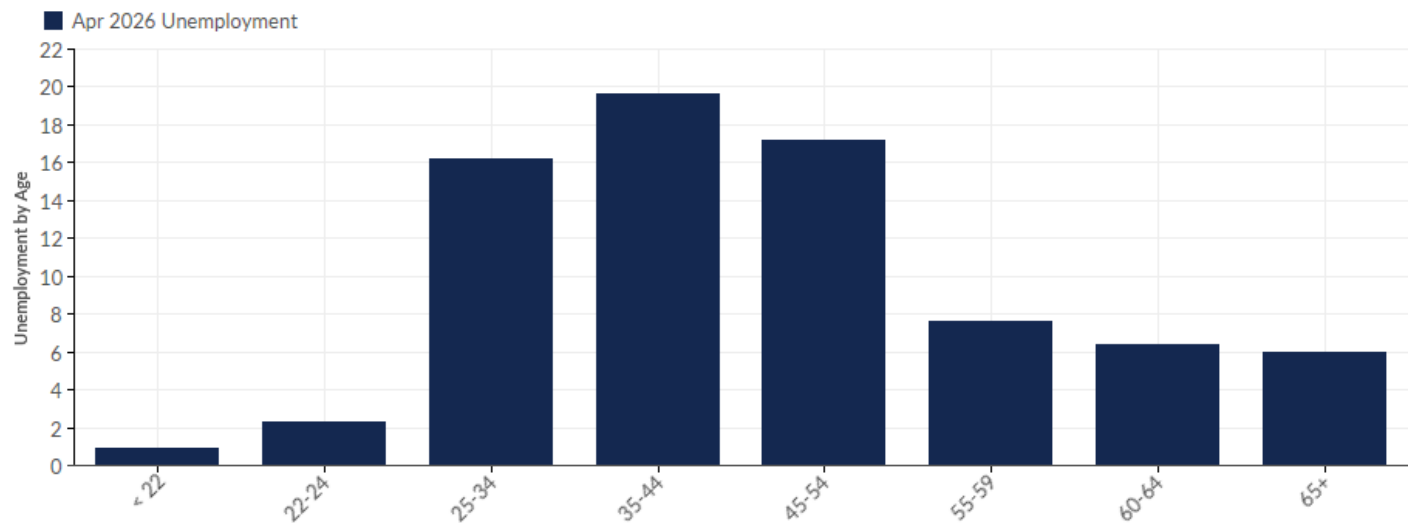
Educational Attainment

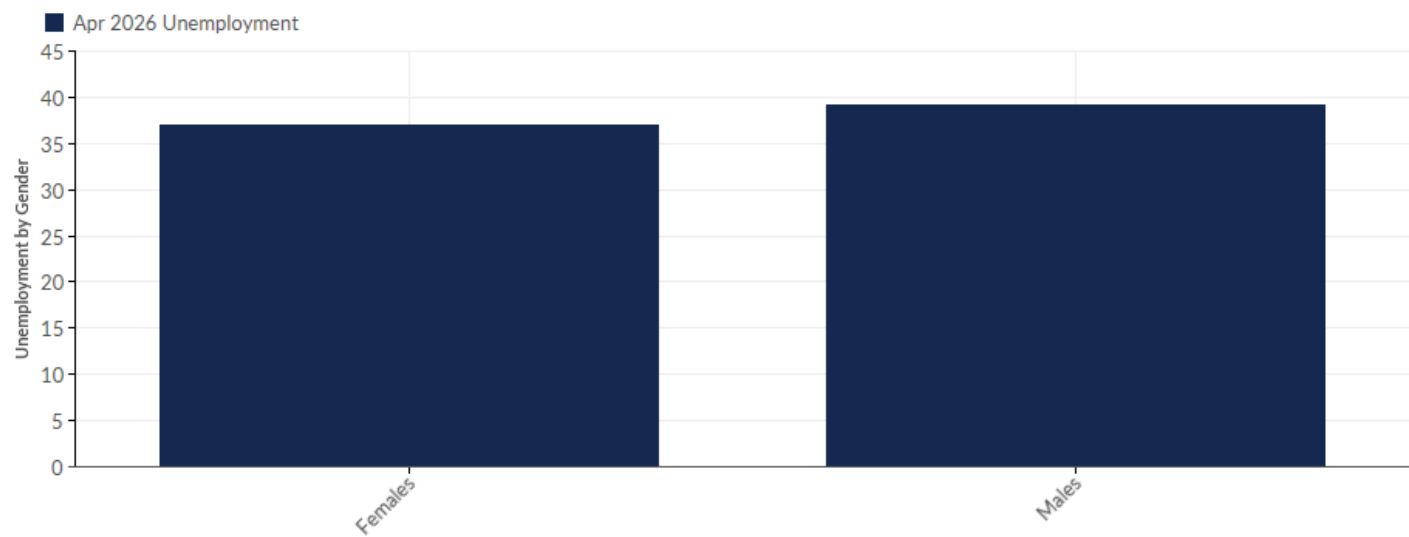
Unemployment by Demographics

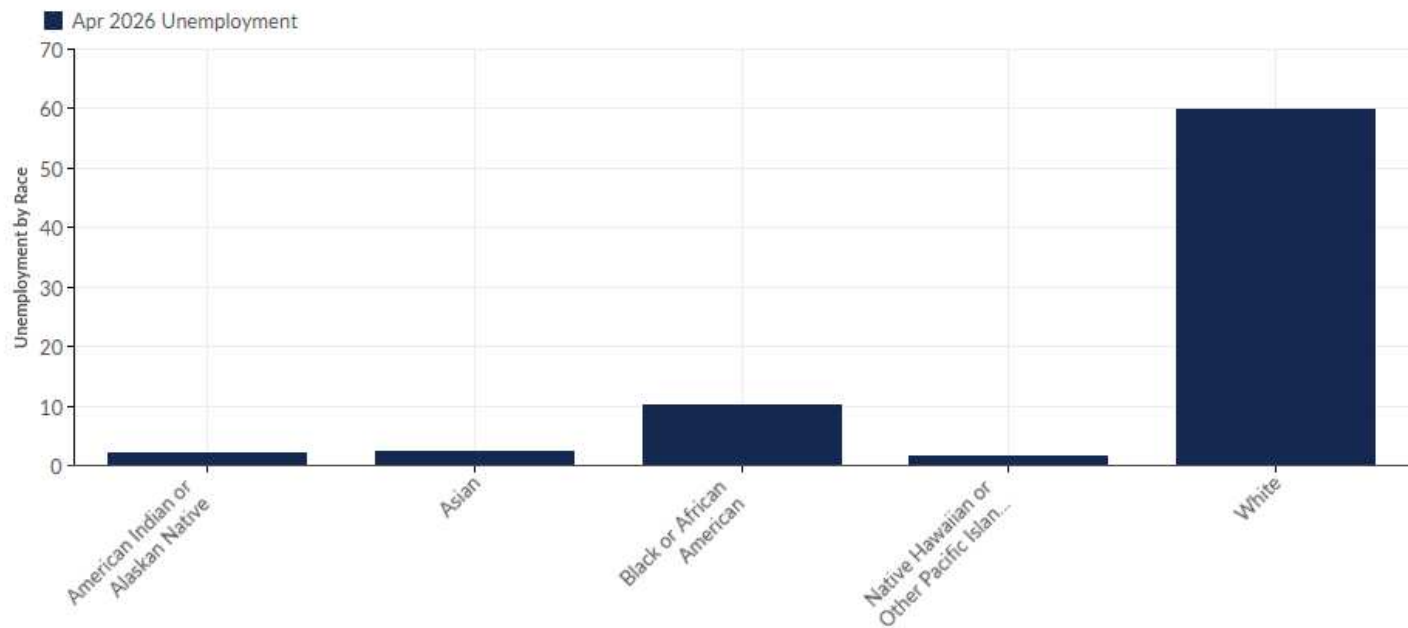

Unemployment by Gender



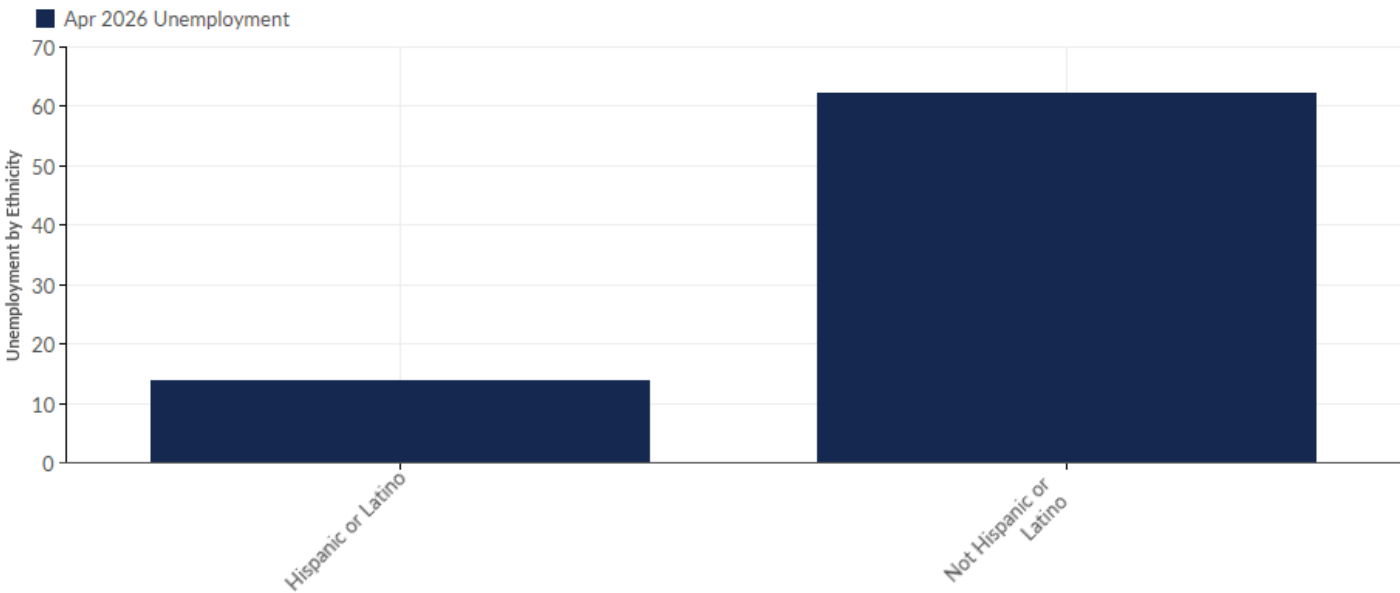

