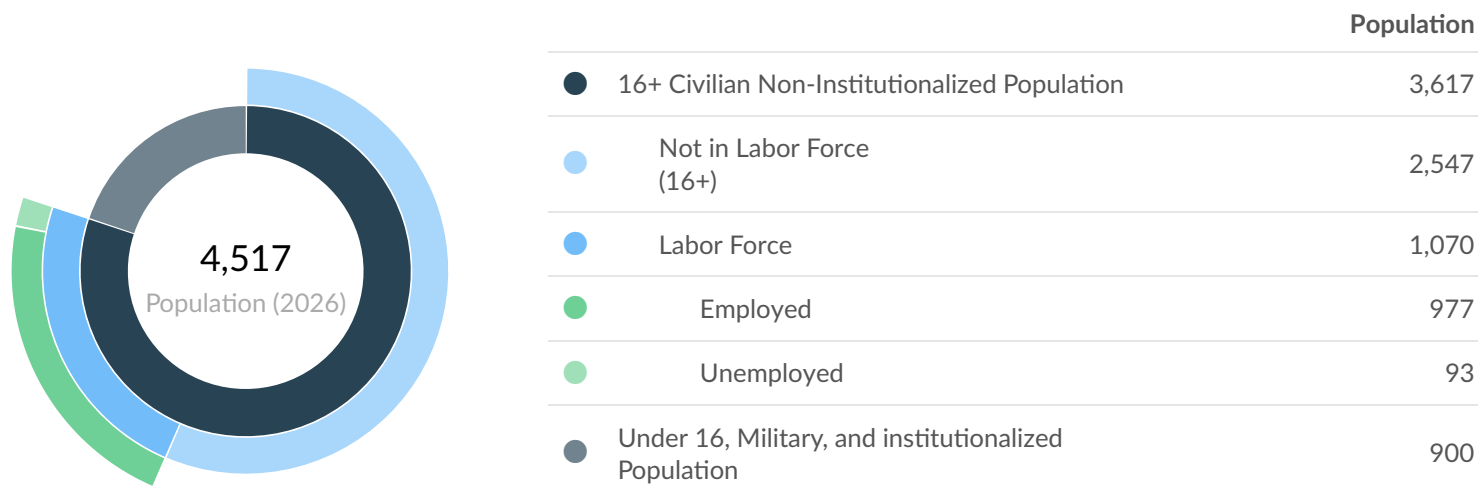
Median household income is **\$25.9K below** the national median household income of \$80.7K.

Takeaways

- As of 2025 the region's population **declined by 1.4%** since 2020, falling by 62. Population is expected to **increase by 1.3%** between 2025 and 2030, adding 56.
- From 2020 to 2025, jobs **declined by 34.1%** in Mineral County, NV from 1,803 to **1,188**. This change **fell short of the national growth rate of 10.7% by 44.8%**. As the number of jobs declined, the **labor force participation rate decreased from 47.9% to 29.1% between 2020 and 2025**.
- Concerning educational attainment, **9.4% of Mineral County, NV residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (12.5% below the national average), and **7.2% hold an Associate's Degree** (1.6% below the national average).
- The top three industries in 2025 are Local Government, Excluding Education and Hospitals, Education and Hospitals (Local Government), and Traveler Accommodation.