Unemployment by Ethnicity

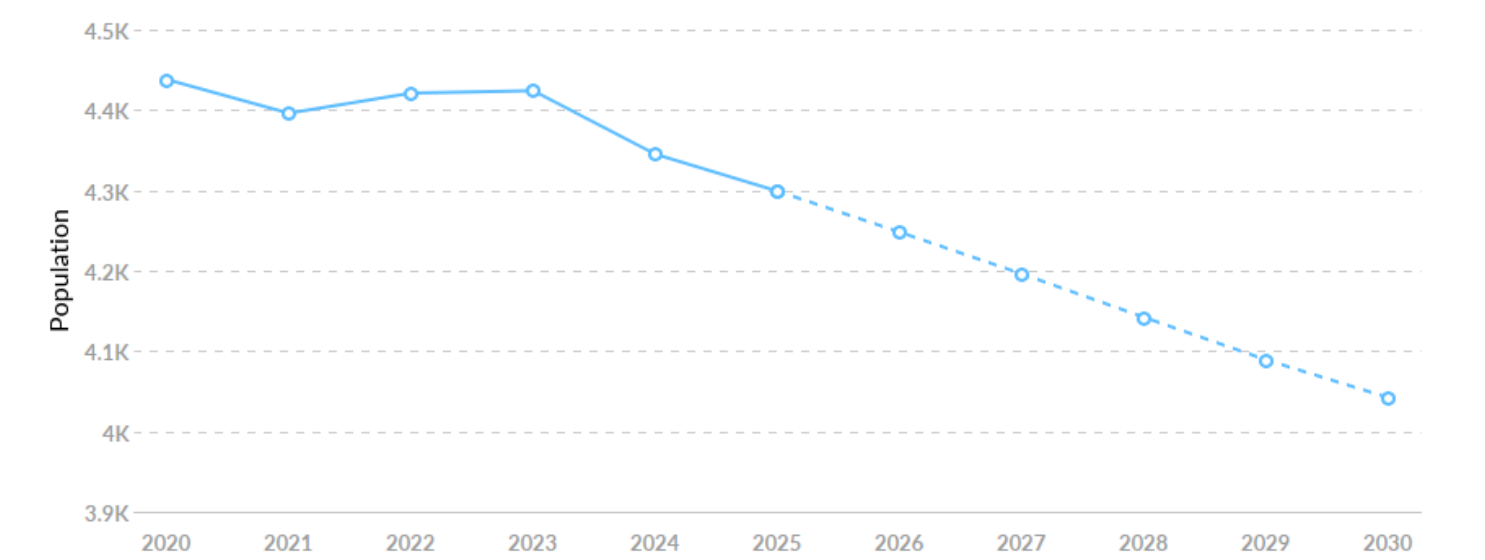

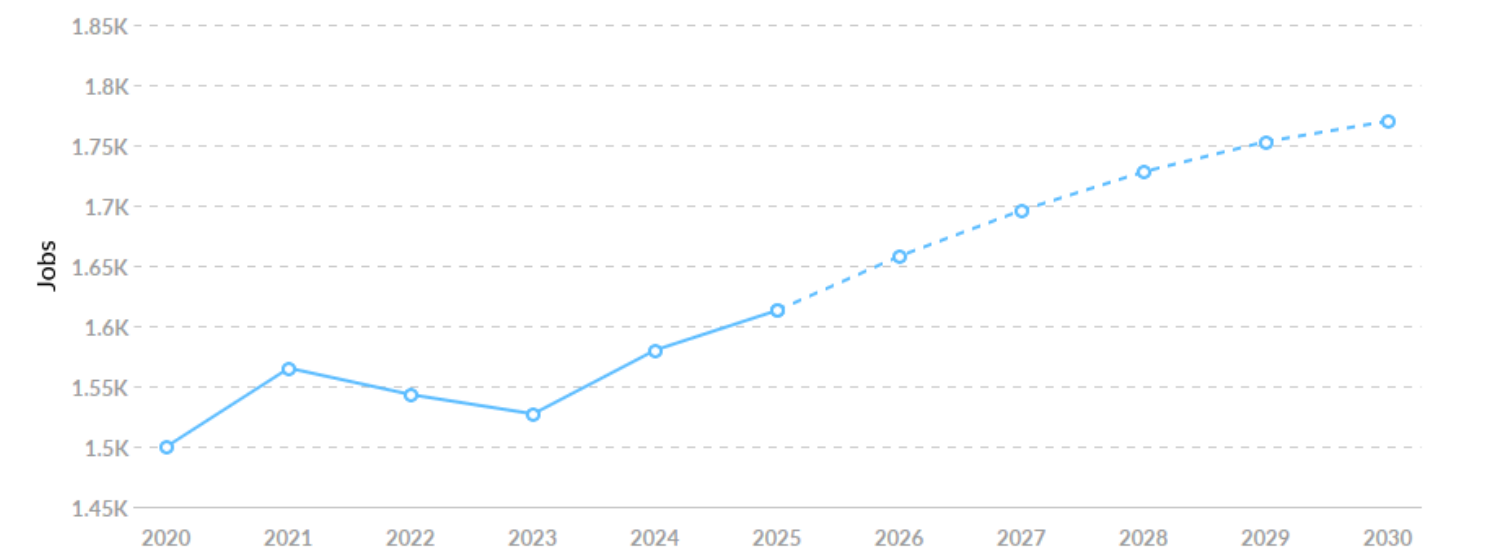

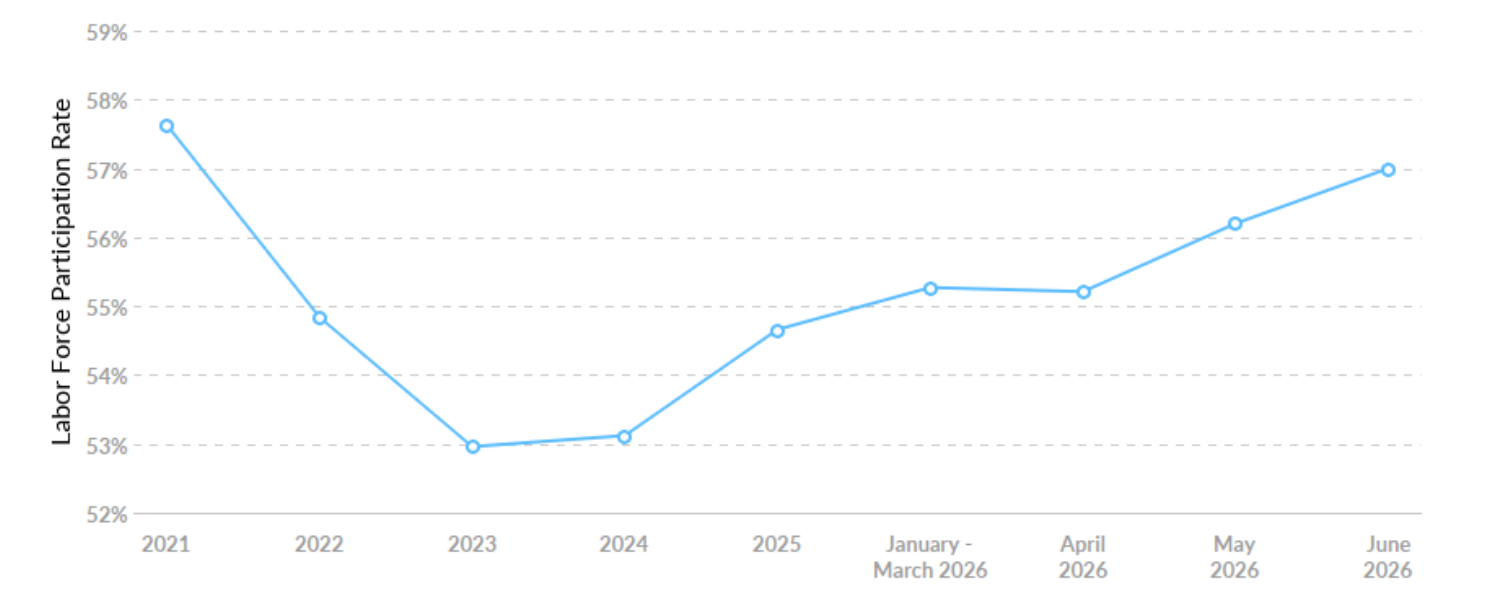
Job Trends

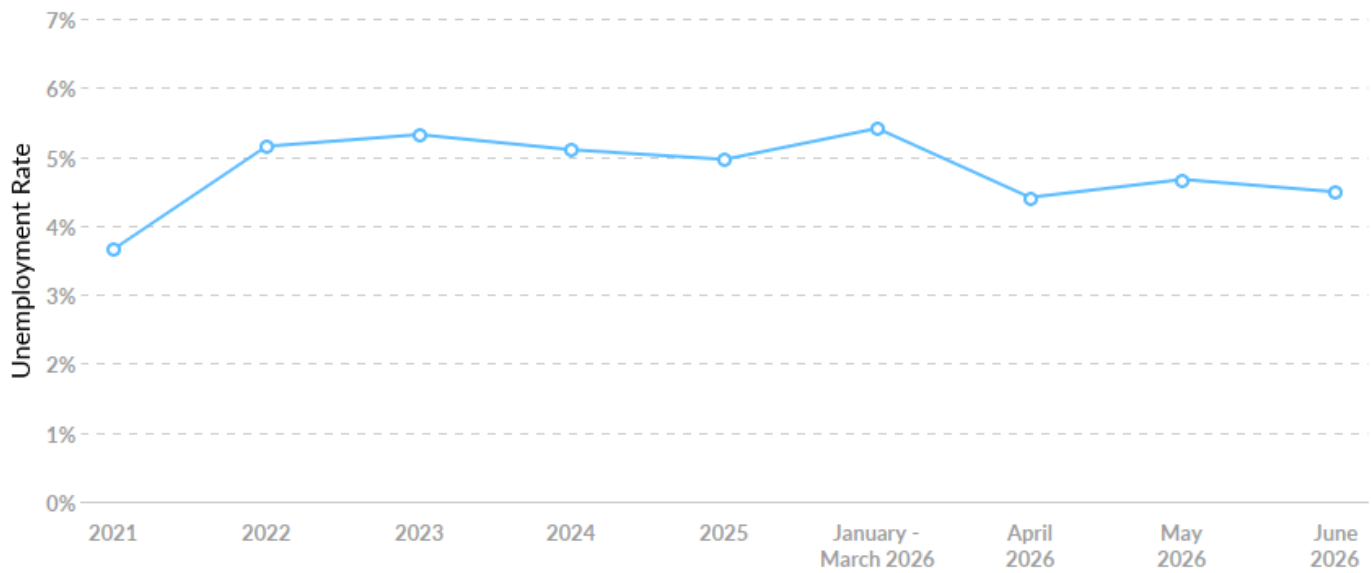

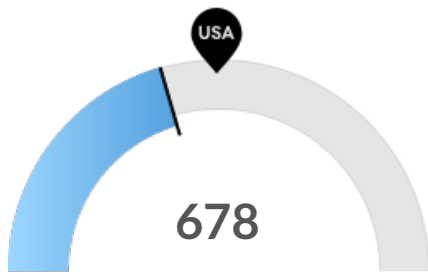