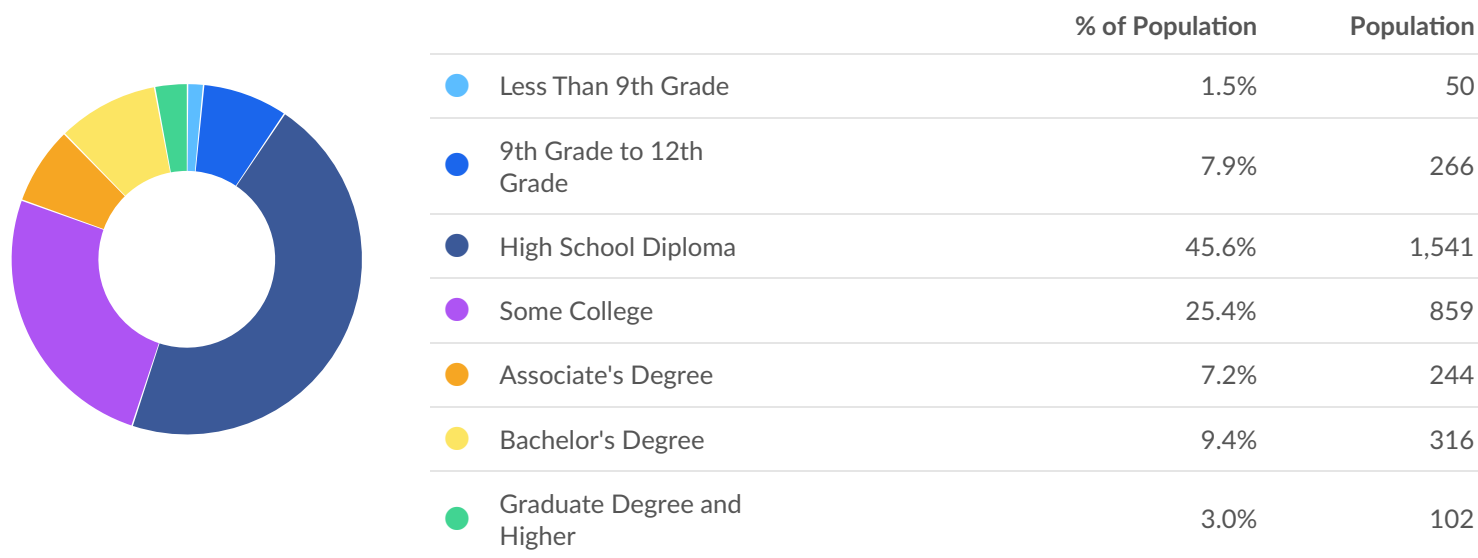

Jun 2026 Labor Force Breakdown



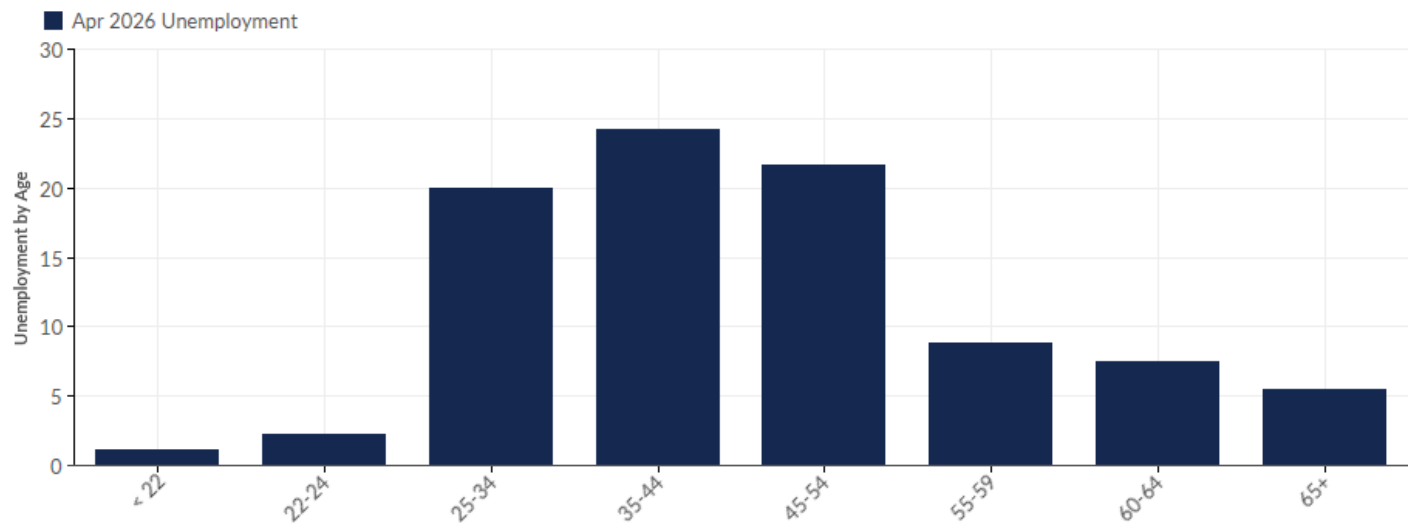
Educational Attainment

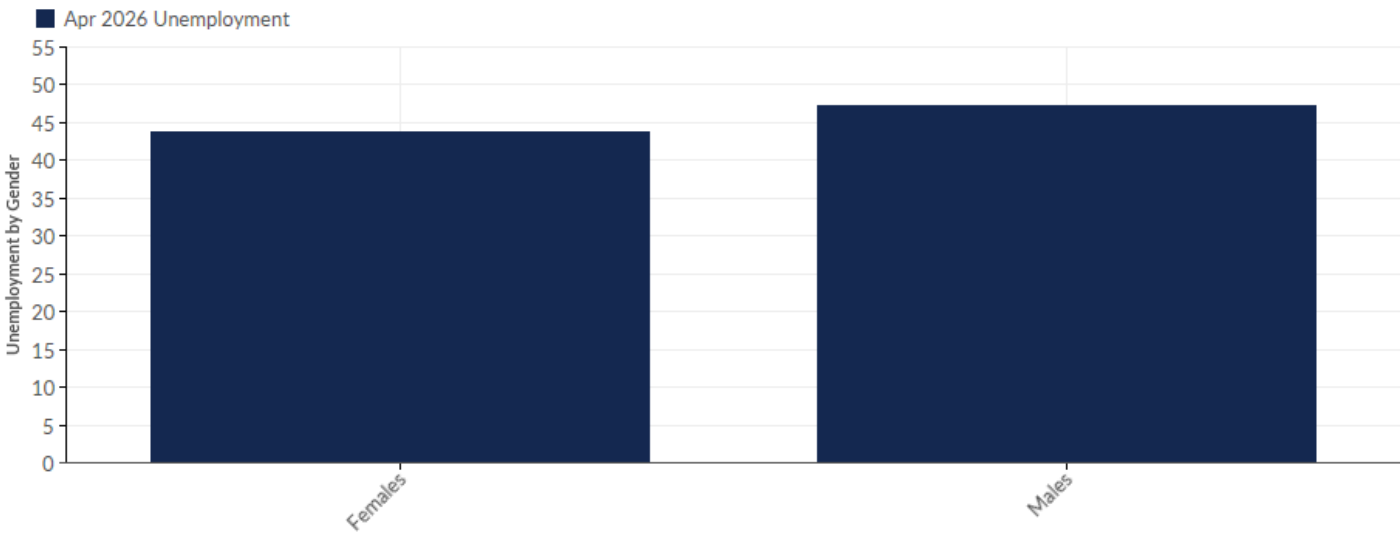

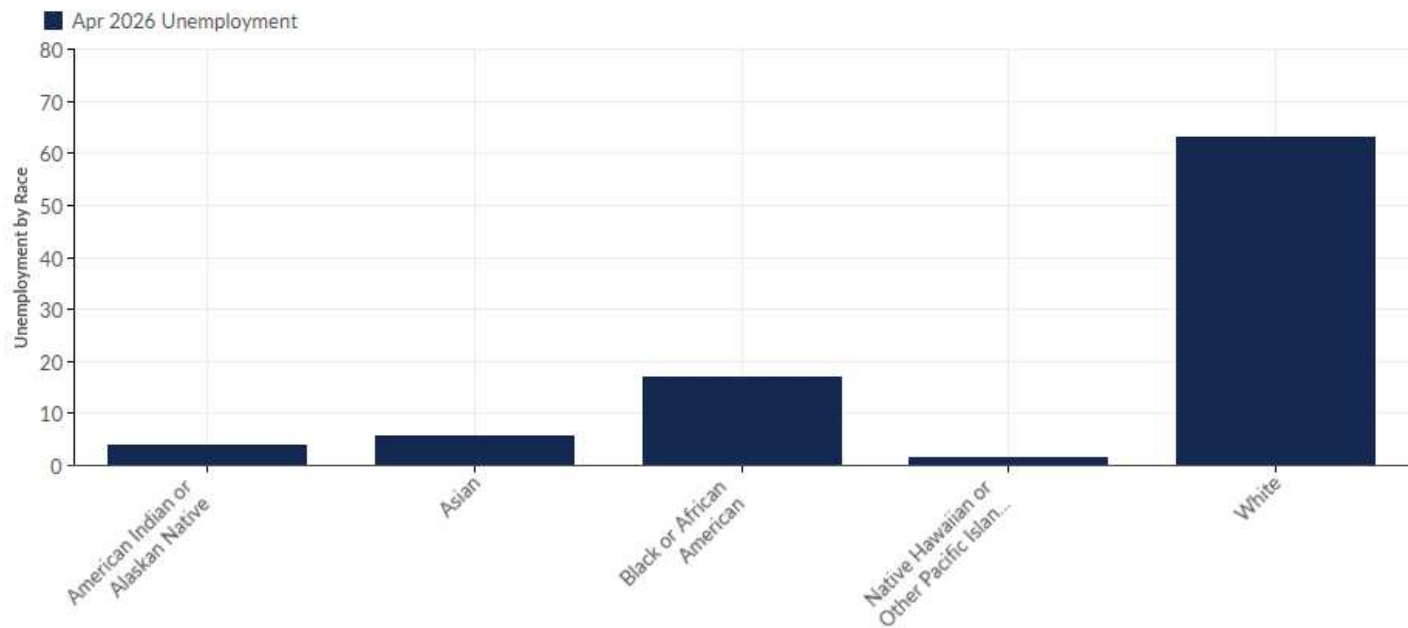

Unemployment by Gender



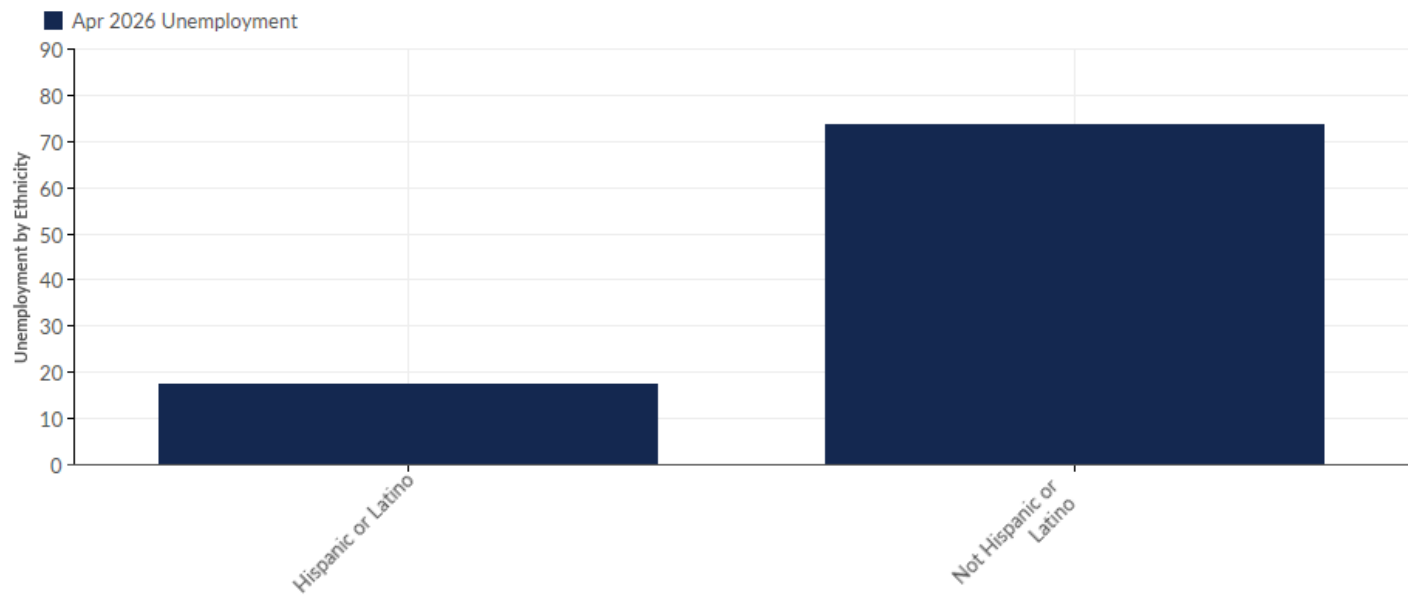

Unemployment by Ethnicity

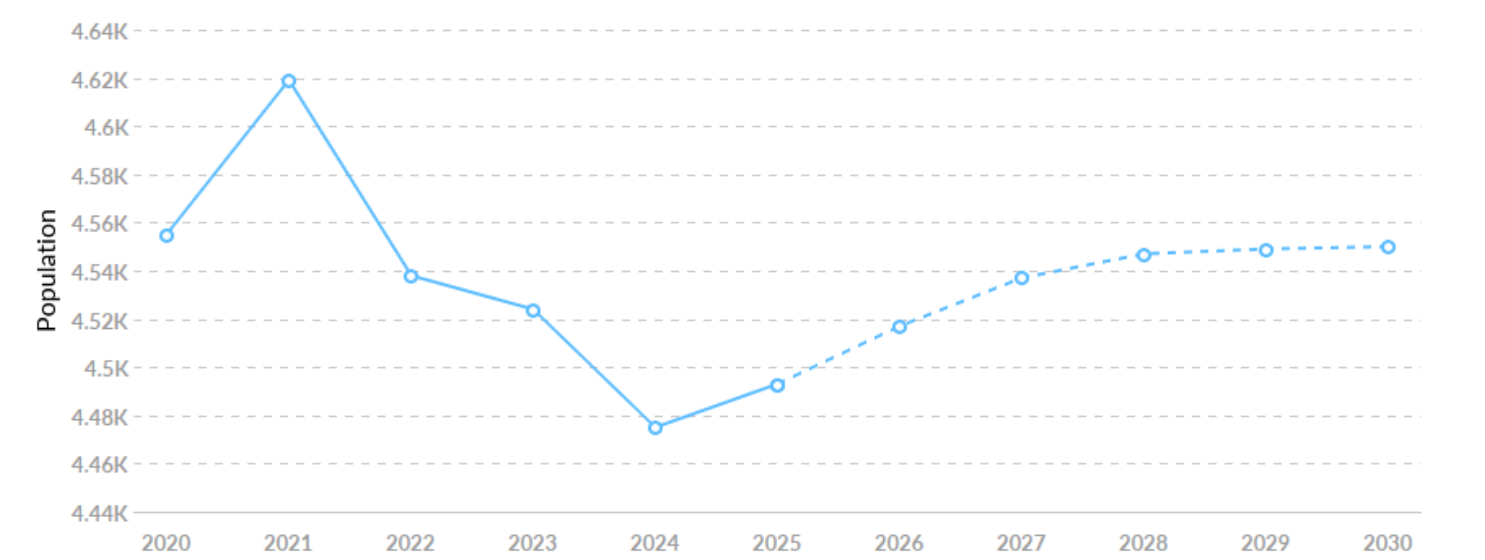

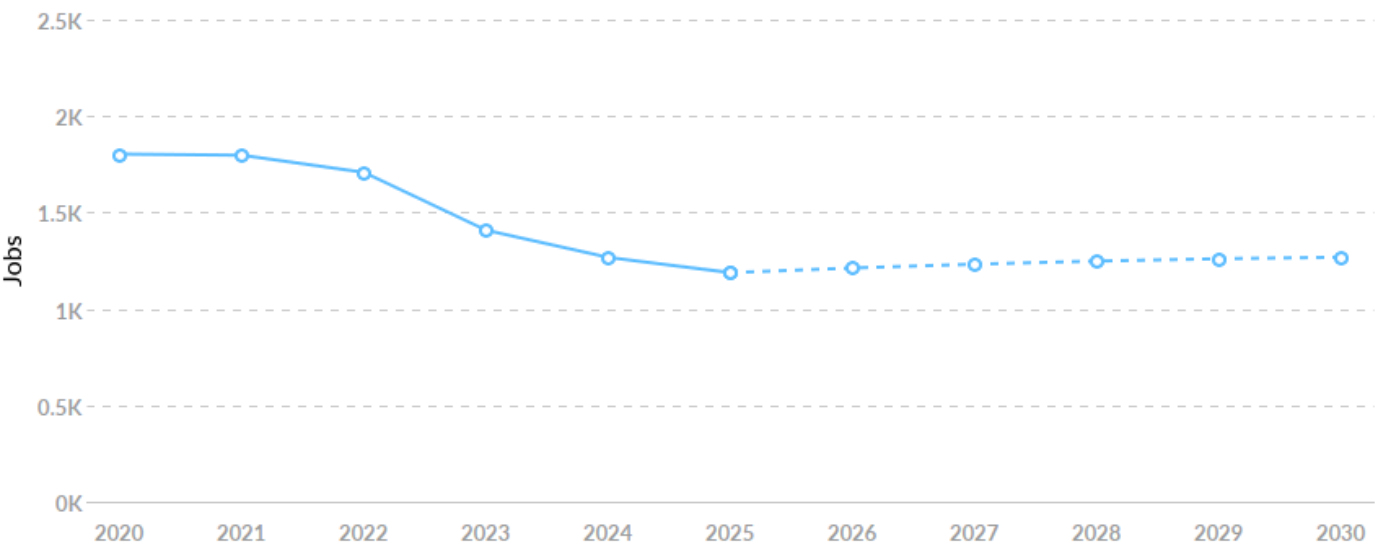

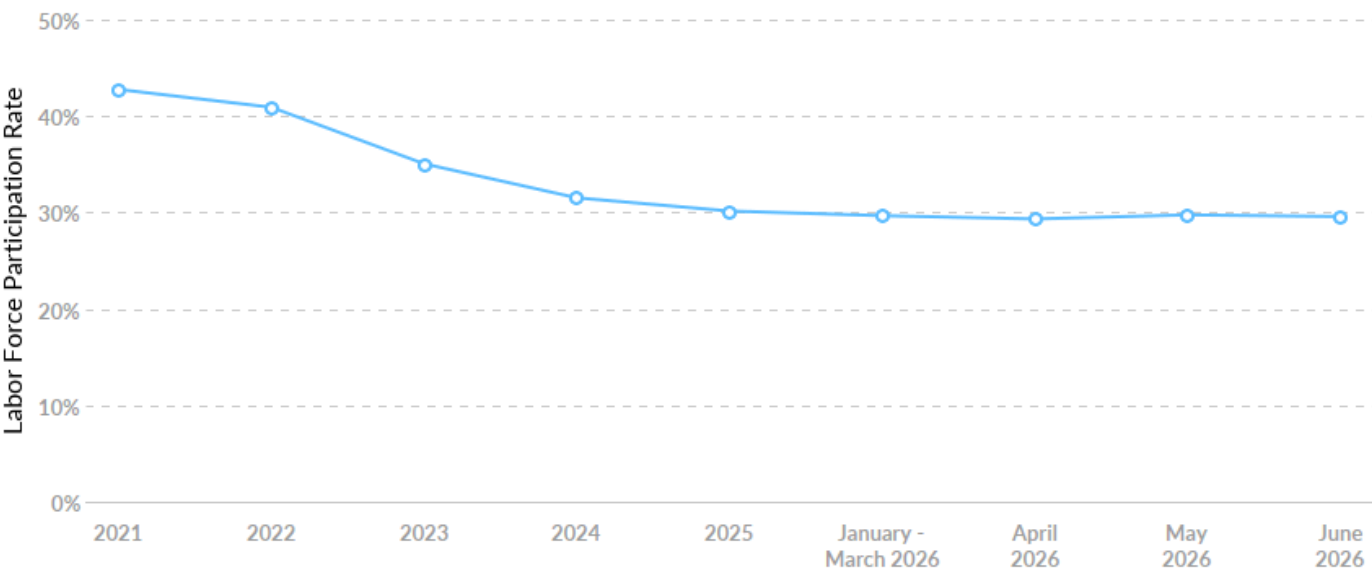
Job Trends

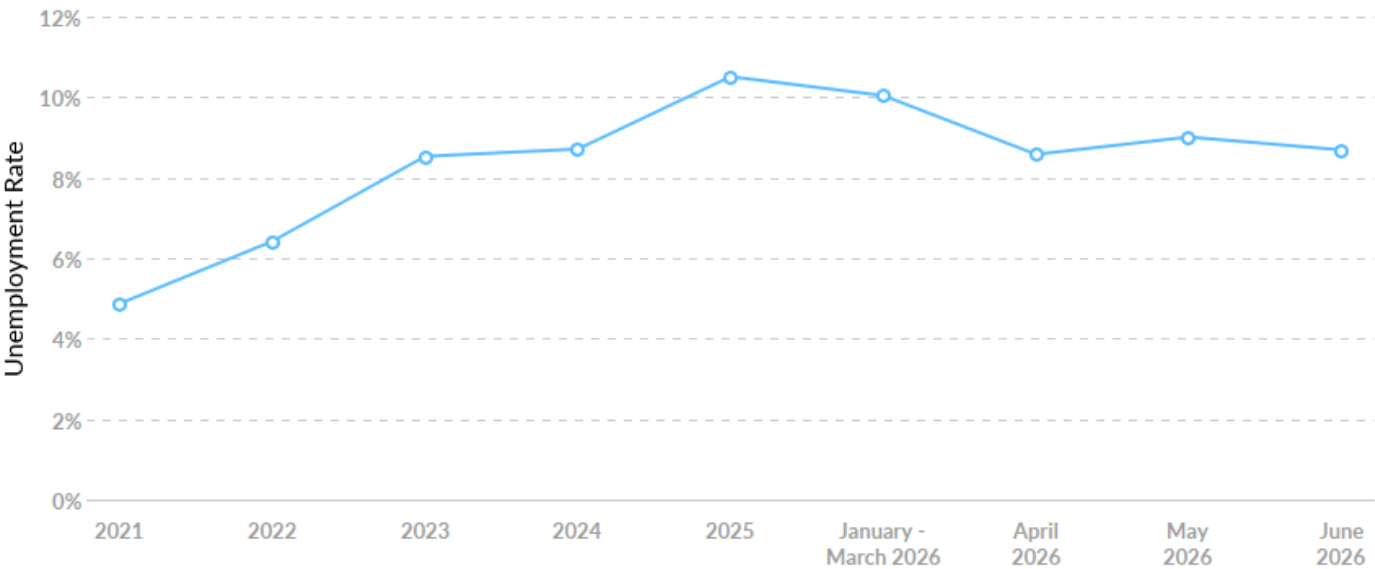