Unemployment Rate Trends

Lincoln County, NV had a June 2026 unemployment rate of 4.49%, **increasing from 3.66%** 5 years before.



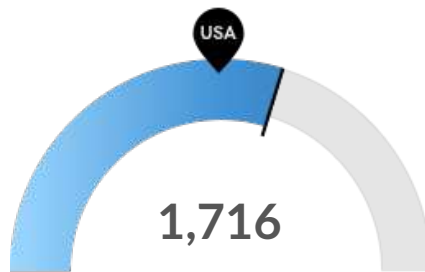

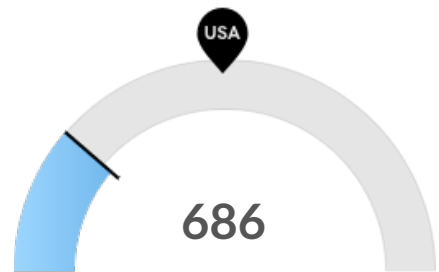
Millennials

Lincoln County, NV has 678 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 889.



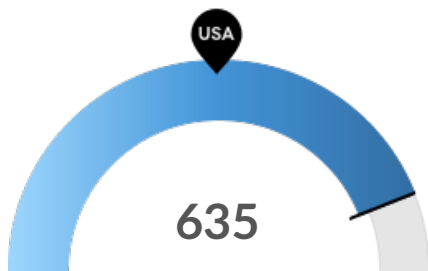
Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is high in Lincoln County, NV. The national average for an area this size is 1,314 people 55 or older, while there are 1,716 here.



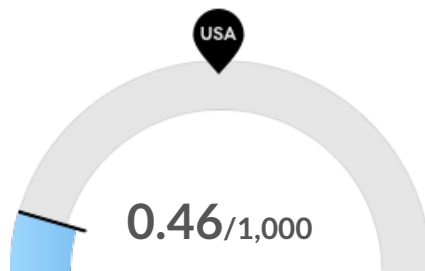
Racial Diversity

Lincoln County, NV has 0.46 violent crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 3.38 per 1,000 people.