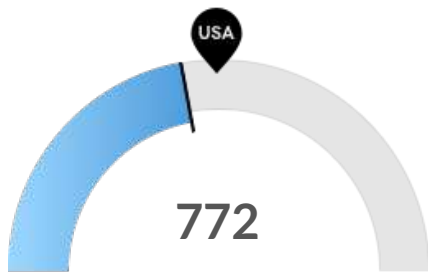
Unemployment Rate Trends

Mineral County, NV had a June 2026 unemployment rate of 8.69%, **increasing from 4.87%** 5 years before.



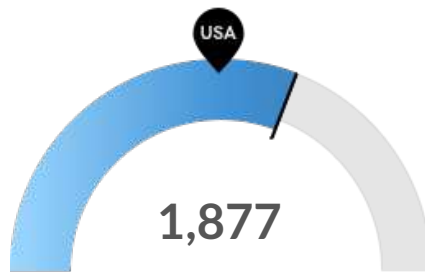

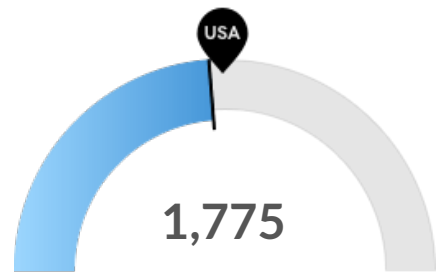
Millennials

Mineral County, NV has 772 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 916.



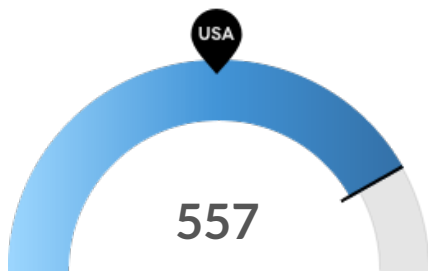
Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is high in Mineral County, NV. The national average for an area this size is 1,353 people 55 or older, while there are 1,877 here.



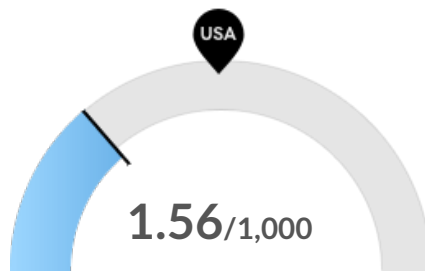
Racial Diversity

Racial diversity is about average in Mineral County, NV. The national average for an area this size is 1,904 racially diverse people, while there are 1,775 here.



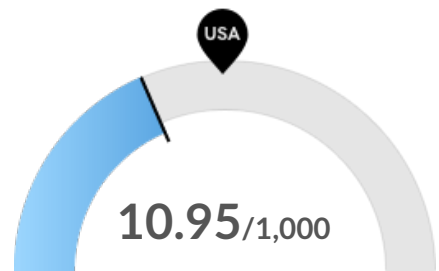
Veterans

Mineral County, NV has 1.56 violent crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 3.38 per 1,000 people.