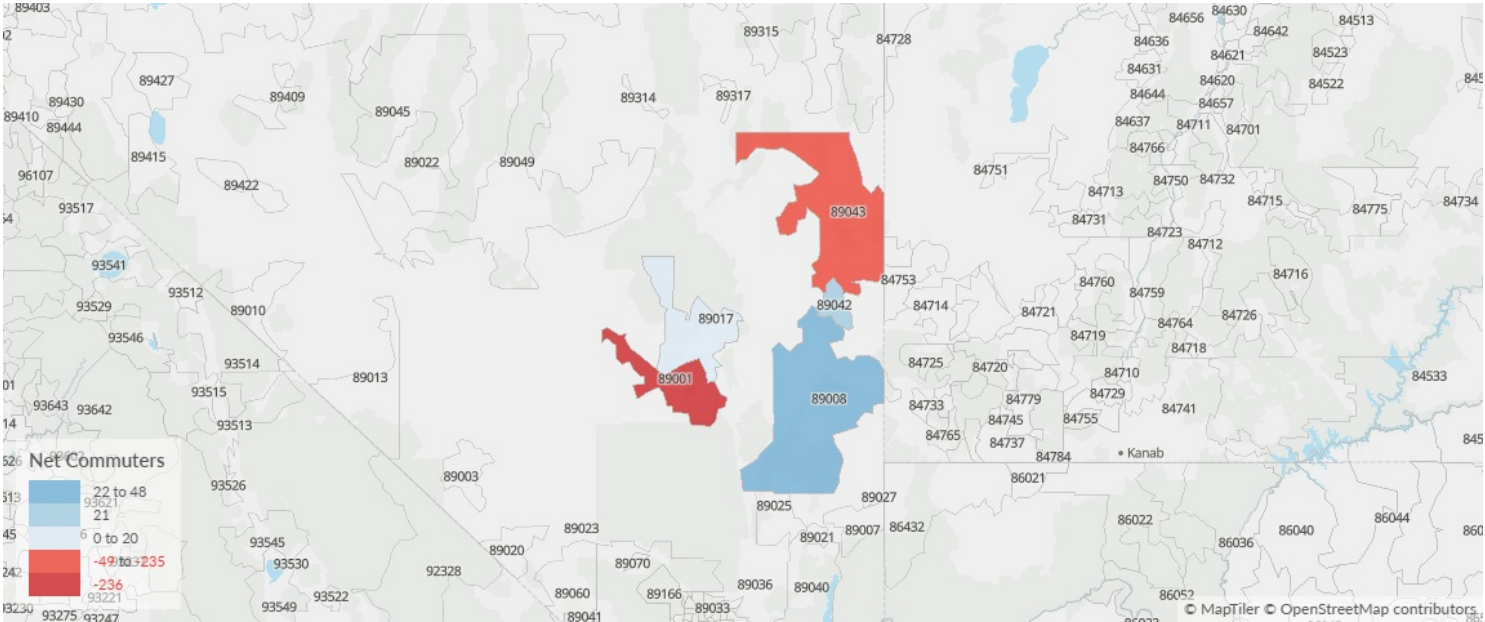

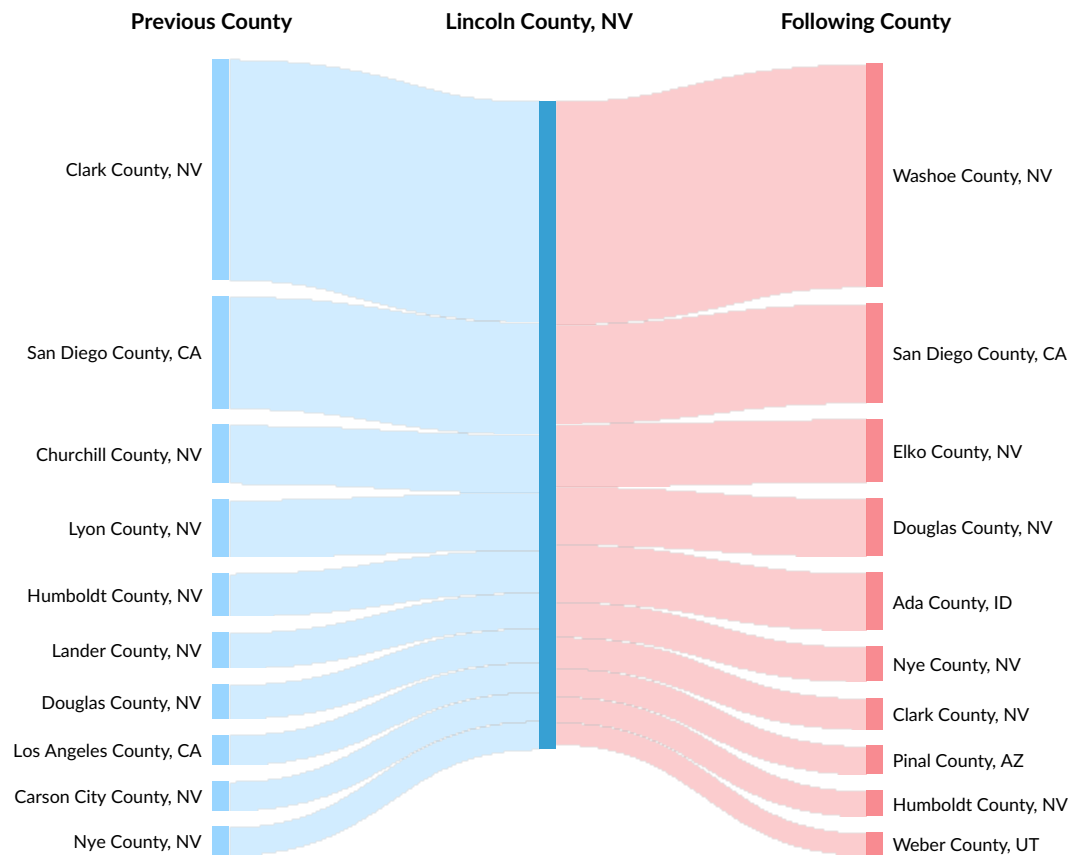

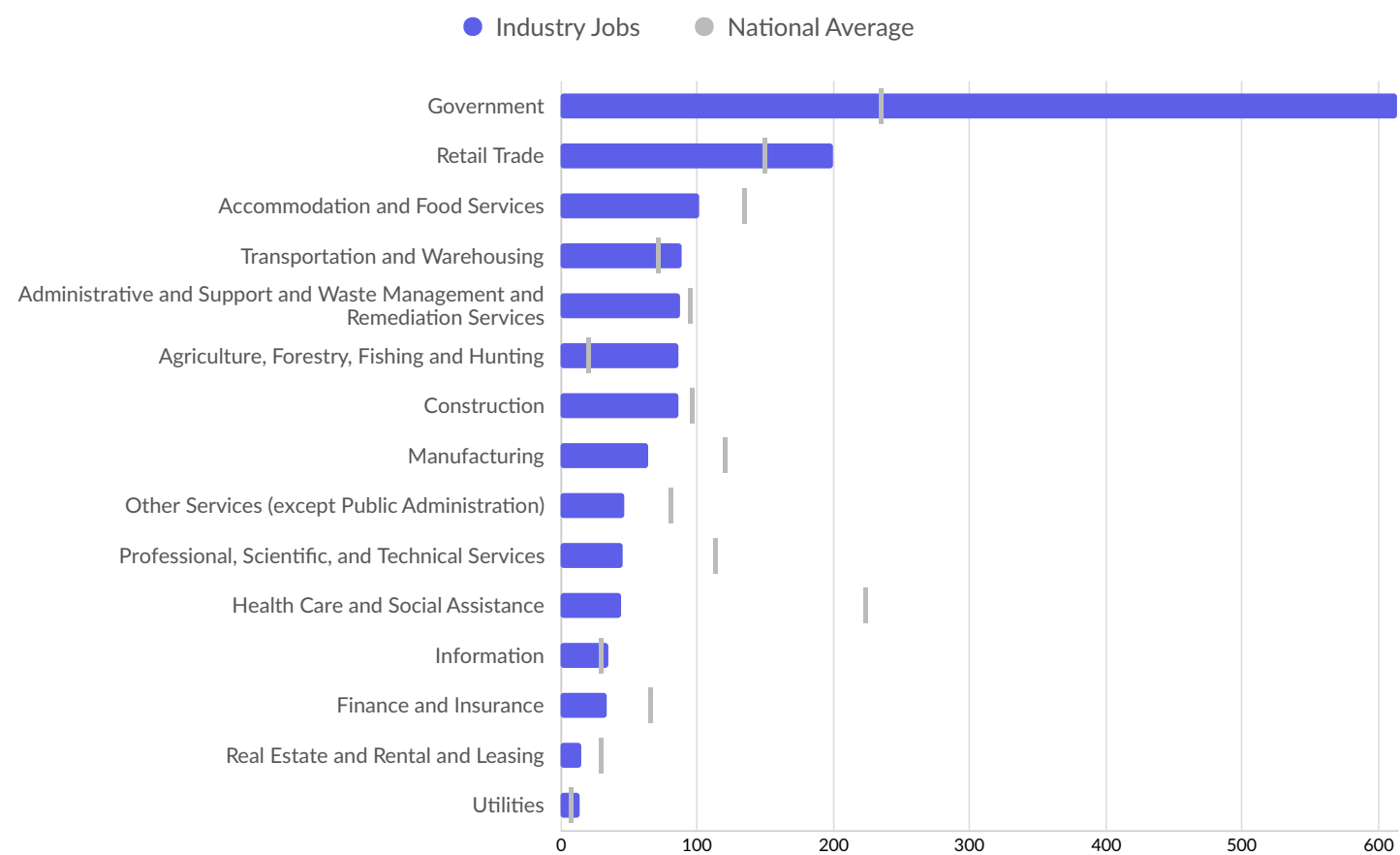

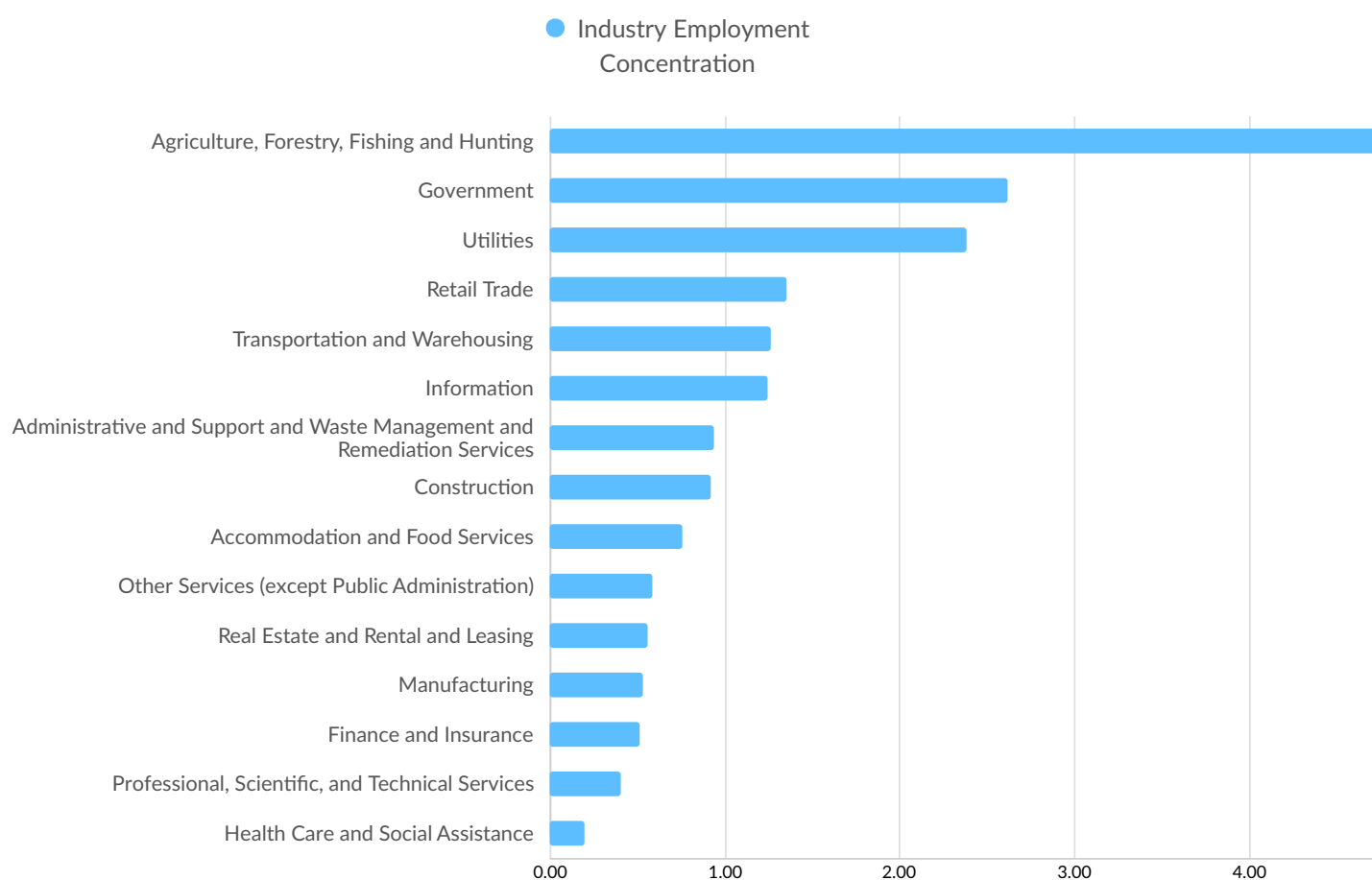

Top Industry Employment Concentration