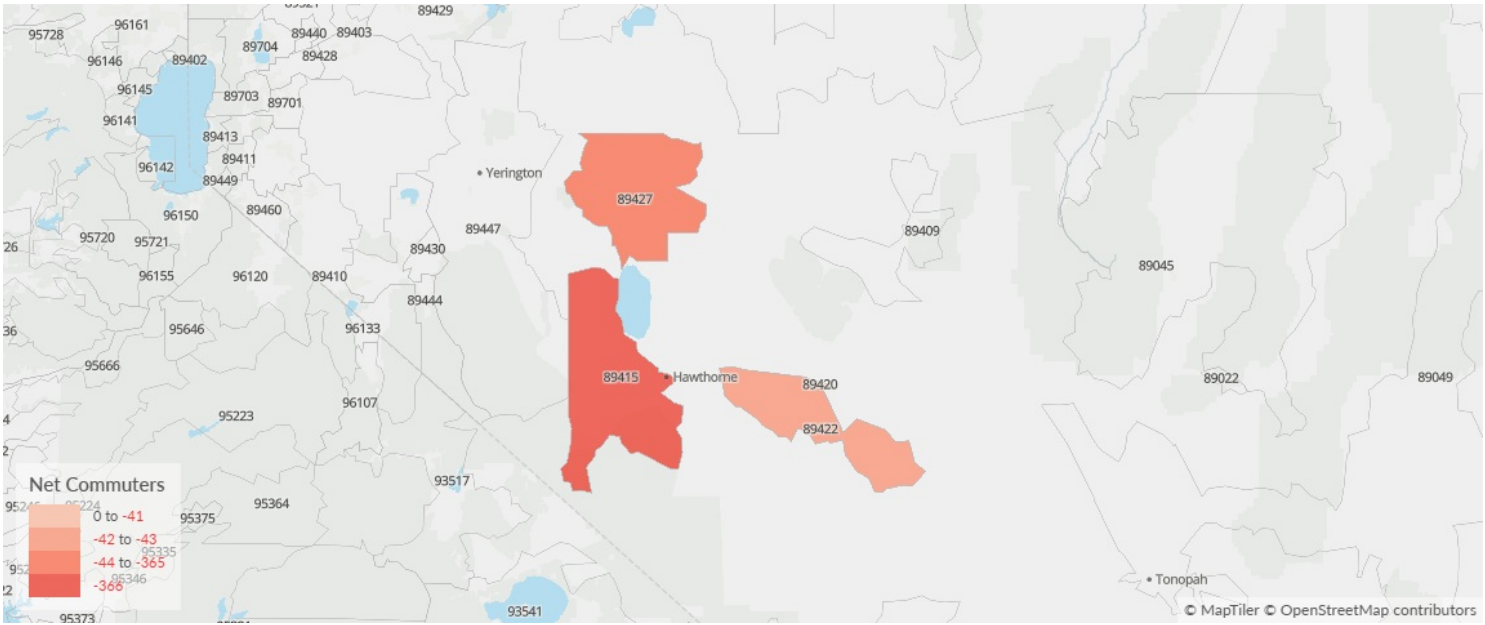


Property Crime

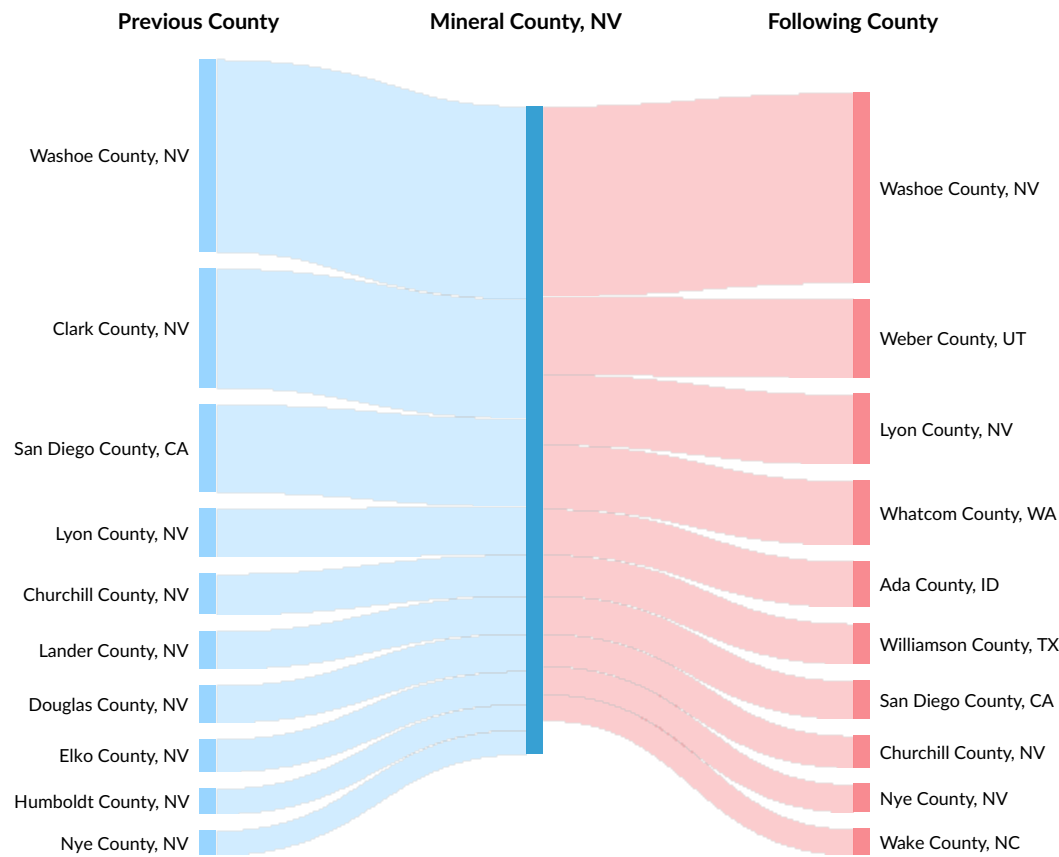

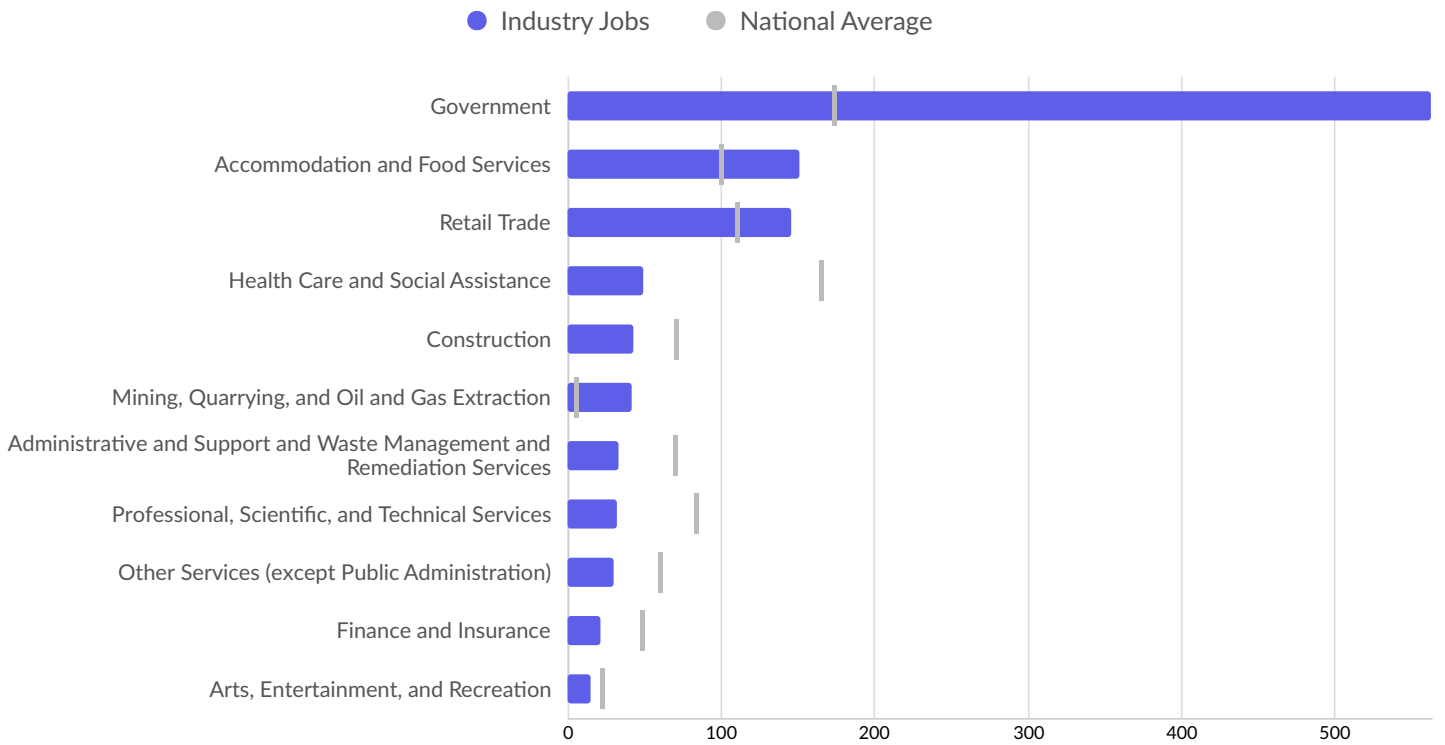

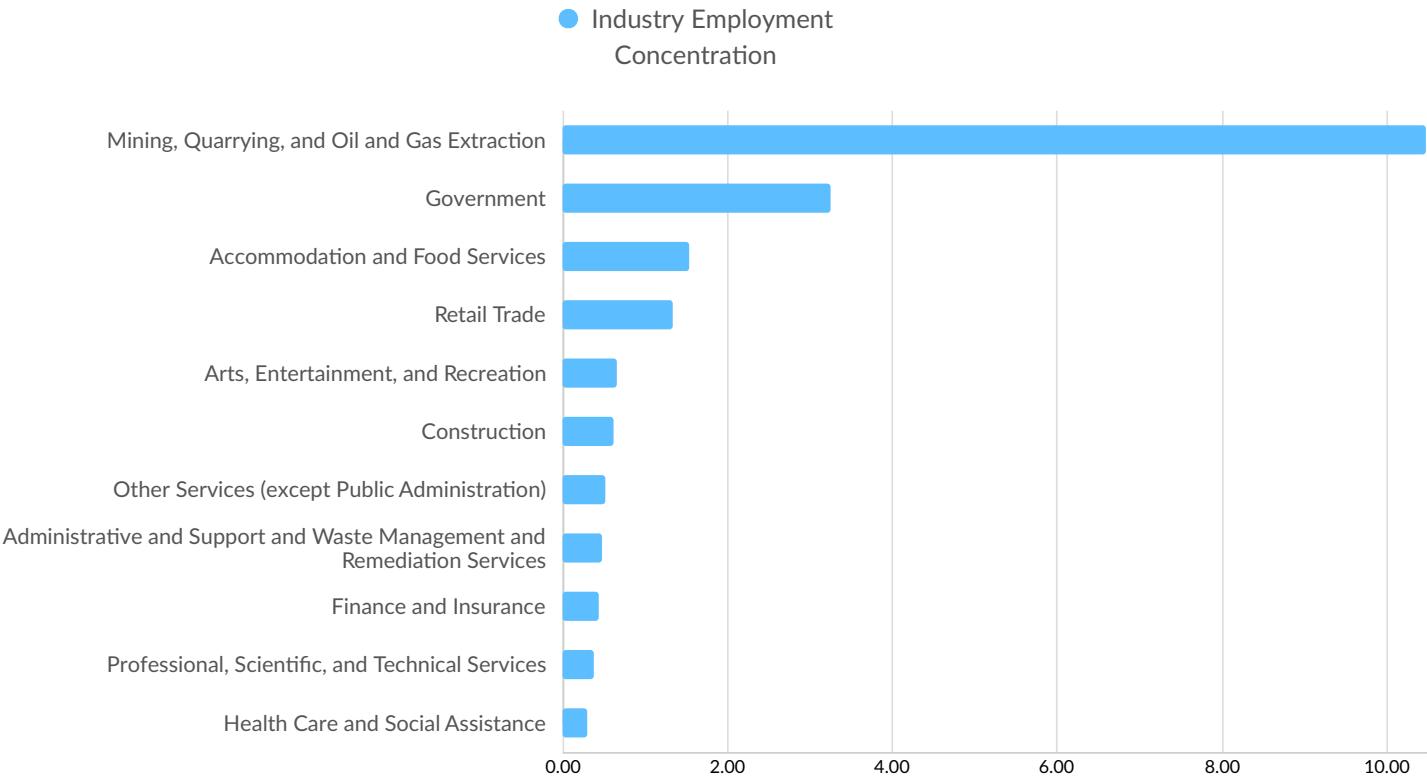

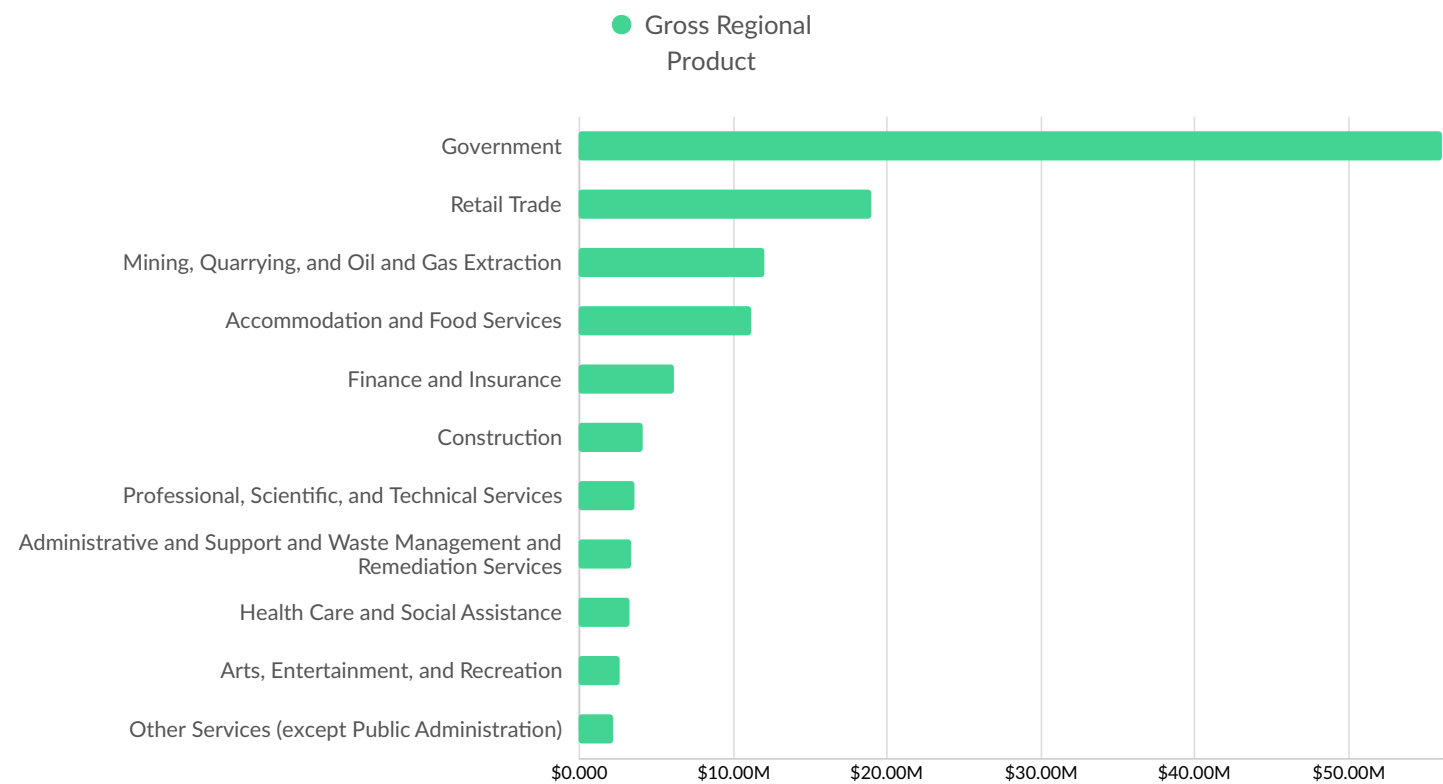
Top Growing Industries



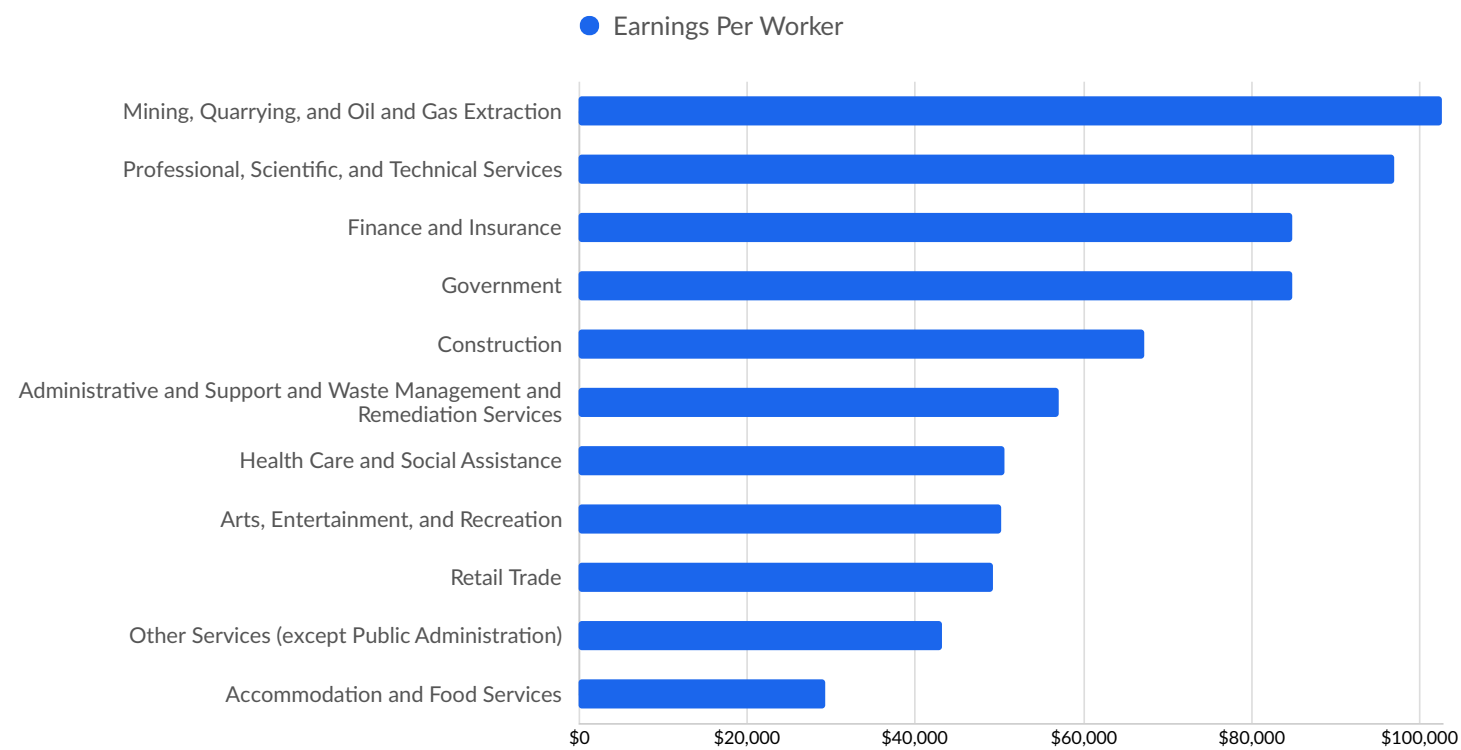
Top Industry Employment Concentration