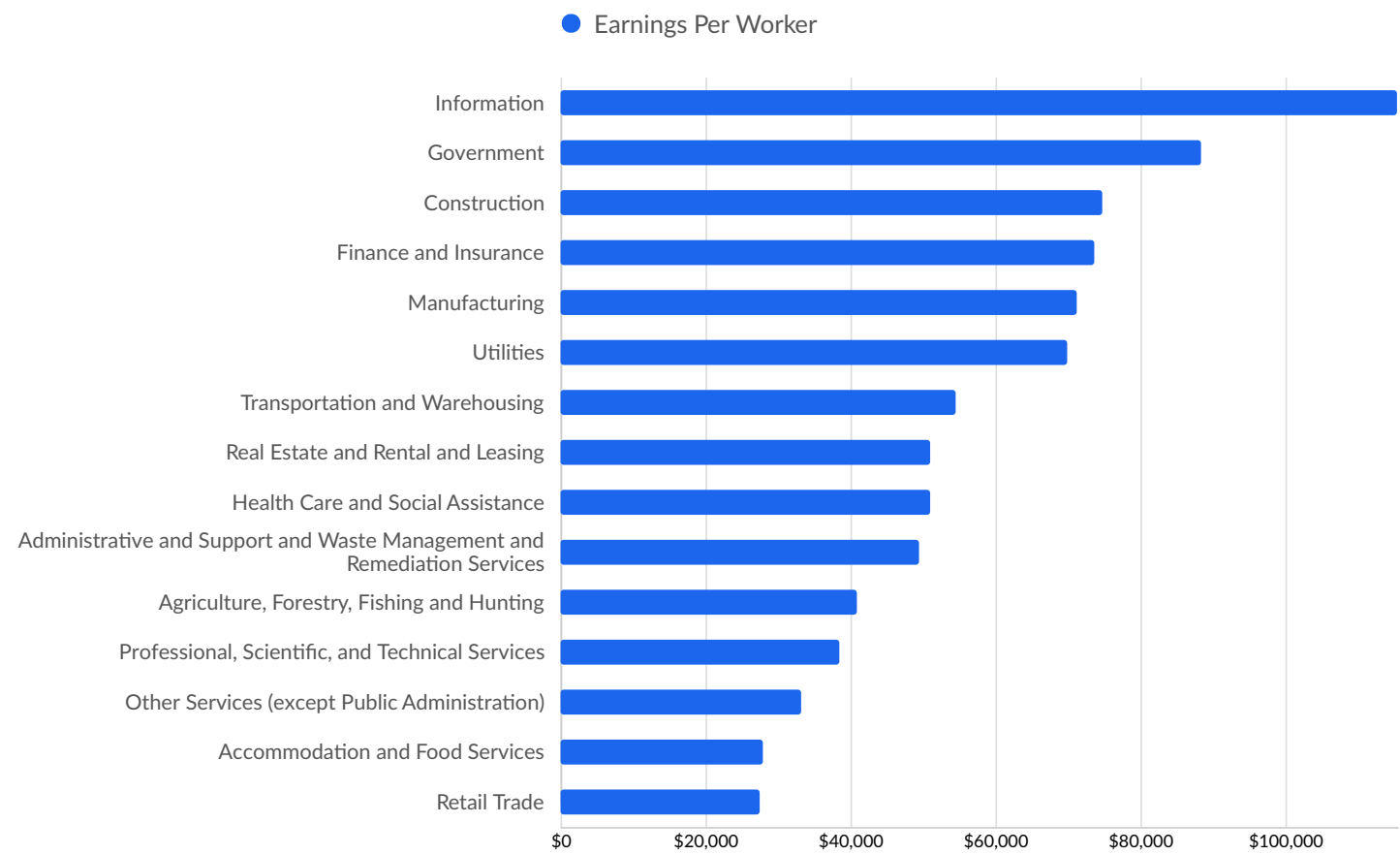


Top Industry GRP

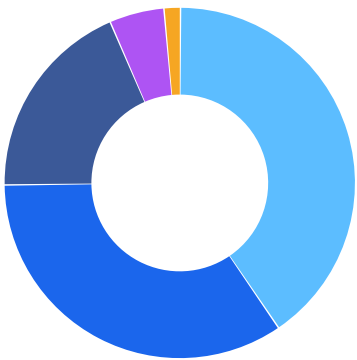