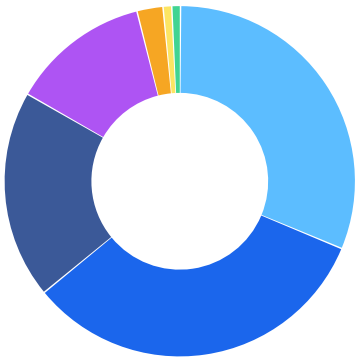

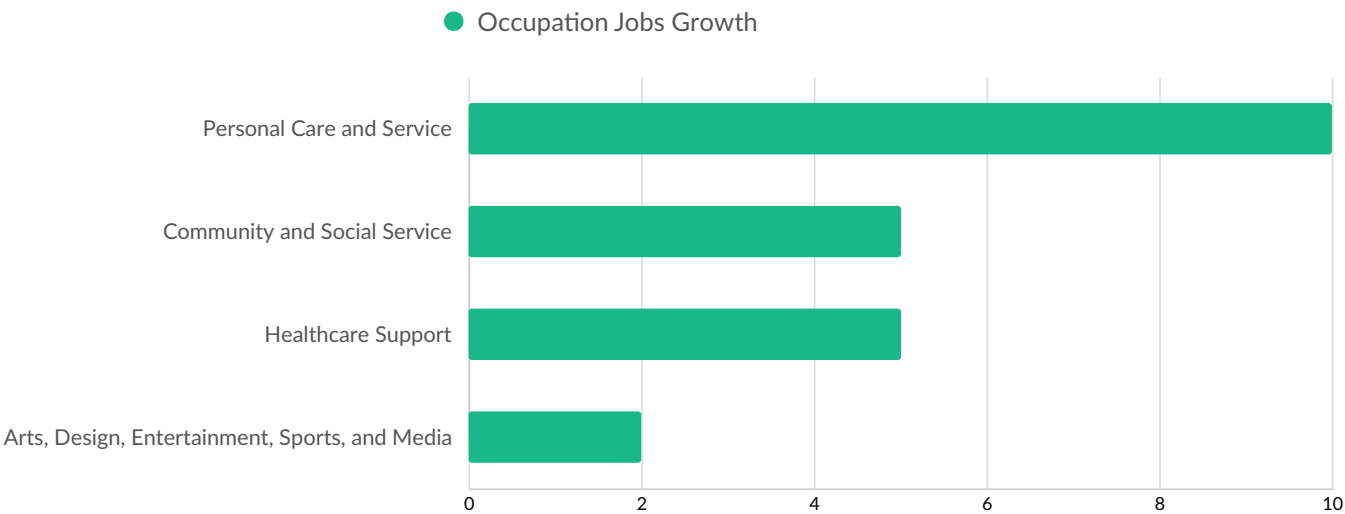

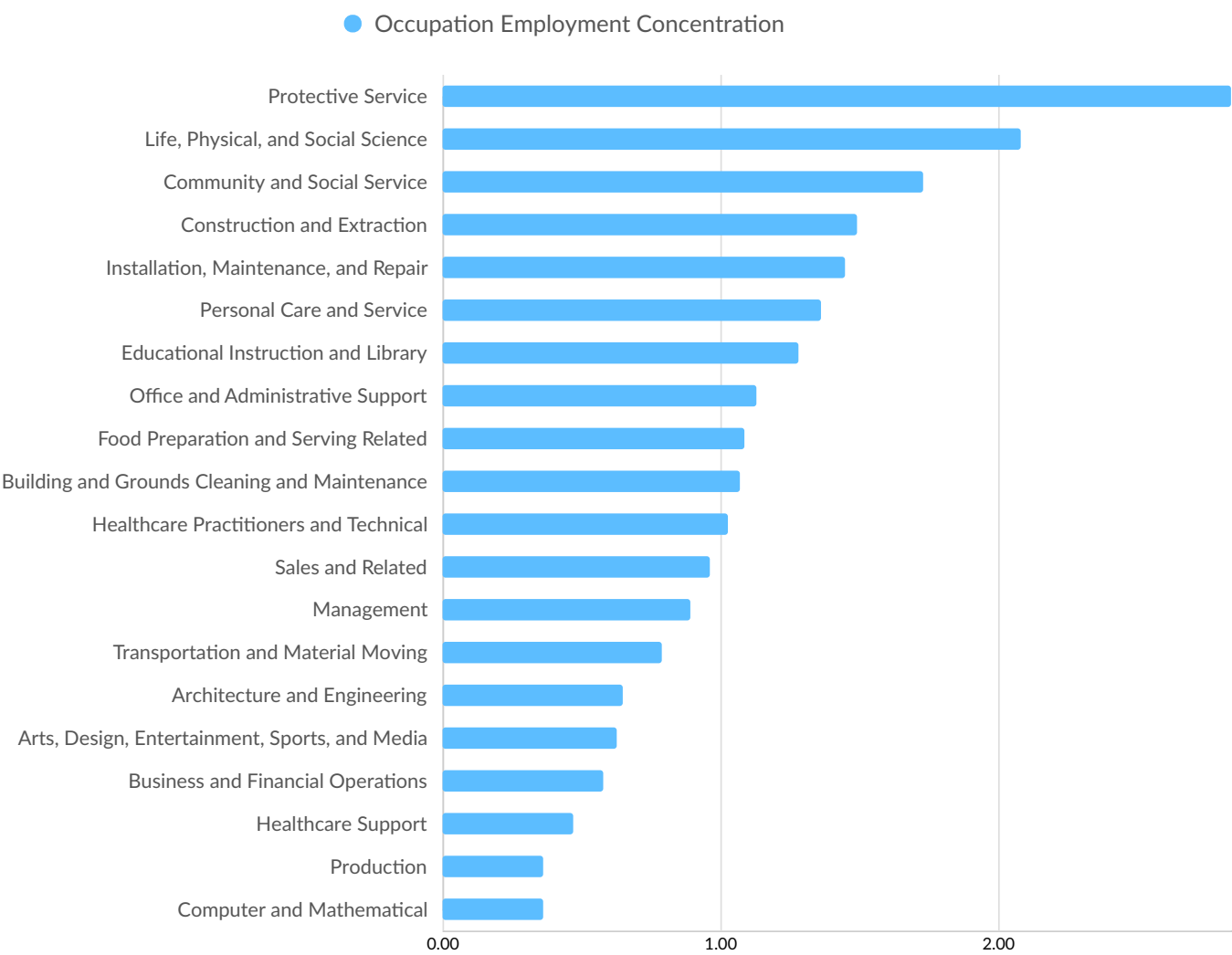

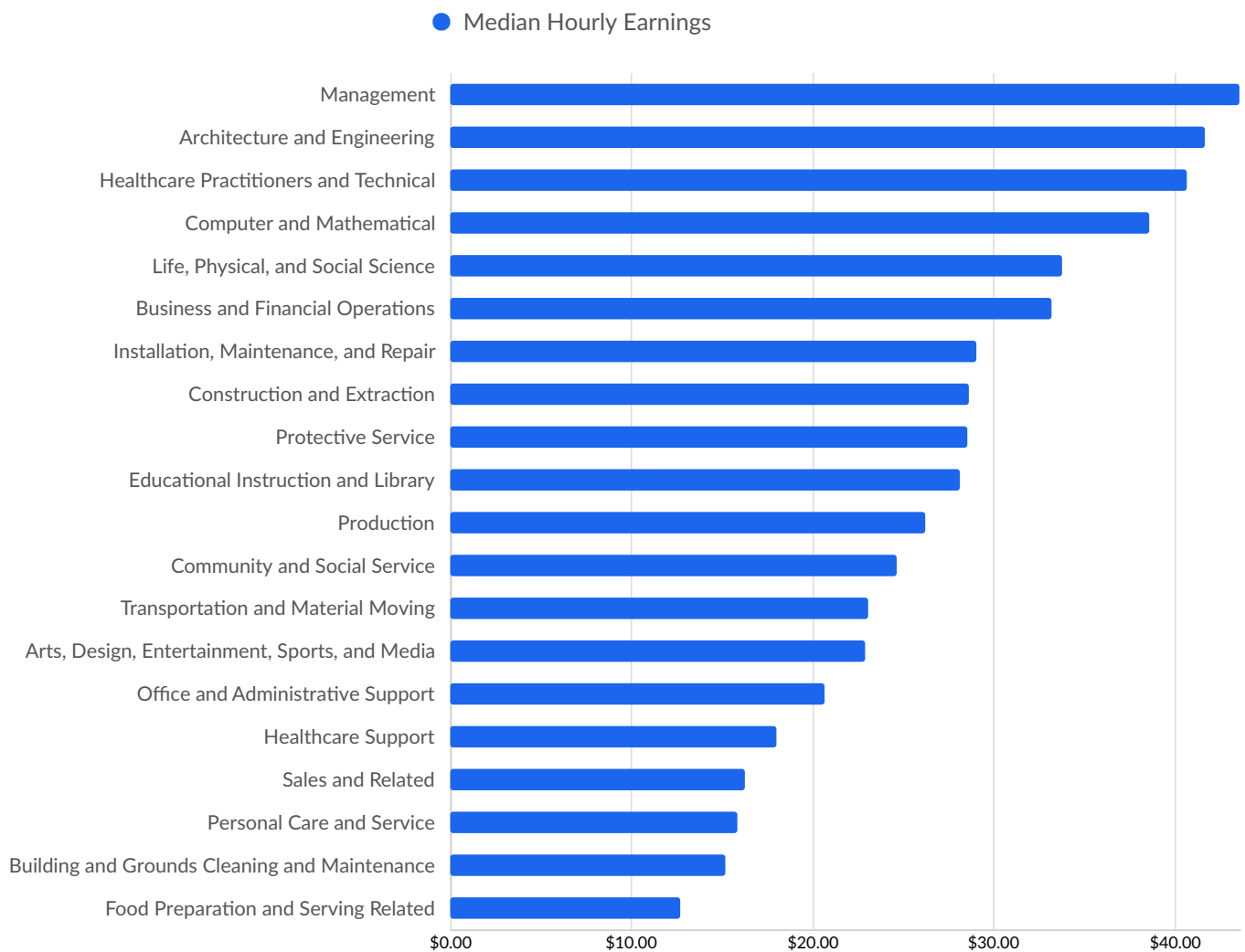
Top Growing Occupations



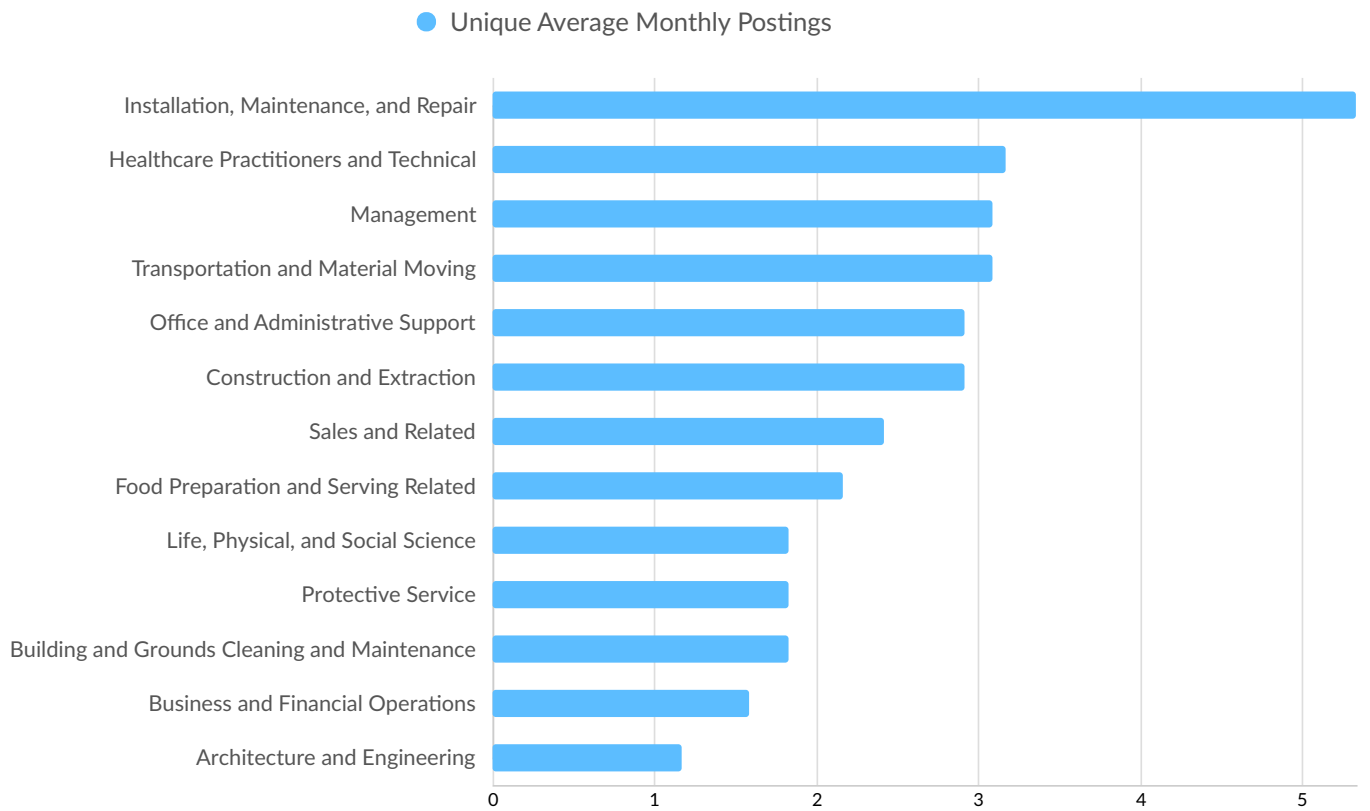
Top Occupation Employment Concentration



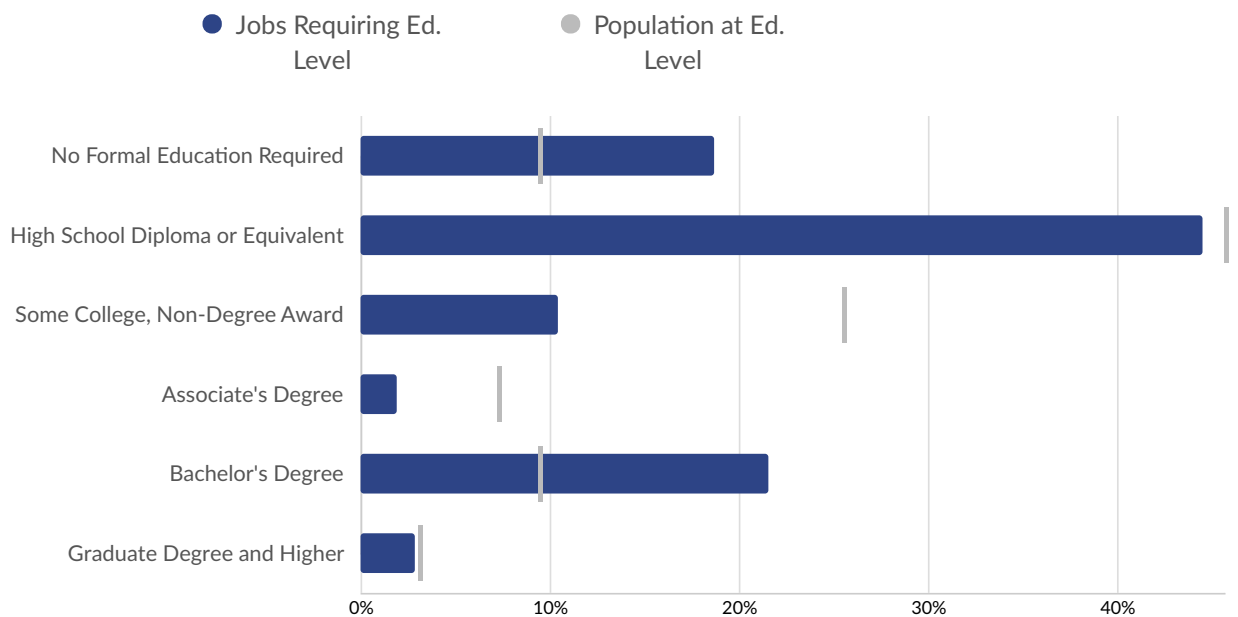
